OPINION

This matter comes before the Board of Appeals as a de novo appeal from the October 10, 2013 decision of the Office of Administrative Law in which the requested special exception for the use of the Petitioners' property to include a professional office was granted with conditions.

BACKGROUND

The property involved in this appeal is known as 204 Brackenwood Court is owned by Joseph and Lynn Farrell. The property is situated on a 0.2486 acre lot and is improved by a single family dwelling. Ms. Farrell is a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) and proposes to operate a professional office for her practice in the basement of the subject property. The property is zoned DR 3.5 and as such under the relevant zoning regulations requires a Special Exception for the proposed use of the property.

The Administrative Law Judge granted the Special Exception with conditions placed upon the use of the property.

HEARING

The appeal before the Board arises from the petition of the Springlake Community Association, Inc. which is the community association that represents the area in which the subject property is located. Counsel for the Springlake Community Association offered as an

initial objection to the relief granted below the provisions of a restrictive covenant executed in 1960 and thereafter assigned in 1982 to the said community association. The provisions of the documents do not specifically identify the situation before the Board. The provisions of the covenants do refer to the use of residential property for owners engaged in the professions of medicine and dentistry. However, in this case the Board has no statutory authority to adjudicate the validity of, or to enforce, restrictive covenants. The Board will therefore defer to a court of competent jurisdiction for the resolution of this matter.

Turning then to the area over which the Board has legal authority to rule we will discuss the evidence presented on the issue of the Special Exception as sought by the Petitioners pursuant to Section 1B0.1(c)(12) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.). As regards the instant case the B.C.Z.R. establishes the following provisions for the establishment of a professional office in a residence located in an area not specifically zoned for the requested use:

Office or studio of physicians, dentists, lawyers, architects, engineers, artists, musicians or other professional persons, provided that such office or studio is established within the same building as that serving as the professional person's primary residence at the time of the application; does not occupy more than 25% of the total floor area of such residence; and does not involve the employment or more than one non resident professional associate nor two other nonresident employees.

Received into evidence on behalf of the Petitioners were: a site plan (Exhibit 1); the CPA license of Mrs. Farrell (Exhibit 6) and a traffic engineering report prepared by Traffic Concepts, Inc. (Exhibit 15).

The Petitioners first witness was Keith Heindel a professional land surveyor who testified that the proposed office would be located in the basement of the Petitioner's residence and would

measure 650 sq ft. The entire usable area of the property, according to Mr. Heindel is 2,823 sq ft. with the basement consisting of 1,195 sq ft.

The next witness called by the Petitioners was Kenneth Schmid of Traffic Concepts, Inc. who was accepted by the Board as an expert in the area of traffic engineering. Mr. Schmid prepared the traffic engineering report introduced into evidence as Exhibit 15. His written and stated conclusion was that the proposed use in this case would have only a minimal impact on the volume and flow of traffic along Petitioners' street. Mr. Schmid described the Petitioners' property as being located in a residential neighborhood with a fully improved roadway including 34 feet of paving with a sidewalk for pedestrian use. He continued in his testimony to indicate that the Petitioners' house has a driveway that can fit one potential client's car along with the car owned by the Petitioners and has room for two parked vehicles in front of their home at the curb.

Several residents who are neighbors of the Petitioners testified as to their concerns above the proposed special exception. The concerns were, inter alia: that there was a fear of a proliferation of special exception uses within the neighborhood; a concern for the safety of children in the area; and, the concern for unanticipated negative impacts to the neighborhood character of the area.

DECISION OF THE BOARD

The law on this subject as interpreted by the Court of Special Appeals of Maryland in found in the case of AT&T Wireless Services v. Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, 123 Md. App. 681 (1998). In AT&T the Court ruled that the test in evaluating a request for a special exception or conditional use is not whether the special exception is compatible with permitted uses in a zone or whether a conditional use will have adverse effects. Adverse effects the Court held are inherent in all conditional or special exception uses. The standard is whether the

adverse effects of the use at the particular location proposed would be greater than the adverse effects ordinarily associated with that use elsewhere within the same zone.

Under Maryland law it has been established that a special exception enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare of a particular zone as allowed by law and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md 1 (1981).

In this case the Board will affirm the decision of the Administrative Law Judge and finds that the Petitioners' property is in conformity with the size requirements of the B.C.Z.R and the proposed use does not present any unacceptable adverse influence to the surrounding neighborhood. The Board will impose the conditions to the Petitioners' grant of the special exception as those established by the Judge in the case below.

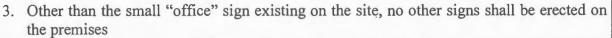
Therefore the request for a special exception is granted subject to the conditions contained in the following Order.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE, this 30¹ day of May, 2014, by the Board of Appeals of Baltimore County

ORDERED that the Petition for Special Exception to for the use of the Petitioners' property to include a professional office is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The "Special Exception Area," in which all office activities must be conducted, shall be in the basement rooms labeled as "OFFICE," as depicted on the site plan labeled as Exhibit 1.
- 2. Client parking shall be located only in the driveway and on the street in front of the Petitioners' dwelling.



4. The Special Exception relief granted herein shall terminate if Mrs. Farrell sells. Leases or in any way conveys her interest in the subject property.

5. The professional office operation shall have no more than one employee other than Mrs. Farrell.

Any petition for judicial review from this decision must be made in accordance with Rule 7-201 through Rule 7-210 of the *Maryland Rules*.

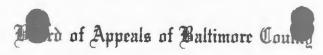

This letter will serve as the required written request for appeal of the above-referenced Special Exception. Appellant is an incorporated homeowners' association. The above Property is subject to certain covenants, conditions, easements, and restrictions, as more fully provided in the Declaration dated November 25, 1960, and recorded in the Land Records of Baltimore County at Liber 3786 Folio 363 (the "Declaration"), a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**. The power to enforce and administer the covenants, conditions, easements, and restrictions was assigned to Appellant by an Assignment and Agreement dated June 21, 1982, and recorded in the Land Records of Baltimore County at Liber 6406 Folio 53 (the "Assignment"), a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

Paragraph 1 of the Declaration provides, "...any building or structure now or hereafter erected...shall be occupied and used for residential purposes only." The Declaration provides a very limited exception to allow the use of a residence as a physician's or dentist's office only, with the prior written consent of Appellant. The Declaration does not indicate any exception that would allow the operation of other professional offices from the Property, including those of a Certified Public Accountant, as allowed by the Special Exception. Additionally, Paragraph 2 of the Declaration prohibits the erection of any "...building, fence, wall, or other structure" without written approval, such as the "Office" sign erected on the Property and allowed by the Special Exception.

Appellant hereby appeals the Special Exception as it is clearly a violation of the Declaration. The Property Owners had notice of the Declaration and the associated covenants when they purchased the Property in 2012. Nevertheless, the Property Owners proceeded to seek a Special Exception that would allow for the operation of a CPA office from the Property, a use

that is prohibited by the Declaration. The Property Owners did not notify Appellant of their desire to use the Property for this purpose, or request permission from Appellant for a limited exception to the Declaration.

Baltimore County Code Section 502: Special Exceptions provides governing principles and conditions to be considered in granting any Special Exception. Specifically, § 502.1 provides, "Before any special exception may be granted, it must appear that the use for which the special exception is requested will not: A. Be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the locality involved." The Declaration provides for a common scheme of development for the Property and the surrounding neighborhood that is intended to be limited to residential purposes. By allowing the operation of a business from the Property, and the additional visitors and traffic associated with operation of such a business, the Special Exception contravenes the purposes of the Declaration and may be detrimental to the welfare of the neighborhood.

Appellant is a not for profit civic organization, performing valuable quasi-governmental functions in the community. Appellants' good faith efforts to enforce and administer the covenants and conditions of the Declaration should be afforded comity by the County. The Special Exception is inequitable in that it would tend to endorse the Property Owners' flagrant and obvious intent to sidestep and violate the Declaration, and therefore should not be granted.

Appellant expressly reserves all other rights or claims not included in this written request for appeal. To the extent that additional supporting documents are requested by the Office of Administrative Hearings and/or The Baltimore County Board of Appeals, this appeal will be promptly supplemented.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Special Exception filed for property located at 204 Brackenwood Court. The Petition was filed by Jeffrey H. Gray, Esquire, on behalf of the legal owners of the subject property, Joseph L. and Lynn A. Farrell. The Special Exception Petition seeks relief pursuant to §1B01.1(c)(12) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to use a portion of the herein described property for the professional office of Lynn A. Farrell, Certified Public Accountant. The subject property and requested relief are more fully described on the site plan which was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1A.

Appearing at the hearing was Joseph and Lynn Farrell and Keith Heindel of Professional Surveys, LLC, who prepared the site plan. Jeffrey H. Gray, Esquire attended and represented the Petitioners. Several neighbors (whose names are in the case file) attended the hearing and expressed certain concerns with the request. The file reveals that the Petition was properly advertised and the site was properly posted as required by the B.C.Z.R.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. The only substantive comment was from the Department of Planning (DOP). which did not oppose the relief, but requested that certain conditions be imposed.

Testimony and evidence offered at the hearing revealed that the subject property is 0.2486 acres and is zoned DR 3.5. The property is improved with a single family dwelling, which the Petitioners purchased last year. Ms. Farrell has been a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) since 1982, and would like to operate a professional office for her practice in the basement of her home. To do so requires Special Exception relief. The BCZR provides as follows concerning this requested special exception use:

Office or studios of physicians, dentists, lawyers, architects, engineers, artists, musicians or other professional persons, provided that any such office or studio is established within the same building as that serving as the professional person's primary residence at the time of application; does not occupy more than 25% of the total floor area of such residence; and does not involve the employment of more than one nonresident professional associate nor two other nonresident employees.

BCZR § 1B01.1.(C)(12).

Special Exception Law in Maryland

In AT&T Wireless Services v. Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, 123 Md. App. 681 (1998), the court ruled that the test in evaluating a special exception or conditional use is not whether a special exception is compatible with permitted uses in a zone or whether a conditional use will have adverse effects. Adverse effects are inherent in all conditional or special exception uses. The standard is whether the adverse effects of the use at the particular location proposed would be greater than the adverse effects ordinarily associated with that use elsewhere within the same zone. Under Maryland law, a special exception enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. Schultz v. Pritts, 291 Md. 1 (1981).

Surveyor Keith Heindel, who prepared the site plan, opined that the Petitioners satisfied the requirements for a Special Exception. Mr. Heindel indicated that the office for Ms. Farrell would occupy 23% of the total floor space in the dwelling, which complies with the B.C.Z.R. Ms.

Farrell testified that she is the only CPA in the practice, and that she has only one other employee, an administrative assistant. Ms. Farrell stated she does not advertise, does not want the practice to grow, and operates (with rare exceptions) between the hours of 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday – Friday. The only sign on the premises is a small metal sign with the word "Office," directing clients to the basement entrance to the home.

In these circumstances, I do not believe that the inherent adverse effects associated with this special exception use would be any greater at this location than they would be at any other location in the DR 3.5 zone. Several neighbors expressed concerns with the loss of a neighborhood feel, unknown visitors in the neighborhood and an increase in traffic. These concerns (while valid) are the same as those that would exist in any professional home office scenario, and the County Council is presumed to have been aware of same when it allowed offices for lawyers, doctors, etc. by special exception in DR zones. Though the petition will be granted, I will impose certain conditions designed to minimize any adverse impacts upon the community. In written comments submitted to the undersigned, a neighbor questioned how these conditions/restrictions would be enforced. Baltimore County zoning and code inspectors conduct investigations and enforcement actions initiated by citizen complaints. To the extent any of the conditions are not observed, the appropriate recourse would be to contact the County's Code Enforcement Bureau.

One of the DOP's recommendations was to restrict the special exception approval to Ms. Farrell personally. Generally speaking, special exceptions, like variances, "run with the land." <u>Van Sciver v. Zoning Board of Adjustment, 396 Pa. 646 (1959)</u> ("... [A] special exception or a variance, although it may be granted conditionally or limited in time or use in any manner consistent with the ordinance *always runs with the land and cannot be personal*"). But there is also authority for the

proposition that if the grant is made personal, and the order is not appealed, that the restriction will bind a subsequent owner/lessee. Kulak v. Zoning Board, 563 A.2d 978 (Pa. 1989). As such, I will include the restriction recommended by the DOP.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this petition, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered, I find that Petitioners' Special Exception request should be granted, subject to the conditions noted below.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, this 10th day of October, 2013, that the Petition for Special Exception relief under §1B01.1 (c)(12) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R."), to use a portion of the herein described property for the professional office of Lynn A. Farrell, Certified Public Accountant, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for appropriate permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.
- The "Special Exception area," in which all office activities must be conducted, shall be the basement rooms labeled "OFFICE," as depicted on the site plan marked as Exhibit 1A.
- 3. Client parking shall be located only in the driveway and on the street in front of (and on the same side of the street) the Petitioners' dwelling. Ms. Farrell shall make good faith efforts to notify her clients of this restriction.
- 4. Other than the small "office" sign existing on the site, no other signs shall be erected on the premises.
- 5. The Special Exception relief granted herein shall terminate if Ms. Farrell sells, leases or in any way conveys her interest in the subject property.
- 6. The professional office operation shall have no more than one employee, in addition to Ms. Farrell.

Judge Beverungen,

Thank you for an opportunity to send in comments.

We have lived on Brackenwood Ct. for 9 years. We are very concerned about the increase in traffic from business related to Amrhein and Flynn Pa at 204 Brackenwood Ct. This past February – April traffic was heavy which prompted contact with the county code enforcement. The code inspector called us and suggested we document the traffic activity.

Brackenwood Ct is a very quiet street; it's not a cut through or a busy street like Padonia Rd. or Timonium Rd. We walk our neighborhood and I don't know of any other professional offices in our general area.

I searched for CPA firms in this area and they are located on commercially zoned roads like Timonium or Padonia. Several of the smaller CPA firms are located in the Kelly Building (20 E Timonium Rd) 1.3 miles away and Elliot Building (57 W Timonium Rd) 1.6 miles away.

Is an easier option for Ms. Farrell and her accounting firm Amrhein And Flynn Pa to lease from one of the multiple commercially available properties along York, Timonium or Pot Spring roads within 1 to 2 miles, so their business be consistent with the above firms location and activity/traffic? Is \$8-10,000 in yearly rent not feasible/reasonable? Did they share their gross revenue when applying for an exception and is that considered when weighing a decision?

They moved their business from 3646 Roland Ave, Baltimore, MD 21211 (based on a Patch.com) in Hampden, which according to Maryland tax records is a commercially zoned building.

From the hearing Monday, I thought I heard Ms. Farrell's lawyer say Amrhein And Flynn Pa has 300 business clients and 107 appointments for taxes with three or four times that number in walk ups. Are those numbers are accurate? If so, that is a sizable accounting business that has been in business for quite a while, and I estimate those numbers translate to low to mid six figures if each of the businesses are \$500-\$2000 clients. Is rent doable for a business of that size? Manta.com lists the revenue @ \$500K+ and 3 employees. http://www.manta.com/c/mmyddp9/amrhein-flynn

Is that accurate revenue @ the old location?

Also, a packet we received Monday at the hearing included a page that was an Inter office correspondence from Andrea Van Arsdale, Director of the Department of Planning to Arnold Jablon Deputy Admin Officer and Director of Permits dated Sept 10th, 2013 that had a summary of recommendations. The last one was interesting:

#4: No employees, except persons who use the dwelling as their primary residence, shall be involved in the home occupation.

This recommendation doesn't seem consistent with current usage.

Ms. Farrell mentioned that they had used a temp employee helping during their busy season at their old location, and did not do so here, maintaining just one fulltime employee. Will an additional temporary employee be allowed under this proposed exception that they are requesting?

How would we know if she is follows code, do we need to constantly monitor Amrhein and Flynn Pa to see if they stay within code or the exception granted? How many cars and clients are ok: 100, 200, 500 during tax season? I have counted 3 cars at a time, some cars just idling outside, while a person picks up or drops off. I started watching more closely after the code inspector suggested we document the traffic.

Amrhein and Flynn Pa has gone to one heck of a lot of trouble and expense to get an exception to zoning laws by hiring a lawyer and surveyor, all to I guess save on rent which we as CPAs think rent is very reasonable cost of doing business for an accounting practice of their apparent size.

I feel like it is inconsistent with Spring Lakes zoning classification if Amrhein And Flynn Pa continues to run their business with the traffic they have created during tax season.

This activity is outside the spirit and intent of this quiet neighborhood, and would be more consistent with an office location on Pot Spring, Timonium and Padonia roads in an office building or individual houses zoned commercially. I see a lot of signage on these roads soliciting for leases. Costar.com lists lots of available space as well.

Lastly, we are now also concerned after speaking with a realtor yesterday telling us we may now have to disclose a business is across the street, and if and when we decide to sell our house, it may impact the sales price.

My concerns have heightened since Monday's hearing, and I feel the activity with the amount of clients and sizable increase in traffic should be conducted in a commercial zone and not in a residential neighborhood.

Traffic Concepts, Inc. has been asked to investigate a Special Exception request by Ms. Lynn Farrell to allow a home professional office (CPA) located at 204 Brackenwood Court in Lutherville-Timonium, Maryland. This Special Exception was approved by the Zoning Hearing Officer but this decision has been appealed and will be heard by the County Board of Appeals at a public hearing scheduled for February 11, 2014.

We have reviewed the Zoning Hearing Officer's decision, the Baltimore County Code, and have had discussions with the applicant Ms. Lynn Farrell. As I understand it, Ms. Farrell will be the one professional at the home office and one administrative assistant will travel to the house each day for work. After discussion with Ms. Farrell, her accounting office will have peak activity during the months of February through April. Past records have indicated that during peak time, on average four appointments are scheduled where a client will come to the home professional office on an average day. In addition, a few clients will drop off their tax information without appointments. During the non-peak time of May through January the number of clients to the home will be dramatically decreased. A review of Ms. Farrell's appointment books indicates most appointments are scheduled after the morning peak travel times and prior to the evening peak travel time on the adjacent roadway. Ms. Farrell also meets some clients away from her home as well.

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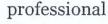

home offices in residential districts.' Absent specific mention in the regulations, these professions would appear to be properly included under the term "other professional persons." Both professions are licensed by the state and disciplined by professional ethics.2 As in the case of lawyers, home offices appear to have attracted few engineers or architects. In one case, a person seeking to operate an engineering business as a home occupation was found not to be entitled to a special exception under a city ordinance since such a business is not customarily carried on in a dwelling unit and would not be an accessory use in relation to the dwelling unit. To qualify as an accessory use, the use must be subordinate or clearly incidental to the residential use of property.3 The court noted that "zoning boards and courts may take notice of what business occupations are customarily conducted in residential dwellings based on general experience and understanding."4

§ 19:21 Accountants

Accountants are infrequently listed among the professions authorized to maintain home offices in residential districts. An occasional ordinance includes this group. Accountants probably can be classed as "other professional persons" as that language is employed in some of the ordinances which permit home offices.

However, like other desired home occupation uses, the applicable zoning ordinance has to be followed. Where an accoun-

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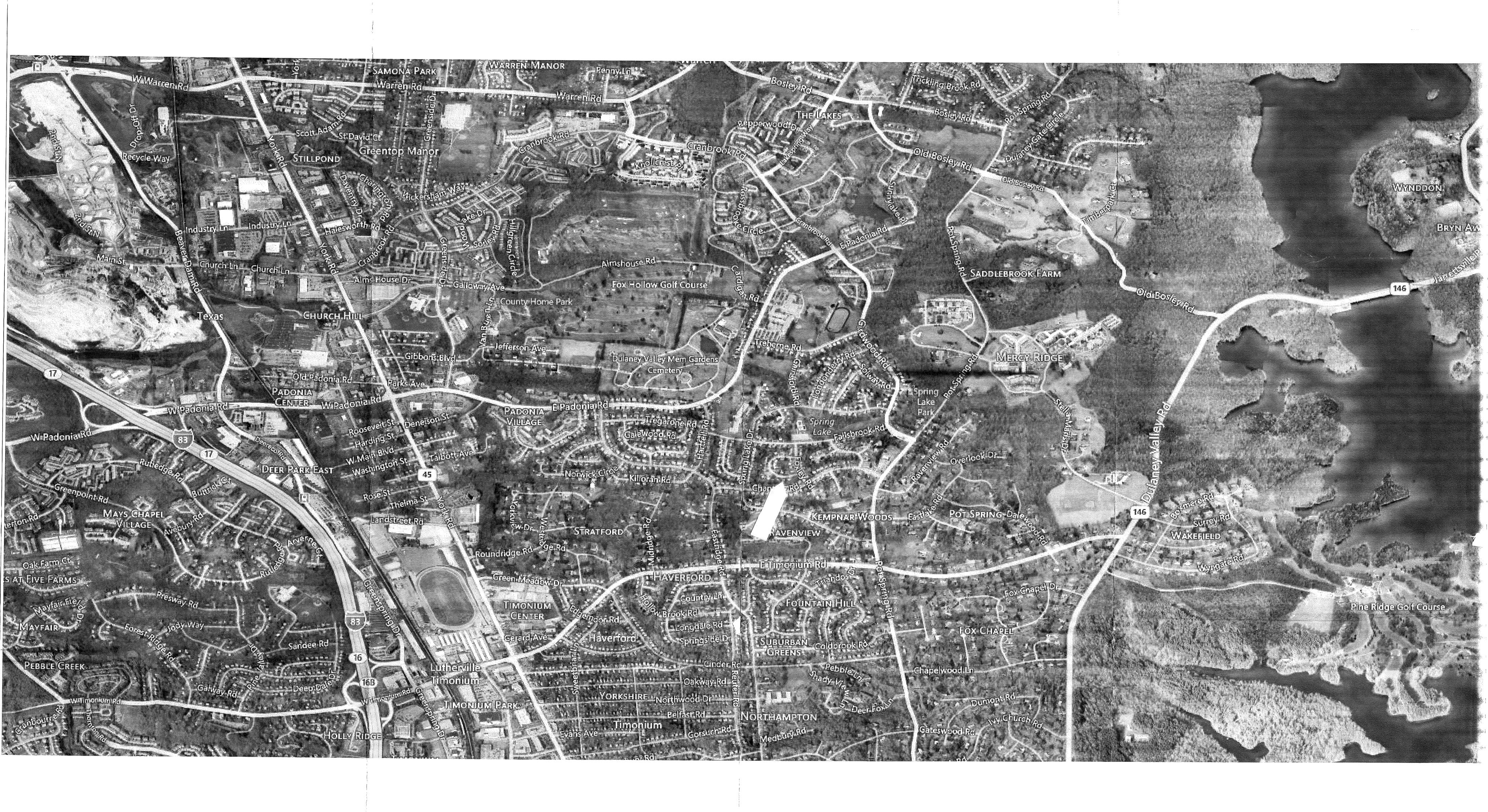
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
