### OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before this Administrative Law Judge as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owner of the subject property, Mark Hafner, Jr. for property located at 23 Flagship Road. The variance request is from Section 1B02.3.C.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit an addition on the rear of an existing dwelling to have a 13 feet rear setback in lieu of the required 50 feet. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1. Petitioner desires to construct an addition measuring 12 feet x 12 feet. Additional living space is necessary for the family of six. Petitioner's home was constructed in 1921, long before the imposition of zoning on the property.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. The comments indicate no opposition or other recommendations concerning the requested relief.

The Petitioner having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on February 27, 2011, and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioner has filed the supporting affidavits as required by Section 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code. Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to

indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Deputy Zoning Commissioner, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of Section 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, strict compliance with the B.C.Z.R. would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioner.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

 The Petitioner may apply for his building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at his own risk until such time as the 30 day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

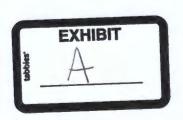
That based upon personal knowledge, the following are the facts which we base the request for an Administrative Variance at the above address (indicated hardship or practical difficulty).

Homeowner, Mark Hafner, applied for a building permit on February 14, 2011 to build a 12x12 addition to the back portion of his home located at 23 Flagship Road Baltimore, Maryland 21222. Due to Baltimore County Zoning, which requires you to have 50 feet from your house to your property line, enables us from building the addition. No home in our area has 50 feet from their home to their property line as the community was built in 1921. Due to the zoning policies in Baltimore County our family will suffer hardship if we are unable to build the addition.

Our home was purchased in 2001 with intent to be our home not an investment property. As children we both were born and raised in Dundalk, Baltimore County. We graduated from Dundalk High School and went on to college at the Community College of Baltimore County Dundalk. Susan graduated from CCBC with a paralegal degree. Our four children attend Dundalk Elementary which is one block from our home on flagship. The two eldest children are in the gifted and talented program at Dundalk Elementary and our fifth grader has recently applied to Parkville Middle School's Science and Engineering Program which was recognized by President Obama as a pilot school for the engineering and science program on February 14, 2011. We are very invested into our community and act as co-chairs and chair persons for the Watersedge Recreational Council where our four children play basketball, baseball, softball, soccer and dance. We are currently raising money to begin a football and cheer program which is scheduled to launch this August 2011.

Over the past 10 years we have completely remolded this home and would like to build a 12x12 addition to provide additional space for our family of six. We chose this home become of the large bedrooms and third floor which provides ample amounts of bedroom space for our children. Moving to a new home has been considered however economically, as working parents, we would ne be able to afford to buy a new home and would risk bankruptcy and foreclosure. Additionally, it would be devastating to pull our kids from their school and their extra curricular activities and they have excelled to very high levels in school and hold titles like Football Team Captain. All four of our children require daycare and even with both parents working full-time our budget is very tight.

Ourselves and our children are both very invested into this community and call this our home. It would be unjust as well as a financial hardship if we were forced to move because we are unable to make additional space for our family as well as the financial devastation if the economy unfortunately turns for the worse and forces one of us out of our jobs. With that being said we respectfully request your consideration and approval the proposed addition to 23 Flagship Road, Dundalk, Maryland 21222.

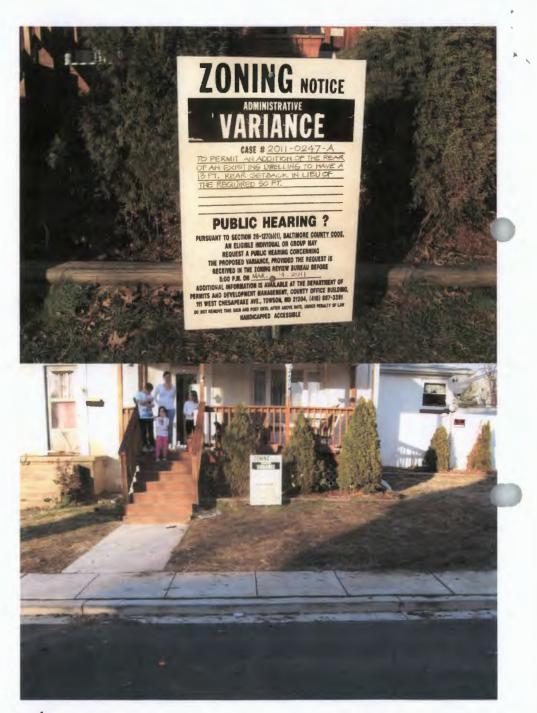
