FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, Emil A. Schott, Jr. and Barbara J. Schott by Power of Attorney of Emil A. Schott, Jr., and the current lessee and contract purchaser of the subject property, Dr. Patricia O'Brien (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Petitioners"). Petitioners are requesting Variance relief as follows:

- From Section 238.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit a side yard of 18 feet in lieu of the 30 feet required; and
- From Section 250.2 of the B.C.Z.R. to permit a side yard of 28 feet in lieu of the 30 feet required, and the sum of two side yards of 46 feet in lieu of the 80 feet required.

The subject property and requested relief are more fully described on the site plan which was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the variance requests were the contract purchaser, Dr. Patricia A. O'Brien, Managing Member, Kafo, LLC, Christine O'Brien --

Dr. O'Brien's daughter and business manager, and William A. Beale, Esquire, attorney for Petitioners. Also appearing in support of the requested relief was Richard E. Matz, with Colbert Matz Rosenfelt, Inc., the professional engineer who prepared the site plan. There were no Protestants or other interested persons in attendance.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is rectangular in shape, containing 0.70 acre, zoned M.L.R.-I.M. and B.R. and located on the north side of Fitch Avenue, east of the centerline of Rossville Boulevard, in the Nottingham area of Baltimore County. The subject property is currently improved with a 1½-story building currently occupied by the contract purchaser, Dr. Patricia O'Brien and her dental practice, O'Brien Family Dentistry. Dr. O'Brien currently leases the property from the legal owners, but at this juncture desires to purchase the property and develop it further. The current office is a residence-like structure that, according to the Real Property Data Search contained in the file, was built in 1963 and contains approximately 1,152 square feet. Photographs of the existing improvements on the property were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibits 3A and 3B. The subject property is located in what could be termed a "transition area" between the large commercial corridor along Belair Road (Route 1), zoned with various business and manufacturing districts, and residential properties to the east of the subject property, including numerous Perry Hall subdivisions. The zoning map, which also shows the various zoning designations surrounding the subject property, was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 2.

Petitioners request variance relief in order to facilitate the sale of the subject property.

Development of the subject property would result in the razing of the current improvements on the property and the subsequent construction of a new and improved two-story medical office building. It is this redevelopment that drives the need for variance relief. The first phase of

redevelopment would entail razing the existing garage and canopy near the rear of the property and removing the existing driveway to the east of the primary structure. The garage, canopy and driveway can be seen more clearly in the aforementioned photographs (Petitioner's Exhibits 3A and 3B). Demolition would make way for the construction of a proposed 50 foot by 74 foot twostory office building for a dental office to be occupied by the O'Brien Family Dentistry on the second floor, and other medical office tenants on the first floor. The second phase of redevelopment, razing the existing primary structure, would commence once the proposed building was completed and occupied. Elevation, cross-section and architectural drawings and renderings of the proposed development were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 5. Petitioners' attorney, Mr. Beale, noted the existence of an agreement with the adjacent property owner to the east, Beltway Property Management, Inc., to execute an agreement similar to the "Declaration of Easement and Covenants for Maintenance of Private Driveway" that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 4, for the use of the private driveway for the benefit of the subject property. As shown on the site plan and explained by Petitioners' engineer, Mr. Matz, the use of this private ingress and egress will result in better traffic flow to and from the proposed parking are to the rear, while not having any measureable effect on the property owner's use of the road for their benefit.

Mr. Matz also explained that the proposed development could not move forward absent variance relief. Under existing Zoning Regulations only a 20 foot wide structure could be built due to the narrow nature of the property and the side yard requirements. Thus, the subject property would be disproportionately impacted compared to others in the zoning district. Additionally, the property's location in a "transition area" renders it unique. Moreover, the unique topography of the property, which slopes from front to back, creates difficult conditions

for development. Mr. Matz also provided expert testimony that strict compliance with the Zoning Regulations would be unworkable and would create practical difficulty and unreasonable hardship upon Petitioners.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. Comments were received from the Office of Planning dated May 21, 2010 which indicate that the Office does not oppose the Petitioners' request provided certain conditions are met, including architectural building elevations to be reviewed and approved prior to issuance of any building permits, and submission of a landscape plan which includes details on any proposed signage and lighting for review and approval prior to the issuance of any building permits. No other comments in opposition to the requests were received.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I am persuaded to grant the request for variance relief. There is adequate evidence that the subject property is peculiar, unusual and unique in accordance with Section 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R., as interpreted in the case of *Cromwell v. Ward*, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995). Factors such as environmental conditions, topography and lot configuration are indicators of a unique property. Further, a property owner has a common law right to use his property in a manner so as to realize its highest and best use. *See, Aspen Hill Venture v. Montgomery County Council*, 265 Md. 303 (1972). Under the current Zoning Regulations, the odd lot configuration of the subject property would only enable Petitioners to construct a 20 foot wide structure -- certainly not practical for this property's commercial zoning. Compliance with the Regulations would thereby create a practical difficulty that would result in depriving Petitioners of a use otherwise permitted under the Regulations. Moreover, the location of the subject property in a transition or "buffer" area between primarily commercial uses to the

west and more residential uses to the east, as well as the sloping topography, contribute to the uniqueness of the subject property.

Finally, I find that the variance requests can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the Regulations, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this petition held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered, I find that Petitioners' variance request should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this ______ day of June, 2010 by this Deputy Zoning Commissioner, that Petitioners' Variance requests as follows:

- From Section 238.2 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit
 a side yard of 18 feet in lieu of the 30 feet required; and
- From Section 250.2 of the B.C.Z.R. to permit a side yard of 28 feet in lieu of the 30 feet required, and the sum of two side yards of 46 feet in lieu of the 80 feet required,

be and are hereby GRANTED, subject to the following:

- Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2. Architectural building elevations for the proposed structure shall be submitted to the Office of Planning for review and approval prior to the issuance of any building permits.
- A landscape plan which includes details on any proposed signage and lighting shall be submitted to the Office of Planning for review and approval prior to the issuance of any building permits.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

DURABLE GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY AND DESIGNATION OF GUARDIAN OF BARBARA J. SCHOTT

I, Barbara J. Schott, of Harford County, Maryland, do hereby execute this General Power of Attorney with the intention that the attorney-in-fact (hereinafter "Agent") named shall be able to act in my place in all matters. I intend that it be governed by Maryland law.

Section 1. Designation of Agent.

- 1.02. Section 2. Effective Date of Power of Attorney.

- **3.14.** Bargain for, contract for, purchase, receive, lease, or otherwise acquire in my name, for my account or on my behalf, property of any kind, real or personal, tangible or intangible, including (but not limited to) United States Treasury Bills, Notes and Bonds, and other obligations of the United States Government, or any of its agencies, of any series or issue.

Prepare and execute any and all federal, state, local, income, gift or other tax returns, FICA returns, payroll tax returns, claims for refunds, or declarations of estimated tax; represent me (directly or through attorneys, accountants, or other agents) in any matter before the Internal Revenue Service or any other federal, state, or local agency; execute closing agreements or powers of attorney forms required by any agency; execute consents extending the statutory period for the assessment or collection of taxes; pay all taxes and interest thereon which I properly may owe or which may be assessed against me; contest the validity of any proposed assessment; exercise any election available

DECLARATION OF EASEMENT AND COVENANTS FOR MAINTENANCE OF PRIVATE DRIVEWAY

THIS DECLARATION OF EASEMENT AND COVENANTS FOR MAINTENANCE OF PRIVATE DRIVEWAY ("Declaration") is made this __ day of ____, 2010, by Beltway Property Management, Inc., a Maryland Corporation (hereinafter "Beltway" or "Declarant").

WHEREAS, the Declarant is the fee simple owner of that parcel of land on Fitch Avenue in Baltimore County, known as parcel 1128, Tax Map 81, which parcel was conveyed to it by Deed recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County in Liber 14580, folio 489; and

WHEREAS, the Declarant desires to subject a portion of the parcel of land, hereinafter defined, to certain covenants and conditions with respect to the use and maintenance of a common right-of-way or driveway ("Common Driveway") for use in common with the owner of the adjacent land presently titled to Emil A. Schott, Jr. and Barbara J. Schott, his wife, which land is known as parcel 248, Tax Map 81, and was conveyed to the present owners by Deed recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County in Liber 6412, Folio 311. The Common Driveway is located within the area denoted on the exhibit attached hereto as Private Ingress, Egress, Maintenance and Utility Easement, having an area of 6,404 square feet, more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Declarant hereby declares that the Common Driveway shall be hereafter held, sold and conveyed subject to the covenants hereinafter set forth, which are for the purpose of providing (i) ingress and egress to, from and between the public street and the lands that share the Common Driveway, (ii) for sharing the cost of making repairs and/or replacements and for maintenance of the Common Driveway, which covenants shall run with the land and shall be binding upon all parties, their heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns, having any right, title or interest in the Common Driveway or sharing the Common Driveway respectively, and shall inure to the benefit of each owner of the immediately adjacent lands or parcels as described above, and (iii) allowing for the installation, maintenance and repair of any utilities along or under the Common Driveway. This Declaration is intended for the sharing of the Common Driveway by the owners of the adjacent parcels ("Owners") and their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors, assigns, tenants, guests, and invitees.

- 1. **Easements.** The Declarant hereby declares and establishes an easement in perpetuity in, on, over and across the Common Driveway, and for the use in common for pedestrian and vehicular access to and from each of the lands sharing such Common Driveway and for the installation and maintenance of drainage and utility facilities on, in and under the Common Driveway.
- 2. <u>Contribution for Maintenance and Improvements.</u> The Owners of the adjacent parcels shall be responsible for contributing towards the costs of maintenance, repair and replacement of the Common Driveway, so that each of those Owners may enjoy the equal use and benefit of the Common Driveway (such maintenance, repair and replacement hereinafter collectively referred to as "Repairs" and the cost therefore referred to as the "Cost of Repairs") in the following amounts:

In the event the Common Driveway requires of any Lot sharing such Common Driveway may make such Repairs or cause such made (such Owner being hereinafter referred to as the "Initiating Owner") and a Cost for Repairs therefor and shall be entitled to contribution for such Cost from

- 3. <u>Initiating Repairs.</u> In the event the Common Driveway requires Repairs, the Owner of any Lot sharing such Common Driveway may make such Repairs or cause such Repairs to be made (such Owner being hereinafter referred to as the "Initiating Owner") and may advance the Cost for Repairs therefor and shall be entitled to contribution for such Cost from the Owners of the other Lot or Common Driveway sharing such Common Driveway, upon compliance with the following procedures:
- 3.1 Except in case of an emergency, before making any Repairs or incurring any Cost for Repairs, the Initiating Owner shall notify the Owner of any lot or parcel sharing the Common Driveway, in writing, sent by certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, addressed to the Owner of the other lot or parcel (the "Benefiting Owner or Owners"), at the mailing address for such Benefiting Owner or Owners as shown on the Land Assessments Records of Baltimore County, Maryland, of the Repairs proposed, and request that such Benefiting Owner or Owners consent to the making of such Repairs. If the Benefiting Owner or Owners consent in writing, the Initiating Owner may contract for or make such Repairs and the Benefiting Owner or Owners shall thereafter be obligated to pay their pro-rata share of the cost of such Repairs. The Initiating Owner may demand that the proportionate share of the estimated Cost for Repairs be paid (to be held in escrow) in advance by the Benefiting Owner or Owners.
- 3.2 In the event of an emergency which creates a hazardous and unsafe condition, the Initiating Owner may make such Repairs or cause such Repairs to be made and advance the Cost of Repairs without giving notice as provided above. Within fifteen (15) days after making the Repairs, the Initiating Owner shall notify the Benefiting Owner or Owners, in writing, sent by certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, addressed to the Benefiting Owner or Owners, at the mailing address for such Benefiting Owner or Owners as shown on the Land Assessments Records of Baltimore County, Maryland, of the Repairs made and that the making of the Repairs was an emergency. The Benefiting Owner or Owners shall then be obligated to pay their pro-rata share of the cost of such Repairs. The payment shall be due within thirty (30) days after delivery of the notice.
- 3.3 Each Owner shall be exclusively responsible for any expenditures incurred for Repairs to the Common Driveway damaged through their negligence, willful misconduct or the delivery of goods or services to their property.
- 4. <u>Cost for Repairs</u>. "Cost for Repairs" as used herein shall mean the actual cost for the Repairs so made or to be made.
- 5. Obligation of Owners. Each Owner, for each of the parcels, hereby covenants, from time to time hereafter, by accepting a deed therefor, whether or not it shall be so expressed in such deed, and agrees to pay his/her/their share of the Cost for Repairs as provided above. The obligation to contribute to the Cost for Repairs shall be binding upon each of the Owners only for Repairs made while such Owner is the fee simple Owner of the Lot or Lands at the time the obligation fell due. The obligation for delinquent Cost for Repairs shall not be binding on a prior or successor Owner in title unless expressly assumed by him/her/them.

- 6. Maryland Contract Lien Act. The Initiating Owner shall be entitled to a lien against the lot or parcel of any Benefiting Owner or Owners responsible for a share of the Cost for Repairs who does not pay his/her/their proportionate share of the costs within sixty (60) days after written demand therefor. The Initiating Owner may establish and enforce the lien for any such cost pursuant to the Maryland Contract Lien Act. The lien may be established and enforced for damages, costs of collection, late charges permitted by law, and attorney's fees of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or such greater amount as may be awarded by a court having jurisdiction for breach of any of the covenants herein.
- 7. <u>Subordination of the Lien to Mortgages.</u> The lien for the Cost for Repairs provided for herein shall be subordinate to the lien of any mortgage or deed of trust now or hereafter placed against a lot or parcel that was recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County prior to the recording of the lien for the Cost for Repairs. The lien for Cost for Repairs shall be effective from the date of its recording.
- 8. <u>No Merger.</u> There shall be no merger of the covenants, conditions, or restrictions created and imposed by this Declaration by reason of the fact that the same person, firm or corporation may hold, own or acquire, directly or indirectly, the fee simple estate in more than one of the lots or parcels. No such merger shall occur unless and until all of the persons, firms and corporations, having such fee simple interest in all of the lots or parcels sharing the Common Driveway, shall join in a written instrument specifically effecting such merger and duly recording the same.
- 9. <u>Termination or Amendment.</u> This Declaration may be terminated or amended in whole or in part with respect to all or a portion of the Common Driveway only with the written consent of all Owners of the lots or parcels, which would be affected by such termination or amendment as well as the consent of the appropriate agency of Baltimore County. Any instrument terminating or amending this Declaration must be recorded in the Land Records of Baltimore County, Maryland.

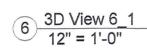
