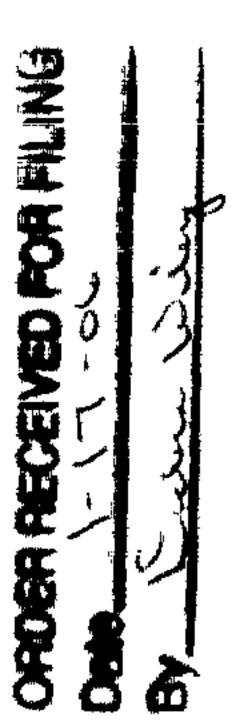
#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Variance filed by James J. and Ann E. Falkenstein, Petitioners. The variance request is for property located at 266 St. Helena Avenue in the Dundalk area of Baltimore County. The variance request is from Sections 400.1 and 400.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R), to permit a carport with a side yard setback of 1 ft. on each side and 11 ft. from the center line of an alley in lieu of the required 2 ½ ft. and 15 ft. respectively.

The property was posted with a notice of the public hearing date and time on December 28, 2005 and notice given to the general public by publication in the Jeffersonian Newspaper on December 27, 2005.

#### Interested Persons

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the variance request was James J. Falkenstein, Petitioner. There were no protestants or citizens attending the hearing. Peter Max Zimmerman, People's Counsel, entered his appearance in this case.



# HORNED FOR FILERS

#### **Zoning Advisory Committee**

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments are made part of the record of this case and contain the following highlights: ZAC comments were received by the Office of Planning dated December 28, 2005, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

#### **Code Enforcement Comments**

This matter is currently the subject of an active violation case (Case No. 05-8149) in the Division of Code Inspections and Enforcement. A citation for code violation has been issued in this matter due to the fact that a building permit is required for a carport at rear of location.

It should be noted, for the record, that the fact that a zoning violation is issued is simply ignored in this zoning case. This means that the Petitioner cannot use the fact that a structure has been built to set a precedent in order to allow it to continue. Nor does the fact that a structure may be costly to remove or modify come into consideration of the zoning case. The reason for this is that this condition is clearly self-imposed and as such cannot be a basis for the hardship or practical difficulty required by Section 307 of the B.C.Z.R. Conversely, the fact that something may have been done which could violate the law is not held against the Petitioner as some sort of an additional punishment. Zoning enforcement is conducted by the Department of Permits and Development Management, which has the authority to impose fines and other penalties for violation of law. This is not the province of this office.

#### Applicable Law

Section 307 of the B.C.Z.R. - Variances.

"The Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County and the County Board of Appeals, upon appeal, shall have and they are hereby given the power to grant variances from height and area regulations, from off-street parking regulations, and from sign regulations only in cases where special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land or structure which is the subject of the variance request and where strict compliance with the Zoning Regulations for Baltimore County would result in practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship. No increase in residential density beyond that otherwise allowable by the Zoning Regulations shall be permitted as a result of any such grant of a variance from height or area regulations. Furthermore, any such

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variance shall be granted only if in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of said height, area, off-street parking or sign regulations, and only in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. They shall have no power to grant any other variances. Before granting any variance, the Zoning Commissioner shall require public notice to be given and shall hold a public hearing upon any application for a variance in the same manner as in the case of a petition for reclassification. Any order by the Zoning Commissioner or the County Board of Appeals granting a variance shall contain a finding of fact setting forth and specifying the reason or reasons for making such variance."

#### Testimony and Evidence

The Petitioner is building a carport at the rear of his home without a permit, the need for which he was unaware. The subject property contains 1,830 sq. ft. and is zoned DR 10.5. See Petitioner's Exhibit 1. The Petitioner indicated that this neighborhood of row homes has a garage or carport facing the alley in the rear for almost all homes in his group. He was the last home to have a dirt-parking pad off the alley. He indicated that he needs to store his full size pickup truck with ladders on the sides out of the weather. Consequently, he poured concrete to pave the parking area and started to duplicate the carport next door in terms of size and design. However, he set his carport farther back from the alley so that he can make the turn with his truck off the alley without backing up.

In regard to the size of the carport he indicated that if the setback were strictly enforced he would not be able to build a practical carport. His lot is only 15 ft. wide; 2-½ ft. setback on each side would allow a carport only 10 ft. wide. His truck with ladders is wider than that.

In regard to length, he indicated that he set his carport back away from the alley as far as he could again so that he can make the turn. The carport needs to be 20 ft. long to cover his truck. He would have to remove his existing deck around the swimming pool in his backyard in order to move the carport back any further into his yard.

Finally, he presented photographs of other wooden carports in the neighborhood including the neighbor's next door. See Exhibit 2. He noted that almost all homes along both

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sides of the alley have garages, carports or the like so that he will not change the character of the neighborhood by erecting the proposed carport. He also testified that he spoke to his neighbors on each side who has no problem with the proposed carport.

#### Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

I find special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land or structure which is the subject of the variance request. This property is extremely narrow at 15 ft. and so unique in a zoning sense. I also find that strict compliance with the Zoning Regulations for Baltimore County would result in practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship. The Petitioner would have to move his pool and deck to move the structure farther back into his yard and the carport needs to be this large to accommodate his truck. A 10-ft. wide carport would be not useful to this Petitioner. No increase in residential density beyond that otherwise allowable by the Zoning Regulations will result by granting this variance. Finally, I find these variances can be granted in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of said regulations, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This carport will certainly not change the character of the neighborhood.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County, this 17 day of January, 2006, that a variance request from Sections 400.1 and 400.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R), to permit a carport with a side yard setback of 1 ft. on each side and 11 ft. from the center line of an alley in lieu of the required 2-½ ft. and 15 ft. respectively, be and is hereby GRANTED; and subject however, to the following restrictions which are conditions precedent to the relief granted herein:

The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition;
- 2. The Petitioners must be in compliance with the ZAC comments submitted by the Office of Planning dated December 28, 2005, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3. When applying for a building permit, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order; and

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

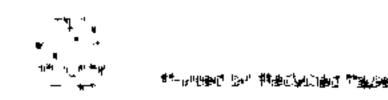

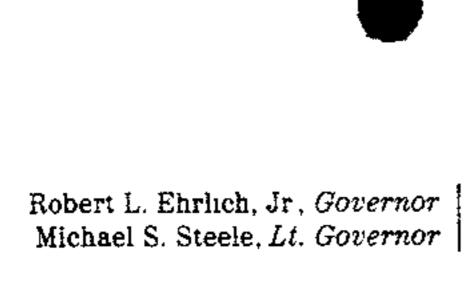
