WHEREAS, Mr. Doak on behalf of Trevor and Kelly Wells, Petitioners, requests that the Petition for Special Exception filed in Case No. 04-343-X be withdrawn as of September 11, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Holzer, on behalf of Josephine and Francis Galczynski, Sr., Appellants

/Protestants, requests that the appeal filed in Case No. 06-073-A be withdrawn as of September 11, 2007;

IT IS THEREFORE this 274 day of Syplimh, 2007, by the County Board of Appeals of Baltimore County
