ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S COMBINED DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND ZONING OPINION & ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County for a public hearing on a development proposal submitted in accordance with Article 32, Title 4, of the Baltimore County Code ("B.C.C."). Patricia A. Malone, Esquire, with Venable, LLP, on behalf of Beazer Homes, Corp., Owner of the subject property, and Community Development Capital Group, LLC, Developer, (hereinafter "the Developer"), submitted for approval a six-sheet redlined Development Plan ("Plan") prepared by Century Engineering, known as "Delight Quarry, 1st Material Amendment."

The Developer proposes to materially amend the previously approved mixed-use Development Plan to remove the proposed retail use and replace with a 5th condominium building having 27 two-bedroom units with ancillary parking and a clubhouse. The resultant use configuration is as follows:

The Developer also has filed a Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R) to determine whether or not the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) should approve a material amendment to prior approved plans. This is in the nature of a housekeeping measure, and the substantive issues involve the development proposal.

Details of the proposed development are more fully depicted on the redlined six-sheet Development Plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Developer's Exhibit 1A-1F. The property was posted with the Notice of Hearing Officer's Hearing and Zoning Notice, both on August 26, 2015 in compliance with the regulations. The undersigned conducted the hearing on September 25, 2015, at 10:00 AM, Room 205 of the Jefferson Building, 105 West Chesapeake Avenue, Towson, Maryland.

In attendance at the Hearing Officer's Hearing (HOH) in support of the Plan on behalf of the Developer was James F. Roberson, President of Koren Development Co., Inc. Also in attendance was Michael J. Pieranunzi, a landscape architect and R. Troy Slevin, a civil engineer, both with Century Engineering, the consulting firm that prepared the site plan. Patricia A. Malone, Esquire, with Venable, LLP, represented the Developer.

Numerous representatives of the various Baltimore County agencies who reviewed the Plan also attended the hearing, including the following individuals from the Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections (PAI): Jan M. Cook, Project Manager, Dennis A. Kennedy and Jean

M. Tansey (Development Plans Review [DPR]), Brad Knatz, Real Estate Compliance, and Jason ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

Seidelman (Office of Zoning Review). Also appearing on behalf of the County were Jeff Livingston from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS), and Matt Diana from the Department of Planning (DOP). Several members of the community attended the hearing to obtain additional information regarding the project.

During the preliminary portion of the hearing, each of the Baltimore County agency representatives identified above indicated that the redlined Development Plan (marked as Developer's Exhibit 1A-1F) addressed any comments submitted by their agency, and they each recommended approval of the Plan. Mr. Diana indicated this 1st Material Amendment proposes only age-restricted condo units, with no increase in the number of single family detached and attached dwellings. Therefore, a school impact analysis was not required. Ms. Tansey testified the Developer has satisfied the Local Open Space regulations and that the open space and recreational amenities shown on the plan exceed County requirements. Ms. Tansey also indicated her agency has approved a schematic Landscape Plan for the project. Following the hearing, Lloyd Moxley of the DOP forwarded to this office a copy of Addendum No. 5 to the Pattern book (titled "Addendum 5 – 5th Active Adult Condominium & Clubhouse") which was approved by that agency.

In the "formal" portion of the case, the Developer presented one witness, Michael J. Pieranunzi, a landscape architect accepted as an expert. Mr. Pieranunzi described the evolution of this project, and reviewed the proposed amendments shown on the Development Plan. He opined the Developer satisfied all Baltimore County rules and regulations.

ZONING REQUESTS AND ISSUES

As noted earlier, the Developer has filed a Petition for Special Hearing requesting the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) to approve a material amendment to prior approved plans. This

is not a substantive request, and the Developer in other respects satisfies the setbacks and other height and area regulations found in the B.C.Z.R.

The Baltimore County Code provides that the "Hearing Officer shall grant approval of a development plan that complies with these development regulations and applicable policies, rules and regulations." B.C.C. § 32-4-229. After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented by the Developer, the exhibits offered at the hearing, and confirmation from the various County agencies that the Plan satisfies those agencies' requirements, I find that the Developer has satisfied its burden of proof and, therefore, is entitled to approval of the Development Plan.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by this Administrative Law Judge/Hearing Officer for Baltimore County, this <u>9th</u> day of October, 2015, that the "DELIGHT QUARRY – 1st Material Amendment" redlined Development Plan, marked and accepted into evidence as Developer's Exhibit 1A-1F, be and is hereby APPROVED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Special Hearing pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R), to approve a material amendment to prior approved plans, be and is hereby **GRANTED**, subject to the condition noted below.

• Developer must provide benches along the pedestrian path located in the rear of Building 4.

Any appeal of this Order shall be taken in accordance with Baltimore County Code, § 32-4-281.
