This matter came before this Board on a Petition for Special Hearing for 5934 Ebenezer Road and a Petition for Special Hearing and Petition for Variance for 5936 Ebenezer Road. The properties adjoin each other and are zoned R.C. 2. Petitioners sought to develop an undersized lot at 5936 Ebenezer Road that adjoins their home place at 5934 Ebenezer Road. Both properties are located on a public road less then 30 feet wide and both lots are undersized under the current zoning regulations.

The Zoning Commissioner granted the relief requested in both cases. The Office of People's Counsel filed a timely *de novo* appeal.

The matter was scheduled for hearing on June 24, 2003 before the County Board of Appeals. Petitioners were duly advised of the hearing date. Deputy People's Counsel, Carole S. Demilio, was present at the Board hearing at 10:00 a.m. and was prepared for trial. Ms. Demilio requested the Petitions be dismissed with prejudice in light of Petitioners' failure to appear and to notify the Board.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

These matters come before the Zoning Commissioner for a single public hearing to consider Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance for adjacent parcels owned by Paul L. Schlogel, Sr., and his wife, Louise B. Schlogel. In Case No. 03-136-SPH, the Petitioners request a special hearing for a determination that there is no conflict with Section 304.1.C of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) for an existing dwelling known as 5934 Ebenezer Road. In Case No. 03-137-SPHA, the Petitioners request approval of the adjacent property, known as 5936 Ebenezer Road, as an undersized lot, pursuant to Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R., and variance relief from Sections 1A01.3.B.2 and 3, and Section 102.4 of the B.C.Z.R. as follows: to allow side yard setbacks of 15 feet and 20 feet in lieu of the required 35 feet; to allow a lot area of 17,905 sq.ft. in lieu of the minimum required 1.0 acre; and to allow construction of a dwelling on a public right-of-way less than 30 feet wide and approval of the subject property as an undersized lot. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the respective site plans submitted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibits 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the requests were Paul and Louise Schlogel, property owners. Appearing as an interested person was Daryl Webster, who owns an adjacent property. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

ORDER CHAMBER OF STATE OF STAT

As noted above, the requests relate to two adjacent lots located on the north side of Ebenezer Road, just east of Pulaski Highway (Maryland Route 40) and Bird River in eastern Baltimore County. Case No. 03-136-SPH relates to a roughly rectangular shaped parcel, identified on the site plan as Lot A, which is approximately 130 feet wide and 246 feet deep, and contains approximately 33,716 sq.ft. in area zoned R.C.2. The property is improved with a two-story single family dwelling, known as 5934 Ebenezer Road, and a detached garage and frame shed.

Case No. 03-137-SPHA relates to the adjacent unimproved lot, identified on the plan as Lot B and known as 5936 Ebenezer Road. This parcel is irregularly shaped, approximately 67 feet wide and 137 feet deep, and contains 17,905 sq.ft. in area also zoned R.C.5. Testimony indicated that public water and sewer serve both parcels. It was also indicated that the two parcels were recorded as separate lots many years ago and the Petitioners receive separate tax bills for each lot.

The Petitioners have resided on Lot A, also known as 5934 Ebenezer Road, for many years. In this regard, testimony indicated that the existing house was built in 1936 and that Mr. Schlogel's uncle purchased the property in 1954. The Petitioners subsequently acquired the property from Mr. Schlogel's uncle and have resided there since that time. The Petitioners now propose the construction of a single family dwelling on Lot B. In this regard, Mr. & Mrs. Schlogel wish to develop the lot adjacent to their existing dwelling so that Mr. Schlogel's parents can reside nearby. Testimony indicated that Mr. Schlogel's parents are elderly and will reside in the new house upon its completion. Ultimately, it is anticipated that Mr. & Mrs. Schlogel will move to the new dwelling and one of their children will occupy the existing dwelling. As shown on the plan, the building envelope provides for a 26' x 48' structure thereon. However, due to the irregular shape of the lot and its narrow width, the requested relief is necessary in order to proceed.

It is also to be noted that Mr. & Mrs. Schlogel own two separate small lots located immediately adjacent to the rear of each respective lot. These small triangular parcels will be incorporated into the respective lots if the requested relief is granted. Although these smaller parcels are undevelopable, this additional acreage will obviously increase the size of the respective lots. Moreover, the Petitioners have no desire to develop those parcels independently.

Mr. Webster is an adjacent property owner and he appeared at the hearing to review the Petitioners' plans. There was an issue raised relative to the proposed driveway that will serve the new dwelling at 5936 Ebenezer Road. It was indicated that this driveway must be located where proposed due to the site constraints associated with this property.

Considering first the relief requested in Case No. 03-136-SPH, I am persuaded to grant the Petition for Special Hearing. This relief will legitimize the use of the property and existing single family dwelling known as 5934 Ebenezer Road. As noted above, the house was built in 1936 and therefore has existed on the property for many years. Moreover, the plan shows that the lot is sufficiently sized for that dwelling. There is no evidence that the continued residential use of that property will be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the locale.

In Case No. 03-137-SPHA, special hearing and variance relief is requested to allow development of the unimproved adjacent lot with a single family dwelling with insufficient side and rear yard setbacks. In this regard, one of the requested setbacks is from the common property line that divides Lots A and B. In effect, this is an internal lot line. Additionally, when the small triangular shaped parcel to the rear of Lot B as described above is added, a sufficient rear yard setback will be provided. Moreover, the additional acreage will likewise increase the overall size of the lot. The testimony and evidence presented was persuasive to a finding that variance relief should be granted in this case. The fact that Lot B has existed as a lot of record and has been taxed separately for many years is a persuasive factor. Thus, I am persuaded that relief can be granted without detrimental impacts to the surrounding locale.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on these Petitions held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this Aland and of November, 2002, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed in Case No. 03-136-SPH, seeking a determination that there is no conflict with Section 304.1.C of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) for the existing dwelling known as 5934 Ebenezer Road, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Special Hearing filed in Case No. 03-137-SPHA seeking approval of the adjacent property known as 5936 Ebenezer Road as an undersized lot, pursuant to Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R., be and is hereby GRANTED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance filed in Case No. 03-137-SPHA seeking relief from Sections 1A01.3.B.2 and 3, and Section 102.4 of the B.C.Z.R. to allow side yard setbacks of 15 feet and 20 feet in lieu of the required 35 feet; to allow a rear yard setback of 20 feet in lieu of the required 35 feet; to allow a lot area of 17,905 sq.ft. in lieu of the minimum required 1.0 acre; to allow construction of a dwelling on a public right-of-way less than 30 feet wide; and, approval of the subject property as an undersized lot, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restrictions:

- 1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.
- 2) Prior to the issuance of any building permits, the Petitioners shall record new deeds in the Land Records for Baltimore County which incorporate the two triangular parcels into the respective properties as set forth above, and referencing these cases and the terms and conditions hereto.
- 3) Prior to the issuance of any building permits, the Petitioners shall submit a landscape plan to the County's Landscape Architect, Avery Harden, for review and approval. Said plan shall provide a buffer of the proposed dwelling and driveway on Lot B from the adjacent property owned by Mr. Webster to the east.

4) When applying for any permits, the site plan filed must reference these cases and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.
