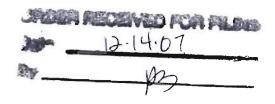

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, Thomas J. and Elizabeth Ahearn for property located at 12845 Stone Eagle Road. The variance request is from Section 400 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a proposed accessory structure (proposed garage) in side yard in lieu of rear yard with a height of 23 feet in lieu of the permitted 15 feet maximum. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1. The Petitioners wish to construct a garage for the storage of vehicles, lawn equipment and incidental items. The 5.81 acre site is heavily wooded and there is an existing septic reserve area 37 feet from the rear of the house. The less invasive location for the proposed garage is at the side of the house as shown on the site plan. There is already a clearing from the existing driveway entering the existing attached garage. Due to the slope of the topography and the additional storage space above the garage, it is not possible to meet the B.C.Z.R. height restriction of 15 feet.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments are made part of the record of this case and contain the following highlights: Comments were received from the Office of Planning dated December 3, 2007, which recommends that the accessory structure not be converted into a



dwelling unit or apartment, not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, kitchen or bathroom facilities, and not be used for commercial purposes.

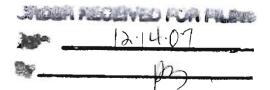
The Petitioners having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on November 25, 2007 and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioners have filed the supporting affidavits as required by Section 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code. Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Deputy Zoning Commissioner, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of Section 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, strict compliance with the B.C.Z.R. would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioner.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County, this _______ day of December, 2007 that a variance from Section 400 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a proposed accessory structure (proposed garage) in side yard in lieu of rear yard with a height of 23 feet in lieu of the permitted 15 feet maximum is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following:

1. The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

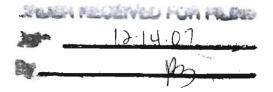


- 2. The Petitioner or subsequent owners shall not convert the subject accessory structure into a dwelling unit or apartment. The structure shall not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, kitchen or bathroom facilities.
- 3. The accessory structure shall not be used for commercial purposes.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

REASON TO ACCOMPANY PETITION

The garage is being proposed for additional vehicle storage, lawn equipment and incidental storage space. This lot is heavily wooded and has an existing septic reserve area 37 feet from the rear line of the house. The less invasive location for the proposed garage is at the side of the house as shown on the Variance Site Plan. There is already a clearing from the existing driveway entering the existing attached garage. The Septic Reserve Area restricts the rear location for the garage size proposed. Due to the slope of the topography and the additional storage space above the garage, it is not possible to meet the B.C.Z.R. height restriction of 15 feet.

It is our opinion that this is the best location of the proposed garage to minimize tree clearing and to avoid filling the area to create a level surface to minimize the height violation.

BEGINNING at a point on the east side of Stone Eagle Road which is 60 feet wide at the distance of 510 feet southeast of the centerline of Golden Eagle Drive which is 50 feet wide. 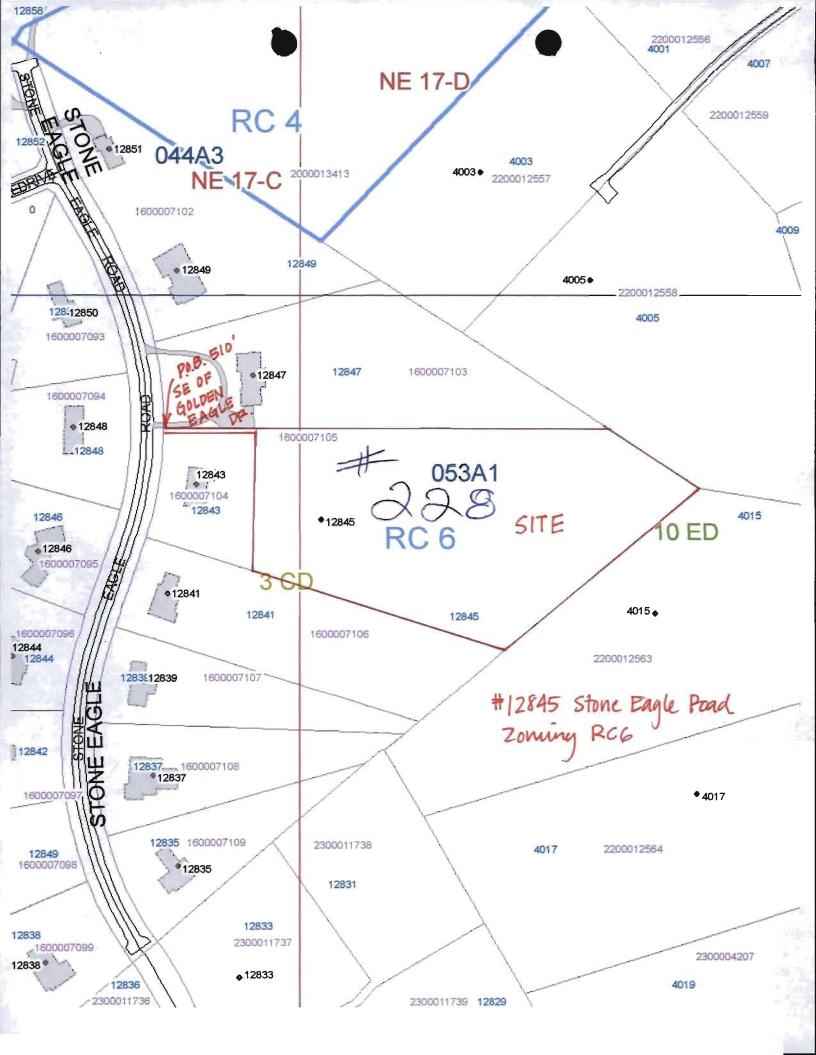

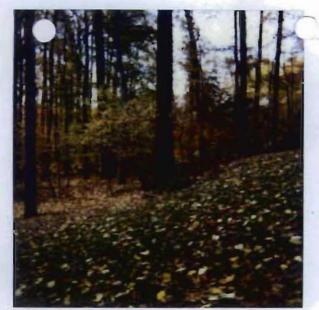
