OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by the legal owner of the subject property, Angela Acitelli. The Petitioner is requesting Variance relief from Section 1A04.3.B.2.b of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to permit a proposed replacement dwelling to have side yard setbacks of 8 ft. each in lieu of the required 50 ft. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the public hearing held for this case was Aldo and Christian Acitelli and Thomas A. Church, P.E., with Development Engineering Consultants Inc., the firm that prepared the site plan. Also appearing was Charles Cargile and Milton Bell. The file reveals that the Petition was properly advertised and the site was properly posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and made a part of the record of this case. A ZAC comment was received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS) on December 7, 2012 indicating that Petitioner is obliged to comply with certain Critical Area regulations, as set forth in B.C.Z.R. § 500.14. Development Plans Review (DPR) submitted a comment indicating Petitioner must comply with the County's flood protection regulations. Finally, the Department of Planning (DOP) submitted a comment noting that Petitioner must provide for its review building elevations and design information so that it can determine whether the proposed dwelling satisfies the RC-5 zone performance standards.

Testimony and evidence revealed that the subject property is 13,534 square feet (0.31 acres) and is zoned RC- 5. The property is improved with a small dwelling constructed in 1952, and the Petitioner indicated the home is in serious disrepair and has severe mold conditions as well. As such, the petitioner proposes to raze the existing dwelling (shown on the photos marked as Exhibit 2) and construct in its place a new home sized at 65' x 34'. The Petitioner's immediate neighbors attended the hearing, and while they agree the existing dwelling needs to be razed and rebuilt, they oppose the construction of a 34' wide dwelling. They indicated that the proposed 8' side yard setbacks would cause the homes to appear crowded together, and they were also concerned with the possibility of excess storm water runoff with such small setbacks. Both residents also explained that most of the homes in the area are between 28'-30' wide. I believe the concerns expressed by the neighbors are valid and legitimate, and a 30' wide dwelling with 10 ft. setbacks on each side would be consistent with the current pattern of development and would allow for some "elbow room," as noted by Mr. Cargile.

At several points during the hearing, the testimony and discussion tended to focus on the size and positioning on the lot (in terms of how close it would be situated to Galloway Creek) of the proposed dwelling. As Mr. Church noted, the hearing was not one to determine whether building permits should be issued or whether the site plan complied with the county's environmental regulations. Those issues will be carefully reviewed by the respective county

agencies responsible for such matters. But one point concerning the site plan and the size of the proposed dwelling is in order at this juncture.

Specifically, B.C.Z.R. §§104.5 and 104.3 are applicable in this case, given that the existing dwelling is nonconforming and is located within the Critical Area. As such, the ground floor area of the replacement dwelling can only be extended or enlarged by 25%. The existing dwelling (51' x 25') has a ground floor area of 1,275 S.F., and under the above cited regulations the replacement dwelling can be no larger than 1,593.75 S.F. ground floor area. The replacement dwelling shown on the plan (Exhibit 1) is sized at 65' x 34', or 2,210 S.F. ground floor area, which would not be permitted under the B.C.Z.R, although that determination will be left to the County's Department of Permits, Approvals, and Inspections, which is the agency that reviews plans and issues permits for construction.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I will grant the request for variance relief. Under *Cromwell* and its progeny, to obtain variance relief requires a showing that:

(1) The property is unique; and

(2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel, 407 Md. 53, 80 (2008).

Petitioner has met this test. The property is zoned RC-5, which imposes stringent setback and lot size requirements. This zoning - - which is somewhat anomalous - - and the waterfront location render the property unique.

If the B.C.Z.R. were strictly enforced, the Petitioner would indeed suffer a practical difficulty and/or hardship, since he would be unable to construct the replacement dwelling as designed. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and ORDER RECEIVED FOR JELLING

general welfare. Other homes in the area have been rebuilt, and the dwelling proposed by Petitioner would improve the site and be compatible with the neighborhood.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on this Petition, and for the reasons set forth above, variance relief shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>17th</u> day of December, 2012 by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief pursuant to Section 1A04.3.B.2.b of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to permit a proposed replacement dwelling to have side yard setbacks of 8 ft. each in lieu of the required 50 ft. be and is hereby **DENIED**.

It is further ordered that variance relief pursuant to B.C.Z.R. Section 1A04.3.B.2.b, to permit a replacement dwelling to have side yard setbacks of 10 ft. each in lieu of the required 50 ft. be and is hereby **GRANTED**.

The relief granted herein shall be conditioned upon and subject to the following:

- 1. The Petitioner may apply for any required permits and may be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however the Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at his own risk until such time as the thirty (30) day appellate process from this Order has expired. If for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the Petitioner will be required to return and be responsible for returning said property to its original condition.
- 2. The Petitioner must comply with the ZAC comments received from DEPS, DOP and DPR; copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

Hardships and practical difficulties justifying the requested side yard variance:

The lot has been in existence since 1921 as a 50 foot wide lot as shown on the plat referenced to on the Plat to Accompany Petition for Zoning Variance, which is well before Baltimore County had any zoning requirements.

The existing dwelling was constructed in 1952, after Baltimore County had adopted zoning and was zoned R-6. The R-6 classification eventually became DR 5.5. The property is also served by public water, which was installed in 1953, and public sewer, which was installed in 2002.

However, the subject property was zoned RDP (Rural Deferred Planning) instead of DR 5.5 as other R-6 properties were throughout the county. Subsequently, RDP became RC-5.

The existing dwelling was constructed with a 12 foot side yard on the southeast side and a 13 foot side yard on the northwest side, allowing for a 25 foot wide dwelling.

However, the current design theory for dwellings, as well as what is desired by most contemporary homeowners, requires a dwelling to be at least 35 to 40 feet wide. The requested side yard setback of 8 feet on both sides would allow for 34 toot wide dwelling, which would acceptable to today's homeowner.

The situation which is described by the above stated facts can be summarized as follows: the proposed work, which is to raze an outdated dwelling and replace it with a new dwelling that meets the current design practices, was been subjected to a zoning classification which probably should have never been placed on the property, especially in view of its lots size and the fact that it had public water in place when it was zoned RC-5, as public water is not allowed for RC-5 zoned properties.

As a result of the decision to zone the property RC-5, it is impossible to meet the requirements of the RC-5 classification, and thus, it is believed the requested side yard setback of 8 feet is justified and should be allowed.

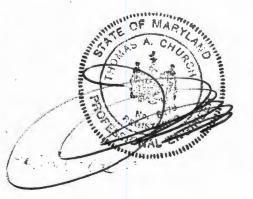

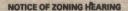

The Bureau of Development Plans Review has reviewed the subject zoning item and we have the following comment(s).

The base flood elevation for this site is 8.5 feet [NAVD 88].

The flood protection elevation is 9.5 feet.

In conformance with Federal Flood Insurance requirements, the first floor or basement floor must be at least 1 foot above the flood plain elevation in all construction.

The property to be developed is located adjacent to tidewater. The developer is advised that the proper sections of the *Baltimore County Building Code* must be followed whereby elevation limitations are placed on the lowest floor (*including basements*) of residential (*commercial*) development.

The building engineer shall require a permit for this project.

The building shall be designed and adequately anchored to prevent flotation, collapse, or lateral movement of structure with materials resistant to flood damage.

Flood-resistant construction shall be in accordance with the Baltimore County Building Code which adopts, with exceptions, the *International Building Code*.

EPS has reviewed the subject zoning petition for compliance with the goals of the Statemandated Critical Area Law listed in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, Section 500.14. Based upon this review, we offer the following comments:

- 1. The subject property is located within a Limited Development Area (LDA) and a Buffer Management Area (BMA) and is subject to Critical Area requirements. The applicant is proposing to allow a replacement single family dwelling with reduced side yard setbacks. The lot is waterfront and is developed with a dwelling, pier, shed, garage, and driveway. The proposed dwelling is within the 100-foot buffer. It appears the dwelling meets the BMA setback requirements; BMA mitigation is required for the portion of dwelling within the 100-foot buffer. Lot coverage on the entirety of this property is limited to 31.25% (4,229 square feet), with mitigation required for new lot coverage over 25% (3,383.5 square feet). Lot coverage information was not provided. If the applicant can meet the lot coverage requirements and the 15% afforestation requirements of 4 trees and provides the BMA mitigation, the relief requested by the applicant will result in minimal impacts to water quality.
- 2. This property is waterfront. If lot coverage, BMA, and afforestation requirements are met, that will help conserve fish, plant, and wildlife habitat in the Chesapeake Bay.
- 3. Lot coverage information was not included. Provided that the applicants meet the requirements stated above, the relief requested will be consistent with established land-use policies.

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petitioner's request and accompanying site plan. According to Baltimore County's GIS information, the proposed dwelling will be located within a 100-year floodplain. The petitioner and any prospective contract purchasers should be advised that the new dwelling must comply with all applicable regulations pertaining to the construction of a dwelling in a floodplain in addition to the performance standards of the RC 5 zone.

This department is required to provide a statement of finding to the Administrative Law Judge indicating how the proposed construction complies with the current RC 5 requirements. To prepare the statement of finding, the following information must be submitted to this department:

- 1. Photographs of existing adjacent dwellings.
- 2. Submit building elevations (all sides) of the proposed dwelling to this department for review and approval prior to the hearing. The proposed dwelling shall be compatible in size and architectural detail as that of the existing dwellings in the area. Ensure that the exterior of the proposed building(s) uses the same finish materials and architectural details on the front, side, and rear elevations. Use of quality material such as brick, stone, or cedar is encouraged.
- 3. Design all decks, balconies, windows, dormers, chimneys, and porches as a component of the building following dominant building lines. Decks shall be screened to minimize visibility from a public street.
- 4. Design all accessory structures at a scale appropriate to the dwelling and design garages with the same architectural theme as the principal building on the site, providing consistency in materials, colors, roof pitch, and style.

5. Provide landscaping along the public road, if consistent with the existing streetscape.
