OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by David H. Karceski, Esquire, of Venable, LLP on behalf of the legal owner, Venture BG LLC, Petitioner. The Variance was filed pursuant to § 450.4 Attachment 1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") as follows: (1) from 7(b) (IX) for a freestanding joint identification sign to display a maximum of 14 lines of text; and (2) from 7(b) (IX) for a freestanding joint identification sign to display lines of text with a sign copy a minimum of 1.5 inches in lieu of the required 8 inch height for sign copy. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibits 1A & 1B.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests was Ken Bernstein and Stephen Warfield, professional engineer from Matis Warfield, Inc., the firm that prepared the site plan. David H. Karceski, Esquire represented the Petitioner. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. There were no Protestants in attendance, nor does the file contain any letters of opposition. There were no substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments received.

The subject property is approximately 61± acres and is improved with a large shopping

center with a Wal-Mart and other tenants. The property has nearly 800,000 square feet of tenant space, and is split-zoned BL-AS, ML-IM and DR 5.5. The property is known as Landsdowne Station, and the relief sought pertains only to the existing joint identification sign.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I will grant the petition for variance.

To obtain variance relief requires a showing that:

(1) The property is unique; and

(2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel, 407 Md. 53, 80 (2008).

Petitioner has met this test. The large property has irregular dimensions and Mr. Warfield (who was accepted as an expert) noted there exists a significant grade change (over 80') across the site. As such the property is unique. If the B.C.Z.R. were strictly interpreted the Petitioner would suffer a practical difficulty, since it would be unable to identify the center's major retail tenants on the sign. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 13th day of June, 2014, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief pursuant to §450.4 Attachment 1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") as follows: (1) from 7(b)(IX) for a freestanding joint identification sign to display a maximum of 14 lines of text; and (2) from 7(b) (IX) for a freestanding joint identification sign to display lines of text with a sign copy a minimum of 1.5 inches in lieu of the required 8 inch height for sign copy, be and is hereby GRANTED.

ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

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The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioner may apply for appropriate permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by the owner of the subject property, Venture B.G., LLC, and the contract lessee, Office Depot, by and through their attorney, J. Neil Lanzi, Esquire. Petitioners request a variance from Section 450.4.5(d) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit wall-mounted signage for a new Office Depot store in the Lansdowne Station Shopping Center. Specifically, Petitioners are requesting a variance to permit:

- 1. One illuminated wall-mounted enterprise sign of 188 square feet without a separate customer entrance in addition to the one wall mounted enterprise sign permitted, and
- 2. To amend previously approved sign variances if necessary. 1

The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the two page site plan and photographs which were submitted into evidence and marked as Petitioners' Exhibits 1 and 2, respectively.

¹ Case No. 07-577-A involved similar sign relief granted to the legal owner Venture B.G. LLC; however, the wall-mounted signage variances in that case involved Wal-Mart Stores East, LP, Lessee of the portion of property known as 3601 Washington Boulevard.

The Office Depot and Service Select Signs representatives confirmed the sign proposed is the standard company wall mounted sign.

As explained by Bruce Doak and the Office Depot representatives, the primary purpose of the additional signage is to assist customers with first locating the site from the various roads surrounding the site and once within the shopping center, then assist customers to the Office Depot store where its products and services are located. As noted by Bruce Doak, the sign regulations currently only allow one wall-mounted enterprise sign per entrance. Noting the single entrance to the new Office Depot and the travel isle between the Office Depot and Walmart Stores, Mr. Doak used the photographs in evidence to demonstrate the practical difficulty facing Office Depot in identifying the Office Depot store and necessity of allowing one additional wall-mounted sign so that the Office Depot could be identified and located by those in vehicles on the surrounding roadway and within the shopping center.

Without a variance, the requested sign(s) and the proposed configuration of enterprise signage would not be permitted by B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4.5(d), which governs commercial signage in multi-tenant centers. The proposed signs are "enterprise" signs which are defined as those which display the identity of a business or advertise products or services associated with a business. *See* B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4.5. Section 450.4.5(d) permits only one wall-mounted sign for each tenant having an exterior customer entrance with a maximum square footage for such signs of two times the length of the wall containing the exterior customer entrance.

A strict interpretation of Baltimore County's sign regulations would provide for only one wall-mounted enterprise sign for this Office Depot store and that being on the front façade of the building with a total maximum square footage of 225 square feet. The second enterprise wall-

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County this

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner of Baltimore County for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by lessee, Wal-Mart Stores East, LP, along with the legal owner of the property, Venture B.G. LLC, by and through their attorneys, Robert A. Hoffman, Esquire and Venable LLP. Petitioners request a variance from Section 450.4.5(d) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit additional wall-mounted signage for a new Wal-Mart Supercenter store. Specifically, Petitioner is requesting variances to permit: (1) a wall-mounted enterprise sign on a wall where no enterprise sign is permitted by right (north side façade/proposed sign no. 4); (2) to permit ten wall-mounted enterprise signs on a wall on which one wall-mounted enterprise sign is permitted by right (west front façade/proposed sign nos. 1, 3, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14); and (3) to permit two wall-mounted enterprise signs on a wall where no enterprise sign is permitted by right (south side façade/proposed sign nos. 1A, 12). The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan, which was submitted into evidence and marked as Petitioners' Exhibit Nos. 1A - 1C.

At the requisite public hearing, Robert A. Hoffman, Esquire appeared as attorney for Petitioners along with Thomas Kleine, Esquire of Troutman Sanders LLP, Corporate Counsel for Wal-Mart. Also appearing in support of the Petition for Variance were Rhoda Washington, a attract customers into the site, but to direct customers once they are on site. The other signs will display certain aspects of Wal-Mart's business contained within the store, specifically the retail, garden, and food centers of the Supercenter, a pharmacy, optical and one-hour photo services, and the tire and lube components of the business. The ten enterprise signs proposed on the west or front façade of the building will face the center's parking lot. One enterprise sign is also proposed on the north side façade of the building, and two enterprise signs are proposed on the south side façade. As indicated on the site plan, other directional signs are proposed for the front, rear, and north side façades, which do not require variance relief.

Without a variance, the requested number of signs and the proposed configuration of enterprise signage would not be permitted by B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4.5(d), which governs commercial signage in multi-tenant centers. The proposed signs are "enterprise" signs, which are defined as those which display the identity of a business or advertise products or services associated with a business. *See* B.C.Z.R. Section 450.4.5. Section 450.4.5(d) permits only one wall-mounted sign for each tenant having an exterior customer entrance with a maximum square footage for such signs of two times the length of the wall containing the exterior customer entrance.

A strict interpretation of Baltimore County's sign regulations would only allow one wall-mounted sign for this entire Supercenter and that being on the western front façade of the building with a total maximum square footage of 1,260 square feet. Clearly, the Zoning Regulations do not take into account this type of large retail store. The arrangement of Wal-Mart's multiple uses within a single structure of this size and without individual customer access points for each of the particular services offered represents a departure from the configuration of other strip retail centers found in Baltimore County, which have traditionally contained smaller

Pursuant to the Zoning Regulations of Baltimore County, the advertising and posting of the property, and public hearing held thereon, and for the reasons set forth above, the Petition for Variance shall be granted.

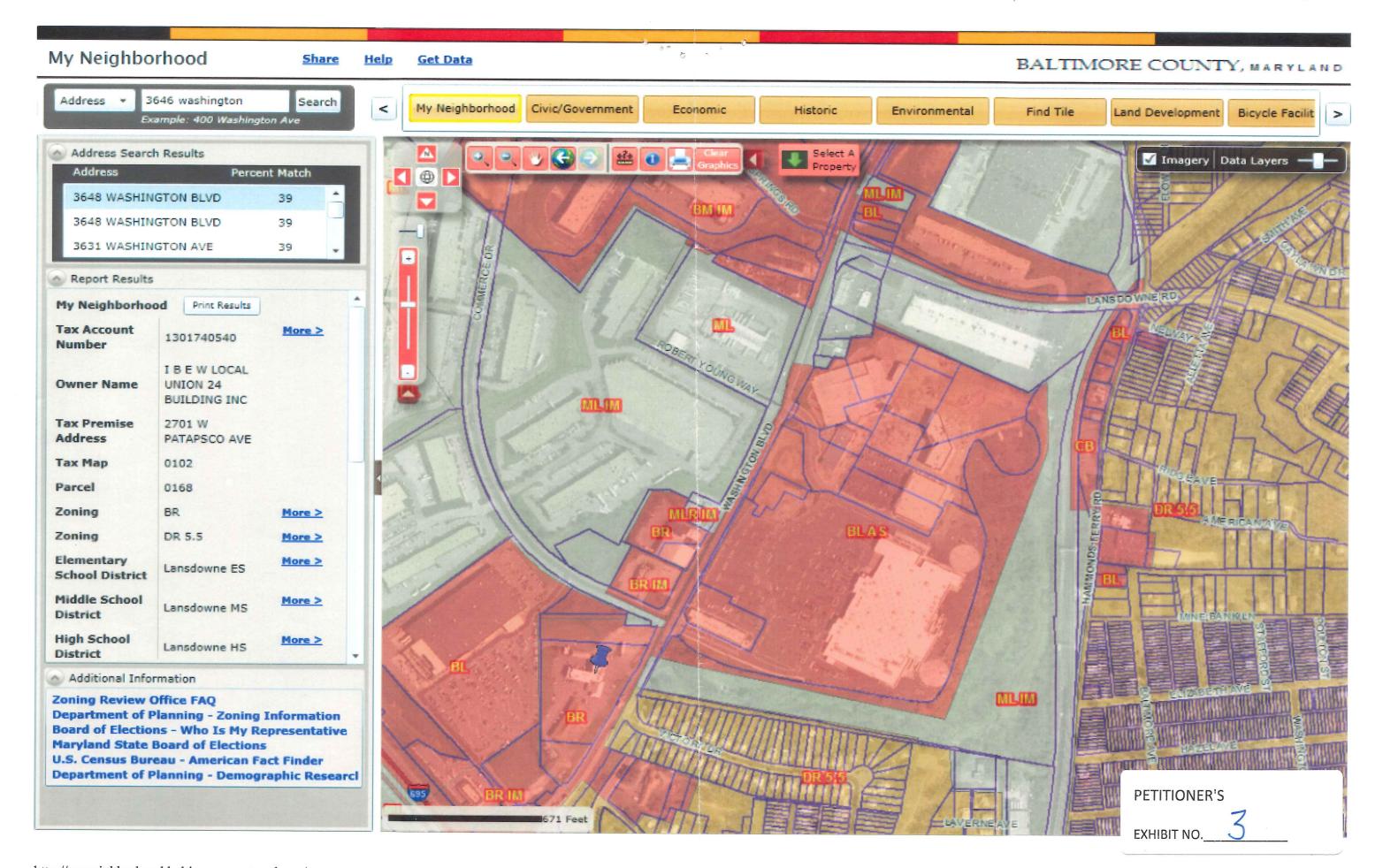
