Dear Mr. Richards:

This firm represents the owner of the above-referenced shopping center, located at the southeast corner of the intersection of York and Padonia Roads in the Timonium area of Baltimore County (the "Property"). In Case No. 2013-0215-A ("the 2013 Case"), our client obtained variances for numerous signs, including three joint identification signs referred to as "Sign A," "Sign B," and "Sign C" on the site plan approved in the 2013 Case (or "2013 Case Site Plan"). A copy of the Order and site plan approved in the 2013 Case are enclosed for your review and convenience. Our client now intends to redesign these three freestanding joint identification signs, which will remain in the same locations shown on the 2013 Case Site Plan. I am writing to confirm that the proposed design changes for Signs A, B, and C are within the spirit and intent of the variance relief granted in the 2013 Case.

By way of brief history, the Administrative Law Judge granted variances to permit the following:

Sign A (York Road): To have a sign area/face of 134 square feet per side with up to 12 lines of text and sign copy a minimum of 1.5 inches in height;

Sign B (Padonia Road): To have a sign area/face of 149 square feet per side with up to 12 lines of text and sign copy a minimum of 1.5 inches in height; and

Sign C (Padonia Road): To have a sign area/face of 90 square feet per side with up to 12 lines of text and sign copy a minimum of 1.5 inches in height.

In September of 2016, I submitted and your office approved a spirit and intent request for a prior redesign of Sign A. A copy of the letter and site plan approved in 2016 are also enclosed with this letter.

The owner is now proposing to redesign all three signs within the parameters of the relief granted in the 2013 Case, as shown and indicated on sheet nos. 1 through 3 of the "Plan to Accompany Spirit and Intent Request for Sign Variance" enclosed with this letter ("2018 S&I Plan") and dated July 6, 2018. The 2018 S&I Plan is identical to the site plan approved in the 2013 Case, with the exception of new sign details for Signs A, B, and C. I have also attached side-by-side comparisons of the approved sign details and proposed new sign details.

Under this proposal, the new signs will be designed to the following specifications:

Sign A (York Road): A sign area/face of 132 square feet per side with less than 12 lines of text;

Sign B (Padonia Road): A sign area/face of 148 square feet per side with less than 12 lines of text; and

Sign C (Padonia Road): A sign area/face of 90 square feet per side with less than 12 lines of text.

As such, all three signs will comply with the variances granted in Case No. 2013-0215-A. We are, therefore, requesting confirmation that the intended design of the freestanding signs, as shown and indicated on the 2018 S&I Plan, is within the spirit and intent of the relief granted in Case No. 2013-0215-A and that another public hearing before the Administrative Law Judge will not be required issuance of permits consistent with the sign details shown on the 2018 S&I Plan.

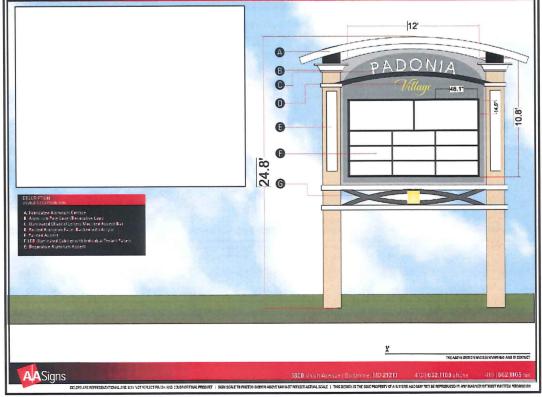

Dear Mr. Richards:

I am writing on behalf of New Plan Maryland Holdings, LLC ("New Plan"), legal owner of Lot 1 of Liberty Plaza (8700 Liberty Road). New Plan is requesting confirmation from you that the proposed site changes described in this letter are within the spirit and intent of the zoning relief granted in Case No. 2011-0249-A.

Together Lot 1 (8700 Liberty Road) and Lot 2 (8730 Liberty Road) comprise the shopping center known as Liberty Plaza. Lot 1 has 59,370± square feet of space (occupied by Marshalls and other retail/restaurant/service shops). Lot 2, which New Plan recently conveyed to Cole WM Randallstown MD, LLC, has 160,908± square feet of space (occupied by Walmart Supercenter). The center will continue to be operated as a unified center pursuant to a Reciprocal Easement and Operation Agreement.

On Lot 1, New Plan seeks to add a drive-through automated teller machine (ATM) to be operated by SunTrust Bank. The proposed configuration for the ATM is shown on the enclosed Plan to Accompany DRC Request and will include a drive-through lane, delineated by pavement striping, a vehicle space at the ATM machine, and five stacking spaces as required by Section 409.10 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"). This use would occupy approximately 3,239 square feet of area within the existing parking lot that serves Lot 1. The installation of the ATM would result in the loss of 17 parking spaces. The adjacent drive aisle is wide enough that vehicles in the spaces directly adjacent of the ATM will be able to back up unimpeded.

By way of Case No. 2011-0249-A, New Plan obtained approval to park the shopping center at a ratio of 4.24 spaces per 1,000 square feet of gross floor area. Lot 1 and Lot 2, combined, have a total of 220,278 square feet of gross leasable area, which, based on the approved ratio, would require 933 parking spaces. See Order and Opinion from Case No. 2011-0249-A, in which the Administrative Law Judge agreed to the proposed parking ratio of 4.24 spaces in

lieu of the required 5.0 spaces and granted a request to permit 933 parking spaces in lieu of the required 1,102 parking spaces.

The enclosed plan for the Liberty Plaza reflects a total of 961 parking spaces for the center with 297 of those spaces being on Lot 1. With the construction of the drive-through ATM facility and the corresponding loss of 17 spaces, the center will have a total of 944 parking spaces remaining, which number exceeds the 933 parking spaces required by Case No. 2011-0249-A. For this reason, I believe the installation of the ATM machine as described in this letter is within the spirit and intent of the prior approved parking variance. If you agree with my conclusion, please indicate your approval by signing below.

With this letter. I have enclosed a check in the amount of \$150.00 made payable to "Baltimore County, Maryland" to cover the administrative costs associated with this review. If you need any additional information in order to complete your review, please feel free to contact me.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by David H. Karceski, Esquire, on behalf of the legal owner of the subject property. The Petitioner is requesting Variance relief from Section 450.4 Attachment 1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), with respect to certain existing and proposed signs at the Padonia Village Shopping Center, which was constructed in 1976. At the hearing, the Petition as filed was amended in the following respects: (1) the proposed freestanding joint identification sign on York Road will be 134 square feet, not 105 square feet; (2) In the next to last paragraph of the attachment, the Petitioners seek a maximum of six (6) enterprise signs (wall mounted and/or canopy), not "up to five." These changes were made to the original zoning petition included in the case file, and were initialed by the undersigned. The subject property and details of each of the existing and proposed signs are more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibits 1A-1C.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests was Haley Gallagher and Matt Bishop, a landscape architect whose firm prepared the plans. David H. Karceski, Esquire with Venable, LLP appeared and represented the Petitioner. Eric Rockel attended the hearing as an

interested citizen. The file reveals that the Petition was properly advertised and the site was properly posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations.

The only substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was submitted by the Department of Planning, which supported the Petition.

Testimony and evidence revealed that the subject property is approximately 586,753 square feet and is zoned BL-CCC, DR 16 and BL-AS. The property is improved with a shopping center, and the owners would like to update and improve the existing signage, which requires Variance relief.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I will grant the request for variance relief. Under *Cromwell* and its progeny, to obtain variance relief requires a showing that:

(1) The property is unique; and

(2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel, 407 Md. 53, 80 (2008).

Petitioners have met this test. As noted in the proffered testimony of Mr. Bishop (who was accepted as an expert) the property is of irregular dimensions, and is surrounded on four sides by roadways. In addition, and Mr. Rockel conceded this point as well, the stores front onto Padonia Road and sit perpendicular to York Road (the major thoroughfare) which is also a unique factor that justifies the proposed signage to alert motorists to the location of the businesses in the center.

If the B.C.Z.R. were strictly enforced, the Petitioners would indeed suffer a practical difficulty, since they would be unable to install the proposed signage. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the support of the County and community.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on this Petition, and for the reasons set forth above, the variance relief requested shall be granted

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 31st day of May, 2013, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief pursuant to Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") as follows: (1) to allow a freestanding joint identification sign on York Rd with a sign area/face of 134 square feet and two freestanding joint identification signs on Padonia Rd. with sign area/faces of 90 sq. ft. and 149 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted one freestanding joint identification sign with an area/face of 100 sq. ft. on York Rd, one freestanding joint identification sign with an area/face of 150 sq. ft. on Padonia Rd., one freestanding joint identification sign with an area/face of 116 sq. ft. on Hillbrook Ct., and one freestanding joint identification sign with an area/face of 100 sq. ft. on Denison Street (Signs A, B, and C); (2) for freestanding joint identification signs to display a maximum of 12 lines of text with a sign copy a minimum of 1.5 inches in height in lieu of the permitted 5 lines of text and required 8 in. height for sign copy (Signs A, B, and C); (3) to allow two wall-mounted joint identification signs on one road frontage (Signs D and No. 61); (4) to allow a total of four wallmounted enterprise signs on a single tenant building in lieu of the three signs permitted, with no more than two such signs on any single façade of the building; (5) to allow up to six enterprise signs (wall-mounted and/or canopy) on a building façade with a single separate, exterior customer entrance (Sign Nos. 1, 35, and 63) in lieu of the permitted one sign and to allow two wall-mounted enterprise signs on a side building façade without a separate, exterior customer entrance in lieu of the requirement for a customer entrance on the façade (Sign No. 1); and (6) to allow a canopy sign to extend no more than two ft. below the face of the canopy in lieu of on the face (Sign No. 63), be and is hereby GRANTED.
