FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of Petitions for Variance filed by the owner of the subject two (2) properties, Richard A. Robinson. Since the properties are owned by the same owner and are located adjacent to one another, the two cases were heard contemporaneously. In Case No. 2011-0160-A (Lot 186 – 13202 Choptank Avenue), the Petitioner requests variance relief from Sections 1B02.3.A.5 and 1B02.3C of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to permit a minimum lot width of 50 feet in lieu of the required 55 feet for a proposed dwelling. In Case No. 2010-0161-A (Lot 187 – 13200 Choptank Avenue), Petitioner requests similar relief. Specifically, relief is requested from B.C.Z.R. Sections 1B02.3.A.5 and 1B02.3C.1 to allow a lot width of 50 feet in lieu of the minimum required lot width of 55 feet for a replacement dwelling. The subject properties and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted in each case, which were accepted into evidence and respectively marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the requests were Richard A. Robinson, property owner, Robert Infussi with Expedite, LLC, the consultant assisting the Petitioner with the permitting process, and David S. Sofsky, P.E., with DSSPE Engineering, who prepared the site plans. There were no Protestants or other interested persons in attendance nor

were there any adverse Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments received from any of the County reviewing agencies.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject lots are located on the southwest side of Choptank Avenue and Gunpowder Road and just south of the Gunpowder River in Oliver Beach. The rectangular lots are identified as Lots 186 and 187 on the plat of subdivision of Oliver Beach, which is an older subdivision that was platted and recorded in the Land Records in 1940, prior to the first set of zoning regulations in Baltimore County. As is often the case with older subdivisions, many of the lots are undersized and do not meet current area and width requirements. In this regard, both lots are 50' wide x 200' deep, contain a gross area of 20,000 square feet, zoned D.R.5.5 and must comply with the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Regulations.

Both lots meet or exceed the lot area of the D.R.5.5 zone but do not meet the lot width requirement. The proposed dwellings will meet all front, side and rear setback requirements and will be situated on the lot consistent with other houses in the community. The only deficiency in this instance is the lot widths, which are 5 feet shy of the required 55 feet. Again, the fact that this subdivision was platted and recorded many years ago, prior to the adoption of the B.C.Z.R., is a persuasive factor, and the dwelling on Lot 187 has existed on the site where located since 1950. See Public Works Water Drawing No. 65-1028 submitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 3 that denotes the location of improvements on the lot in 1965 and also provides insight as to the pattern of development in this community.

Petitioner desires to redevelop the lots with new single-family dwellings. The existing structure and concrete patio will be removed and rebuilt. The new dwellings will be 30' wide x 40' deep and will meet all setback requirements. Public water and sewer will serve both lots.

Relief is required to approve the properties as undersized lots (width at building lines less than required by the area regulations) to permit the proposed development. Obviously, strict compliance with the regulations would create a hardship as the zoning regulations result in a denial of a reasonable and sufficient use of the property (See Belvoir Farms v. North 355 Md. 259 [1999]). Moreover, based on the testimony and evidence presented, the Petitioner is entitled to their variances as they have met the requirements of Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R. (See Mueller v. People's Counsel for Baltimore County 177 Md. App. 43 [2007]). In my view, the relief requested will not result in any detriment to the health, safety and general welfare of the surrounding locale and, therefore, would meet the spirit and intent of Section 307 for relief to be granted.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the properties and public hearing on these Petitions held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this

day of January 2011, that the Petition for Variance filed in Case No. 20100160-A (Lot 186 - 13202 Choptank Road), seeking relief from Sections 1B02.3.A.5 and
