FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed by the owners of the subject property, Robert and Jill Lewis. The Petitioners request a special hearing to approve a waiver, pursuant to Section 500.6 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), of Sections 517.1 (510.1) of the Building Code, and Sections 26-670 and 26-172(a)(3) of the Baltimore County Code, to build a single family dwelling in a tidal floodplain. In addition, the Petitioners request a variance from Section 1A04.3.B.2 of the B.C.Z.R. to permit (side) property line setbacks of 22 feet each in lieu of the required 50 feet, a street centerline setback of 65 feet in lieu of the required 75 feet, and approval of the subject lot as an undersized lot, and any other variances deemed necessary to permit redevelopment of the property with a single family dwelling. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request were Jill Lewis, property owner, and Don Schmelzer, a nearby neighbor. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is a waterfront lot, with frontage on Galloway Creek and Burke Road in Bowleys Quarters. The property contains a gross area of .32 acres, more or less, zoned R.C.5 and is improved with a single family dwelling

which was built in 1924. The Petitioners have owned and resided on the property since 1993 and are desirous of razing the existing dwelling and constructing a new home in its place. However, due to the location of the property and it's zoning classification, the requested relief is necessary in order to proceed with the proposed improvements.

Presently, the existing dwelling features 21-foot side yard setbacks on both sides. The new dwelling will be slightly narrower and increase those setbacks to 22 feet on each side. However, 50-foot setbacks are required in the R.C.5 zone. In addition, the Petitioners propose to relocate the building envelope 8 feet closer to Burke Road. It was indicated that the house is being shifted in that direction due to environmental concerns raised by the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM). Apparently, DEPRM desires that as large a setback as possible be maintained from the dwelling to the bulkhead at the water. Thus, the requested street centerline setback of 65 feet in lieu of the required 75 feet is sought. As for the Petition for Special Hearing, the property is located within a tidal floodplain. Thus, the Petitioners request the appropriate waiver to permit construction of the new dwelling.

As noted above, no one appeared in opposition to the request. In fact, Ms. Lewis indicated that her neighbors support the request and believe that the new house will be an improvement to the Petitioners' lot and surrounding neighborhood. Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from several agencies, however, which offer certain recommendations. DEPRM notes that development on the property must be in compliance with the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area regulations and that an evaluation of the septic system must be conducted prior to building permit approval. Ms. Lewis indicated that she was aware that the property need comply with the Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas regulations and had already contacted DEPRM about an evaluation of the septic system. She indicated no opposition to the inclusion of that comment as a restriction on the grant of the special hearing and variance relief.

It is also to be noted that the Petitioners submitted building elevation drawings for review by the Office of Planning, which approved same on March 5, 2001. Thus, the new dwelling shall be constructed in accordance with the approved drawings.

A ZAC comment was also received from Robert W. Bowling of the Development Plans Review Division of the Department of Permits and Development Management (DPDM). This comment offers a number of recommendations relating to the redevelopment of the subject property, including the creation of a 15' x 15' drainage and utility easement for a simplex sewer grinder pump when public sewer becomes available to this property. In this regard, it is to be noted that although the property is served by public water, a private septic system is in place. Although construction is in the area to bring public sewer to this property and the surrounding community, those public improvements have not yet been completed. The Petitioner indicated a willingness to accept the conditions contained within Mr. Bowling's recommendation. Ultimately, the dwelling will be connected to public sewer when such utilities are made available.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this day of April, 2001 that the Petition for Special Hearing to approve a waiver, pursuant to Section 500.6 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), of Sections 517.1 (510.1) of the Building Code, and Sections 26-670 and 26-172(a)(3) of the Baltimore County Code, to build a single family dwelling in a tidal floodplain, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from Section 1A04.3.B.2 of the B.C.Z.R. to permit (side) property line setbacks of 22 feet each in lieu of the required 50 feet, a centerline setback of 65 feet in lieu of the required 75 feet, and approval of the subject lot as an undersized lot, and any other variances deemed necessary to permit redevelopment of the subject property with a single family dwelling, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restrictions:

1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.

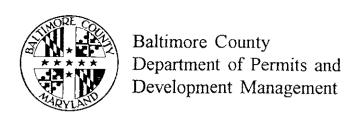

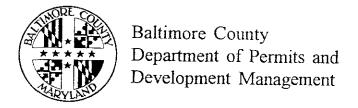

The Bureau of Development Plans Review has reviewed the subject zoning item.

In conformance with Federal Flood Insurance requirements, the first floor or basement floor must be at least I foot over the flood plain elevation in all construction.

The property to be developed is located adjacent to tidewater. The developer is advised that the proper sections of the Baltimore County Building Code must be followed whereby elevation limitations are placed on the lowest floor (including basements) of residential (commercial) development.

Minimum flood protection elevation is 11 feet for this site.

The proposed building or additions shall be designed and adequately anchored to prevent flotation, collapse, or lateral movement of the structure with materials resistant to flood damage.

Additionally, the Miami Beach Collection Sewer System design has been completed with construction of the pressure sewer approximately two years away. Enclosed is a drawing showing the proposed grinder pump, number 136, for the existing house at 1612 Burke Road.

We are requesting the owner set aside the 15-foot by 15-foot drainage and utility easement shown on Lot #175 for a simplex sewer grinder pump to supply public sewer service to the dwelling.
