#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner pursuant to an **Order of Remand** by the County Board of Appeals dated August 23, 2005. That Order states, in part, that the above captioned case is remanded to the Zoning Commissioner for proceedings and further review consistent with the purposes stated in the Joint Motion for Remand. That Joint Motion was filed on or about July 19, 2005 by the Petitioners and the Office of People's Counsel of Baltimore County.

The subject property under consideration consists of three adjacent tracts owned by different parties. The Petitioner Paul Goodman owns two tracts (Parcels 277 and 779) and the third (Parcel 841) is currently owned by Phillip Ruby. The contract purchaser, Pace Properties, Inc., intends to acquire these parcels, raze all improvements thereon and redevelop the property with a Walgreen's Pharmacy. In addition, Pace Properties, Inc. has entered into an agreement with Alfred L. Brennan Sr. and his wife, Marjorie L. Brennan, the owners of a fourth adjacent tract, known as Parcel 983, to utilize a shared parking arrangement and reciprocal access easement to provide egress/ingress to these properties to and from Eastern Avenue.

The four properties, which all lie adjacent to one another and abut the southwest corner of Eastern Boulevard and Marlyn Avenue, collectively contain 1.70 acres, predominantly zoned BM (Business Major) with a small area zoned BL (Business Local). A new pharmacy building is proposed, which will be approximately 120 feet by 105 feet in dimension, with a maximum height of 27 feet. The building will total 14,706 square feet in area and will feature a drive-through window along the rear of the building. Initially, the Petitioners sought variance relief from certain signage requirements as contained in Section 450 of the BCZR, as well as relief to permit certain landscape transition areas that were slightly less than required.

That matter came in for public hearing on March 9, 2005. By Order of the undersigned dated April 26, 2005, the variances were granted with certain restrictions. Specifically, the Order required the developer to comply with certain recommendations made by the Office of Planning, as set forth in their Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment dated February 1, 2005.

Following the issuance of that Order, an appeal was filed to the County Board of Appeals by the Office of People's Counsel on May 4, 2005. That appeal largely challenged the propriety of certain of the variance relief granted relative to signage.

Following the appeal, the parties met and resolved the open issues between them. The Petitioners and People's Counsel agreed to amend the Petition for Variance to revise the request for one of the freestanding signs proposed for the property. Specifically, for the freestanding sign on Eastern Avenue, the parties agreed to limit the area of the enterprise face to 75 sq.ft., and the changeable copy face not to exceed 25 sq.ft., or a total 100 sq.ft. Additionally, for a proposed "monument sign" along Marlyn Avenue, it was agreed that said sign would be no greater in area than 40 sq.ft. and with a maximum height of 8 feet. Having reached that agreement, the Petitioners jointly requested a remand of the matter to the undersigned Zoning Commissioner for

a modification of the prior order as it related to this signage issue. In this regard, the matter was then scheduled for further public proceedings on October 4, 2005. Appearing at that hearing was counsel for the Petitioner and Matthew Allen of Bohler Engineering. An amended, two-page, site/signage plan was submitted, which was accepted into evidence and marked collectively as Exhibit 5, which depicts the proposed signage as amended. The parties requested the undersigned approve this amended site plan and revise the prior Order as described hereinabove.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I am satisfied that the proposed modifications to the sign package are appropriate and that variance relief should be granted. In this regard, I find the requirements of Section 307 of the BCZR have been satisfied, and the following new Order will be issued reflecting this revision. Additionally, the applicable provisions of the prior Order shall remain in full force and effect and shall be incorporated herein.

Pursuant to the advertising, posting of the property and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this day of June 2006 that the Petition for Variance, as amended, seeking approval of a freestanding sign on Eastern Avenue with an enterprise face not to exceed 75 sq.ft. and a changeable copy face not to exceed 25 sq.ft., or 100 sq.ft. total, in accordance with the revised site plan submitted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 5, be and is hereby GRANTED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance as amended, seeking approval of a monument sign on Marlyn Avenue, to be no greater than 40 sq.ft. in area and with a height of 8 feet, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 5, be and is hereby GRANTED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that but for the amended relief described above, all other terms and conditions of the Order issued on April 26, 2005 shall remain in full force and effect.

Any appeal of this decision must be entered within thirty (30) days of the date hereof.

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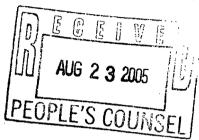

#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the owners of the subject properties, Phillip W. Ruby, Paul Goodman, Alfred L. Brennan Sr. and Marjorie L. Brennan, and the Contract Purchasers, Pace Properties, Inc. through their attorney, D. Dusky Holman, Esquire. The Petitioners request variance relief from Section 450 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) as follows: 1) From Section 450.4.5(A) to permit seven wall-mounted enterprise signs in lieu of the maximum permitted three wall-mounted enterprise signs; 2) to permit three wall-mounted enterprise signs on the east elevation façade in lieu of the permitted two maximum wall-mounted enterprise signs per facade; 3) to permit four wall-mounted enterprise signs on the north elevation façade in lieu of the maximum permitted one sign per façade; 4) from Sections 450.4.5(B) and 450.5.B.4.D(2) to permit a freestanding enterprise sign with an area face of 113.73 sq.ft. in lieu of the maximum permitted 100 sq.ft. per freestanding enterprise sign; 5) from Section 450.4.5(A) and (B) to permit a freestanding enterprise sign with an area face of 113.73 sq.ft. in lieu of the maximum allowed 75 sq.ft. per freestanding sign; 6) from Section 1B01.1.B.1.e to permit landscape transition areas of 3.66 feet, 6.96 feet, and 5.34 feet in lieu of the required 15 feet; 3.20 feet in lieu of the required 20 feet; and 4.33 feet in lieu of the required 10 feet; and, 7) for such other

and further relief as may be required by the Zoning Commissioner. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly shown on the site plan submitted, which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request were David LaPee on behalf of Pace Properties Inc, Contract Purchaser; Adam Valanth and Michael Giesell, on behalf of Bohler Engineering, the consultants who prepared the site plan for this property; and D. Dusky Holman, Esquire, attorney for the Petitioners. Chris McCollum from the Office of Economic Development appeared in support of the request. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

The subject property under consideration consists of three adjacent parcels presently owned by different parties. As noted above, Paul Goodman currently owns Parcels 277 and 779, and Phillip Ruby currently owns Parcel 841. Pace Properties, Inc. intends to acquire these parcels, raze all existing improvements and redevelop the property with a Walgreen's pharmacy building as shown on the plan. In addition, Pace Properties, Inc. has entered into an agreement with Alfred and Marjorie Brennan, the owners of a fourth adjacent tract (Parcel 983) to utilize a shared parking arrangement and reciprocal access easement to provide egress/ingress to these properties to and from Eastern Avenue. The Brennan tract is improved with a building containing law offices and will continue to be used in that fashion. The law office and pharmacy generate traffic/parking at different times and the shared parking arrangement is appropriate in this instance.

These four properties, which all lie adjacent to one another and abut the southwest corner of Eastern Boulevard and Marlyn Avenue, collectively contain 73,845 sq.ft. (1.70 acres), split zoned B.M. (Business Major) and B.L. (Business Local). The predominant zoning of the

property is B.M., which encompasses the southern portion of the overall tract. The northern part of the parcel located immediately adjacent to the intersection of Eastern Boulevard and Marlyn Avenue is zoned B.L. As shown on the plan, the new pharmacy building will be approximately 120 feet by 105 feet in dimension, with a maximum height of 27 feet, for a total 14,706 sq.ft., and will feature a drive-through window along the rear of the building.

Access to the building will be by way of two curb cuts, one leading to the interior of the site from Eastern Boulevard, and the other from Maryln Avenue. The plan also shows a macadam parking area containing 75 parking spaces. Included in this total are 15 parking spaces that are located on the Brennan lot and will be utilized as part of a shared parking arrangement, pursuant to BCZR Section 409.6.B.3. All of the details of the proposed site redevelopment are more particularly shown on the plan.

A series of variances are requested. Generally they fall into two categories; one related to signage and one related to landscape transition areas. As to signage, there will be a freestanding sign located immediately adjacent to the intersection to advertise the site to traffic on both of the abutting public roads. That sign will be 113.7 sq.ft. in area and consist of two components, a panel containing the Walgreen's name and logo, and a changeable copy portion. Additionally, there will be signage on the building. That signage identifies the structure as a Walgreen's Pharmacy and also advertises that one-hour photo services and a pharmacy are available.

The proposed sign is required due to the unusual configuration and location of the site. Specifically, the building will face two different public roads, both of which are heavily traveled. Moreover, the property is irregularly shaped. It was indicated at the hearing that the proposed sign is necessary to adequately direct traffic in a safe manner into the property.

The second series of variances relate to landscape transition area requirements. As more particularly shown on the plan, the property abuts a series of commercial and institutional (American Legion Hall) uses. The parking lot has been designed to provide a sufficient number of spaces and due to the unusual configuration of the property, has necessitated a variance from landscape transition area requirements. The property will be landscaped where practical, and a fence will be installed to buffer the site and provide aesthetic enhancement.

Based upon the testimony and evidence offered, I find that the Petitioner has satisfied the requirements of Section 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. for relief to be granted. The property is unique, given its unusual shape and location immediately adjacent to a well-traveled intersection. The shape/configuration of the property, in particular, is significant and drives the need for both landscape transition area relief and the sign variances. Moreover, I find that if relief were not granted, the Petitioner would suffer a practical difficulty. Specifically, strict application of the regulations would be unduly burdensome and restrictive on the proposed redevelopment of the site. Finally, I find that relief can be granted without detrimental impact to adjacent properties. In this regard, there was no opposition at the hearing, and the proposed redevelopment appears appropriate for this site. As noted above, adjacent and nearby uses are commercial in nature and there will be no detrimental impact upon adjacent or surrounding properties. For all of these reasons, I find that the relief requested should be approved.

Finally, the Baltimore County Design Review Panel (DRP) reviewed this proposal on October 15, 2004 to assure an appropriate design of the site so as to be compatible with the surrounding neighborhood. The findings of the DRP are binding on the Zoning Commissioner and were agreeable to the Petitioners. Thus, those findings shall be incorporated herein as

conditions to the grant of the variance. A copy of the Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments submitted by the Office of Planning setting out those findings is attached hereto.

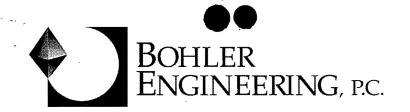

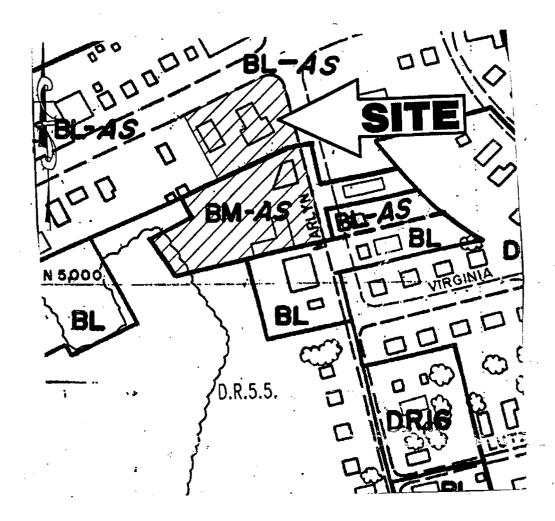

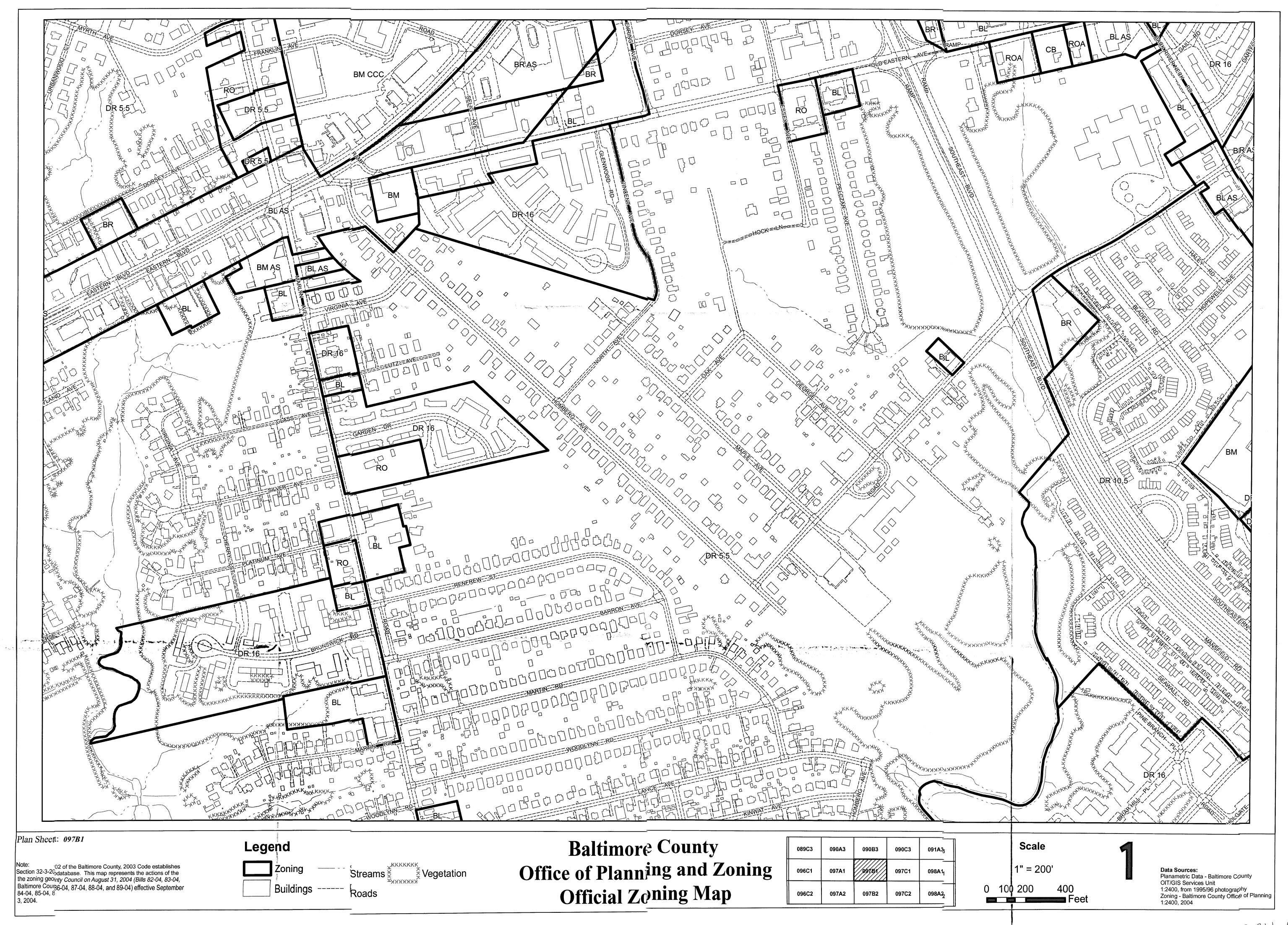

#### SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The subject development was presented to the Baltimore County Design Review Panel on October 13, 2004. As a result of this meeting, the proposed development was revised and the revised plans (including building elevations and landscaping) was submitted to the Office of Planning on November 5, 2004. After careful review of the revised plans, this office has determined that the design review comments have been addressed and recommends that the petitioner's request be approved. - 5. Provide more significant foundation plantings at the bases of the two proposed signs to give them more solidity while not minimizing traffic visibility.
- 6. Provide lighting on the side and the rear of the building. Fixtures should be cut-off type.
- 7. Change the rear canopy over the pick up window to match the front canopies in style and color.
