FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by Thuylan Nguyen, managing member of the property owner, Mindful, LLC, by and through their attorney, Deborah C. Dopkin, Esquire. The Petitioner requests variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) as follows: (1) Section 205.4.A and 206.4.C.2, to permit building setbacks from a street line of 20 feet and 30 feet, respectively, in lieu of the required 35 feet; (2) Section 409.8A.4 to permit parking in a surface parking facility for a nonresidential use within 3 feet of the right-of-way line of a public street in lieu of 10 feet required; (3) Sections 409.8.A.1 and Condition B.1.a and B.1.b of the Baltimore County Landscape Manual to permit no screening of a parking lot adjacent to a public right-of-way and no six-foot landscape strip adjacent to commercial properties; (4) Section 409.3 to permit offstreet parking spaces 8 ½ x 16 feet in lieu of the 8 ½ x 18 feet required; (5) Section 450.4.F to permit two (2) freestanding enterprise signs per frontage in an OR-1 zone, in lieu of one (1) sign per frontage permitted; and for such other and further relief as may be consistent with the requirements of the Design Review Panel, and as may be deemed necessary by the undersigned Zoning Commissioner. The property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

DRP. As mentioned, this hearing officer is bound by the recommendations and decisions of the DRP. By adding sidewalk and improving the property's ingress/egress, the building plan embraces the goals of the Plan. Therefore, I find that the building addition as proposed will be a benefit to the surrounding neighborhood and the economic development goals of Pikesville and the County. Accordingly, the requested relief is considered as being within the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this

day of January 2010, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from the
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) as follows: (1) from Sections 205.4.A and
206.4.C.2, to permit building setbacks from a street line of 20 feet and 30 feet, respectively, in
lieu of 35 feet required; (2) from Section 409.8A.4 to permit parking in a surface parking facility
for a nonresidential use within 3 feet of the right-of-way line of a public street in lieu of 10 feet
required; (3) from Sections 409.8.A.1 and Condition B.1.a and B.1.b of the Baltimore County
Landscape Manual to permit no screening of a parking lot adjacent to a public right-of-way and
no six-foot landscape strip adjacent to commercial properties; (4) from Section 409.3 to permit
off-street parking spaces 8 ½ x 16 feet in lieu of the 8 ½ x 18 feet required, and (5) from Section
450.4.F to permit two (2) freestanding enterprise signs per frontage in an OR-1 zone, in lieu of
one (1) sign per frontage permitted (for a total of three [3] signs), in accordance with Petitioner's
Exhibit(s) 1 (site plan), 8 (landscape plan), and 9 (architectural drawings), be and is hereby
GRANTED subject to the following:

1) The Petitioner may apply for its permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that

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proceeding at this time is at its own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.

- 2) The plan shall be amended and the property improved to incorporate the conditions set forth in the minutes of the DRP, dated November 16, 2009.
- 3) When applying for any permits, the site plan and/or landscape plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

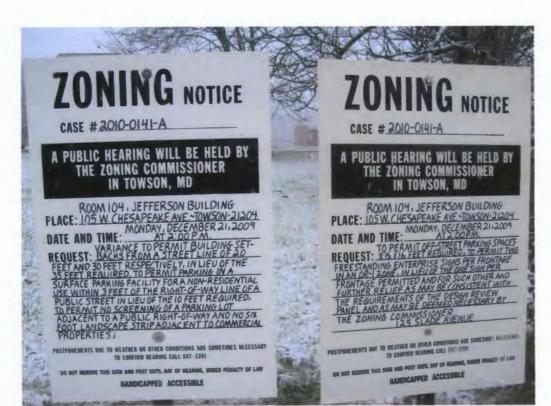

The petitioner requests several variances including street setback variances, sign variances, parking setback and size of spaces, and landscape manual relief. The property in question is within the Pikesville Revitalization Design Review area in the Urban Convenience area.

A DRP meeting was held on November 10, 2009 and the panel recommended approval subject to compliance with its comments, a copy of which is attached.

While the DRP agreed with the applicant on the issue of having multiple freestanding signs, they stated that the applicant should work with planning staff to assure compliance with the Pikesville Revitalization Design Guidelines.

The OR 1 zone requires a compatibility finding for new development. The applicant has submitted a compatibility report, which demonstrates that the addition meets the objectives for compatibility with the neighborhood.

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The revised site development plan dated 11/17/09, final landscape plan, architectural elevations drawings and sign details dated 11/23/09 are in compliance with the DRP comments. The Office of Planning recommends approval of the requested variances.

The existing property is a former two-story residence that had been converted for office use, most recently for a dental office. At the present time, the building is vacant. The property is located on Slade Avenue in Pikesville, with frontage on both Slade Avenue and Milford Mill Road. The property is .30 acres and is zoned OR-1. It is located within the Pikesville Commercial Revitalization Area, and mapped as the Urban Convenience Area.

The current owner is proposing to construct a one-story addition of approximately 1100 square feet, to be used for general offices, specifically an insurance agency. The existing parking on the site is adequate for the proposed expansion. Variances will be required for building and parking setbacks.

The façade of front entrance is faced with brick, with the remaining facade covered in vinyl siding. The addition will be constructed of HardiePlank siding; wood-grain vinyl shutters, fiberglass trim, and shingled roofing. Faux slate shingles are proposed for the shingle roofing. All materials will be of a color to match the materials of the existing building.

Compatibility Report – 125 Slade Avenue Addition 11/23/09

The proposed addition to 125 Slade Avenue meets the objectives for compatibility with the neighborhood in which it is located.

Site Development Context: This property has two separate development contexts. The existing building faces Slade Avenue and is part of the fabric of that street. The side of the property facing Milford Mill Road is the rear of the building but is visible from Milford Mill Road, a local collector road.

The Slade Avenue context will be preserved because the entrance door will remain facing Slade Avenue and a sidewalk has been added from the street to the front door.

The Milford Mill Road context will be enhanced by additional landscaping and the design of the addition with the residential appearance of the existing building.

Building and Parking Layout: There is no change to the existing parking layout, other than to shift it slightly toward Slade Avenue to provide additional space for cars exiting onto Milford Mill Road.

Road Width and Sidewalks: No new streets are proposed. The only new sidewalk is to fill a small existing gap in the sidewalk along Slade Avenue, which will improve pedestrian accessibility on this street.

Open Space Planning: The open space on this property at the eastern end of the site is part of the roadside environment along Milford Mill Road. Two of the three large existing trees in this area will be retained and additional landscaping will provided to enhance the appearance of this area. This is the location of the designated "Amenity Open Space" area.

Site Features: Distinctive features of the site are the existing building, which is an older house that had been converted for office use, and the large trees at the eastern end of the site. The addition has been designed to retain the residential appearance of the building and two of the existing large trees will also be retained.

Site Landscaping, Streetscapes and Buffers: The proposed landscaping is a combination of retention of the existing landscaping and providing additional enhancements. These include strategically placed ornamental trees and a new hedgerow along Milford Mill Road to soften the view from the road of the rear of

the building. There will also be foundation planting around the perimeter of the addition.

Exterior Signs, Lighting and Accessory Structures: Existing site lighting is minimal and no new site lighting is proposed. The proposed signs will be wood with residential-style posts.

Architectural Design: The scale, proportions, massing and detailing of the proposed addition is in proportion to, and similar in appearance to, the existing building, which has been on this site for about one hundred years.
