## **AMENDED** OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Special Exception filed by Jason T. Vettori, Esquire on behalf of Coppermine LLC, the legal owner. This Amended Opinion and Order shall supersede and replace the Order issued on March 26, 2013 in the above captioned matter. The Petition for Special Hearing was filed pursuant to §500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R."), to: (1) approve and determine the parking required for a commercial recreational facility; or in the alternative; (2) to approve a modified parking plan. In addition, a Petition for Special Exception was filed to approve a commercial recreational facility pursuant to B.C.Z.R. § 253.2.D.3.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests was Alex Jacobs and Michael Pieranunzi, a landscape architect who prepared the site plans. Jeffrey Budnitz of the Ruxton Riderwood Lake Roland Area Improvement Association (RRLRAIA) attended the hearing and indicated that the Association met and voted to "conditionally support" the petitions. The file reveals that the Petition was properly advertised and the site was properly posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. The file does not contain any letters of opposition.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. The only substantive comment was from the Department of Planning (DOP), which supported the petitions, and noted that Falls Road is a designated scenic route which may require enhanced landscaping and aesthetic upgrades.

Testimony and evidence offered at the hearing revealed that the subject property is 11.06 acres and is zoned ML and MLR. The Petitioner operates on site a recreation facility that provides a myriad of programs ranging from gymnastics to flag football. The Petitioner is proposing to construct additional facilities on site to accommodate increased program offerings, but to do so requires zoning relief. The Petitioner indicated that the contemplated improvements will be subject to the full development process, as noted in the DOP's ZAC comment.

#### **Special Hearing**

The Petition for Special Hearing seeks (1) to approve and determine the parking required for a commercial recreational facility; or in the alternative; (2) to approve a modified parking plan. As an initial matter, the facility which exists at the premises (and which is proposed to be expanded) is properly characterized as a commercial recreation facility. The B.C.Z.R. defines such a facility as one "whose principal purpose is to provide space and equipment for non-professional athletic activities." B.C.Z.R. §101.1. The DOP supports this characterization, and the numerous brochures submitted (Exhibits 6A - 6T) detailing the many programs offered also establish that this is a commercial recreational facility.

The next order of business is to determine the size and scale of the parking lot that will serve this facility. The B.C.Z.R. does not contain specific requirements for a commercial recreation facility. The site is isolated geographically and topographically, and as discussed at the hearing, there are no adjacent properties on which customers could safely park, so there is ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

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little danger that any parking shortage would negatively impact the community. At present, Petitioner provides 91 spaces for the existing facility. The Petitioner proposes to add 178 spaces in connection with the expansion project, such that 269 spaces would be provided for the facility.

The most important fact driving the parking analysis is that the Petitioner provides scheduled athletic programming, with defined time slots during which participants (or in most cases, their parents) will enter and exit the facility. Thus, the business model here is unlike a health or athletic club, where members are free to drop in at anytime. As such, I believe the parking requirements for such a facility are much more modest than with commercial health clubs. In light of the scheduling and activity programming described by Petitioner, I believe parking at a ratio of 2.0 spaces per 1,000 sq. ft. of building space is appropriate.

As noted at the outset, the RRLRAIA "conditionally" supports the Petitions, and the terms of the endorsement were discussed by Mr. Budnitz at the hearing and set forth in a memorandum he presented. <u>See</u> Citizens' Exhibit 1. The Petitioner indicated it was amenable to these requests, and the relief granted herein will be expressly subject to these conditions.

## **Special Exception Standards**

Special exception uses are presumptively valid and consistent with the comprehensive zoning plan, <u>People's Counsel v. Loyola College</u>, 406 Md. 54, 77 n. 23 (2008), and no evidence was offered here to rebut the presumption. As such, the commercial recreation facility use shall be permitted in the ML/MLR zone by special exception.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered, I find that Petitioner's Special Hearing and Special Exception requests should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>23<sup>rd</sup></u> day of April, 2013, by this Administrative Law Judge, that Petitioner's request for Special Hearing relief to determine the parking required for a commercial recreational facility, wherein parking shall be provided at a ratio of 2.0 spaces per 1,000 sq. ft. of building space (and in no event shall fewer than 269 spaces be provided), be and is hereby GRANTED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner's Special Exception request from B.C.Z.R. §253.2.D.3, to approve a commercial recreational facility, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioner may apply for appropriate permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- 2. Compliance with the five (5) conditions set forth in a memorandum from the RRLRAIA, attached as an Exhibit hereto.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

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The Ruxton Riderwood Lake Roland Area Improvement Association has voted to conditionally support the requested special exception and special hearing relief as defined in Case Number: 2013-0157-SPHX.

#### The Conditions Are:

- 1) A fence to run the length of the property line between the home owners at 6606 Falls Road, the Brown Property, and at 6608 Falls Road, the Friedel Property, and the property and inclusive parcels requesting the special exception and special hearing relief at 1400 Copper Mine Terrace, the Copper Mine Field House Property.
- 2) Vegetative screening between the home owners at 6606 Falls Road, the Brown Property, and at 6608 Falls Road, the Friedel Property, and the property and inclusive parcels requesting the special exception and special hearing relief at 1400 Copper Mine Terrace, the Copper Mine Field House Property. Based on topography/steep slope, planting may need to occur on the home owner's property at 6606 Falls Road, the Brown Property, and at 6608 Falls Road, the Friedel Property to achieve the desired result. A process best handled between Mr. Jacobs, Mrs. Freidel and Mr. Brown.
- 3) Efforts will be implemented to reduce the level of noise emanating from the site at 1400 Copper Mine Terrace and its associated impact on the home owners at 6606 Falls Road, the Brown Property, and at 6608 Falls Road, the Friedel Property. This will be achieved via the installation of the vegetative screening as described in condition two, the actual building structures that will eventually be located if and when constructed on the site and the relocation of certain activities on the site at the discretion of Mr. Jacobs.
- 4) The containment of light pollution on the site at 1400 Copper Mine Terrace and the associated impact on the home owner's property at 6606 Falls Road, the Brown Property, and at 6608 Falls Road, the Friedel Property. This will be achieved via the installation of the vegetative screening as described in condition two and the compliance with required design standards.
- 5) Improvements to the entrance as it relates to access to the site via the acquisition of a portion of an adjoining parcel south of the current entrance to Copper Mine Terrace. This condition is purely a recommendation and is to be acted on at the sole discretion of Mr. Jacobs.

in connection with the expansion project, such that 269 spaces would be provided for a total commercial recreational facility area of 77,644 SF, as shown on note 13 of the Plan. Exhibit 1. That correlates to a ratio of approximately 3.4 spaces per 1,000 SF of recreation floor space.

The most important fact driving the parking analysis is that the Petitioner provides scheduled athletic programming, with defined time slots during which participants (or in most cases, their parents) will enter and exit the facility. Thus, the business model here is unlike a health or athletic club, where members are free to drop in at anytime. As such, I believe the parking requirements for such a facility are much more modest than with commercial health clubs. In light of the scheduling and activity programming described by Petitioner, I believe parking at a ratio of 3.0 spaces per 1,000 SF of recreational floor area is appropriate. This ratio is slightly less than the 3.4 spaces per 1,000 SF referenced above, and is designed to provide the Petitioner with some latitude in the event the existing swimming pool or other outdoor amenity is expanded or reconfigured during the development process.

As noted at the outset, the RRLRAIA "conditionally" supports the Petitions, and the terms of the endorsement were discussed by Mr. Budnitz at the hearing and set forth in a memorandum he presented. See Citizens' Exhibit 1. The Petitioner indicated it would be amenable to the fence, landscaping and lighting issues raised therein. In any event, these conditions will be imposed in connection with any future Development Plan approvals, and are set forth here to simply memorialize the conversation and understanding.

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#### **Special Exception Standards**

Special exception uses are presumptively valid and consistent with the comprehensive zoning plan, <u>People's Counsel v. Loyola College</u>, 406 Md. 54, 77 n. 23 (2008), and no evidence was offered here to rebut the presumption. As such, the commercial recreation facility use shall be permitted in the ML/MLR zone by special exception.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered, I find that Petitioner's Special Hearing and Special Exception requests should be granted.

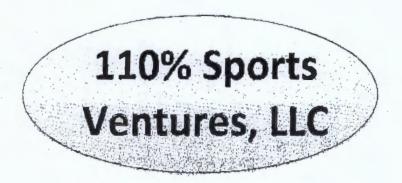

#### SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petitioner's request and accompanying site plan. The petitioner intends to expand the existing facility to include an additional field house, basketball courts, and a new lobby. The facility will be classified as a Commercial Recreational Facility (if granted), which will require 175 additional parking spaces. Due to the nature of the scheduling of events at the facility, the required amount of parking will not be needed. The existing entrance to the site will remain the same and no additional lighting is planned. The existing building on the site will be used for storage in the future.

After reviewing the RRLR Community Plan for 2010, the property is adjacent to the Bare Hills focus area of the plan but no real references to the Coppermine property are noted.

The Department of Planning supports the petitioner's request to classify the project as a Commercial Recreational facility as well as the accompanying modified parking plan. The project will go through the full development process after the zoning hearing, at which time the Department of Planning will review architecture, landscaping, etc.

The plan should note that Falls Road is a Baltimore County designated scenic route as well as a Maryland Scenic Byway. As such, high quality building materials, architecture and enhanced landscaping may be required depending on grading and retention of existing vegetation.

Peggy,

I spoke with Jeffrey Budnitz earlier this morning. He notified me that you met with neighbors Cynthia Friedel and Tom Brown last night and there were a few items that I was to share with Alex for his consideration and comment.

I spoke with Alex and I believe each of the items can be addressed to the satisfaction of all parties involved.

First, it is our understanding that Ms. Friedel is concerned about her property being sufficiently buffered from the subject site. While Alex would prefer the visual aesthetics of opaque vegetative screening, he is amenable to providing a fence along the lot line in common with Ms. Friedel. In order to further clarify what I'm talking about please note that Alex will provide the required screening between the commercial recreational facility and the adjoining properties. This is because the landscape manual requires nonresidential buildings to be screened from adjacent residential properties. In particular, he will be required to provide screening between the proposed parking lot adjoining Ms. Friedel's and Coppermine Fieldhouse's (1400 Coppermine Terrace Road's) lot line in common as part of the permitting process. Therefore, he's going to be required to provide screening that complies with the "Class A" requirements. See p. 29-30, of the landscape manual (http://resources.baltimorecountymd.gov/Documents/Permits/Development%20Plans%20Review/landscapemanual.pdf). The definition of "Screening, Class A", as noted in Part VI, Appendix A, p. 85, is as follows:

Screening, "Class A" - Any combination of major deciduous trees, minor deciduous trees, evergreen trees, and shrubs used to provide a visual screen with the needed level of height, density, and opacity for the site conditions. Elimination of an unsightly view or provision of a filtered view may be the objective. Quantities are generated at one planting unit per 15 linear feet of the area to be screened. Minimum height at installation shall be 30 inches for shrubs and 6 feet for evergreen trees. A six-foot high opaque fence or wall may be required in conjunction with a planting screen.

While the landscape manual does not expressly state that a fence as opposed to an opaque wall of vegetation (which would have the same affect of preventing anyone from trespassing easily) is required, in my experience the County's new landscape architect will expressly require a fence to be constructed. It is our position that this will also address some related concerns of Ms. Friedel.It is our understanding that Ms. Friedel has expressed concerns regarding a few other issues related to the level of noise emanating from the site and lighting (noise pollution and light pollution). In reverse, all lighting for off-street parking facilities is required to comply with the design standards set forth in BCZR Section 409.8.A.3. Specifically, that section provides that "[a]ny fixture used to illuminate any parking fixture shall be so arranged as to reflect light away from residential lots and public streets. Light standards shall be protected from vehicular traffic by curbing or landscaping." It is our contention that the screening will reduce the alleged noise emanating from the site, but Alex further indicated that he was not aware that there was any issue regarding noise generated on the site. He will address this issue immediately with his staff but adds that once the proposed addition is constructed, he should have sufficient space inside to further reduce activities which currently take place outdoors. Furthermore, the proposed structure should buffer the bulk of the noise from the site. I believe state law controls the number of decibels generated from a property and we will certainly comply with that law. With respect to the prior owner's use of the on-site pool, Alex has spoken with his liability insurer and while he's amenable to working with her regarding use of his pool he can't provide her keys to access it as she sees fit for obvious reasons.

I assure you that Alex continues to try and figure out how he can provide additional parking and improve ingress and egress for his patrons. Towards that end, I have advised him that someone speculated that Nick Lambros may be interested in selling his properties fronting on Falls Road. Alex assures me that, if Mr. Lambros is interested in selling, he will explore the feasibility of acquiring said parcels but can't make any promises. Insofar as the bridge to Old Pimlico Road that has previously been discussed, that option will be completely dependent upon the commercial recreational facility being cash flow positive.

Many of these issues will be more specifically developed during the full development review and approval process (i.e. Concept Plan filing, CPC, CIM, Development Plan filing, DPC and Hearing Officer's Hearing). We look forward to continuing to work with RRLRAIA in a collaborative fashion as we move forward. Thanks for your assistance and as always please feel free to contact me with any questions, comments or concerns.

#### ALI Beverungen,

I am aware that People's Counsel would like the terms of RRLRAIA's conditional support listed in (or otherwise incorporated into) the Opinion and Order. Please note that Michael Pieranunzi's name is spelled incorrectly on page 1 of the Order (second line of second paragraph). Also, I have identified another substantive issue.

Jeffrey Budnitz called me to point out the fact that special hearing relief for a ratio of 3.0 spaces per 1,000 sf was stated in the Opinion and Order. However, I've investigated Jeffrey's recollection that the ratio we requested was 2.0 rather than 3.0 and come up with some interesting observations. It would appear as if we neglected to delete/redline all of the outdated notes off of the plan. The 77,644 sf figure for the commercial recreational facility was, as we testified at the hearing, an earlier iteration where we tried to break down each room in the existing and proposed buildings. This led to a discrepancy between what Mr. Jacobs told the community he would doing in each room and what Planning noted in its ZAC Comment (that the entire existing building would be used for storage). Planning had no issue with how the respective buildings would be used (i.e. fully commercial recreational facility or partially). After working with the community on this issue, we amicably resolved it. That resolution involved the imposition of certain conditions reflected in Citizens' Exhibit 1. I believe the testimony reflects the fact that we didn't want to be precluded from utilizing all of the square footage (existing and proposed) for commercial recreational facility purposes, despite a substantial unlikelihood that that would take place. It was this very issue which led us to submit a redlined plan that did not break down the respective uses of the buildings. Alas, it would appear as if we neglected to delete the portion of Note 13 which indicates a "Total Recreational Facility Area" of 77,644 sf. If we are to use the existing 42,000 sf building and proposed 88,094 sf building for commercial recreational facility purposes at any given time, we would have an insufficient amount of parking were a 3.0 spaces per 1,000 sf ratio to be applied. In order to utilize all of the square footage of each building (not necessarily all at once of course), we would need a ratio of no more than 2.0 spaces per 1,000 sf.

As we indicated at the hearing, the 2.0 ratio was determined by "reverse engineering" the minimum parking requirement formula to come up with an acceptable ratio. A review of my notes/hearing outline indicates that Mr. Pieranunzi testified that the existing 42,000 sf structure was presently served by 91 spaces. In order to determine the ratio we would need we used the following formula x (the ratio) times 42,000/1,000 = 91 spaces OR 42x = 91 OR x = 91/42 (i.e. 2.166666). Mr. Pierananunzi further testified that x (the ratio) times 130,094 (88,094 + 42,000)/1,000 = 269 (178 + 91) spaces OR 130.094x = 269 OR x = 269/130.094 (i.e. 2.0677). The testimony and evidence further reflects the fact that the lowering of the ratio is appropriate under the circumstances as the programs would largely move from the existing building to the proposed building. However, we want to reserve the ability to utilize the existing building for commercial recreational facility purposes. The testimony further indicates that the existing outdoor swimming pool and associated amenities were not included in this ratio as they were complimentary uses.

In order to capture the existing complimentary uses (which are obviously not calculated in the ratio between the existing 42,000 sf building and the existing 91 spaces), and any moderate expansions/improvements to same, the ratio should be caveated to read "2.0 per 1,000 square feet **of building**." By adding this qualifier, the ratio reflects the traditional use of the property for it's various programs. Building is a specifically defined term in the Baltimore County Code (BCC § 32-4-101(g)). In short, it only refers to enclosed structures. In this matter, there are outdoor activities, including but not limited to a pool.

These outdoor activities are incorporated into the use which is made of the building(s). As such, we were asking that the ratio of 2.0 only apply to the building as there is limited land available for outdoor activities and those activities which exist (such as the pool) could be expanded/modified without adversely impacting the parking requirements. Without revisiting all of the evidence in support of the continuation of the present use and essentially the same parking ratio, please modify the Opinion and Order accordingly.

Subject: Community/Neighbor Issues

Peggy,

I spoke with Jeffrey Budnitz earlier this morning. He notified me that you met with neighbors Cynthia Friedel and Tom Brown last night and there were a few items that I was to share with Alex for his consideration and comment.

I spoke with Alex and I believe each of the items can be addressed to the satisfaction of all parties involved.

First, it is our understanding that Ms. Friedel is concerned about her property being sufficiently buffered from the subject site. While Alex would prefer the visual aesthetics of opaque vegetative screening, he is amenable to providing a fence along the lot line in common with Ms. Friedel. In order to further clarify what I'm talking about please note that Alex will provide the required screening between the commercial recreational facility and the adjoining properties. This is because the landscape manual requires nonresidential buildings to be screened from adjacent residential properties. In particular, he will be required to provide screening between the proposed parking lot adjoining Ms. Friedel's and Coppermine Fieldhouse's (1400 Coppermine Terrace Road's) lot line in common as part of the permitting process. Therefore, he's going to be required to provide screening that complies with the "Class A" requirements. See p. 29-30, of the landscape manual (http://resources.baltimorecountymd.gov/Documents/Permits/Development%20Plans%20Revie w/landscapemanual.pdf). The definition of "Screening, Class A", as noted in Part VI, Appendix A, p. 85, is as follows:

Screening, "Class A" - Any combination of major deciduous trees, minor deciduous trees, evergreen trees, and shrubs used to provide a visual screen with the needed level of height, density, and opacity for the site conditions. Elimination of an unsightly view or provision of a filtered view may be the objective. Quantities are generated at one planting unit per 15 linear feet of the area to be screened. Minimum height at installation shall be 30 inches for shrubs and 6 feet for evergreen trees. A six-foot high opaque fence or wall may be required in conjunction with a planting screen.

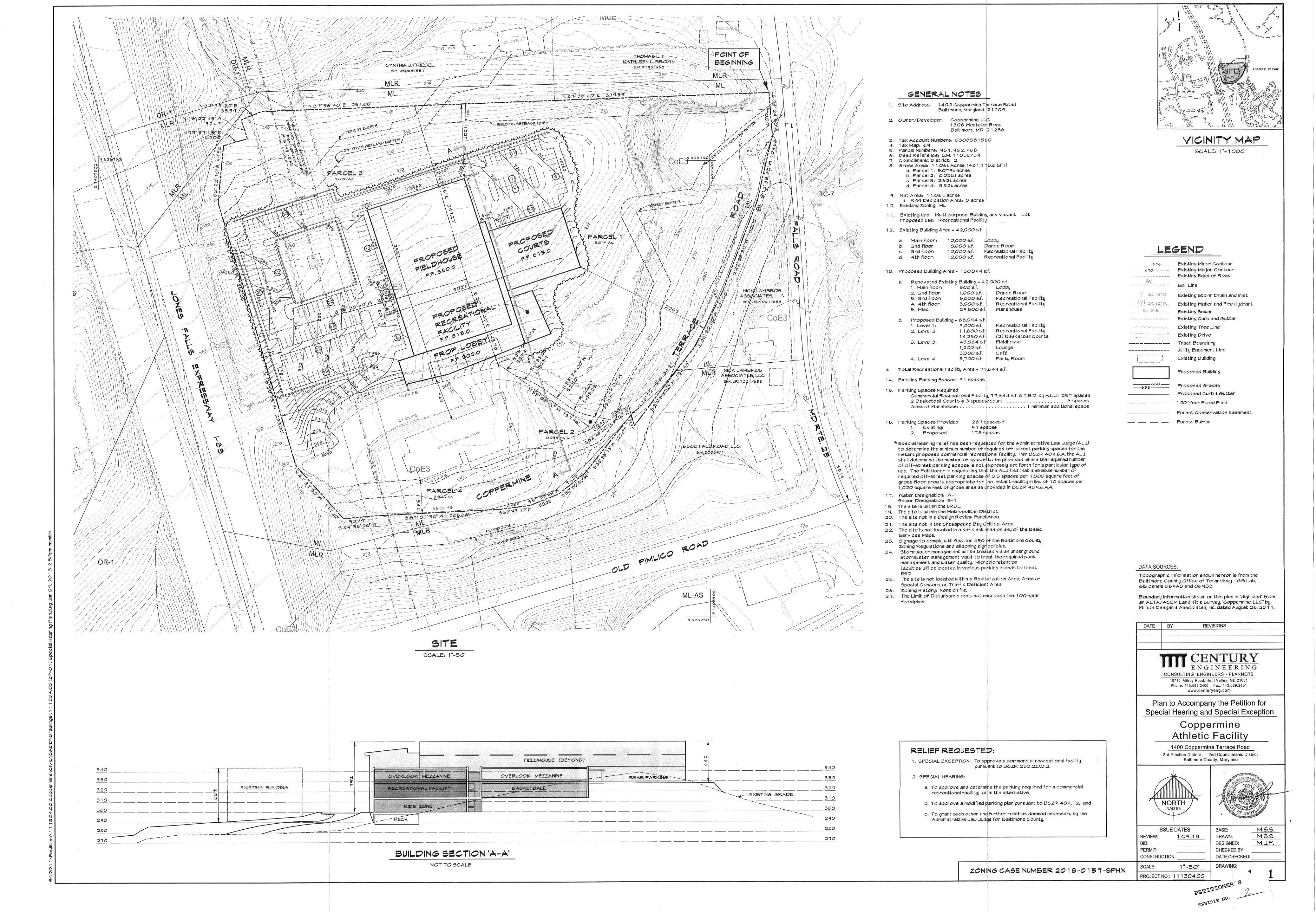
While the landscape manual does not expressly state that a fence as opposed to an opaque wall of vegetation (which would have the same affect of preventing anyone from trespassing easily) is required, in my experience the County's new landscape architect will expressly require a fence to be constructed. It is our position that this will also address some related concerns of Ms. Friedel.It is our understanding that Ms. Friedel has expressed concerns regarding a few other issues related to the level of noise emanating from the site and lighting (noise pollution and light pollution). In reverse, all lighting for off-street parking facilities is required to comply with the design standards set forth in BCZR Section 409.8.A.3. Specifically, that section provides that "[a]ny fixture used to illuminate any parking fixture shall be so arranged as to reflect light away from residential lots and public streets. Light standards shall be protected from vehicular traffic by curbing or landscaping." It is our contention that the screening will reduce the alleged noise emanating from the site, but Alex further indicated that he was not aware that there was any issue regarding noise generated on the site. He will address this issue immediately with his staff but adds that once the proposed addition is constructed, he should have sufficient space inside to further reduce activities which currently take place outdoors. Furthermore, the proposed structure should buffer the bulk of the noise from the site. I believe state law controls the number of decibels generated from a property and we will certainly comply with that law. With respect to the prior owner's use of the on-site pool, Alex has spoken with his liability insurer and while he's amenable to working with her regarding use of his pool he can't provide her keys to access it as she sees fit for obvious reasons.

I assure you that Alex continues to try and figure out how he can provide additional parking and improve ingress and egress for his patrons. Towards that end, I have advised him that someone speculated that Nick Lambros may be interested in selling his properties fronting on Falls Road. Alex assures me that, if Mr. Lambros is interested in selling, he will explore the feasibility of acquiring said parcels but can't make any promises. Insofar as the bridge to Old Pimlico Road that has previously been discussed, that option will be completely dependent upon the commercial recreational facility being cash flow positive.

Many of these issues will be more specifically developed during the full development review and approval process (i.e. Concept Plan filing, CPC, CIM, Development Plan filing, DPC and Hearing Officer's Hearing). We look forward to continuing to work with RRLRAIA in a collaborative fashion as we move forward.
