FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner on a Petition for Special Hearing for the property located at 7315 York Road. The Petition was filed by Michael J. Cullison, the legal property owner. Subsequent to filing this Petition the property was sold to Heather G. and Andrew C. Loyd. Special Hearing relief is requested pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to approve a non-conforming use for two (2) apartments for 7315 York Road.

The property was posted with Notice of Hearing on September 21, 2006, for 15 days prior to the hearing, in order to notify all interested citizens of the requested zoning relief. In addition, a Notice of Zoning hearing was published in "The Jeffersonian" newspaper on October 3, 2006, to notify any interested persons of the scheduled hearing date.

Applicable Law

Section 500.7 of the B.C.Z.R. Special Hearings

The Zoning Commissioner shall have the power to conduct such other hearings and pass such orders thereon as shall in his discretion be necessary for the proper enforcement of all zoning regulations, subject to the right of appeal to the County Board of Appeals. The power given hereunder shall include the right of any interested persons to petition the Zoning Commissioner for a public hearing after advertisement and notice to determine the existence of any non conforming use on any premises or to determine any rights whatsoever of such person in any property in Baltimore County insofar as they may be affected by these regulations.

Zoning Advisory Committee Comments

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) Comments are made part of the record of this case and contain the following highlights: ZAC comment letters were received from the Planning Office dated September 21, 2006 which contains restrictions and a copy of which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof the file.

Interested Persons

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the requested special hearing were Pat Cullison, and Andrew Loyd, the substitute Petitioner. Edward J. Gilliss, Esquire, with Royston, Muelier, McLean & Reid, LLP, represented the Petitioners. Virginia Barnhart, Esquire, representing the Wiltondale Improvement Association, attended the hearing. People's Counsel, Peter Max Zimmerman, entered the appearance of his office in this case.

Testimony and Evidence

The subject property contains 7659 square feet zoned DR 5.5 and is improved by a dwelling which is the subject of the case at bar. See Petitioner's exhibit 1, the Plat to Accompany. Mr. Gilliss indicated that his client reached agreement with the Wiltondale Improvement Association as to the non conforming status of the two apartments in the dwelling as indicated in the letter from Ms. Barnhart to Mr. Gilliss dated October 17, 2006 and entered into evidence as Joint exhibit 1. Ms. Barhart noted that the community and Petitioner jointly request that the terms of the agreement noted in the letter be incorporated into the order of this case. She also noted that the Association does not waive their right to contest further development of the subject property or use inconsistent with the terms of Joint exhibit 1.

Mr. Gilliss indicated that the property was constructed in 1938 and divided into two dwelling units. The first floor and basement comprise one unit and the second floor comprises

the second. Each have separate kitchen and bath facilities as shown in photographs exhibit 4 A through 4E.

Ms. Cullison testified that she lived in the subject property from 1944 through 1998 as the daughter of James and Ethel Murphy, her parents. Her father was an electrician who worked in the adjacent development and moved into the dwelling in 1938. She presented the original contract of sale for the dwelling which indicates that it was designed from the outset as two dwelling units. See exhibit 2. She also presented a *Sunpaper* article from 1955 which referred to the two apartment units and which highlighted her father's linoleum business and the house. She noted that the second floor apartment was always rented out. She indicated that her mother moved out of the first floor apartment in 1998 and the two apartments were rented thereafter by her brother: Finally she indicated that the two apartments have been occupied as separate dwellings continuously and without interruption all her life.

Mr. Gilliss proffered and Ms. Cullison confirmed that the property has a three car garage and an apron leading to it which can park six vehicles. He indicated that the parking requirements of Section 409 of the BCZR require three spaces. He noted that the floor plan shown as exhibit A to the Parties' agreement, Joint exhibit 1, fulfill the request for information by the Planning Office in their September 21, 2006 ZAC comment.

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

As noted at the hearing, proof of non conforming status is becoming more and more difficult as time passes. In this case the Petitioner was fortunate to have Ms. Cullison who was born in house testify to its continued and uninterrupted use as two dwellings. Again witnesses with personal knowledge such as Ms. Cullison are very rare indeed and a more suitable system for determining non conforming status is urgently needed.

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Based on the testimony and evidence presented I find the subject property has been used as two dwellings starting prior to the imposition of zoning in the County, that the use was a legal use prior to the regulations, and that the use has continued uninterruptedly as two dwellings since that time. As such I will confirm the non conforming status of the property as requested.

I will also incorporate the terms and conditions of the agreement between the Parties as shown in Joint exhibit 1 again as requested by the Parties.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this petition held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by the Petitioner, I find that the Petitioners' request for special hearing should be granted with conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County, this 18th day of October, 2006, that the Petitioners' request for Special Hearing relief filed pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to approve a non-conforming use for two (2) apartments for 7315 York Road is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following.

- a. The Petitioners shall abide by and to require all occupants of the Property to abide by all County laws and regulations relating to the Property;
- b. Approval of the non-confirming use is limited to two apartment units only (the "Units"), generally consistent with the floor plan attached hereto as Exhibit A;
- c. The Petitioners shall lease the Property only to Named Lessees not less than 23 years of age at the time of leasing and to allow occupancy only by residents 23 years of age or older at the time of leasing unless related by blood, adoption or marriage to a Named Lessee;
- d. The Petitioner's shall not lease the Property to any business, corporation, or association;
- e. The Petitioners shall use the Property strictly for residential purposes;
- f. The Petitioners acknowledge that the Property is burdened by the covenants for Section One of Wiltondale as recorded in the Land Records of Baltimore County, excepting only those covenants which restrict occupancy by persons of color;

- g. The Petitioners shall send copies of all leases for the Property, along with a list identifying the names, relationship and ages of the occupants annually to the President of the Wiltondale Improvement Association, Inc., PO Box 10116, Towson, MD 21285-0116, or to such other address as may from time to time be designated by Wiltondale in writing;
- h. The Petitioners shall include in each lease for all or part of the Property provisions that will require eviction if more than three post-midnight noise violations are handled by the Baltimore County Police Department and shall disclose tenant information to the Wiltondale Improvement Association, Inc.;
- i. These conditions may be enforced by Wiltondale Improvement Association, Inc. and/or Baltimore County.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

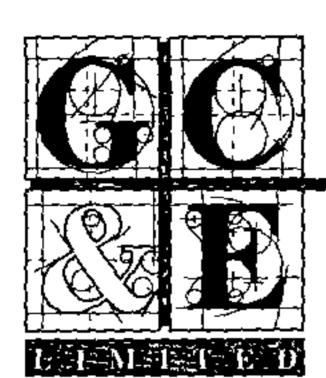

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Office of Planning does not oppose the petitioner's request to approve a non-conforming use for two apartments on the subject property provided the following conditions are met:

- 1. Petitioner must demonstrate that the subject property was converted from a single family dwelling into two separate dwelling units (apartments) prior to the current version of the applicable zoning regulations.
- 2. Petitioner must demonstrate that the requested non-conforming use has existed on the subject property for no less that 365 consecutive days prior to property acquisition.
- 3. Petitioner shall submit a scaled drawing and photos showing the existing floor layout of the subject property.
- 4. Scaled drawing and photos shall specifically show the location of separate cooking and bathroom facilities on each floor.

It should also be noted that the subject property must adhere to meet current parking requirements under group homes (Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (BCZR) section 409). Since the number of bedrooms for each apartment dictates parking requirements, this Office recommends that the zoning commissioner determine if the requested non-conforming uses will meet BCZR Section 409 under "group house".

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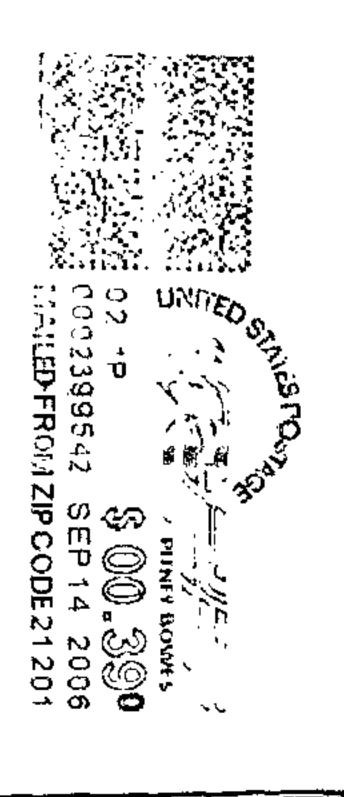

The purpose of this letter us to advise you that I am authorized to resolve Wiltondale's objections to the pending petition for approval of a non-conforming use for the Property, subject to the following requirements:

The owners, Andrew C. Loyd and Heather G. Loyd, their successors and assigns, will agree:

- a. that the following requirements will be included as an express condition of any non-conforming use approval or permit issued by Baltimore County for the Property;
- b. to abide by and to require all occupants of the Property to abide by all County laws and regulations relating to the Property;
- c. that approval of the non-conforming use will be limited to approval for two apartment units only (the "Units"), generally consistent with the floor plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.
