FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Variance filed by the legal owner of the subject property, Panagiota Tsaousis. The Petitioner is requesting variance relief for property she owns at 2125 Lodge Forest Drive, located in the Edgemere section of Baltimore County. The property is unimproved at this time. The Petitioner is interested in constructing a new single-family dwelling on the subject property which will meet all zoning setbacks. However, given that the lot width is 50 ft., the Petitioner is requesting a variance to allow construction of the new home on a lot with a width of 50 ft. in lieu of the required 55 ft.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the variance request was Mr. Joey Houseknecht, the current husband of the property owner. Mr. Houseknecht and Ms. Tsaousis were recently married. There were no protestants or others in attendance.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this variance request, consists of 0.25 acres, more or less, zoned D.R.5.5. The property is unimproved at this time. The owner of the property is interested in constructing a single-family dwelling on the vacant lot as is depicted on the site plan submitted into evidence. In order to proceed with the construction of this new house, the variance request is necessary given that the lot is only 50 ft. wide. However, most all of the other homes along Lodge Forest Drive are situated on lots that are also 50 ft. in width. There is nothing unusual about the construction of this home on this lot.

4/23/03 Manual An area variance may be granted where strict application of the zoning regulations would cause practical difficulty to Petitioner and her property. <u>McLean v. Soley</u>, 270 Md. 208 (1973). To prove practical difficulty for an area variance, the Petitioner must meet the following:

- 1) whether strict compliance with requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdensome;
- 2) whether a grant of the variance would do a substantial justice to the applicant as well as other property owners in the district or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give sufficient relief; and,
- 3) whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured.

Anderson v. Bd. Of Appeals, Town of Chesapeake Beach, 22 Md. App. 28 (1974).

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, it is clear that practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship will result if the variance is not granted. It has been established that special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the property which is the subject of this request and that the requirements from which the Petitioner seeks relief will unduly restrict the use of the land due to the special conditions unique to this particular parcel. In addition, the relief requested will not cause any injury to the public health, safety or general welfare, and meets the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by the Petitioner, I find that the Petitioner's variance request should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this Aday of April, 2003, by this Deputy Zoning Commissioner, that the Petitioner's request for variance from Sections 1B02.3.C.1 and 304 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, to allow construction of the new home on a lot with a width of 50 ft. in lieu of the required 55 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED, subject, however, to the following restrictions which are conditions precedent to the relief granted herein:

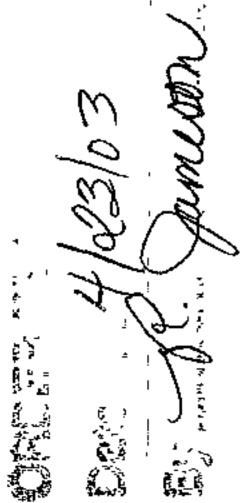
- 1) The Petitioner may apply for her permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at her own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2) Compliance with any recommendations, if any, made by DEPRM.
- 3) When applying for a building permit, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

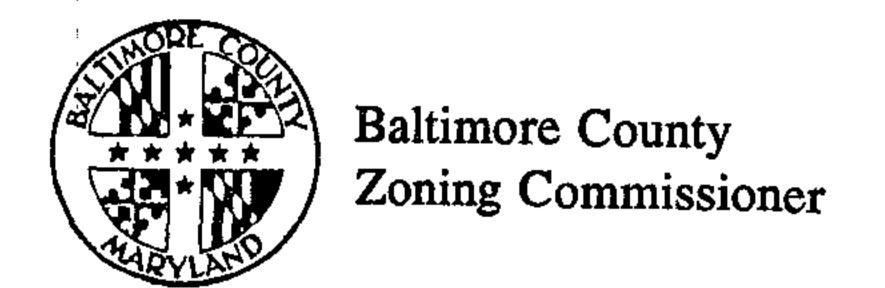

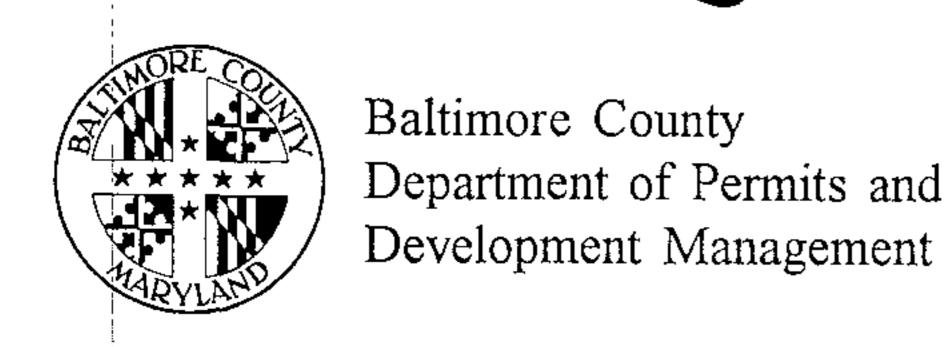

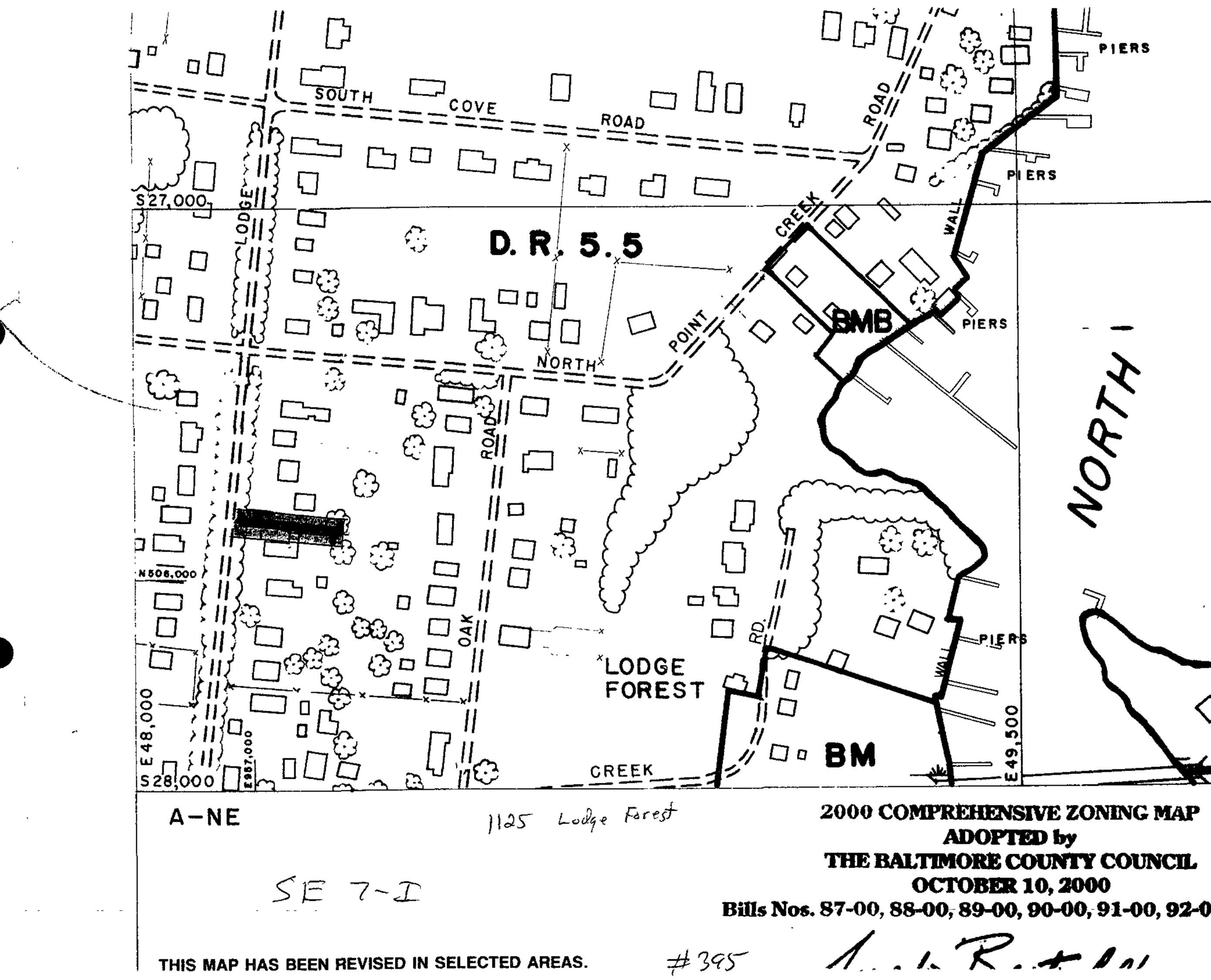
