FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the owners of the subject property, Kenneth and Cindy Metzler. The Petitioners request a variance from Section 1B02.3.B of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit an open projection (carport) with a side yard setback of 1 foot in lieu of the minimum required 7½ feet. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request was Kenneth Metzler, property owner. There were no Protestants or other interested persons.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is a rectangular shaped parcel, 50' wide by 120' deep, located on the southwest side of Page Drive, just north of Trappe Road in Dundalk. The property contains a gross area of 6,000 sq.ft., more or less, zoned D.R.5.5 and is improved with a single-family dwelling. On-site parking is provided by way of an existing driveway leading into the property from Page Drive and extending the length of the house along the east side. The Petitioners recently commenced construction of a carport without benefit of a building permit over that portion of the driveway located adjacent to the house. Mr. Metzler testified that the carport was necessary to provide protection during inclement weather for the Petitioners as well as their vehicles. Upon receipt of an anonymous complaint, the Code Enforcement Division of the Department of Permits and Development Management inspected the property and advised the Petitioners to file the instant Petition due to the close proximity of the

carport to the side property line. Mr. Metzler testified that he does not know who is opposed to his request as he discussed the carport with his immediate neighbors on that side of the lot and that they had no objections to his plans. He indicated that the carport will have a pitched roof and will be compatible with the design of the house from an architectural standpoint. Furthermore, downspouts will be installed so that water runoff will be properly directed towards the street and away from the neighbors' property.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I am persuaded that relief should be granted. I find that the Petitioners have met the requirements of Section 307 of the B.C.Z.R. As shown on the site plan, the existing house is located 12 feet from the side property line; thus, without a variance the proposed carport cannot be constructed. There were no adverse Zoning Plans Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments submitted by any County reviewing agency and it appears that relief can be granted without detrimental impact upon the health, safety or general welfare of the surrounding locale.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this day of December 2003 that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from Section 1B02.3.B of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit an open projection (carport) with a side yard setback of 1 foot in lieu of the minimum required 7½ feet, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restriction:

1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, the Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.

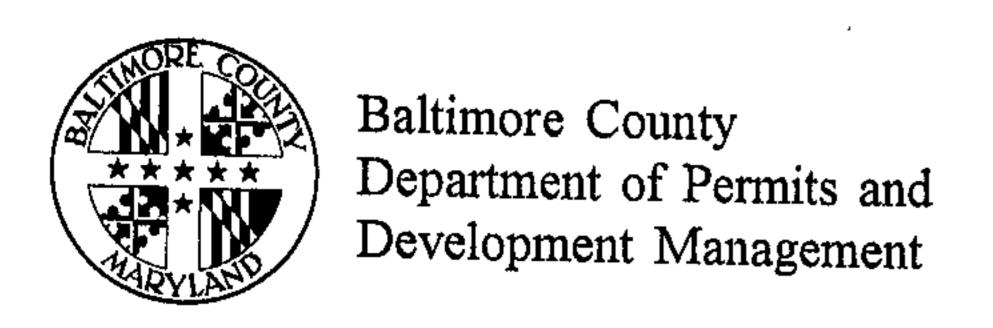

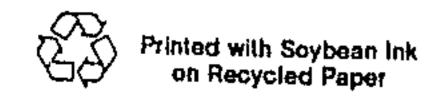

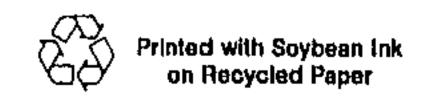
