### OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed by the lessee of the subject property, McDonald's USA, LLC ("McDonald's" or "Petitioner"), through its attorneys, Stanley S. Fine, Esquire, and Caroline L. Hecker, Esquire, for the property located at 7801 Eastern Avenue. The Petitioner requests a Special Hearing to determine whether a separate, free-standing enterprise sign on the McDonald's pad site is permitted. If it is determined that McDonald's is permitted to have a separate, free-standing enterprise sign on its pad site, McDonald's seeks variance relief from the following sections of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R."):

- Section 405.4 Attachment 1, 5(a)(VI) to permit 6 wall-mounted enterprise signs on the building facades in lieu of the permitted 3 signs; and
- Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(b)(VII) to permit a directional sign of 10.7 ft. in height in lieu of the permitted 6 ft.; and
- Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(b)(VII) to permit two (2) directional signs of 9.71 ft. in height in lieu of the permitted 6 ft.; and
- Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(II) to permit a canopy-type directional sign in lieu of the permitted wall-mounted or free-standing sign; and

• Section 450.5.B.3.b to permit erection of the sign above the face of the canopy in lieu of its erection on the face of the canopy.

In the alternative, if McDonald's is not permitted to have a separate, free-standing enterprise sign on its pad site, then McDonald's requests an additional variance from Section 450.4, Attachment 1, to permit two free-standing enterprise signs on the North Point Boulevard frontage of Eastpoint Mall. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the Plat to Accompany Zoning Petition, color sign elevation drawings, and the Plat to Accompany Special Hearing, which were accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibits 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, and 5, respectively.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request were Caroline L. Hecker, Esquire, attorney for McDonald's; Lee May, Area Construction Manager for McDonald's Corporation; and Iwona Rostek-Zarska of Baltimore Land Design Group, Inc., the engineer who prepared the site plan for this property. No protestants or other interested persons appeared at the hearing.

Testimony and evidence presented at the hearing discloses that McDonald's is the current lessee of a pad site in the Eastpoint Mall Shopping Center, which is owned by Thor Eastpoint Mall, LLC. There is an existing McDonald's restaurant located on North Point Boulevard across from Eastpoint Mall, which has been in operation since October 1987. McDonald's lease at that location is now expiring, and McDonald's has elected to relocate the restaurant to a new pad site at Eastpoint Mall for improved visibility, access, and operational efficiency. The new restaurant will be approximately 4,164 sq. ft. and will have approximately 69 seats.

Ms. Rostek-Zarska was accepted as an expert in site engineering and testified that the unique size and shape of the site impose certain constraints on the new restaurant that make the requested special hearing and variances necessary. The McDonald's site, shown on the site plan

and photographs submitted by Petitioner (Petitioner's Exhibits 1 and 3, respectively), is located on a pad site at the intersection of North Point Boulevard and the I-695 exit ramp. Although the site fronts on two busy streets, it does not have direct access to either one. Rather, patrons must enter the Eastpoint Mall Shopping Center in order to reach the McDonald's site. Ms. Zarska testified that the small size and irregular shape of the McDonald's pad site, and the fact that it is located at an intersection with frontage on two busy streets, make this property unique. Due to these unique features of the site, the requested signage variances are necessary in order to identify the McDonald's restaurant to passing motorists and to safely direct traffic in and around the site.

Petitioner seeks special hearing relief to permit the installation of a free-standing enterprise sign on the McDonald's pad site. Ms Zarska testified that this sign would be similar in size and character to an existing Chick-Fil-A sign located on another pad site at Eastpoint Mall, which was approved by letter dated July 28, 2008 from the Baltimore County Department of Permits and Development Management. Ms. Zarska testified that although the new McDonald's will be located at a pad site at Eastpoint Mall, it will not be identified on the Eastpoint Mall identification signs and therefore will not benefit from the existing free-standing signs at the mall. Like the Chick-Fil-A restaurant at Eastpoint Mall, the new McDonald's restaurant will be surrounded by curb islands and separated from Eastpoint Mall by the ring road. As a result, the McDonald's, like the Chick-Fil-A, will function as its own independent site.

After due consideration of the testimony presented on the Petition for Special Hearing, I find that McDonald's is permitted to have its own free-standing enterprise sign at its pad site. The McDonald's site functions independently from the rest of Eastpoint Mall and is physically separated from the mall by curb islands and the ring road. The fact that McDonald's will not be advertised on the Eastpoint Mall identification signs further demonstrates the need for independent

signage on the McDonald's pad site. For these reasons, I will grant the Petition for Special Hearing and approve the free-standing enterprise sign on the McDonald's pad site as shown on Petitioner's Exhibit 5.

Petitioner also seeks variance relief from B.C.Z.R. Section 405.4 Attachment 1, 5(a)(VI) to permit six (6) wall-mounted enterprise signs on building facades in lieu of the permitted three (3) signs; from B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(b)(VII) to permit a directional sign of 10.7 ft. in height in lieu of the permitted 6 ft.; B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(b)(VII) to permit two (2) directional signs of 9.71 ft. in height in lieu of the permitted 6 ft.; B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(II) to permit a canopy-type directional sign in lieu of the permitted wall-mounted or free-standing sign; and B.C.Z.R. Section 450.5.B.3.b to permit erection of the sign above the face of the canopy in lieu of its erection on the face of the canopy. Although the site is located at the busy intersection of North Point Boulevard and the I-695 exit ramp, patrons must enter the Eastpoint Mall Shopping Center parking lot in order to access the site as there is no direct access from the McDonald's pad site to either street that it abuts. As a result, these variances are necessary in order for the restaurant to be visible to passersby and in order to safely direct traffic in and around the McDonald's pad site. In addition, these signs are McDonald's standard signage plan, and the restaurant at this location would deviate from the standard style of other McDonald's restaurants if the proposed signs were not permitted.

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, it is clear that the requested variances meet the standards set forth in B.C.Z.R. § 307. The Property is unique by virtue of its small size and irregular shape. In light of these unique features of the Property, I find that the Petitioner has satisfied its burden at law. The constraints imposed by these features would create a practical difficulty for the Petitioner if strict compliance with the provisions of the B.C.Z.R. were required. I further find that the relief requested meets the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R, and I will therefore grant the requested variances. As I have granted Petitioner's special

hearing request, Petitioner's alternative variance request from B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4, Attachment 1, to permit two free-standing enterprise signs on the North Point Boulevard frontage of Eastpoint Mall is now moot and will be dismissed.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on these petitions held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance relief from the following sections of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R."):

- Section 405.4 Attachment 1, 5(a)(VI) to permit 6 wall-mounted enterprise signs on the building facades in lieu of the permitted 3 signs; and
- Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(b)(VII) to permit a directional sign of 10.7 ft. in height in lieu of the permitted 6 ft.; and
- Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(b)(VII) to permit two (2) directional signs of 9.71 ft. in height in lieu of the permitted 6 ft; and
- Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 3(II) to permit a canopy-type directional sign in lieu of the permitted wall-mounted or free-standing sign; and
- Section 450.5.B.3.b to permit erection of the sign above the face of the canopy in lieu of its erection on the face of the canopy, all as shown on Petitioner's Exhibits 2A and 4A,

be and are hereby GRANTED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance from B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4, Attachment 1, to permit 2 free-standing enterprise signs on the North Point Boulevard frontage of Eastpoint Mall is most and is hereby DISMISSED.

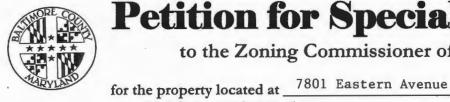

# These variances to the zoning law of Baltimore County are requested for the following reasons:

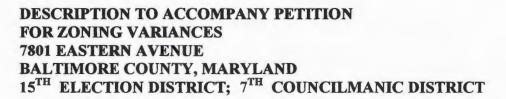
The irregular shape and location of this lot are unique and create practical difficulties in the layout of the site. Specifically, the site is separated from the rest of East Point Mall by curb islands and the ring road, and it can only be accessed from inside the Mall property. As a result, the requested signage variances are necessary in order to make the restaurant visible to passing motorists and to direct circulation safely within the site. In addition, this McDonald's would differ from McDonald's standard signage plan that has been implemented on other restaurants in Baltimore County if the requested variances were not permitted.

Dear Mr. Kotroco and Mr. Long:

This firm represents Chick-fil-A with regard to one of its future locations in the Dundalk area of Baltimore County. The subject site has frontage on Eastern Avenue, situated between Eastern and the ring road that serves the Eastpoint Mall. Chick-fil-A is undergoing construction on a 4,227 sq. ft. restaurant within an independent lease area, as shown on the enclosed site plan entitled "Site Plan for Chick-fil-A on Eastern Avenue" and dated July 17, 2008 (the "Site Plan"). I am writing to request confirmation that Chick-fil-A may install its own ground-mounted enterprise sign, as shown on the enclosed sign details, within its independent lease area.

Although Eastpoint Mall and certain of its tenants benefit from joint identification signage on the Mall property, Chick-fil-A will *not* be a tenant displayed on those Mall signs. Instead, Chick-fil-A intends to install a one tenant, ground-mounted brick

enterprise sign that will be located within its independent lease area. Freestanding enterprise signs such as this one that display the identity of single building occupants are permitted under Section 450.4.5(b) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations.

The location of Chick-fil-A's independent lease area on the perimeter of the Eastpoint Mall property, together with several other attributes of the site, justify the need for a freestanding enterprise sign for the use. As explained below, although this Chickfil-a will technically be within that overall Eastpoint Mall property, its location is distinguishable from other tenants of the Mall for signage purposes. Chick-fil-A is situated on what will operate as a stand-alone site for a number of reasons. A review of the Site Plan indicates: (a) the restaurant will be surrounded on all sides by curb islands (including islands separating the site from the ring road and the Mall tenants); (b) two ingress/egress lanes will be installed to serve this restaurant user which will be its only means of access to the ring road and the overall Mall property; and (c) and there will be parking spaces surrounding the restaurant that, pursuant to the terms of Chick-fil-A's lease, will be dedicated solely for use by its restaurant patrons. These features differentiate this restaurant from other tenants in and around the Mall. For example, as shown on the enclosed "4th Refined CRG Plan Eastpoint Mall," tenants throughout the Mall site are not set apart from each other by substantial curbing and they do share common parking fields with other tenants. In other words, when comparing the Chickfil-A site with the existing tenants that are located on sites that are, more or less, fully integrated with the Mall, it is apparent that the Chick-fil-A will be located on its own independent site, separate and distinct from the Mall, with its own supporting parking. For these reasons, it is our position that Chick-fil-A is entitled to its own enterprise sign to identify the stand-alone use.

Mr. Long, as you may remember, I met with you on two prior occasions to discuss signage for this particular Chick-fil-A site. During our initial meeting, we discussed the height of the sign, that it would be ground-mounted, and that the sign would be clad primarily in brick. During our second meeting, I showed you the enclosed sign detail, which indicates the sign will be limited to 9 feet in height and constructed primarily of brick that, as I explained, will match the brick used for the Chick-fil-A building. At the conclusion of our meeting, you indicated that the proposed sign, as shown on the enclosed detail, is to your Office's satisfaction and appropriate to represent Chick-fil-A given its location on the Mall property.

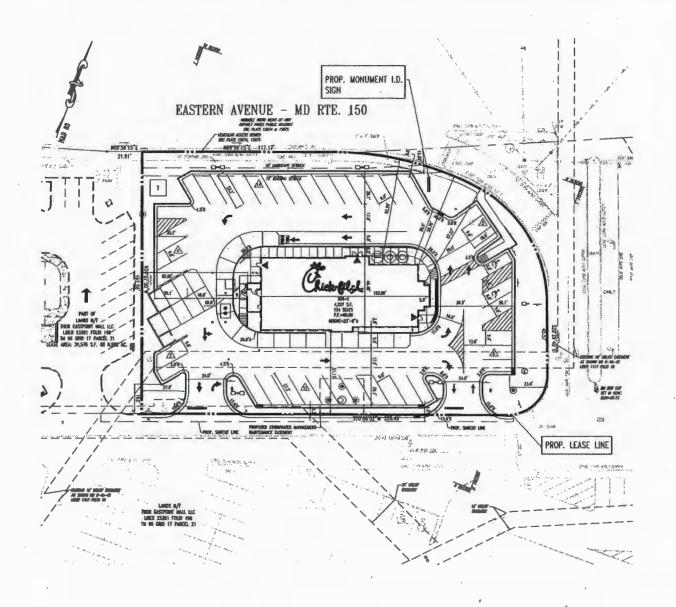

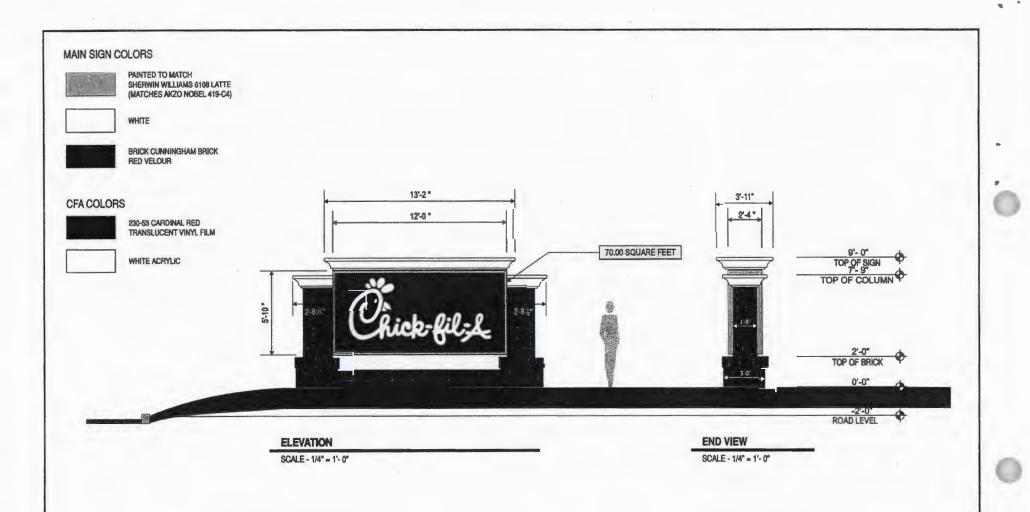

What is the location that is the subject of the petition?

Eastpoint Mall - 7801 Eastern Avenue

The McDonald's pad site is technically part of the mall property but has the address of 1050 North Point Blvd.

What is your interest in the property?

McDonald's USA, LLC is the current lessee of the property.

### What is at this location currently?

Until recently, this site was unimproved and used for parking as part of Eastpoint Mall. The new McDonald's restaurant, which is a permitted use as a matter of right, is currently under construction at this location.

# What is McDonald's proposing to do at this location?

Construct a new McDonald's restaurant.

This restaurant will replace an existing McDonald's restaurant located on North Point Blvd. across from the mall.

That McDonald's has been in operation since October 1987. However, McDonald's lease is now expiring at that location and they have elected to relocate the restaurant to a pad site at Eastpoint Mall for improved visibility and better access.



The proposed new restaurant will be a much more efficient building, both operationally and in terms of energy usage.

# SEE EXHIBITS 2A & 2B – PLAT TO ACCOMPANY ZONING PETITION (V-1 / V-1A)

We are constructing a new McDonald's restaurant at this location.

Preliminarily, as part of the signage package, we have requested a Special Hearing to determine whether a free-standing monument sign is permitted on this site, similar to the sign that was approved for the Chick-Fil-A restaurant on the other side of the mall.

We are also requesting several signage variances for the new restaurant in order to make the restaurant visible to passing motorists and to bring the new restaurant into conformity with other new McDonald's restaurants in Baltimore County.

In the event that it is determined that the free-standing sign is not permitted, we are also requesting an additional variance to permit an additional free-standing enterprise sign at Eastpoint Mall.

There is ample off-street parking on this site as it is part of Eastpoint Mall.

What is the square footage of the new McDonald's restaurant? 4,164 sq. ft.

How many seats will the new restaurant have? 69 seats

### Explain the sign package:

# What is proposed?

We are proposing 6 enterprise signs on the faces of the buildings: 2 signs on the front of the building; 1 sign on the drive-thru side of the building; 2 signs on the non-drive-thru side of the building; and 1 sign on the rear of the building.

We also propose a "canopy"-style directional sign on the front side of the building. This sign will have the word "Welcome" above the face of the canopy, rather than printed directly on the face of the canopy.

We are also proposing a directional sign over each of the drive-thru lanes which, because they are intended to go over the drive-thru lanes, are higher than what would otherwise be permitted.

Finally, we are proposing a free-standing enterprise sign for the McDonald's site, which is the subject of the Petition for Special Hearing.

### Why are you proposing these signage variances?

We have requested these signage variances to make the building visible to passing motorists at this busy intersection and to safely direct traffic in and around the site.

These signage variances will also permit the appearance of this restaurant to be consistent with other McDonald's restaurants in Baltimore County.

Similar signage packages have been approved by variances granted by the Baltimore County Administrative Law Judge for other McDonald's restaurants located at 502 Reisterstown Road, 2116 York Road, 2222 Dundalk Avenue, 6650 Security Boulevard, 2107 E. Joppa Road, 934 York Road, and 7927 Belair Road.

# Describe how proposed construction will improve the operation.

The new restaurant will have significantly better access than the existing restaurant, which is difficult to access from North Point Blvd. It will also be more functionally efficient than the existing restaurant and, as we are implementing as many "green building" items in our design as possible, the new building will be much more energy efficient than the existing one.

### What is the amount of capital investment for this project?

Approximately \$ 2.2 million

#### What is the construction schedule for the new restaurant?

Construction of the new restaurant, which is a permitted use as a matter of right, is already underway. If the petition is approved, we will update our signage permit to include the additional signs.

### SPECIAL HEARING:

Preliminarily, we are requesting a Special Hearing to determine whether a separate free-standing enterprise sign for the McDonald's pad site is permitted.

The proposed free-standing sign would be located on the southwest corner of the pad site and would consist of a 12' tall monument sign.

EXHIBIT 5 – PLAT TO ACCOMPANY PETITION FOR SPECIAL HEARING (SH-1)

McDonald's will not be identified on the Eastpoint Mall identification signs and therefore will not benefit from the existing free-standing signs at the mall.

In addition, although the McDonald's restaurant is technically part of the mall, the site will be surrounded by curb islands and separated from the mall property by the ring road. The McDonald's will therefore function as its own independent site.

The McDonald's will also have a separately dedicated parking area, distinguishing its pad site from the rest of the mall.

On the Eastern Avenue side of the mall, Chick-Fil-A was permitted to install its own free-standing monument sign by decision dated July 28, 2008.

McDonald's proposed free-standing sign will be similar in size and character to the Chick-Fil-A sign.

For these reasons, we request that McDonald's be permitted to install its own free-standing sign on its pad site.

If the Special Hearing is denied, we are also requesting an additional variance to permit a second free-standing sign on the North Point Blvd. frontage of Eastpoint Mall.

### SEE EXHIBIT 4B – ELEVATIONS / SIGNAGE DETAILS (V-2A)

Is the subject property peculiar, unusual, or unique when compared to other properties in the neighborhood?

Yes. The property is unique due to its small size, as well as the fact that it is located within the Eastpoint Mall property and does not have direct access from the streets it abuts. In addition, the view of the site to northbound traffic on North Point Blvd. is obstructed by a grove of trees located immediately south of the site.

Since you have indicated that the property is peculiar, unusual, or unique, would strict compliance with the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations result in a practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship to the Petitioner?

Yes.

The small size of the lot, the fact that the property is located within the Eastpoint Mall property, and the obstructed view of the property due to the location of a grove of trees on the adjacent lot all create practical difficulties in identifying the building and safely directing traffic in and around the site.

The additional wall-mounted enterprise signs identify the building as a McDonald's restaurant from all sides, and will permit motorists to more easily identify the building as a McDonald's as the exit I-695, as well as from North Point Blvd. and within the mall property.

In addition, the proposed signage identifies the drive-thru lane and the entrances to the restaurant in order to safely direct traffic around the site.

This McDonald's would also differ from McDonald's standard signage plan that has been implemented on other restaurants in Baltimore County if the requested variances were not permitted.

Would the granting of the variance be injurious to the use and enjoyment of the other property owners in the immediate vicinity, or substantially diminish and impair property values in the neighborhood?

The granting of the variance will likely improve property values in the vicinity, as the new restaurant will activate a currently vacant corner.

In addition, as the requested variances will permit McDonald's to replace an existing restaurant on North Point Blvd. with this new one, there will be no greater impact on the use and enjoyment of the neighboring properties than that created by the existing restaurant.

We have shared our plans with the Eastpoint Estates Improvement Association and they have expressed no objection to the proposed variances.

Would the granting of the variances impair an adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property, or overcrowd the land, or create an undue concentration of population, or substantially increase the congestion of the streets, or create hazardous traffic conditions, or increase the danger of fire, or otherwise endanger the public safety?

The granting of the variances will not impact the size, shape or location of the proposed building and therefore will not impair the supply of light and air to adjacent properties, nor will these variances cause an overcrowding of the land. Similarly, the granting of the variances will have no affect on the concentration of population, congestion of the streets, traffic conditions, or the danger of fire, nor will they endanger the public safety in any manner.

# Would the granting of the variances adversely affect transportation or unduly burden water, sewers, school, park, or other public facilities?

The granting of the variances will not have any impact on transportation, nor will they burden water, sewers, school, park, or other public facilities.

# Would the granting of the variances be in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR?

The granting of these variances is in harmony with the purpose of the Zoning Regulations, as they will promote the health, security, comfort, convenience, orderly development and other aspects of the general welfare of the community by permitting McDonald's to replace an outdated restaurant with a more modern, attractive one. This will improve the general welfare of the surrounding neighborhood.

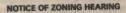
