FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

*

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Exception filed by the legal owner of the subject property, David Love, Esquire. The Petitioner is requesting a special exception for property located at 7717 Philadelphia Road. The special exception request is to use as professional office space (attorney) as permitted by special exception under Baltimore County Zoning Regulation Section 1B01(a)(12).

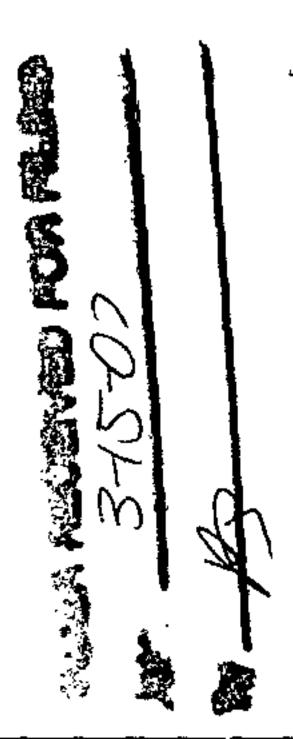
The property was posted with Notice of Hearing on February 27, 2007, for 15 days prior to the hearing, in order to notify all interested citizens of the requested zoning relief. In addition, a Notice of Zoning hearing was published in "The Jeffersonian" newspaper on March 1, 2007 to notify any interested persons of the scheduled hearing date.

Applicable Law

Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R. - Special Exceptions.

Before any special exception may be granted, it must appear that the use for which the special exception is requested will not:

- A. Be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the locality involved;
- B. Tend to create congestion in roads, streets or alleys therein;
- C. Create a potential hazard from fire, panic or other danger;
- D. Tend to overcrowd land and cause undue concentration of population;
- E. Interfere with adequate provisions for schools, parks, water, sewerage, transportation or other public requirements, conveniences or improvements;
- F. Interfere with adequate light and air; [Bill No. 45-1982]
- G. Be inconsistent with the purposes of the property's zoning classification nor in any other way inconsistent with the sprit and intent of these Zoning Regulations; [Bill No. 45-1982]



- H. Be inconsistent with the impermeable surface and vegetative retention provisions of these Zoning Regulations; nor [Bill No. 45-1982]
- I. Be detrimental to the environmental and natural resources of the site and vicinity including forests, streams, wetlands, aquifers and floodplains in an R.C.2, R.C.4, R.C.5 or R.C.7 zone. [Bill No. 74-2000]

Zoning Advisory Committee Comments

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments are made part of the record of this case and contain the following highlights: None.

Interested Persons

Appearing at the hearing in support of the request were David Love, Esquire, Petitioner.

The Petitioner was represented by Frank V. Boozer, Jr., Esquire. There were no protestants or citizens at the hearing. Peter Max Zimmerman entered the appearance of his office in this case.

Testimony and Evidence

Testimony and evidence presented in this case indicated that this property contains 0.5235 acres zoned DR 5.5. The property is improved with an existing 2 story dwelling, wood shed and 1 story stone garage as shown in Petitioner's exhibit 1. Mr. Love indicated that contrary to note 2, he no longer lives in Upper Falls but rather has his residence in the subject property which he purchased in 2006. He indicated that he is a member of the State Bar and has an active law practice which he would like to conduct from the property. He noted that the professional office will consume only 6.6 % of the area of the building and he will have only one employee, his secretary.

He indicated that he contacted his neighbors who support his request as they welcome his investment in the property which previously was not in good condition. He presented photographs of the property and neighborhood as Exhibit 2 which show the deteriorated condition of the circular driveway which presently exists around his home. He noted that the paving company was applying new asphalt surface as of the hearing date. Finally he pointed out

using the photographs that access to the three parking spaces (two spaces are required) will be completely on his property. This issue arose in context of the stone driveway indicated on Exhibit 1, which is located on the Weitzel property to the west.

Finally he opined that the special exception if granted would not violate the criteria of Section 502.1 of the BCZR enumerating the reasons for each listed consideration. He also indicated that the use of the property for an attorney's office would be consistent with the spirit and intent of the regulations.

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

SYSON STATES

In regard to the request for special exception that the proposed use as a professional office for an attorney meets the criteria of Section 502.1 of the BCZR, is within the spirit and intent of the DR 5.5 regulations and will not adversely affect the community. Once the issue of the Petitioner's address was clarified that note 2 no longer applies, he indicated that this property is and will be his residence. He will occupy only 6.6 % of the building area and have only one employee. Consequently the proposed use will not cause traffic congestion on Philadelphia Road which is a major arterial roadway in the County. He is making substantial investment in the property and so the attorney's office is welcomed by his neighbors.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this petition held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by the Petitioners, I find that the Petitioners' request for special exception should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 15 day of March, 2007 by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner, that the Petitioners' request for special exception use as professional office space (attorney) as permitted by special exception under Baltimore County Zoning Regulation Section 1B01(a)(12) be and is hereby GRANTED subject, however, to the following:

1. The Petitioners may apply for their use permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

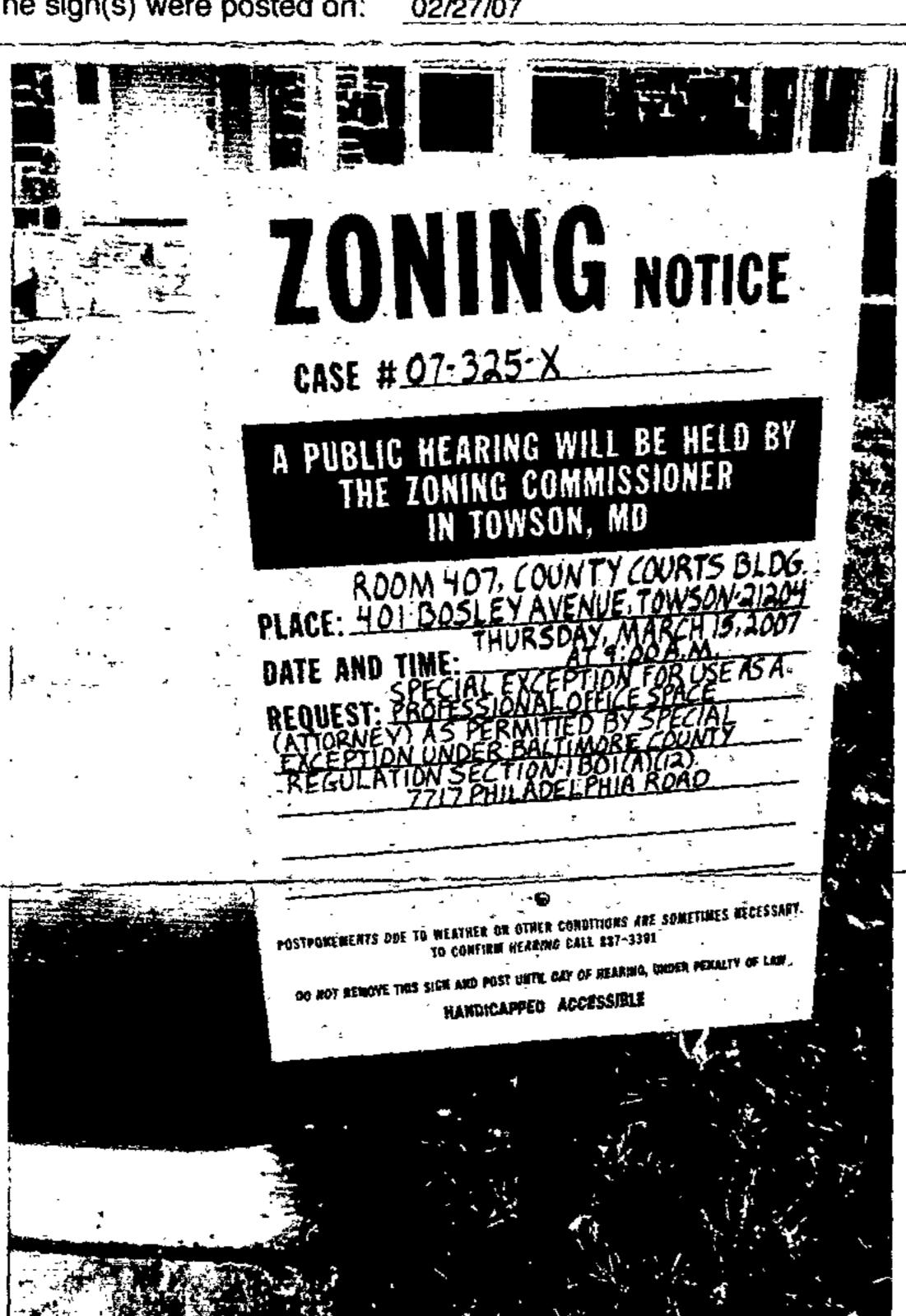

Hello Mr. Murphy:

My name is John Lake; I live In Rosedale at 4 Shiphorst Terrace, Baltimore Maryland 21237. I am concerned about a special exception for the address reference listed above. A few of my neighbors have also expressed their concerns to me about the activity at this address. We've been having issues with the property and its owners for the past two years. The previous owner had bought it as a residential home, yet used the property as a construction storage yard, at times having as many as twenty vehicles and twenty employees on the premises. His construction activities resulted in piles of debris through his backyard, which is connected to my own; the debris has still not been removed. In addition to this visual pollution, the constant traffic caused disruption to the neighbors and the neighborhood as a whole. Individuals in the neighborhood who tried to voice their disapproval for this activity were harassed and threatened numerous times.

When Mr. Love, the current owner, bought this property I explained that this is a residential neighborhood. He explained to me that he would be running a home office from the house. He has already begun the business at the address and has 3 or 4 employees now working there, leading to a disruptive traffic flow. He has applied for a special exception for a home office, but has no intention to actually move into the house. The neighborhood is, again, concerned about the use of this property. Many people in the neighborhood are in their eighties and, as such, are unable to get to court hearings and meetings to express this concern.

I ask that you please consider this information before your final decision on the exception is made. Feel free to contact me with any questions you may have about the case; I'd be happy to answer them.

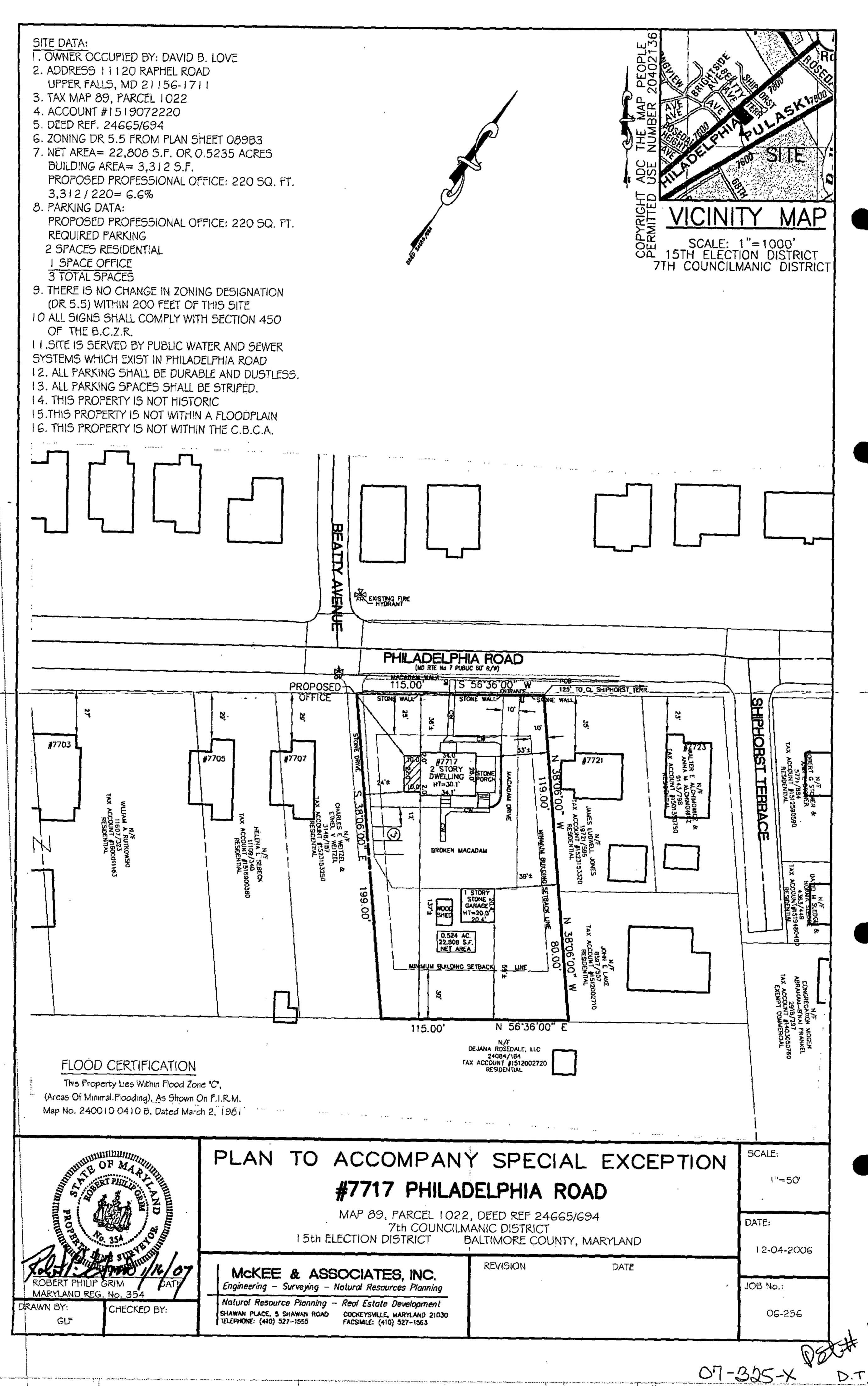

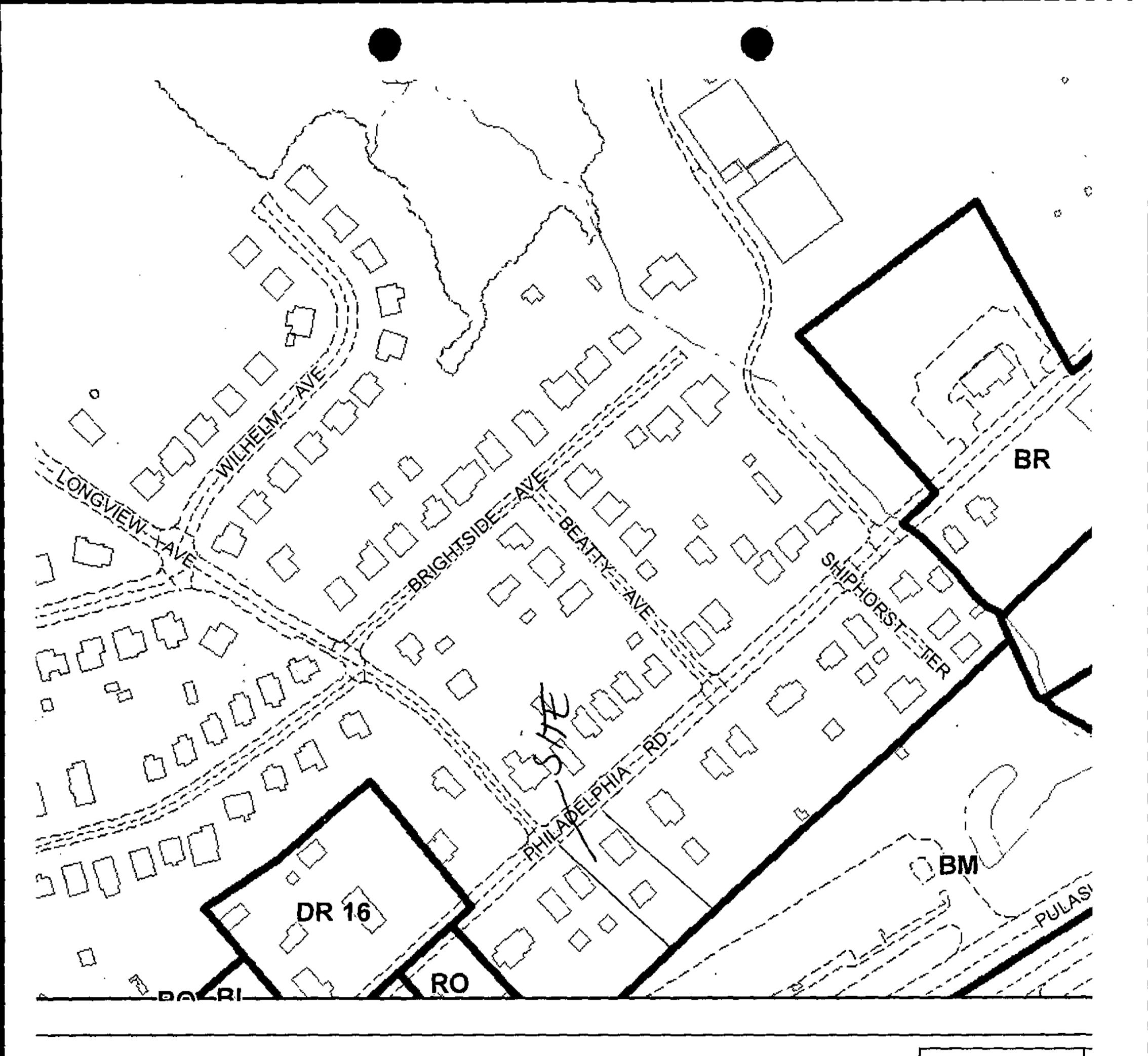
