OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing, Special Exception and Variance filed on behalf of Adebayo & Modupe Togun, legal owners. The Petition for Special Hearing was filed pursuant to \$500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to allow off-street parking spaces on multiple lots within the site in lieu of the requirement that the spaces be located on the same lot on which the Class B office building is proposed, and to confirm that such request does not conflict with B.C.Z.R. Sections 204.3.C.2 and 204.4.C.7. A Petition for Special Exception was filed pursuant to B.C.Z.R. \$204.3.B.2 for a class B office building in the RO zone. Finally, a Petition for Variance was filed pursuant to B.C.Z.R. as follows: (1) to allow a side yard setback a minimum of 7 ft. in lieu of the required 20 ft.; (2) to allow a landscape buffer a minimum of 10 ft. along a property line which abuts a residentially zoned/residentially used property in lieu of the required 20 ft. landscape buffer; and (3) to allow a freestanding directional sign with a height of 7 ft. and a sign area/face of 35 ft. in lieu of the permitted 4 ft. in height and 8 sq. ft.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests was Adebayo and Modupe Togun, and professional engineer Mike Razavi, whose firm prepared the plan. David H. Karceski, Esq. and Adam Rosenblatt, Esq. represented the Petitioners. There were no protestants or ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING.

interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. A Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was submitted by the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR). That agency did not oppose the request, but requested that landscape and lighting plans be submitted prior to issuance of permits.

SPECIAL HEARING

The petition for special hearing pertains to the location of the parking for the proposed office building. The parking would be on-site, but would not be on the same "lot" as the building itself, as required by the R.O. zone regulations. I believe the intent of the regulation is to prevent offsite parking (which would likely be in a residential zone, which often adjoins an R.O. zone) to serve the office building. That concern is not animated here.

The subject property was subdivided in the 1980s, and that development plan created five lots on the site (Exhibit 8). The residential subdivision never came to fruition, but it is the multiple lots comprising the site which created the need for the special hearing.

SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. Schultz v. Pritts, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The Schultz standard was revisited in People's Counsel v. Loyola College, 406 Md. 54 (2008), where the court emphasized that a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use. No such evidence was presented in this case, and Mr. Razavi testified (via proffer) the proposal satisfied the requirements set forth in B.C.Z.R. §502.1. As such, the petition will be granted.

VARIANCES

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I will also grant the petition for variance. A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The Petitioners have met this test. The property has an irregular "L" shape, and though it fronts on three roads it has access on only one. As such the property is unique. If the B.C.Z.R. were strictly interpreted, the Petitioners would suffer a practical difficulty since they would be unable to construct the proposed building. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 18th day of November, 2015 by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to §500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to allow off-street parking spaces on multiple lots within the site in lieu of the requirement that the spaces be located on the same lot on which the Class B office building is proposed, and to confirm that such request does not conflict with B.C.Z.R. Sections 204.3.C.2 and 204.4.C.7., be and is hereby GRANTED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Special Exception pursuant to B.C.Z.R. §204.3.B.2 for a class B office building in the RO zone, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance as follows: (1) to allow a side yard setback a minimum of 7 ft. in lieu of the required 20 ft.; (2) to allow a landscape buffer a minimum of 10 ft. along a property line which abuts a residentially zoned/residentially used property in lieu of the required 20 ft. landscape buffer; and (3) to allow a freestanding directional sign with a height of 7 ft. and a sign area/face of 35 ft. in lieu of the permitted 4 ft. in height and 8 sq. ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

2. Prior to issuance of permits, landscape and lighting plans must be submitted

for approval by the Baltimore County Landscape Architect.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

SECTION 203

General Provisions: All Office Classifications [Bill No. 186-1994]

§ 203.1. Findings.

It is found that:

- A. There is a need for a range of office zoning classifications to allow for differing needs and intensity of use;
- B. It is to the interests of the county to have available a variety of office zones so that the zone best suited to the needs of the market can be applied at a scale and with a range of uses and protections appropriate to the surrounding locale;
- C. A variety of office zoning tools is needed to meet the goals for managed growth and redevelopment as stated in the adopted master plan; and
- D. The regulations in the O-1 (Office Building) Zone and the O-2 (Office Park) Zone enacted in 1980 are, for the most part, duplicative, and there is no need to apply the O-1 Zone to additional land.

§ 203.2. Purposes.

Pursuant to the above findings, it is the purpose of the office zones to establish a continuum of office classifications to provide:

- A. A low-intensity alternative use for dwellings which are no longer desirable for residential use (R-O-A);
- B. A transition or buffer between residential and the more intense office, retail or industrial use of property by permitting office development highly compatible with residential uses (R-O and S-E);
- C. For the development of office buildings and moderate density residential development, with commercial development limited to serving the needs of tenants (OR-2);
- D. For office development as the only permitted principal use in areas where public services are not planned to support additional dwellings (O-3) and;
- E. For intensive development of employment uses which may be combined with high density residential uses in the county's growth areas (O.T.).

ELEVATOR-APARTMENT RESIDENCE ZONES, RESIDENTIAL-OFFICE ZONES, OFFICE ZONES, BUSINESS ZONES, MANUFACTURING ZONES AND DISTRICTS

§ 204.3

SECTION 204

R-O (Residential — Office) Zone [Bill No. 13-1980⁷]

§ 204.1. Declaration of findings. [Bill No. 186-1994]

It is found that:

- A. Residential use of certain sites may not be economically feasible in some predominantly moderate-density residential areas that are within or near town centers, are near C.C.C. Districts, or lie along commercial motorways;
- B. Neither business zoning nor high-density residential zoning of those sites is appropriate; and
- C. With appropriate restrictions, houses converted to offices and, in some cases, small Class B office buildings and similar buildings are suitable, economically feasible uses of such sites.

§ 204.2. Statement of legislative policy. [Bill Nos. 151-1988; 186-1994]

The R-O zoning classification is established, pursuant to the findings stated above, to accommodate houses converted to office buildings and some small Class B office buildings in predominantly residential areas on sites that, because of adjacent commercial activity, heavy commercial traffic or other similar factors, can no longer reasonably be restricted solely to uses allowable in moderate-density residential zones. It is intended that buildings and uses in R-O Zones shall not intrude upon or disturb present or prospective uses of nearby residential property. It is not the R-O classification's purpose to accommodate a substantial part of the demand for office space, it being the intent of these zoning regulations that office space demand should be met primarily in C.T. Districts, C.C.C. Districts and, to a lesser extent, in other commercial areas.

§ 204.3. Use regulations. [Bill Nos. 167-1980; 37-1988; 151-1988; 186-1994]

- A. Uses permitted as of right. The following uses, only, are permitted as of right in any R-O Zone:
 - 1. Uses permitted as of right and as limited in D.R.5.5 Zones.
 - Class A office buildings containing offices or medical offices and their accessory
 uses, including parking, except that no more than 25% of the total adjusted gross
 floor area of the office building may be occupied by medical offices.

Editor's Note: This bill originally added the R-O Zone as Section 203. It was subsequently changed to Section 204 by Bill No. 186-1994.

- B. Uses permitted by special exception. The following uses, only, may be permitted by special exception in an R-O Zone, if such use has an approved County Review Group (CRG) plan prior to the granting of a special exception:
 - 1. Uses permitted by special exception and as limited in D.R.5.5 Zones.
 - Class B office building.
 - Class B office buildings containing offices or medical offices, except that no a. more than 25% of the total adjusted gross floor area of the office building may be occupied by medical offices. A Class B office building in existence prior to the effective date of this legislation with medical offices in excess of 25% of the total adjusted gross floor area is a conforming use if it is in compliance with the terms of its special exception. Such an office building may be expanded if the expansion meets the current parking requirements for medical offices. A Class B office building listed on the Baltimore County Final Landmarks List, as part of the adaptive reuse of the building, is allowed up to 1,200 square feet of carry-out restaurant or standard restaurant (without service of alcoholic beverages), and storage of wine is permitted. Special exception uses required for community buildings or community swimming pools that involve a Baltimore County final landmarks structure may be reviewed as a permitted use subject to review and approval by the Baltimore County Planning Board. [Bill No. 100-2009]
 - b. Up to 100% of the total adjusted gross floor area of a Class B office building may be occupied by medical offices if:
 - (1) The floor area ratio of the proposed Class B office building is not greater than 0.20;
 - (2) A documented site plan and a special exception for a Class B office building have been approved by the Zoning Commissioner or the Board of Appeals, either on appeal or as a result of its original jurisdiction, prior to the effective date of Bill No. 151-1988;
 - (3) Construction of the Class B building is started prior to the expiration date of the special exception as required by Section 502.3; and
 - (4) Parking requirements shall be calculated by requiring the maximum number of parking spaces as determined by Section 409 of these regulations, the requirements of the documented site plan, or the requirements of the order granting the special exception, whichever shall yield the greatest number of spaces.
 - 3. Animal grooming facility. [Bill No. 50-2013]
- C. Signs and off-street parking requirements.

Editor's Note: Veterinarians' offices was originally included in this subsection by Bill No. 13-1980 as a permitted use but was deleted by Bill No. 167-1980.

§ 204.4. Bulk regulations in R-O Zones. [Bill No. 186-1994]

Uses permitted as of right or by special exception are governed by the following bulk regulations:

- A. Uses permitted under Sections 204.3.A.1 and 204.3.B.1 and new structures accessory to Class A office buildings are governed by the bulk regulations of D.R.5.5 Zones.
- Class A office buildings themselves, which by definition may not be enlarged, are not subject to bulk regulations, nor are unenlarged structures accessory to the original building.
- C. Class B office buildings.
 - Maximum floor area ratio: 0.33.
 - 2. Maximum height of structure: 35 feet.
 - Minimum front yard setback: 25 feet or the average of the setbacks of the adjacent 3. structures, whichever is less.
 - Minimum side yard setbacks: 10 feet, except if the adjacent property is 4. predominantly residentially zoned, residentially used, or is adjacent to a residential street, in which case the setback shall be 20 feet.
 - Minimum rear yard setback: 30 feet. 5.
 - 6. Amenity open space: 7% of the interior of the parking lot, not including setback and buffer area requirements, shall be pervious land area in association with plantings.
 - 7. Maximum lot size: one acre, except that if located on a principal arterial and if there is adjacent nonresidentially used or nonresidentially zoned frontage, the maximum lot size may be two acres.
 - The office building shall be the only principal building on the lot on which it is 8. situated and shall not be attached to another building.
 - 9. Landscape requirements. In addition to the requirements set forth in the Baltimore County Landscape Manual:
 - All parking and dumpster areas which abut a residential zone shall be screened by an opaque fence, wall or berm in association with plantings.
 - b. The minimum screening height shall be five feet.
 - The following buffers, which shall not be encroached upon by aboveground c. stormwater management, parking or dumpster areas but which may be broken by the entrance way, shall be provided:
 - (1) Property lines which abut any property which is predominantly residentially zoned, residentially used or which abut any residential street must have a twenty-foot landscape buffer; and

(2) Property lines which abut any nonresidentially zoned property must have a ten-foot landscape buffer.

§ 204.5. Plan. [Bill Nos. 56-1982; 186-1994; 137-2004]

The use or development of any property in an R-O Zone may not be changed from that existing on the effective date of the classification's application to that property, except in accordance with a plan approved by the County Review Group as provided in Article 32, Title 4 of the Baltimore County Code, unless the change in use is confined to a change in the number of dwelling units in accordance with the provisions of Section 402.

§ 204.6. Conversion of dwellings to office buildings. [Bill Nos. 161-1985; 151-1988; 186-1994]

Any one- or two-family dwelling or apartment building which is under application for either a change in zoning classification to R-O or for a conversion from a residential use to an office use shall require a special exception if the dwelling has been enlarged in floor area by 10% or more within a period of five years prior to the date of application for change or conversion.

SECTION 205 OR-1 (Office Building — Residential) Zone [Bill No. 167-198010]

§ 205.1. Declaration of findings. [Bill No. 186-1994]

- A. It is found that the name of the O-1 (Office Building) zoning classification is misleading the public because the name implies that only office buildings are permitted when, in fact, the zone does permit residential and other uses permitted in the D.R.5.5 Zone.
- B. It is further found that the O-1 zoning classification is sufficiently similar to the O-2 classification that there is no longer a need for two separate zones.

§ 205.2. Statement of legislative policy. [Bill No. 186-1994]

- A. It is the intent of the county that the name of the O-1 zoning classification be changed to the OR-1 (Office Building Residential) Zone.
- B. Properties classified as O-1 before the effective date of Bill No. 186-1994 shall be classified as OR-1 and shall be subject to the use and performance standards of the OR-1 Zone.

Editor's Note: This bill also repealed former Sections 203.5.A.B and 203.5.A.C in their entirety. Similar provisions
detailing the content of development plans are now contained in Title 16 of the Baltimore County Code, 1988 Edition,
as revised.

Editor's Note: This bill originally added the O-1 Zone as Section 204. It was subsequently changed to OR-1 and Section 205 by Bill No. 186-1994.

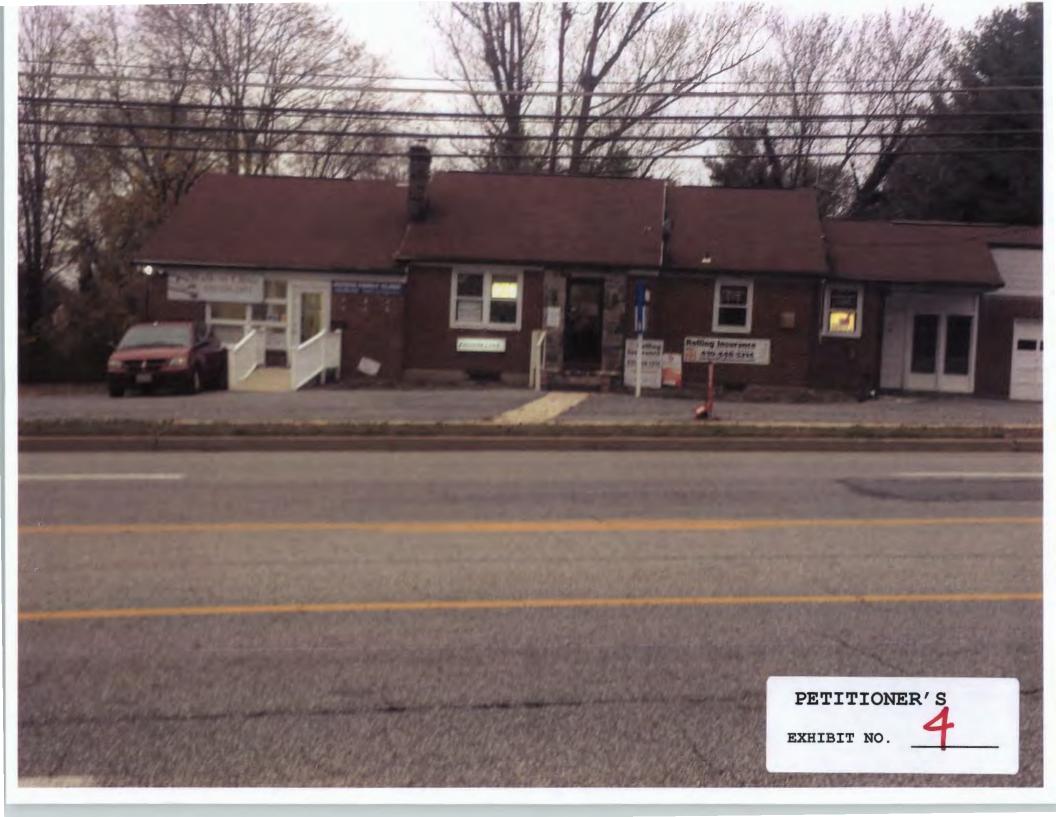

Dear Judge Beverungen,

Upon review of your November 18 decision in this case, I noticed that there was mention of the October 9 Development Plans Review (PAI) comment but no mention of the attached Planning Department (DOP) November 9 detailed comment and recommendations prepared by Lloyd Moxley. Recently, in significant cases, your opinions have frequently either attached the DOP comment and recommendations as conditions, selected some as conditions, or explained why some recommendations were unnecessary.

It occurred to me that the DOP comment perhaps was not delivered to your office in the mail.

The comment has recommendations for compatibility, architecture, parking arrangement, access, landscaping, lighting, preservation of trees and plantings to the maximum extent possible, lighting direction, and dumpster requirements and screening.

The specific recommendations at the end of the comment look reasonable and should be incorporated as conditions. I also note DOP's general recommendation, discussed in the body of the comment, that there be compatibility of the architecture, parking lot layout, access, and monument sign. To implement this, it seems reasonable to include the fairly customary condition that there be review by DOP to assure or confirm the expected compatibility, architecture, and elevations.

I called David Karceski to express my view. He had not seen the opinion, so I anticipate he should and will have the opportunity to comment.

By way of background, I am familiar with this case, which now involves an amended petition. The initial petition filed in August, 2014 had two buildings and a different layout. Early on, I communicated several concerns to Mr. Karceski, including the R.O. Zone limit of one principal building. He responded with Petitioners' undertaking to prepare a revised plan with one building. Meanwhile, I visited the site and saw in this mixed commercial/residential area that the property has some very nice mature trees.

On May 26, 2015, I had a very cordial and constructive meeting with Mr. Karceski and Mr. Togun and we went over the essentials of the revised plan. My notes reflect that based on the single building, the very attractive architectural drawings, and the layout, I agreed that this basically satisfied my concerns. We did discuss that there would be appropriate stormwater management, landscaping and lighting to be reviewed by county staff, and some amenity open space. I also suggested that as many trees be retained as possible. The DOP comment coincidentally echoes some of my observations.

Mr. Karceski mentioned yesterday that he thought there would be a development plan review.

Under all the circumstances, I ask that you consider adding the DOP recommendations as conditions, including a compatibility review or review of building elevations, architecture, and layout along with the itemized recommendations at the end of the comment.

It is my impression that these recommendations are not inconsistent with the Petitioners' plan, architectural drawings, and intent as I understand them. However, I appreciate that Mr. Karceski should have an opportunity to make his observations and response.

Thank you in advance for your further consideration. Our office will respect your judgment on this matter.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for a special hearing to determine whether or not the Administrative Law Judge should approve off-street parking spaces on a lot adjacent to the lot on which the Class B office building is proposed and to confirm no conflict with BCZR Sections 204.3.C.2 and 204.4.C.7 and the petition for special exception to use the property for a Class B office building in the RO zone and the petition for variance to allow a side yard setback of a minimum of 7' and a landscape buffer a minimum of 10' along a property line which abuts a residentially zoned/residentially used property in lieu of the required 20' and 20' respectively and to allow a freestanding sign with a height of 7' with an area/face of 35 (sq.) ft. in lieu of the permitted 4' and 8 sq. ft. respectively.

Pursuant to Section 32-4-402.1(a) of the Baltimore County Code, the Director of Planning recommends that the proposed office development meets the compatibility objectives contained in BCC Section 32-4-402.1(b). The Director recommends that the proposed structure repeats architectural characteristics of the surrounding multi-family buildings and is similar in size and mass to these structures. The building presents little commercial character on those facades facing the adjacent residential use while showing the office access to the commercial corridor of Rolling Road. The parking arraignment repeats established layout patterns in the area in being a surface facility adjacent to the structure and will allow safe access to the established road network. No new roads are proposed nor are any locally significant features impacted. Landscaping will complement that existing in the neighborhood as will the monumental type entrance sign.

The Department has no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief conditioned upon the following:

Submit a landscape and lighting plan to the Baltimore County Landscape Architect for approval prior to the issuance of building permits. The Department requires that any plan so submitted will include the following features:

- Install to the maximum extent possible street trees and other vegetative plantings along Rolling Road.
- Install to the maximum extent possible vegetative screening along the property lines common with the dwelling at 2320 North Rolling Road.

 Lighting shall be of a directional type to ensure excessive glare does not spill into the surrounding residentially used properties.

 Ensure the proposed dumpster enclosure meets the requirements of Condition H of the Baltimore County Landscape Manual. The Department recommends the screening material match that used on the exterior of the principal building.

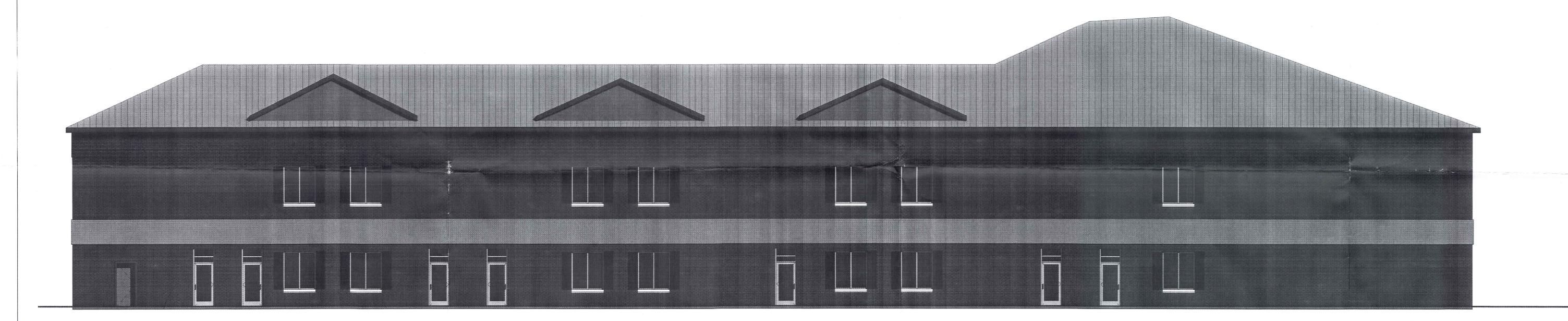

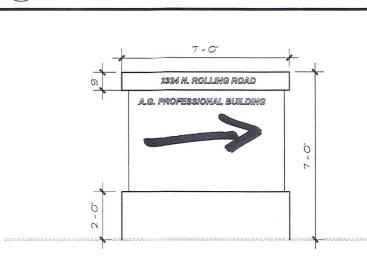
