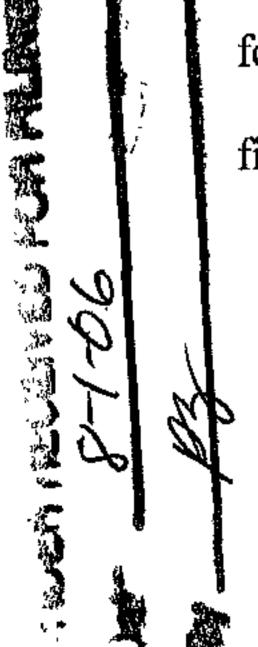

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

*

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, Robert Gentry and Alfred Guerieri, Beazer Homes Corp. The variance request is for property located at 2714 Lightfoot Drive. The variance request is from Sections 504 and V.B.8 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to allow a garage setback of 17 feet instead of the required 22 feet, and to amend the Final Development Plan of Greenspring Quarry, Lot J 12, Area J. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on Petitioners' Exhibit No.

1. The Petitioners state that the recently completed new house on the property would have to be completely removed including the foundation and re-established at the proper setback of 22 feet. The structure now built was initially placed erroneously in the field by occupying an offset to the property corner instead of the actual corner for the initial placement as well as the subsequent foundation certification. The error was recognized when the house location was surveyed for final certification in order for the builder to sell the house and lot to the contract purchaser.



Zoning Advisory Committee Comments

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments are made part of the record of this case and contain the following highlights: A ZAC comment letter was received from the Office of Planning dated July 13, 2006 which contains a restriction. Copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Applicable Law

Section 307 of the B.C.Z.R. - Variances.

"The Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County and the County Board of Appeals, upon appeal, shall have and they are hereby given the power to grant variances from height and area regulations, from off-street parking regulations, and from sign regulations only in cases where special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land or structure which is the subject of the variance request and where strict compliance with the Zoning Regulations for Baltimore County would result in practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship. No increase in residential density beyond that otherwise allowable by the Zoning Regulations shall be permitted as a result of any such grant of a variance from height or area regulations. Furthermore, any such variance shall be granted only if in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of said height, area, off-street parking or sign regulations, and only in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. They shall have no power to grant any other variances. Before granting any variance, the Zoning Commissioner shall require public notice to be given and shall hold a public hearing upon any application for a variance in the same manner as in the case of a petition for reclassification. Any order by the Zoning Commissioner or the County Board of Appeals granting a variance shall contain a finding of fact setting forth and specifying the reason or reasons for making such variance."

The Petitioner having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on June 30, 2006 and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioners have filed the supporting affidavits and photographs as required by Section 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code. Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Deputy Zoning Commissioner, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide

sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of Section 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, strict compliance with the B.C.Z.R. would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioner.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be GRANTED.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County, this 1st day of August, 2006, that a variance from Sections 504 and V.B.8 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to allow a garage setback of 17 feet instead of the required 22 feet, and to amend the Final Development Plan of Greenspring Quarry, Lot J 12, Area J be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following:

- 1. The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2. No further front additions will be permitted.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.
