OPINION

This case comes before the Board of Appeals as an appeal of the May 10, 2012 decision of the Office of Administrative Law by which the Petitoners Ronald W. and Jean Ruff were denied their request for a variance for the use of their property located at 1218 Elm Avenue. The Petitioners sought zoning approval in the form of a Variance to allow 1) a minimum lot width of 50 feet in lieu of the required 90 feet; 2.) a minimum side yard setback of 10 feet in lieu of he required 15 feet; and 3) a minimum sum of side yard setback of 20 feet in lieu of the required 35 feet. The Variance request is from Section 400.1 and 400.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.).

A hearing was held before the Board of Appeals (Board) at which the Petitioners were represented by counsel J. Neil Lanzi, Esquire. The variance request was opposed by a number of Protestants who were collectively represent by counsel Benjamin Bronstein, Esquire. The Office of the People's Counsel appeared in opposition to the request variance and was represented by Peter Max Zimmerman, Esquire.

BACKGROUND

The subject property is located is located in the Arbutus community of Baltimore County.

The Petitioners, according to the evidence, sought the requested variance to enable them to use and/or convert the use of their property from a single family dwelling into a multiple family apartment use. The subject property is presently zoned D.R. 5.5 and has a combined proposed lot area of 12,870 S.F. The proposed combined lot area consists of three adjacent lots (Lot 4, 6A and 7A) owned by the Petitioners. The precise description of the requested variance and lots is contained in Petitioner's Exhibit 1 which is titled "Plat to Accompany a Petition for Zoning Variances", prepared by Gerhold, Cross & Etzel, LTD. Professional Land Surveyors.

The proposed lot combination would comply with the lot size requirement contained in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations for a 2 apartment multi family building if the zoning variance was granted.

According to the testimony presented at the hearing in the building situate on the subject property is presently configured as a duplex apartment building with an additional apartment in the basement of the building. Testimony was taken as to the duration of the duplex use of the property. It appears that the property has been in a duplex configuration since the 1940's. However the Petitioner (Mr. Ruff) testified that the use of the building as an occupied duplex apartment building lapsed for a period exceeding one year and therefore he could not seek relief from the DR 5.5 single family zoning requirement on the theory that the property presented a "non-conforming use" as defined in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations.

Several neighbors of the subject property appeared to testify in opposition to the variance request and voiced their concerns about the propriety of the proposed use of the property as a multi-family dwelling.

The Office of Peoples' Counsel represented by Peter M. Zimmerman, Esq. presented two arguments to the Board.

- 1. People's Counsel advised the Board that his office believed that the Petitioners had failed to properly post the notice of variance request on their property. In sum People's Counsel complained that the "posting" did not contain sufficient information to effectively place the neighbors and any interested persons on proper notice the Petitioners were seeking to gain approval for a multi-family use of their property. The Board examined a photograph of the "posting" (People's Counsel Ex. 8). While the posting contains no language of the Petitioners' intention to change the dwelling status of their property, the Board finds that the description of the variance sought was sufficient for notice of the intended variance by virtue of the fact that the dwelling usage was not a matter before this Board for its review.
- 2. Peoples' Counsel argued that the subject property does not meet the threshold test for a variance in that the property is not "unique". Counsel introduced into evidence a plat; aerial map; and two neighborhood maps depicting the subject property and the surrounding neighborhood. (Peoples' Counsel Ex. 2-5). The exhibits were offered to the Board as evidence that the subject property does not by its physical characteristics differ substantially from the other lots in the neighborhood.

DECISION

Maryland jurisprudence is well established regarding the factors to be considered when contemplating variance relief.

Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, Section 307.1, in pertinent part, states as follows:

Ronald and Jean Ruin Petitioners-Legal Owners

Case No.: 12-235-A

"...(T)he County Board of Appeals, upon appeal, shall have and they are hereby given the power to grant variances from height and area regulations...only in cases where special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land or structure which is the subject of the variance request and where strict compliance with the Zoning Regulations for Baltimore County would result in practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship.... Furthermore, any such variance shall be granted only if in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of said height, area...regulations, and only in such manner as to grant relief without injury to public health, safety, and general welfare...."

In *McLean v. Soley*, 270 Md. 216 (1973) the court established the following criteria for determining practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship:

- "1) Whether compliance with the strict letter of the restrictions governing various variances would unreasonably prevent the owner from using the property for a permitted purpose or would render conformity with such restrictions unnecessarily burdensome.
- "2) Whether a grant of the variance applied for would do substantial justice to the applicant as well as to other property owners in the district, or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give substantial relief to the owner of the property involved and be more consistent with justice to other property owners.
- "3) Whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured."

Further, in North v. St. Mary's County, 99 Md. App. 502 (1994) the Court held that

"...the 'unique' aspect of a variance requirement does not refer to the extent of improvements on the property, or upon neighboring property. 'Uniqueness' of a property for zoning purposes requires that the subject property have an inherent characteristic not shared by other properties in the area, i.e., its shape, topography, subsurface condition, environmental factors, historical significance, access or non-access to navigable waters, practical restrictions imposed by abutting properties (such as obstructions) or other similar restrictions. In respect to structures, it would relate to such characteristics as unusual architectural aspects and bearing or party walls." Id at 514

In the Court of Special Appeals in Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md.App. 691 (1995), wherein the

Court writes:

...The Baltimore County ordinance requires "conditions ...peculiar to the land...and...practical difficulty...." Both must exist. ...However, as is clear from the

language of the Baltimore County ordinance, the initial factor that must be established before the practical difficulties, if any, are addressed, is the abnormal impact the ordinance has on a specific piece of property because of the peculiarity and uniqueness of that piece of property, not the uniqueness or peculiarity of the practical difficulties alleged to exist. It is only when the uniqueness is first established that we then concern ourselves with the practical difficulties...." <u>Id.</u> at 698.

In requiring a pre-requisite finding of "uniqueness", the Court defined the term and stated:

In the zoning context the "unique" aspect of a variance requirement does not refer to the extent of improvements upon the property, or upon neighboring property. "Uniqueness" of a property for zoning purposes requires that the subject property has an inherent characteristic not shared by other properties in the area, i.e., its shape, topography, subsurface condition, environmental factors, historical significance, access or non-access to navigable waters, practical restrictions imposed by abutting properties (such as obstructions) or other similar restrictions.... <u>Id.</u> at 710.

Petitioner's Argument

The Petitioners argue that the property is unique under BCZR 307.1 based upon the reasoning that the shape of the parcel under the proposed deed mergers will result in a combined lot that is "L" shaped. The shape of the proposed lot will differ from that of most of the lots in the neighborhood and is arguable unique. However the proposed L shape lot is obviously a creation of the Petitioners rather than an existing "inherent characteristic" of the property.

CONCLUSION

This Board is not persuaded that the Petitioner has illustrated uniqueness of its parcel to deviate from standing zoning requirements its property. Consequently, Petitioner's requested Variance relief is DENIED.

ORDER

THEREFORE, IT IS THIS 2/St day of March, 2013 by the Board of Appeals of Baltimore County

ORDERED that the Petitioner's request for a variance from Section 400.01 and 400.3 of the BCZR, to permit 1) a minimum lot width of 50 feet in lieu of the required 90 feet; 2) a minimum side yard setback of 10 feet in lieu of the required 15 feet; and 3) a minimum sum of side yard setbacks of 20 feet in lieu of the required 35 feet is hereby **DENIED**.

Any Petition for Judicial Review from this decision must be made in accordance with Rule 7-201 through Rule 7-210 of the *Maryland Rules*.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the legal owners, Ronald W. and Jean Ruff. The Petitioners are requesting Variance relief from Section 402.1.B (Chart) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), as follows:

- To allow a minimum lot width of 50' in lieu of the required 90',
- To allow a minimum side yard setback of 10' in lieu of the required 15', and
- To allow a minimum sum of side yard setbacks of 20' in lieu of the required 35'.

The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the amended site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the variance request were Petitioners Ronald W. and Jean Ruff and Bruce E. Doak with Gerhold, Cross & Etzel, Ltd., the professional land surveyor who prepared the site plan. Appearing in opposition were John Kapustka, Jacqueline V. Harle, Nancy L. Yospa, and Edward M. Williams. Benjamin Bronstein, Esquire appeared as counsel and represented the community. The file reveals that the Petition was properly advertised and the site was properly posted as required by the B.C.Z.R.

Testimony and evidence revealed that the subject property is a single-family dwelling constructed in 1923. Mr. Doak testified the Petitioners own Lots 4, 6A and 7A, which in the ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

aggregate total 18,475 square feet. Ms. Ruff testified about the history of the property, which was first owned by the Ruff family in 1941. See Exhibits 3A-G. Ms. Ruff stated that the second floor of the premises was first rented to a tenant (Ms. Cooper) in or about 1965, and that a separate entrance was used to access this apartment. Apparently, the second floor continued to be rented as an apartment through at least 2009. At or about that time, the Petitioners acquired the premises and began renovations to the first floor and basement. Ms. Ruff stated that the basement was first used to house a tenant in 2011, at which time she secured from Baltimore County licenses for the three apartments.

The Petitioners now propose to merge Lots 4, 6A and 7A (shown on Exhibit 1) into one deed, which would satisfy the minimum square footage required under B.C.Z.R. § 402.1. See Exhibit 2. However, to lawfully operate three apartments in the dwelling, the Petitioners would require a lot width and setback variances, as mentioned above.

Mr. Kapustka, who lives at 1216 Elm Ridge Road, testified he is opposed to the variance relief, and believes three apartments in the dwelling would be detrimental to the community. Mr. Kapustka, who has lived in the area for approximately 45 years, also stated that in his opinion there was nothing "unique" about 1218 Elm Ridge, which he felt was very similar to the other homes and lots in the neighborhood.

The final witness was Edward Williams, who lives at 1220 Elm Ridge Road. Mr. Williams has lived in his home for 15 years, and he has for many years rented the second floor of his home to a tenant. He indicated he was opposed to the variance relief, and felt that three apartments in the dwelling would negatively impact the community

Counsel for Protestants submitted (Protestants' Exhibit 2) a 14-page exhibit signed by 42 neighboring owners. Each of these owners stated they opposed the variance request, and felt that "permitting rental houses with more than two rental units" would disrupt the general welfare of the ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

community.

Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made a part of the record of this case. There were no adverse comments received from any of the County reviewing agencies.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I am persuaded to deny the request for variance relief. The Petitioners have simply failed to adduce sufficient proof, as required by Maryland law.

Under Cromwell and its progeny, to obtain variance relief requires a showing that:

(1) The property is unique; and

(2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel, 407 Md 53, 80 (2008).

In this case, the subject property is substantially similar to the adjoining homes shown on the Plan (Exhibit 1). Mr. Doak testified that since the lots were created in 1926 and 1940 (See Plats, Exhibits 3H and 3I), before the B.C.Z.R. was enacted, that renders the property "unique." I respectfully disagree, and would note that if that argument prevailed, each of the homes shown on the subdivision plats would also qualify as "unique," and would be entitled to variance relief. That is an untenable proposition.

In addition, there was no proof the Petitioners would suffer a practical difficulty and/or hardship if the B.C.Z.R. were strictly enforced. Indeed, when Petitioners acquired the home in 2009, only two apartments were established in the dwelling, and the community has indicated it has no objection to such use continuing.

I also do not believe the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is amply demonstrated by the opposition of the several community members ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

who attended the hearing, and the signatures of 42 adjoining homeowners who also objected to the relief requested.

Finally, as noted at the outset, Petitioners' site plan was amended, and they now propose to combine three (3) lots. Under the Baltimore County Code (B.C.C.), the "combination of any two or more lots ... for any purpose" constitutes "development," which would require the Petitioners to obtain approval or an exemption from the Baltimore County Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on this Petition, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered by the Petitioners, I find that Petitioners' variance request should be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>10th</u> day of May, 2012, by this Administrative Law Judge that Petitioners' Variance request from Section 402.1.B (Chart) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), as follows:

- To allow a minimum lot width of 50' in lieu of the required 90',
- To allow a minimum side yard setback of 10' in lieu of the required 15', and
- To allow a minimum sum of side yard setbacks of 20' in lieu of the required 35',
 be and is hereby DENIED.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

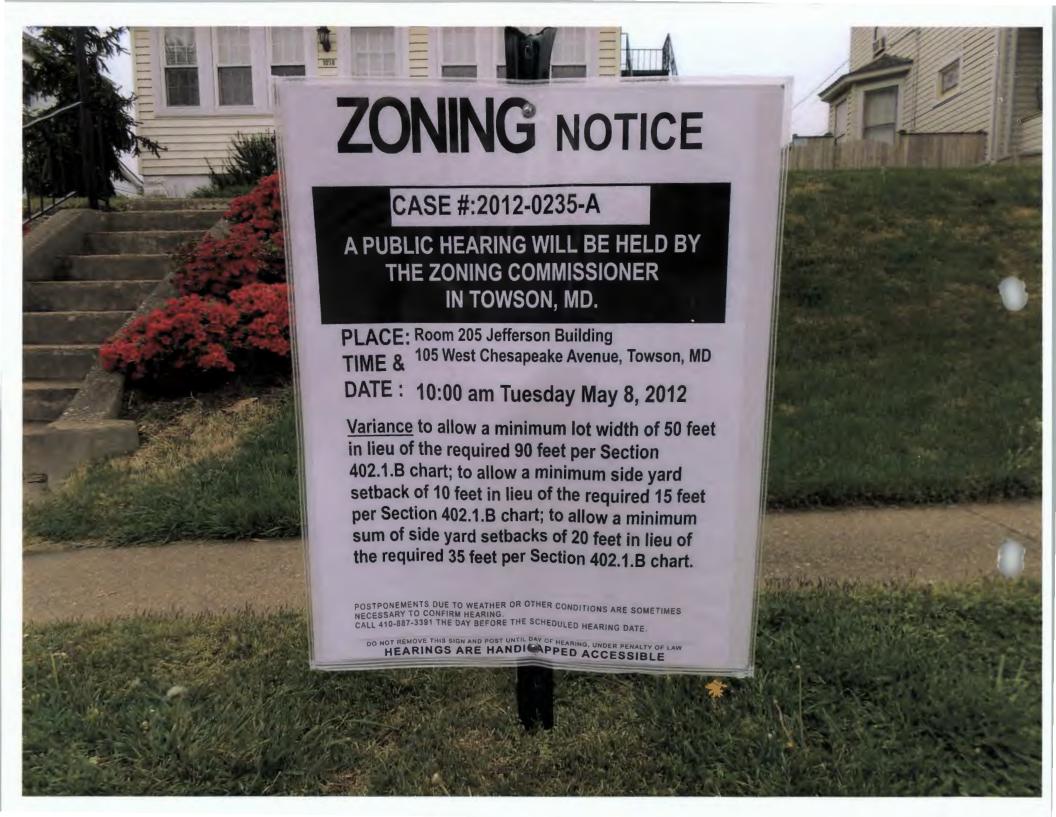

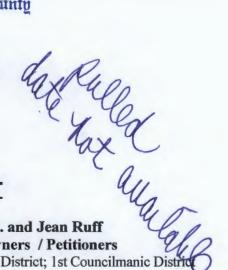

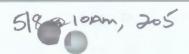

The purpose of this letter is to clarify and amplify the observations made in our letter sent yesterday, October 4, 2012. It will cover problems arising under BCZR Sections 307.1 and 402.1.B. relating to density variance, use variance, and area variance issues BCZR Section 307.1 allows area, parking, and sign variances, but does not allow use and density variances.

To preview the case, the questions presented will be:

- 1. Does the amended petition for conversion to a 3-family conflict, as a practical matter, with the prohibition on density variances?
- 2. Anyway, does a variance to the single-family dwelling conversion schedule constitute an impermissible use variance?
- 3. Even if considered as an area variance, does the petition satisfy the standards of uniqueness and resulting practical difficulty?

I. The Density Variance Issue

The case is complicated by the fact that Petitioner originally filed a petition with site plan for conversion of a one-family dwelling to a two-family dwelling spanning front to rear lots 4 and 7A (erasing the lot division line between them), but amended it at the ALJ hearing to submit a site plan Wendell H. showing a conversion to a three-family dwelling spanning lots 4, 7A, and 6A (further erasing the division line between adjacent – side by side – rear lots 7A and 6A). Upon our further review, it appears that additional explanation is warranted to cover this complicated situation.

As to the density variance, it is necessary to expand on our October 4 letter. The dwelling and garage area spanning lots 4 and 7A comprise amount to 12,780 square feet. This is enough under the Section 402.1.B conversion chart to meet the two-family dwelling minimum of 10,000 square feet, but not the 13,000 square feet required for a three-family dwelling. Petitioner attempts to overcome this deficiency for the three-family dwelling by merging Lot 6A in the amended site plan to bring the area to 18,475 square feet.

In context, the addition of vacant lot 6A into the mix, whether it be called merger or by any other name, appears as an afterthought, artificial and unrealistic. Lot 6A does not, as a practical matter, reduce the density impact of the Lot 4 dwelling which fronts Elm Ridge Avenue. The severe deficiencies for front lot width and side yard setbacks reflect the density problem. To sum up, as to density, the amended petition and site plan to allow a three-family dwelling conflicts with the spirit and intent of the BCZR Section 307.1 prohibition of any variance which results in excessive density.

II. The Use Variance Issue

It is settled that BCZR Section 307.1 does not permit any use variance. See <u>Loyola Loan ass'n v. Buschman</u> 227 Md. 243, 250-51 (1961); <u>McLean v. Soley</u> 270 Md. 208, 213-14 (1973). Although the BCZR Section 402.1B dimension schedule articulates various requirements normally associated with area variances, the essence of conversion is to vary the use from a one-family dwelling to a multiple-family dwelling. Generally, the Density-Residential Zones delineate single-family dwellings, two-family dwellings, and multifamily dwellings as different uses. See BCZR Section 1B01.1.A.1, 1B01.2.C, and the Comprehensive Manual of Development Policies. So, where a requested conversion does not meet the dimensional requirements of the BCZR Section 402.1.B schedule, which requirements in isolation may be viewed as area requirements, does this also in context amount to a use variance?

It is noteworthy that the Court of Appeals has recently reiterated that context, history, and common sense are essential in statutory interpretation. <u>Building Materials Corporation of America v. Board of Education of Baltimore County</u> Md. (2012), 2012 WL 4329334, pages 7-8, enclosed. In context, a petition for conversion of one use to another constitutes a use variance, whether viewed primarily or in combination with area variances. Therefore, the petition for conversion, whether to a two-family or three-family dwelling, conflicts with BCZR Section 307.1.

III. The Area Variance Issue

As stated in our October 4 letter, even if considered as an area variance, there is not in any event a basis to justify a variance on the grounds of uniqueness and resulting practical difficulty. See, e.g. <u>Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel</u> 407 Md. 53, 79-85 (2008). Indeed, the nature of the conversion variance is such that it does not fit into any logical framework of uniqueness and practical difficulty.

We appreciate the Board's patience in reviewing this additional correspondence. This also will serve to provide all of the parties with time to consider these issues in advance of the hearing.

The case comes with a complex background of petition and amended petition. Moreover, it presents issues of public interest.

This case involves a petition for zoning variance from the BCZR Section 402.1.B dimensional requirements. The objective of the petition is to approve the use and/or conversion to multiple family apartment use of a single-family dwelling in the Arbutus area. Because the request would effectively result in a density variance, it is impermissible as a matter of law under BCZR Section 307.1. Anyway, even if the petition were otherwise eligible, there is lacking the requisite uniqueness and/or ensuing hardship or practical difficulty to satisfy the BCZR Section 307.1 standards for area variances.

The property at 1218 Elm Ridge Avenue is zoned D.R. 5.5. The property presently includes front lot 4, with a dwelling, and rear lot 7A, with a garage. The combined lot area is 12,870 square feet. The front lot width is 50 feet, and the side yard setbacks are 10 feet on each side, with a sum of 20 feet.

BCZR Section 402.1.B, which has been in place since the 1955 Zoning Regulations, requires that any conversion of a dwelling to add any apartments must satisfy the dimensional requirements of the schedule entitled, "CONVERSION OF SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLINGS MINIMUM DIMENSIONS." For the D.R. 5.5 Zone, the proposal here satisfies the 10,000 square feet minimum lot area for a two-family dwelling, but does not satisfy the minimum front lot width of 90 feet, minimum side yard setback requirement of 15 feet and sum of side yard setbacks of 35 feet.

As we have pointed out in the past, and the CBA has agreed, a petition to vary the conversion requirements functions as a petition to increase the residential density of a property. BCZR Section 307.1 explicitly states that "No increase in residential density beyond that otherwise allowable by the zoning

regulations shall be permitted as a result of a grant of a variance from height or area regulations." The CBA addressed this issue in the enclosed May 21, 1999 opinion in Maria and Joseph Horodowicz, Case No. 98-342-A, page 7.

In any event, we do not perceive any unique characteristic of the subject property which results in any unnecessary hardship or practical difficulty here. The property may be used as a single-family dwelling. Indeed, it is hard to imagine any unique aspect of any property which could justify a variance to convert of a single-family dwelling to multiple apartment use.

As a footnote, we see that the application includes a request to merge the additional vacant rear lot 6A, which adjoins rear lot 7A, so that the property would consist of 3 lots. This does not in any way resolve the variance problem and, in our view, is irrelevant to the case.

So, for all of the above reasons, it is respectfully submitted that the County Board of Appeals must dismiss and/or deny this petition.

Maria and Joseph Horodowicz filed a timely appeal from the Deputy Zoning Commissioner's decision, dated July 20, 1998, denying a variance from Section 402 of the <u>Baltimore County Zoning Regulations</u> (BCZR) to permit a lot width of 50 feet in lieu of the required 80 feet; and to amend the previously approved site plan in prior Case No. 75-109-A to reflect the proposed multi-family dwelling use on the subject property owned by the Appellants /Petitioners at 9305 Carney Road, 11th Election District, 6th Councilmanic District.

The Petitioner, Joseph Horodowicz, was the first witness. He testified that he and his wife are the owners of the subject property but they do not reside there. Mr. Horodowicz purchased

- The Board determined that since the property fails on the uniqueness standard, they do not need to discuss the practical difficulty standard.
- The Board also determined that although there was argument with respect to notice; the Board determined
 at proper Notice was given and that the issue of proper notice should not be heard in the future. The sign
 was sufficient in providing the required information.

DECISION BY BOARD MEMBERS:

The property is not unique by the standards of Cromwell v. Ward. Proper Notice was given.

<u>FINAL DECISION:</u> After thorough review of the facts, testimony, and law in the matter, the Board unanimously agreed to DENY the requested Variances.
