### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as Petitions for Special Exception and Special Hearing filed by the legal owner of the subject property, Byong Gook Lee. The Petitioner is requesting special exception and special hearing relief for property located at 8208 Harford Road in Baltimore County. The special exception request is to allow a dental laboratory pursuant to Section 230.13(BL) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.). In addition, special hearing relief is requested to approve a modified parking plan (Section 409.12.b) which will allow parking spaces without a turn-around area and to allow a driveway width of 10 ft. for two-way movement.

The property was posted with Notice of Hearing on November 4, 2004, for 15 days prior to the hearing, in order to notify all interested citizens of the requested zoning relief. In addition, a Notice of Zoning hearing was published in "The Jeffersonian" newspaper on November 4, 2004 to notify any interested persons of the scheduled hearing date.

### Applicable Law

### Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R. - Special Exceptions

Before any special exception may be granted, it must appear that the use for which the special exception is requested will not:

- Be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the locality involved;
- Tend to create congestion in roads, streets or alleys therein;
- Create a potential hazard from fire, panic or other danger;
- Tend to overcrowd land and cause undue concentration of population;



- E. Interfere with adequate provisions for schools, parks, water, sewerage, transportation or other public requirements, conveniences or improvements;
- F. Interfere with adequate light and air; [Bill No. 45-1982]
- G. Be inconsistent with the purposes of the property's zoning classification nor in any other way inconsistent with the sprit and intent of these Zoning Regulations; [Bill No. 45-1982]
- H. Be inconsistent with the impermeable surface and vegetative retention provisions of these Zoning Regulations; nor [Bill No. 45-1982]
- I. Be detrimental to the environmental and natural resources of the site and vicinity including forests, streams, wetlands, aquifers and floodplains in an R.C.2, R.C.4, R.C.5 or R.C.7 zone. [Bill No. 74-2000]

### Section 500.7 of the B.C.Z.R. Special Hearings

The Zoning Commissioner shall have the power to conduct such other hearings and pass such orders thereon as shall in his discretion be necessary for the proper enforcement of all zoning regulations, subject to the right of appeal to the County Board of Appeals. The power given hereunder shall include the right of any interested persons to petition the Zoning Commissioner for a public hearing after advertisement and notice to determine the existence of any non conforming use on any premises or to determine any rights whatsoever of such person in any property in Baltimore County insofar as they may be affected by these regulations.

### Zoning Advisory Committee Comments

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments are made part of the record of this case and contain the following highlights: A ZAC comment was received from the Office of Planning dated November 16, 2004, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. In addition, a facsimile was received from the Fire Department on November 16, 2004, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

### Interested Persons

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the special hearing and special exception requests were David Billingsley, from Central Drafting and Design Inc. and Byong Gook Lee, Petitioner. Ralph K. Rothwell, Jr., Esquire represented the Petitioner. Ruth Baisden, representing the Greater Parkville Community Council, attended the hearing. People's Counsel, Peter Max Zimmerman, entered the appearance of his office in this case.

### Testimony and Evidence

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this variance request, consists of 7,110 sq. ft. and is zoned BL-AS. The property is improved by an existing garage and main building, which apparently had been used as a residence and perhaps sometime in the past as an antique shop. See Petitioner's Exhibit 1 and note that the principal building is not aligned with the property lines but rather is set somewhat at an angle to these lines. The Petitioner would like to operate a dental laboratory in the main building, which is allowed by The business would be conducted by technicians who special exception in this BL zone. manufacture false teeth for area dentists. As such, no customers come to the property but rather the Petitioner's courier picks up orders and delivers product. This procedure extends to the courier picking up dental supplies from which the teeth are made at dental supply distributors rather than UPS or the like deliveries to the property. There is one customer who uses the Postal Service for deliveries. This method of operation has proved so successful at the Petitioner's present location that he proposes to expand his business at this new location. He now has two employees but would like hire two more in the near future. The Plat to Accompany shows parking for up to six employees.

Mr. Billingsley indicated that the parking required for a building of this size is seven spaces. The Plat shows that eight spaces are provided. However, two spaces located on the rear next to the Gun Shop have no access to a turn-around as required by the regulations. In addition, the curb cut on Harford Road is only 10 ft. wide while the regulations require 20 ft. wide for two-way traffic. Testimony indicated that because of the relatively small amount of traffic in and out of the site, actual two way traffic would be quite rare. He also indicated that the use of the property as a dental laboratory would not be detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the community and would not violate any of the criteria of Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R.

Ms. Baisden, representing the Greater Parkville Community Council, welcomed the Petitioner to the area as a new business. She gave a brief history of the efforts the County is making to revitalize this older area of businesses along Harford Road, including a substantial streetscape that is planned to be implemented shortly. She emphasized attempts to have businesses along the road add landscaping to their frontage along Harford Road and also in the rear of these businesses to screen the adjacent residences from the business uses. Specifically, she asked that the Petitioner give up one parking space shown in the front of the main building to allow room for landscaping the front along Harford Road.

Mr. Billingsley clarified that the Plat to Accompany shows only one parking space in the front because the County regulations require parking 10 ft. from the property line. However, he noted the fact that the area is paved so that two vehicles could actually park in front.

Mr. Rothwell strenuously objected to giving up any parking spaces in front or to provide any landscaping thereon and cited the burdens he experiences at his own office on Eastern Avenue in similar circumstances. He noted that he was required not only to plant but maintain the plantings at great expense to himself without benefit to the community. He also note that there is an existing privacy fence in the rear which screens the adjacent residences from this business so that further landscaping is not required.

Ms Baisden noted that the County was trying to improve the neighborhood, which improvements will benefit all owners with rising property values and business income. She requested that the special exception be granted for this owner only and not the property, so that when a new owner arrives in the future the community can review its plans for compatibility.

### Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

### Special Exception

It is clear from the evidence that the use of the property as a dental laboratory would not be detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the community. The very limited traffic

generated by this use will not create congestion on roads either interior to the property or on Harford Road. As mentioned at the hearing, there appears to be no practical turn-around for large trucks entering the property and the thought of such vehicles backing out onto heavily traveled Harford Road is frightening. The Petitioner assures me that this will not happen and I accept his word. However, because another owner of the dental laboratory in the future may not operate the same way as the Petitioner, I will grant the special exception to this owner only and require future owners to return for public hearing on the issue of traffic as well as other special exception criteria.

### Special Hearing

I will also grant the special hearing relief requested to allow a modified parking plan on the property pursuant to Section 409.12.b, which will allow parking spaces without a turn-around area and to allow a driveway width of 10 ft. for two-way movement. I find that it would be a hardship on the Petitioner to comply with all parking regulations as this is a small lot with existing structures on it.

I note that the building is not aligned with the property lines but sits askew to some degree. This means that vehicles going to the parking in the rear must traverse a 12 ft. wide driveway width. No one is proposing to remove a corner of the building to widen the driveway for two-way traffic. Consequently, simply widening the curb cut would not alleviate the smaller than required driveway width. I also appreciate that Mr. Billingsley has attempted to bring the parking plan up to code to the extent reasonable under the circumstances. Other such requests have too often assumed that nothing could be done to upgrade the parking. Here we have handicapped parking and full width spaces.

I will grant the modified parking plan, however, with the condition that the area between the parking space in the front of the building and the right-of-way of Harford Road be made available to the County to landscape the front of the property consistent with the streetscape plan.

Se record for the second secon

I am not requiring any specific planting or landscaping plan at this time because whatever is done should be consistent with the overall plan. Said another way, landscaping should not be done twice on this property. I am requiring that when the County is ready the macadam should be removed and this area should be available to landscape the front of the property along Harford Road without cost to the County for the land. Cost of the landscaping shall be in accord with the streetscape plan.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by the Petitioner, I find that the Petitioner's requests for special exception and special hearing should be granted with conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 29 day of November, 2004, by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner, that the Petition for Special Exception requested to allow a dental laboratory pursuant to Section 230.13(BL) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the special hearing relief requested to approve a modified parking plan (Section 409.12.b) which will allow parking spaces without a turn-around area and to allow a driveway width of 10 ft. for two-way movement, be and it is hereby GRANTED, subject, however, to the following restrictions which are conditions precedent to the relief granted herein:

- 1. That the area between the parking space in the front of the building and the right-of-way of Harford Road be made available to the County to landscape the front of the property consistent with the streetscape plan. No specific planting or landscaping plan is required of the Petitioner at this time. However, when the County is ready to implement the streetscape, the macadam should be removed at the cost of this Petitioner and this area shall be made available to landscape the front of the property along Harford Road without cost to the County for the land. Cost of the landscaping shall be in accord with the streetscape plan.
- 2. The Petitioner must be in compliance with the ZAC comments received by facsimile from the Fire Department dated November 16, 2004, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. When applying for a permit, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

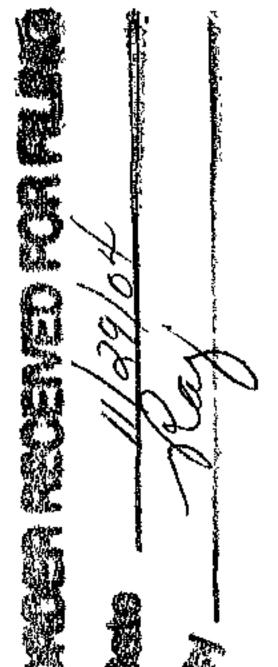

The above referenced petition was accepted for processing by the Bureau of Zoning Review, Department of Permits and Development Management (PDM) on October 1, 2004.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC), which consists of representatives from several approval agencies, has reviewed the plans that were submitted with your petition. All comments submitted thus far from the members of the ZAC are attached. These comments are not intended to indicate the appropriateness of the zoning action requested, but to ensure that all parties (zoning commissioner, attorney, petitioner, etc.) are made aware of plans or problems with regard to the proposed improvements that may have a bearing on this case. 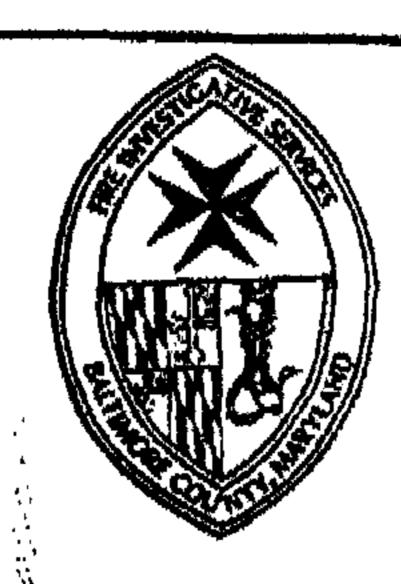

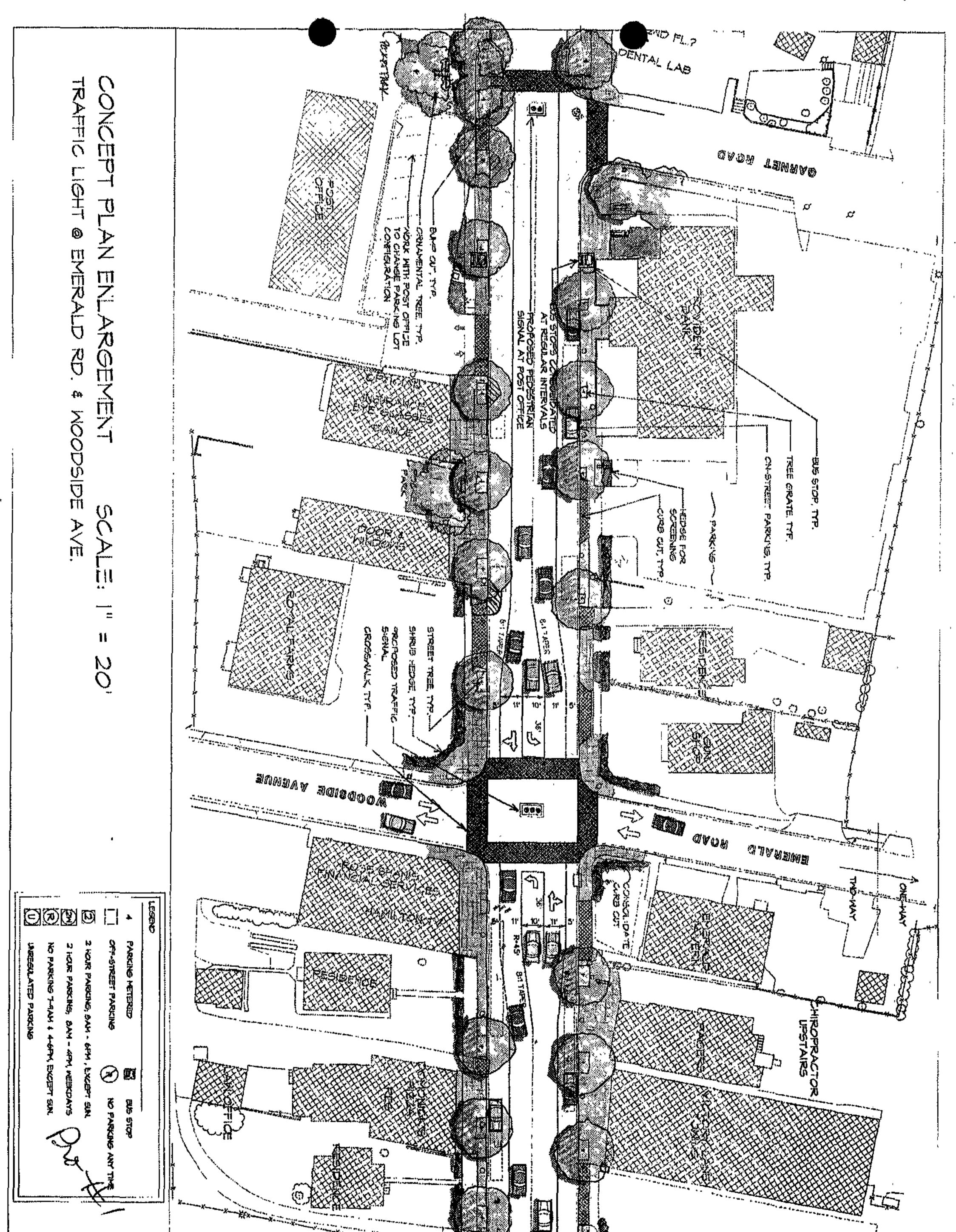

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# GREATER PARKVILLE COMMUNITY COUNCIL (GP) H

The Greater Parkville Community Council (GPCC) is an umbrella organization representing the communities of Parkville, Carney, and Cub Hill. Its membership includes community associations, civic groups, and individual residents residing within these communities.

### BACKGROUND

The GPCC was originally established June 1952, following World War II when an increasing number of families made the Greater Parkville area their home. The purpose of the GPCC was to protect the welfare of the community that was rapidly expanding. They were instrumental in brining capital improvements to our neighborhoods by providing practical suggestions in the County's planning process. However, they became inactive during the mid 80's.

During the mid 90's, it was felt by community leaders that our area was not receiving its fair share of tax dollars and community issues were not always being addressed appropriately. Realizing the need to reestablish a community council for the area, the GPCC was officially reactivated March of 1997, receiving its incorporation. The boundaries remain the same (south: city / county line, west: Oakleigh Road, north: Cub Hill Road, east: Simms Avenue), but our purpose and goals are more clearly defined.

## GPCC PURPOSE AND GOALS

To take an active role in bringing County and State tax dollars to the area, especially at a time when resources are limited and other areas are competing for the same funds.

To give the community more unity and influence (having strength in numbers) to address community concerns and issues.

To focus on preservation and enhancement of the quality of our community and to keep the community an attractive, desirable place to live, shop, and raise a family.

## BENEFITS OF COMMUNITY COUNCIL

The GPCC recognizes that each neighborhood within our boundaries is unique. We wish for each neighborhood to retain its own identity. Some of our neighborhoods have community associations, others may have active individuals where community associations do not exist. The benefit of a council is that it unites these associations and individuals so they can effectively advocate for the area to the County and State.

The GPCC works with other councils on County and State legislation, advisory boards, and special projects for the betterment of our communities. Like other community councils we are active in community planning for the area, developing community enhancement projects, and regularly represent the area in the County zoning and planning processes.

## THE STABILITY OF OUR COMMUNITY IS NO ACCIDENT

The GPCC is stepping up to the challenge of actively participating and planning the future of the community instead of only reacting to issues as they arise. Over the years, we have made great progress in fulfilling our purpose and goals as a community councilfunction order to better represent the area, we need your involvement and to hear your ideas and concerns. Residents are encouraged to become a member of the GPCC and attend monthly membership meetings

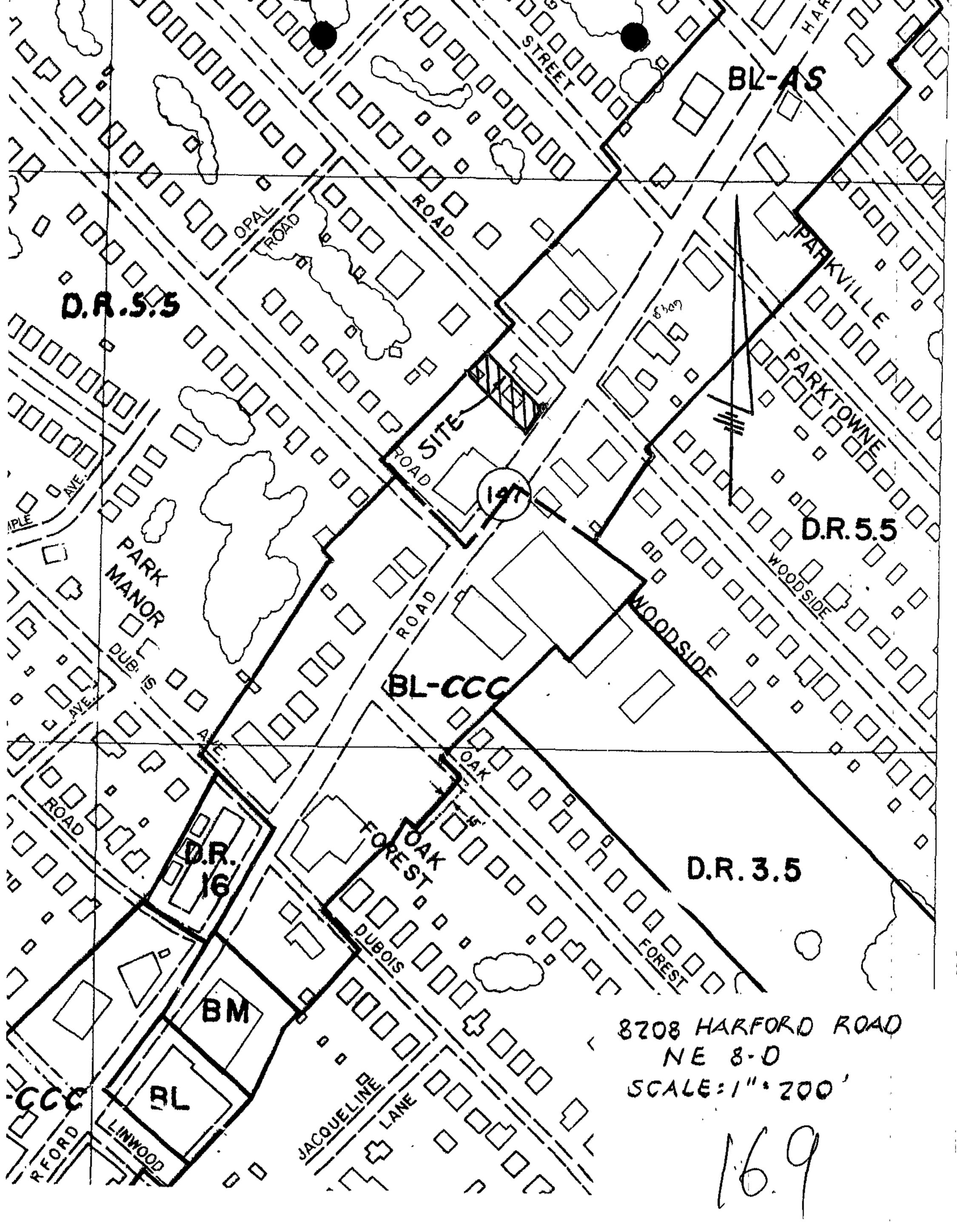
