Your recent letter to the Zoning Review Office was forwarded to me for reply. Based upon the <u>revised</u> information provided and my review of the above referenced zoning cases, the following has been determined:

- 1. The revised parking calculations that show the elimination of 55 parking spaces that were to be located on the ground level of a structured parking facility (associated with the new second proposed multifamily apartment community building), as provided on the green-lined site plan submitted with your letter, are within the Spirit and Intent of the 2011 and 2015 zoning cases. However, please be aware that no additional Spirit and Intent letters will be issued for any future changes or additions to the referenced property and those future changes or additions will require zoning relief from the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ).
- 2. A copy of your request letter, as well as a copy of this response, will be recorded and made a permanent part of the two zoning case files.
- 3. You must place a verbatim copy of your request letter, as well as a copy of this response letter, in the details of all building permit application plans.
- 4. This approval is for zoning purposes only. You will also be required to comply with all other County and State regulations relative to this property.

Please accept this request as an amendment to our previous Spirit and Intent letter, dated October 7, 2019, and approved by your office on October 8, 2019. A copy of your prior letter is enclosed. Your signature was subject to final approval of detailed plans, including any drive-through facilities. Our amended request and the enclosed red-lined plan show a 4,000-square foot addition to the former Sears store (retail), residential component comprised of multi-family apartments, senior housing apartments (independent living units), assisted living, and memory care (nursing) units, and an 828- space parking garage. The number of required and proposed parking spaces for the existing/new retail and residential uses are included on the plan as well.

As mentioned in our previous letter, the owners are proposing 2 new buildings on the Sears Lot (Lot 1A) replacing the Sears Automotive Service Center, which is approximately14,500 square feet (to be removed). The new buildings, which will be used for either retail or restaurant use, total no more than 20,800 square feet, which results in a net increase of approximately 6,300 square feet. A new Sears addition, which will be 4,000 square feet in size, is also now proposed and shown on the enclosed site plan. Since all commercial uses part of the HVTC, with the exception of the existing movie theater, are calculated at 5 parking spaces per 1,000 square feet of gross leasable area, a total of 52 parking spaces are required for the additional commercial square footage on the Sears Lot (32 spaces for the additional 6,300 square feet related to the two new buildings and 20 spaces for the addition to the Sears building). It is important to note that 26 existing parking spaces will be displaced for this partial redevelopment of the Sears Lot, and that this number of spaces is also addressed in the required parking calculations provided on the site plan. Those required spaces are shown as part of the overall provided parking on the Sears Lot.

As also mentioned in our previous letter, on June 19, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge granted a Special Hearing (Order enclosed) confirming that Sears Roebuck and Co. and Hunt Valley Towne Centre LLC are each entitled to their proportionate share of the parking variance (a 17.8% parking reduction) granted in Zoning Case No. 2015-232-SPH. Prior to the Hearing, your office approved a letter (Letter enclosed)

confirming that the Sears building, with its proportionate share of the parking variance, requires 654 parking spaces and currently provides 879 parking spaces generating a surplus of 225 parking spaces. The razing of the Sears Service Center, addition of the 2 new pad buildings, and the Sears building addition will now generate an 847-parking space requirement without utilization of the granted parking variance.

With the new residential project on the Sears Lot, existing spaces being restriped in the field and additional parking provided in the proposed parking garage, 1,189 spaces will be provided on the Sears Lot. Of the 1,189 spaces, 626 spaces are within the proposed garage and 563 are existing/restriped surface parking. The residential uses require 491 spaces without utilization of the granted parking variance. The residential use parking requirement is calculated as follows:

322 Residential Apartments – 491 spaces
32 Studio at 1.25 sp per unit – 40
161 1BR at 1.5 sp per unit – 241.5
97 2BR at 1.5 sp per unit – 145.5
32 3BR at 2 sps per unit – 64

With the 17.8% parking reduction allowed for the Sears Lot, the commercial uses require 697 parking spaces. With the 491 spaces required for the residential uses, a total of 1,188 parking spaces are required leaving a 1- parking space surplus on the Sears Lot and still complying with the Parking Regulations contained in Section 409 of the BCZR.

With regards to the HVTC Lots, a Brightview Senior Living facility with garage parking is now proposed. The existing commercial, proposed senior living facility and required parking are calculated as follows:

Existing retail/outdoor seating (not including the Sears Lot Buildings): 666,133 square feet = 3,331 spaces
25,000 square feet within BM Zone = 125 spaces
641,133 square feet within BM-CT Zone = 3,206 spaces

Existing 2,262-seat movie theater within BM-CT Zone = 566 spaces

Proposed Senior Living Facility within BM-CT Zone
101 Independent Living Units (1 sp per Apt) = 101 spaces
44 Assisted Living Units (1sp per 3 Beds) = 15 spaces
35 Memory Care (Nursing) Beds (1 sp per 3 Beds) = 12 spaces
Total Elderly Required Parking = 128 spaces

The total required amount of required parking without the granted variance and 25% transit reduction is 4,025 spaces. Utilizing just the 17.8% variance for 25,000 square feet of commercial in the BM Zone generates a 103-space requirement. Utilizing both reductions for commercial buildings in the BM-CT (641,133 square feet and 2,262-seat movie theater) generates a 2,326-space parking requirement. Lastly, utilizing just the 25% transit reduction for the senior living facility generates a 96-space requirement generating a 2,525-space requirement for the HVTC Lots. The total provided spaces, which consist of 2,868 surface spaces and 202 garage spaces, on the HVTC Lots, equal 3,070 spaces leaving a surplus of 545 parking spaces still complying with the Parking Regulations.

The proposed new buildings in the entire Hunt Valley Town Center, including the Sears Lot and HVTC Lots, along with the modifications to the existing parking layout onsite, as shown on the enclosed red-lined hearing plan, are well within the Spirit and Intent of Zoning Case No. 2015-0232-SPH. Please countersign this letter in the space allotted below. We have enclosed the red-lined plan, Zoning Order, referenced Spirit and Intent Letter, and a check in the amount of \$200 for the letter-processing fee.

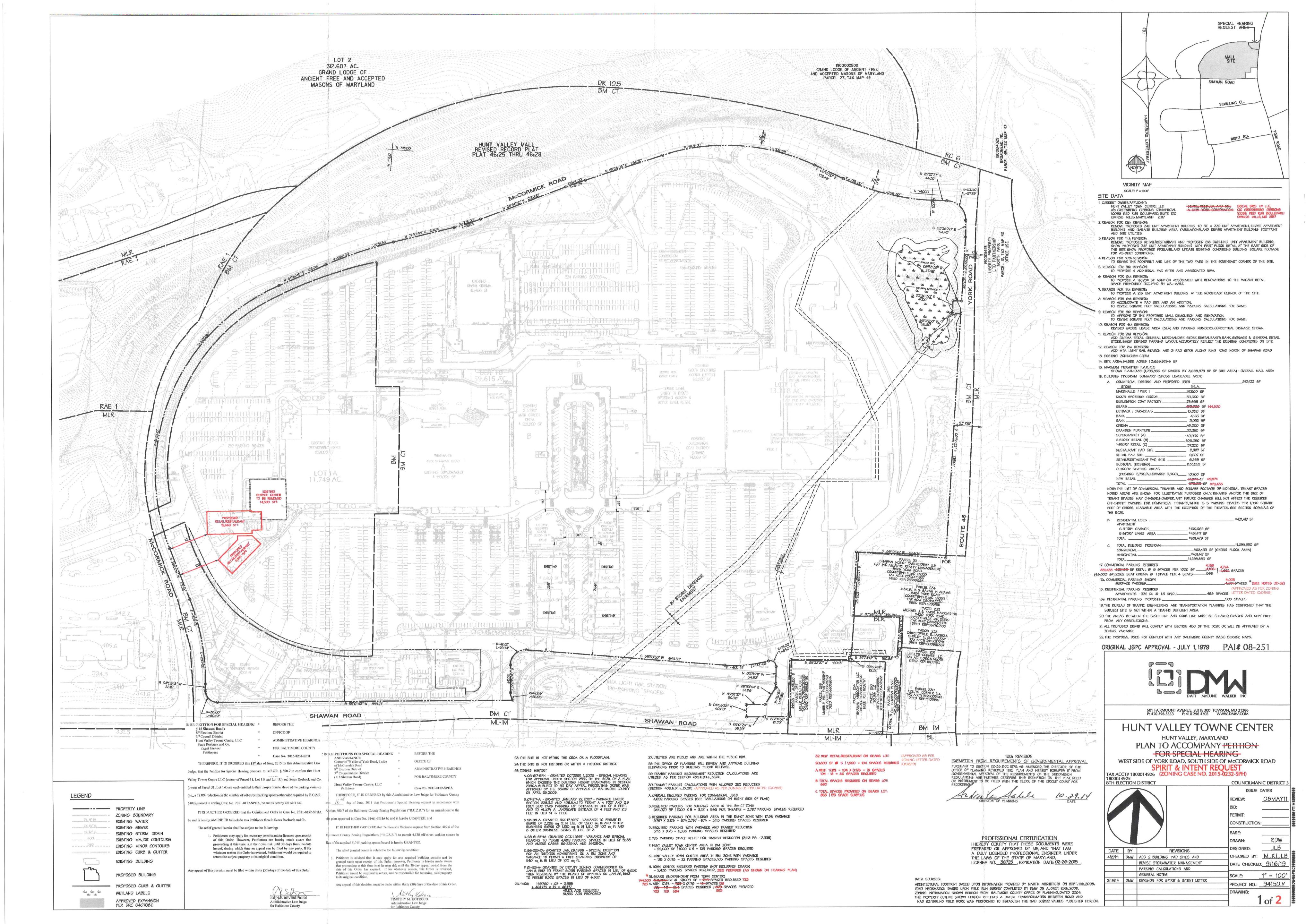

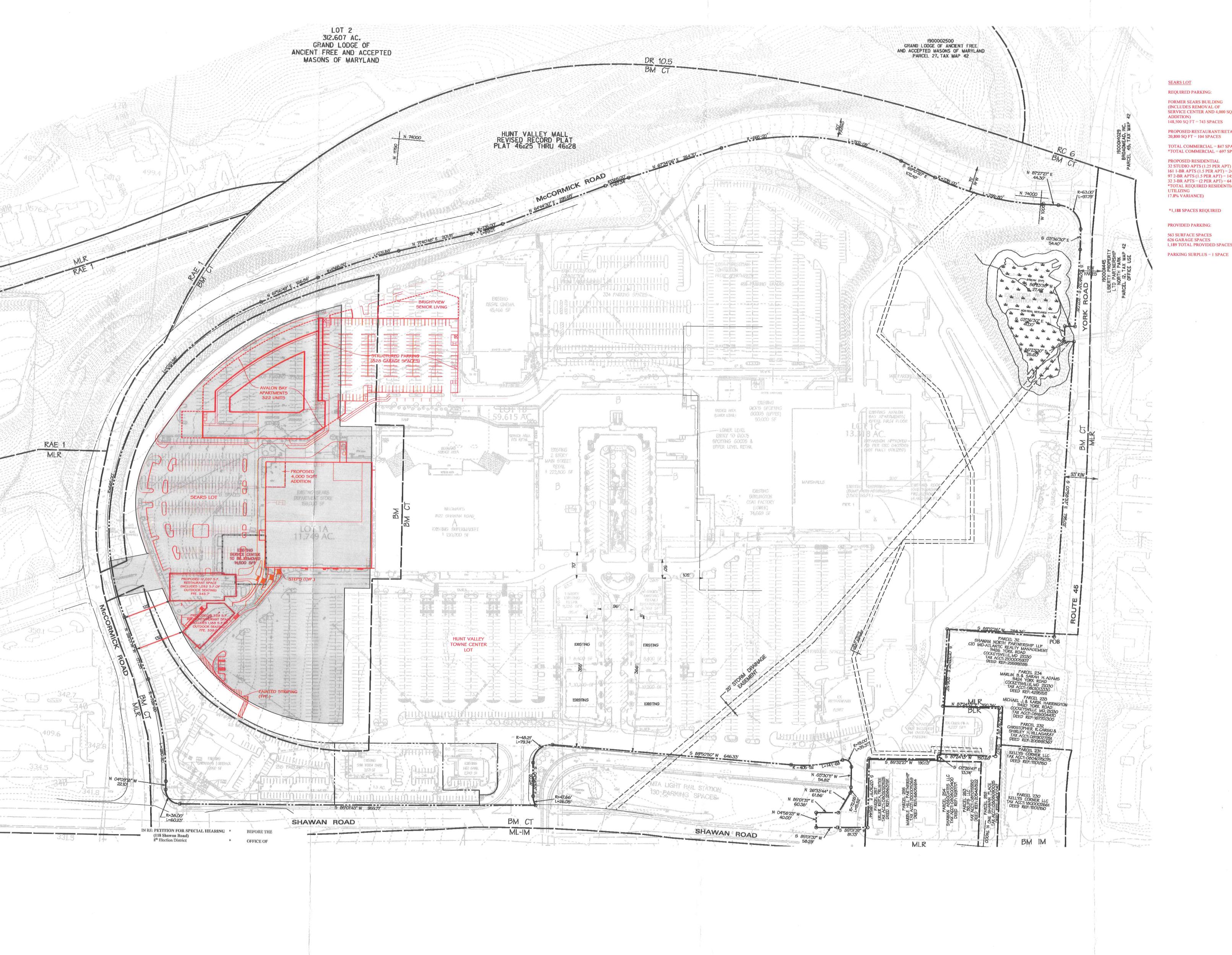

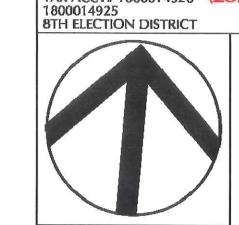

Daft-McCune-Walker, Inc. (DMW) represents the owners of the Hunt Valley Towne Centre (HVTC) and we have been responsible for the continuous engineering and planning of their projects.

The owners are proposing 2 new buildings on the Sear's Lot (Lot 1A), replacing the Sear's Automotive Service Center, which is approximately14,500 square feet (to be removed). The new buildings, which will be used for either retail or restaurant use, total approximately 20,800 square feet, which results in a net increase of approximately 6,300 square feet. Since all commercial uses part of the HVTC, with exception of the movie theater, are calculated at 5 parking spaces per 1,000 square feet of gross leasable area, an additional 32 parking spaces are required. The 2 new buildings will displace 26 parking spaces, yielding 58 additional required parking spaces with the change. Some of the 58 spaces will be made up with new parking.

On June 19, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge granted a Special Hearing (Order enclosed) confirming that Sears Roebuck and Co. and Hunt Valley Towne Centre LLC are each entitled to their proportionate share of the parking variance granted in Zoning Case No. 2011-0152-SPHA. Prior to the Hearing, your office approved a letter (Letter enclosed) confirming that the Sears building, with its proportionate share of the parking variance, requires 654 parking spaces and currently provides 879 parking spaces, generating a surplus of 225 parking spaces. The razing of the Sears Service Center and the addition of the 2 new buildings will now generate a 680-parking space requirement and the Sears Lot will provide at least 853 spaces, exceeding the parking requirements by at least 173 spaces.

We feel that the proposed new buildings along with the parking modification, as shown on the enclosed red-line hearing plan, is well within the Spirit and Intent of Zoning Case No. 2015-0232-SPH and we hope you consider the same by countersigning this letter in the space allotted below. We have enclosed the red-lined hearing plan, Zoning Order, referenced Spirit and Intent Letter and a check in the amount of \$200 for the letter-processing fee.

Daft-McCune-Walker, Inc. ("DMW") represents Hunt Valley Towne Centre, LLC, legal owner of certain lots (Lot Nos. 1B and 1C, referred to hereafter as the "H.V.T.C. Lots") that are part of the above-referenced property. DMW is responsible for the development-processing, engineering, planning, and zoning approvals of a proposed 342 unit, multi-family apartment building and accompanying structured parking to be constructed on the eastern portion of the Hunt Valley Towne Centre ("H.V.T.C.").

As part of the zoning process for this residential apartment building, we are in receipt of a zoning confirmation letter, countersigned by your department and dated February 20, 2014, that verifies our red-lined site plan submitted with the February 2014 letter (showing 4,031 provided parking spaces in lieu of 4,706 required parking spaces) is within the "spirit and intent" of a prior parking variance case for H.V.T.C. granted in Zoning Case No. 2011-0152-SPHA (or the "2011 Zoning Case"). The 2011 Zoning Case, which related to the H.V.T.C. Lots and the Sears lot (as defined below), allowed for 4,120 parking spaces in lieu of the required 5,015 parking spaces, which is an 895 parking space deficiency. The red-lined site plan showing the 342 unit residential building, approved by your confirmation letter, allowed for a 675-parking space deficiency, which is well within the zoning case approval.

As you are aware, a Sears store is located on the western portion of the property on a separate lot, known as Lot No. IA which is owned in fee by Sears, Roebuck and Co. (the "Sears Lot"). Recently, Sears requested that the owners of the H.V.T.C. Lots obtain written confirmation from the Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections that no off-street parking spaces on the Sears Lot are being utilized in determining that the H.V.T.C. Lots meet the minimum parking requirements under all laws and regulations of Baltimore County. In other words, for parking calculation purposes, the Sears operations would stand on their own. By itself, Sears is required to have 795 parking spaces, according

to the Parking Regulations contained in Section 409 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR" or "Zoning Regulations"), and, in the field, the Sears Lot is striped with a total 879 spaces, which results in a surplus of 84 parking spaces on the lot.

The Sears Lot is entitled to its proportionate share of a parking variance granted in the 2011 Zoning Case and attributing that variance to the Sears Lot reduces the required parking for the Sears Lot. With this parking variance, the required number of parking spaces for the Sears lot is reduced from 795 to 654 off-street parking. When considering the parking for the Sears Lot independent from the remainder of H.V.T.C., the result is a surplus of 225 parking spaces on the Sears Lot.

Pursuant to Section 409.6.B.I.b of the Zoning Regulations, "[t]he required number of offstreet parking spaces for any plan of development with a minimum of 750,000 square feet of gross leasable area in the C.T. District may be reduced by 25% if served by a transit stop on a Mass Transit Administration route with scheduled peak-period headway of 20 minutes or better." There is an approved development plan for H.V.T.C, and the H.V.T.C Lots meet the criteria laid out in Section 409.6.1.b of the Zoning Regulations. The H.V.T.C. Lots are: (1) zoned B.M. - C.T.; (2) improved with more than 750,000 square feet of gross leasable area; and (3) served by an MTA route that meets the threshold for schedule service of 20 minutes or better during peak-period headway. A red-lined site plan, dated April 30, 2014 and prepared by DMW, confirms that the H.V.T.C. Lots satisfy these requirements. See Note No. 11 (for current zoning classification). Without the 25% reduction, the H.V.T.C Lots would require 3,912 off-parking spaces and provide 3,152 parking spaces. With the 25% reduction, the required number of parking spaces is reduced to 2,966 parking spaces, creating a surplus of 186 parking spaces on the H.V.T.C. Lots. In addition, the H.V.T.C. Lots benefit from their proportionate share of a parking variance granted in the 2011 Zoning Case, which further reduces the parking spaces required for the H.V.T.C. Lots to a total of 2,438 parking spaces.

Please countersign this letter in order to confirm your department's confirmation regarding the following:

- The DMW red-lined site plan, enclosed with this letter and dated April 30, 2014, is within the spirit and intent of the 2011 Zoning Case and, therefore, does not require another parking variance and public hearing before the Administrative Law Judge.
- 2. The Sears Lot is entitled to its proportionate share of the 2011 Zoning Case, which results in a reduction of the number of required off-street parking spaces for the Sears Lot from 795 parking spaces to 654 parking spaces.

- 3. No off-street parking spaces on the Sears Lot are being utilized in determining that the H.V.T.C. Lots meet the minimum parking requirements under all laws and regulations of Baltimore County.
- The H.V.T.C Lots zoned BM-CT may utilize the 25% transit reduction contained in Section 409.6.B.I.b of the Zoning Regulations and their proportionate share of the 2001 Zoning Case, without the need for another parking variance and public hearing before the Administrative Law Judge.

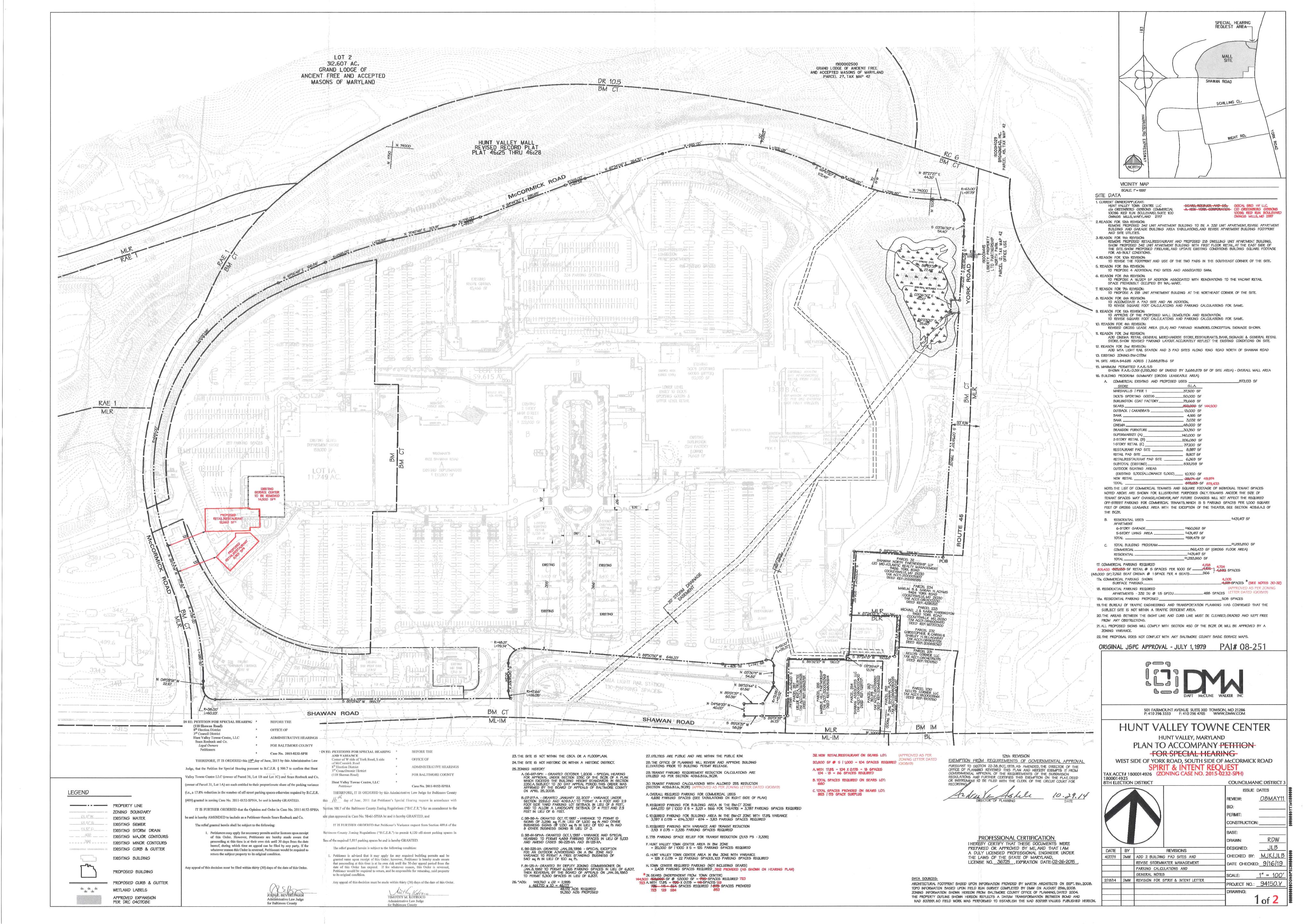

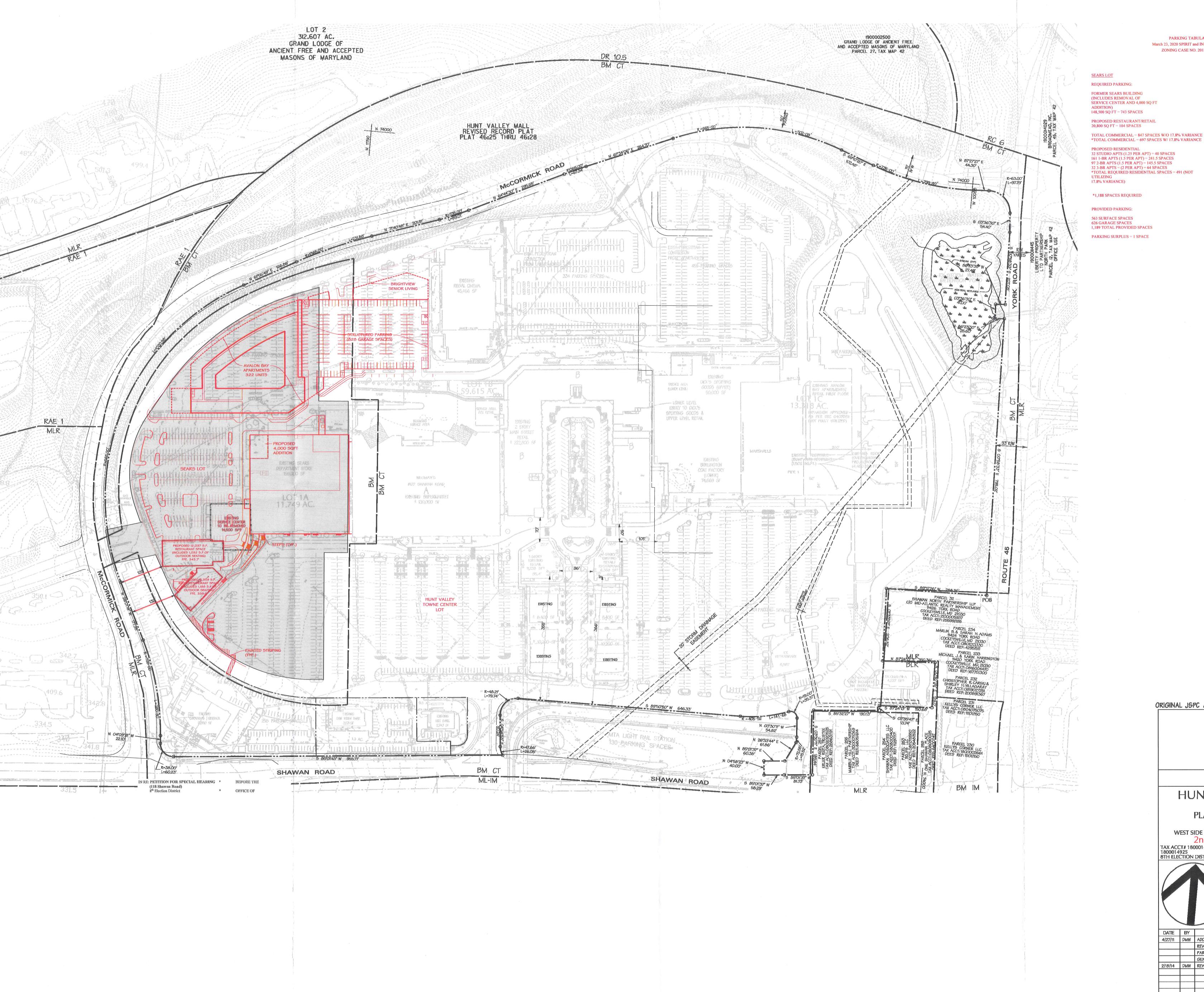

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of a Petition for Special Hearing filed on behalf of Hunt Valley Towne Centre, LLC ("Hunt Valley") and Sears Roebuck and Co. ("Sears"), legal owners. The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to confirm that Hunt Valley (owner of Parcel 31, Lot 1B and Lot 1C) and Sears (Owner of Parcel 31, Lot 1A) are each entitled to their proportionate share of a parking variance granted in zoning Case No. 2011-0152-SPHA.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the request was Donna Sills and Mitch Kellman, Director of Zoning Services at Daft McCune Walker Inc. David Karceski, Esq. represented Hunt Valley and Jen Busse, Esq. represented Sears. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance.

The subject property is 84.685 acres and zoned BM-CT and BM. The Hunt Valley Towne Center is located at the site. The site is comprised of three lots: Lot 1A (11.749 acres), Lot 1B (59.615 acres) and Lot 1C (13.318 acres). Lot 1A is owned by Sears, and is improved with a

159,000 sq. ft. Sears department store. Lots 1B and 1C are owned by Hunt Valley, and contain a Wegman's grocery store, restaurants, retail shops and other commercial uses.

In 2011, former Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Kotroco granted a variance permitting 4,120 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the 5,015 spaces required. Exhibit 4 (Order and site plan). The sole Petitioner in that case was Hunt Valley, even though the site plan shows the same 84.685 acres of land (including Lot 1A owned by Sears) at issue in this matter. As I explained at the hearing, I believe Sears should have been a Petitioner in the 2011 zoning case, even though it seems clear that the variance granted by the ALJ encompassed their property. To "tie up loose ends" (so to speak) the Petition in this case was amended at the hearing to include a special hearing request to amend the Order in Case No. 2011-0152-SPHA to include Sears as a Petitioner therein.

The sole purpose of this special hearing petition is to formally allocate between Sears and Hunt Valley a "proportionate share of the parking variance" granted in the 2011 case. Mr. Kellman, who was accepted as an expert in zoning matters, testified that the variance granted in 2011 equated to a 17.8% reduction in the required number of parking spaces. The number of offstreet parking spaces required for this site (as determined by the Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections) has changed since the 2011 case. Mr. Kellman testified that a regulation was recently enacted (B.C.Z.R. §409.6.B.1.b) permitting a 25% reduction in parking requirements for certain developments with mass transit stops. As such, the order below will not refer to any particular number of spaces required, but will simply provide that Hunt Valley and Sears are both beneficiaries of the relief granted in the 2011 zoning case and are entitled to a proportionate share of the variance granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 19th day of June, 2015 by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to B.C.Z.R. § 500.7 to confirm that Hunt

Valley Towne Centre LLC (owner of Parcel 31, Lot 1B and Lot 1C) and Sears Roebuck and Co. (owner of Parcel 31, Lot 1A) are each entitled to their proportionate share of the parking variance (i.e., a 17.8% reduction in the number of off-street parking spaces otherwise required by B.C.Z.R. §409) granted in zoning Case No. 2011-0152-SPHA, be and is hereby GRANTED.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed by Hunt Valley Towne Centre, LLC, the legal property owner, by HV Holdings, LLC, Sole Member, and by ELG Hunt Valley LLC. Petitioner is requesting Special Hearing relief in accordance with Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") for an amendment to the site plan approved in Case No. 98-61-SPHA. Petitioner is also requesting Variance relief from Section 409.6 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit 4,120 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 5,015 parking spaces. The subject property and requested relief are more fully described on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Daft-McCune-Walker, Inc. ("DMW") represents Hunt Valley Towne Centre, LLC, legal owner of certain lots (Lot Nos. 1B and 1C, referred to hereafter as the "H.V.T.C. Lots") that are part of the above-referenced property. DMW is responsible for the development-processing, engineering, planning, and zoning approvals of a proposed 342 unit, multi-family apartment building and accompanying structured parking to be constructed on the eastern portion of the Hunt Valley Towne Centre ("H.V.T.C.").

As part of the zoning process for this residential apartment building, we are in receipt of a zoning confirmation letter, countersigned by your department and dated February 20, 2014, that verifies our red-lined site plan submitted with the February 2014 letter (showing 4,031 provided parking spaces in lieu of 4,706 required parking spaces) is within the "spirit and intent" of a prior parking variance case for H.V.T.C. granted in Zoning Case No. 2011-0152-SPHA (or the "2011 Zoning Case"). The 2011 Zoning Case, which related to the H.V.T.C. Lots and the Sears lot (as defined below), allowed for 4,120 parking spaces in lieu of the required 5,015 parking spaces, which is an 895 parking space deficiency. The red-lined site plan showing the 342 unit residential building, approved by your confirmation letter, allowed for a 675-parking space deficiency, which is well within the zoning case approval.

As you are aware, a Sears store is located on the western portion of the property on a separate lot, known as Lot No. IA which is owned in fee by Sears, Roebuck and Co. (the "Sears Lot"). Recently, Sears requested that the owners of the H.V.T.C. Lots obtain written confirmation from the Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections that no off-street parking spaces on the Sears Lot are being utilized in determining that the H.V.T.C. Lots meet the minimum parking requirements under all laws and regulations of Baltimore County. In other words, for parking calculation purposes, the Sears operations would stand on their own. By itself, Sears is required to have 795 parking spaces, according
