FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the contract purchaser, Robert Chiapparelli, and legal owners of the subject property, Joy L. Cole, John R. Lintz, Janet L. Loizeaux and Martha L. Meseroll. The Petitioners request variances from Section 1B02.3C.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to allow a proposed dwelling with a lot width of 63 feet in lieu of the required 70 feet, a front street setback of 14 feet in lieu of the required 30 feet and if necessary, a sum of side yard setbacks of 24 feet in lieu of the required 25 feet. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted, which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request were the property owners Janet L. Loizeaux, Joy Lintz Cole, contract purchaser Robert Chiapparelli and Joseph L. Larson, president and consultant with Spellman, Larson & Associates, Inc., who prepared the site plan for this property. Appearing as interested citizens in this matter were adjacent and nearby neighbors Mary Jane Norris, Noel A. Caron and Stephen Lane.

Testimony and evidence disclosed that the subject property is located on the east side of York Avenue at its intersection with Glenmore Avenue just north of Warren Road in Cockeysville and was part of the "Lintz Farm" in the late 1940's. The lot referred to as parcel 399



on tax map 51 still contains existing farm buildings and stone foundations referred to by Mr. Lintz's daughters as the "turkey house" and farm equipment garage. The lot is rectangular in shape approximately 64 feet wide x 300 feet deep containing a gross area of 0.484 acres or 19,215 square feet zoned D.R. 3.5. The present owners, the son and daughters of William R. Lintz, state that the property has been held by the Lintz family for many years and as a result of a prior subdivision became a deeded lot of record in the early 1970's. The property is a classic infill corner lot defined in Section 101 of the B.C.Z.R. as "a lot abutting on and at the intersection of two or more streets". In this regard, it is surrounded by Glenmore Avenue running along the northern boundary, York Avenue to the west and a 20 foot paved alley along the southern property line. An old stone driveway bisects the lot centrally.

Petitioners' engineer, Joseph Larson, explained that he believed the property was unique from a zoning standpoint because of the long narrow shape further complicated by the double frontage (side building face to the paving of Glenmore Avenue) generated by the Zoning Commissioner's Policy Manual (Z.C.P.M.) Section 1B02.3C.1-page 1B-26 requiring a corner lot to have a 30 foot side yard setback instead of the 10 foot side yard setback depicted on the small lot table of Section 1B02.3C of the B.C.Z.R. As depicted on the site plan, the side yard distance of 14 feet is to the existing right-of-way line. The proposed home will actually be set back a distance of 30 feet from the paved portion of Glenmore Avenue.

Mr. Larson offered as part of this testimony aerial and photographic views of the area to illustrate the pattern of development. It is also noted that the subject property is 63.71 feet wide and the regulations require a minimum lot width of 70 feet. Thus, the subject lot is undersized by today's development standards as it does not meet the current width requirements.

Variance relief is requested as set forth above to allow the development of the subject property with a single-family dwelling 39 feet wide x 79 feet deep (includes a 21 foot front loaded attached garage). The proposed house will face York Avenue and the side yard will parallel Glenmore Avenue and contain window treatments and architectural amenities to avoid the appearance of a plain or flat exterior wall.

Ms. Norris, whose home is located (107 Glenmore Avenue), to the rear of the subject property, was worried that should relief be granted that Mr. Chiapparelli may further intend to subdivide the lot and she did not want another home built on the rear of the property next to hers. The parties entered into a general discussion and Mr. Chiapparelli stated at the conclusion that it was not his intention to further subdivide the property nor to build any other accessory buildings on the rear portion of the lot. Likewise, Ms. Caron's home is across the alley from the proposed structure and the rear of her house will view the new home. She did not oppose the request, but wanted a clear understanding of just what type of home was contemplated. Mr. Chiapparelli explained it would be a one-story dwelling that would be his permanent residence and would be designed so as to be in keeping with the neighborhood. He further agreed to make available his building drawings. Mr. Lane, whose home on Brecon Place, is kitty-cornered to the now vacant lot also stated that he did not oppose a home being built on the lot, but wanted a better understanding of just what was being requested and why. Mr. Larson satisfactorily addressed these concerns.

I find that special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land or structure which is subject to the variance request. I find that strict compliance with the zoning regulations of Baltimore County would result in practical difficulty. There is no land on either side of the lot for the Petitioners to acquire and avoid the variance request. The property owners and the contract purchaser cannot meet the regulations under any reasonable circumstance and still be able to use the property for a permitted purpose. The Petitioners have satisfied the requirements of Section 307 for relief to be granted. No increase in residential density beyond otherwise allowable by the zoning regulations would result by granting these variances. Finally, I find that these variances shall be granted in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of the said regulations, and in such a manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, or general welfare. There were no adverse Zoning Advisory Committee (Z.A.C.) comments submitted and the Petitioners have indicated a willingness to provide the proposed architectural

elevations to those interested to see what the new home will look like and that it will be compatible with the pattern of development in the neighborhood.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this _____ day of February, 2008 that the Petition for Variance seeking relief pursuant to Section 1B02.3C.1 to permit a proposed dwelling with a lot width of 63 feet in lieu of the required 70 feet, a front street setback of 14 feet in lieu of the required 30 feet, and a sum of side yard setbacks of 24 feet in lieu of the 25 feet, in accordance with Petitioners' Exhibit 1, be and the same are hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restriction:

1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, the Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.

Any appeal of this decision shall be taken in accordance with Section 32-3-41 of the Baltimore County Code.

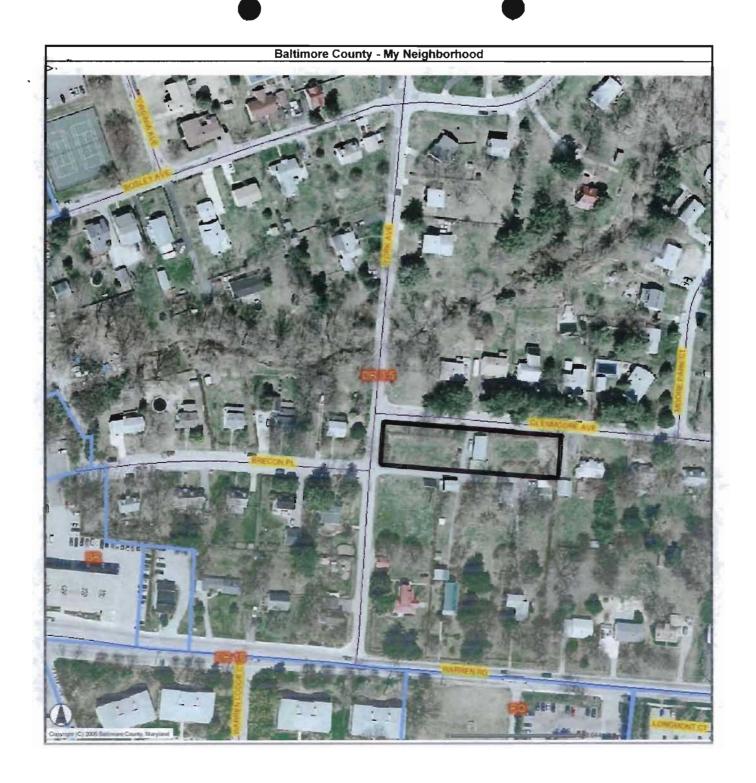

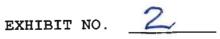

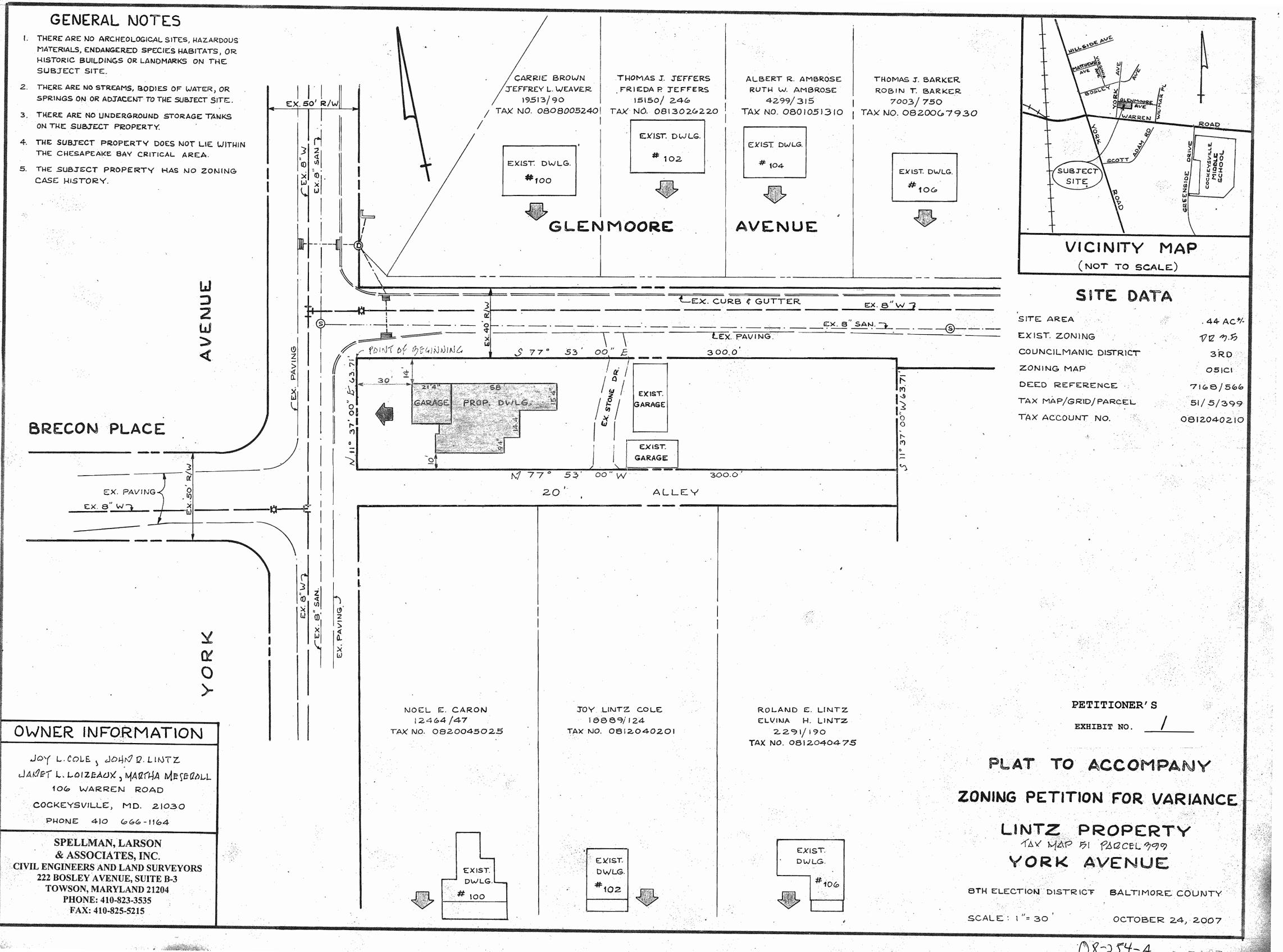
