#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Variance filed by the Essex United Methodist Church, Inc., for property they own at 524 Maryland Avenue, located in the Essex area of Baltimore County. The variance request is to permit a freestanding changeable copy sign with 32 sq. ft. and 8 ft. in height in lieu of the permitted 25 sq. ft. and 6 ft. in height.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the variance request were Reverend Jim Chambly, the pastor of the Essex United Methodist Church and L. Paul Snyder, Jr., the attorney who represented the church. Mr. Pugh and Mr. Hoch also appeared on behalf of the church. There were no protestants or others in attendance.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this variance request, consists of 0.66 acres, more or less, split-zoned D.R.5.5 and BL/CCC. The property is located at the intersection of Maryland Avenue and Woodward Drive. It is the home of the Essex United Methodist Church which has existed at this location for the past 60 years. The church is interested in replacing the old identification sign, which has been on the property since the time the church was created. Submitted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit No. 2 was a rendering of the new sign to be installed on the property. In order to proceed with the installation of this new sign the variance request is necessary.

An area variance may be granted where strict application of the zoning regulations would cause practical difficulty to Petitioners and their property. McLean v. Soley, 270 Md. 208 (1973). To prove practical difficulty for an area variance, the Petitioners must meet the following:

- 1) whether strict compliance with requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdensome;
- 2) whether a grant of the variance would do a substantial justice to the applicant as well as other property owners in the district or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give sufficient relief; and,
- 3) whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured.

Anderson v. Bd. Of Appeals, Town of Chesapeake Beach, 22 Md. App. 28 (1974).

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, it is clear that practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship will result if the variance is not granted. It has been established that special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the property which is the subject of this request and that the requirements from which the Petitioners seek relief will unduly restrict the use of the land due to the special conditions unique to this particular parcel. In addition, the relief requested will not cause any injury to the public health, safety or general welfare, and meets the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by the Petitioners I find that the Petitioners' variance request should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 23 day of December, 2002, by this Deputy Zoning Commissioner, that the variance requested by Petitioners from Section 450.4.I.1 (Chart) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, to permit a freestanding changeable copy sign with
