OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Stanley & Denise Feiden and Paul & Rosemary Krause, legal owners, and JC Bar Development, LLC, contract purchaser ("Petitioners"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to §500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") as follows: (1) to approve commercial parking in a residential zone; (2) to approve four stacking spaces, not including space next to the transaction window, for a pharmacy drive-up window; and (3) to permit access to a commercial use through a residential zone.

In addition, an amended Petition for Variance seeks the following: (1) to allow off-street parking spaces to be located a minimum of 15 feet from a tract boundary in lieu of the required 75 feet and to remove the required 50 foot landscaped residential transition area along the western portion of the property that is proposed to be undeveloped open space. In lieu, a 15-foot Class "A" landscape buffer will be provided; (2) from B.C.Z.R. §409.8 to permit a setback of 3 ft. in lieu of the required 10 ft. setback requirement from an adjoining commercial property; and (3) to permit a freestanding sign to be erected 0 ft. from a residential zone in lieu of the required 25 ft. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1A & 1B.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests was Jason Mitchell, Dan Wallace, Eric McWilliams, Carl Wilson, Garry Russell and Joseph Ucciferro. David H. Karceski, Esq. and Adam Rosenblatt, Esq. represented the Petitioners. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Department of Planning (DOP) and Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR). The DOP did not oppose the relief, but requested a note be added to the plan concerning a 2012 rezoning of the property. The Petitioners added such a note to the plan, and thus the DOP comment is satisfied. DPR requested a landscape plan for the site, and a condition to that effect is included below.

SPECIAL HEARING

The subject property contains approximately 3.04 acres and is located at the intersection of Joppa and Harford Roads. Petitioners propose to construct a CVS pharmacy, and due to several site constraints variance and special hearing relief is required.

The first special hearing request concerns commercial parking in a residential zone. The plan shows four parking spaces would be located in the DR zone, adjacent to an open space area of the site Petitioners propose to convey to NeighborSpace. Mr. Ucciferro, a professional engineer accepted as an expert, testified Petitioners satisfy all requirements in B.C.Z.R. §409.8, and I concur.

The second special hearing request relates to the number of stacking spaces required for a pharmacy drive thru lane, an issue which is not addressed in the Regulations. Developer's representatives noted the average drive thru transaction time at CVS is approximately 3-4 minutes, which means that an extended queue is unlikely. Other CVS stores in Baltimore County have been approved with only 2 stacking spaces and Representatives property approach to the county have been approved with only 2 stacking spaces and Representatives.

spaces would accommodate even the busiest peak-hour periods at the store. As such, I believe four stacking spaces are sufficient for the proposed CVS.

The final special hearing request seeks approval for accessing a commercial use through a residential zone. Counsel indicated the Zoning Commissioner's Policy Manual (ZCPM) provides that such access is permitted when "it is the sole access to the site." ZCPM, p.1-42.2. As Mr. Ucciferro testified, the Joppa Road access shown on the plan, located in a residential zone, is the only "full access" point for the store. As such the request will be granted.

VARIANCES

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioners have met this test. Mr. Ucciferro testified the property is irregularly shaped and that a significant grade change (approximately 25 feet) exists at the site. As such it is unique. Petitioners would experience practical difficulty if the regulations were strictly interpreted because they would be unable to construct the proposed CVS store. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>18th</u> day of May, 2016, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to §500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) as follows: (1) to approve commercial parking in a residential zone; (2) to approve four stacking spaces, not including space next to the transaction window, for ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

a pharmacy drive-up window; and (3) to permit access to a commercial use through a residential zone, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance: (1) to allow off-street parking spaces to be located a minimum of 15 feet from a tract boundary in lieu of the required 75 feet and to remove the required 50 foot landscaped residential transition area along the western portion of the property that is proposed to be undeveloped open space. In lieu, a 15-foot Class "A" landscape buffer will be provided; (2) from B.C.Z.R. §409.8 to permit a setback of 3 ft. in lieu of the required 10 ft. setback requirement from an adjoining commercial property; and (3) to permit a freestanding sign to be erected 0 ft. from a residential zone in lieu of the required 25 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must submit for approval by Baltimore County landscape and lighting plans for the site.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

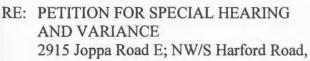

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Department of Planning has reviewed the Petition for Special Hearing to determine whether or not the Administrative Law Judge should approve commercial parking in a residential zone and four stacking spaces not including the space next to the transaction window and the Petition for Variance relief from residential transition area, landscape and sign regulations as follows:

- Variance from Section 1B01.1.B.1.e to maintain a 5 foot uncleared and landscaped residential transition area buffer in lieu of the required 50 feet and to permit a residential transition area setback of 70 feet in lieu of the required 75 feet along the western portion of the property that is proposed to be undeveloped open space.
- Variance from Section 409.8.A.1 and the Baltimore County Landscape Manual to permit a setback of 3 feet in lieu of the required 10 foot setback requirement from an adjoining commercial property.
- Variance from Section 450.5.B.4.b to permit a freestanding sign to be erected 0 feet from a residential zone in lieu of the required 25 feet.

The property was the subject of CZMP Issue 5-019 in 2012 which changed the zoning to its current split zoned designation of BL, BL-AS and DR 5.5 and is further subject to a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the current property owners and the Carney Improvement Association. The MOU outlines specific criteria for landscaping requirements, signage, maintenance of and the possible relocation of the Carney community sign located on the property. The MOU also covers the development and preservation of the passive space area at the western edge of the property.

This Department has reviewed the documentation in support of the petitions including the MOU and recommends that the building and landscaping are adequate and appropriate for this commercial intersection.

The Department has no objection to the granting of the zoning relief conditioned upon the following:

- The aforementioned 2012 CZMP Issue 5-019 shall be noted on any site plans submitted to Baltimore County for review and approval.
- Through the hearing process, the entity charged with the maintenance of the neighborhood park area should be identified and so noted in the Decision and Order of the Baltimore County Administrative Law Judge.

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS:

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- Variance from Section 409.8.A.1 and the Baltimore County Landscape Manual to permit a setback of 3 feet in lieu of the required 10 foot setback requirement from an adjoining commercial property.
- Variance from Section 450.5.B.4.b to permit a freestanding sign to be erected 0 feet from a residential zone in lieu of the required 25 feet.

The property was the subject of CZMP Issue 5-019 in 2012 which changed the zoning to its current split zoned designation of BL, BL-AS and DR 5.5 and is further subject to a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the current property owners and the Carney Improvement Association. 102.6 ACCESS

- A. For Heavier Uses Through Lighter Zones:
 - Access for a heavier commercial or industrial use or a heavier commercial or industrial zone through a lighter or more restrictive commercial or industrial zone is permitted. It does not have to be the only possible access that the property has.
 - 2. Access through O-1 and O-2 for commercial and industrial uses is only permitted if it is demonstrated that it is the only possible access. If it is not the only possible access, a special hearing would be required by the Zoning Commissioner. A hearing may also be required if it is the only access.
 - Access through a residential zone (RC, DR, RAE) for a commercial or industrial use may be permitted if it is the sole access to the site. A public hearing may be required based on a determination that:
 - a. it is the only possible access from a public street;
 - and/or the residential land in issue is too small;
 - c. and/or the land in issue is subject to other restrictions which prevents a residential use.
 - 4. Access through an RO zone, a public hearing would only be necessary pursuant to Section 1.C above if it is determined that the use of the land in issue at the time the subdivision and/or development plan was submitted was residential if commercial, no hearing would be required (See M84-6 and 85-302 SPH).
 - 5. Interior driveways that serve commercial or industrial uses through residential zones which are for circulation only with no access to the property from a public street would not require a public hearing.
- B. If property is wholly or partially zoned ML-IM, and the proposed use is located wholly or partially in the ML-IM zone with access to the site through a zone other than ML-IM, the requirements of Section 253.1.C with regard to access is not applicable.

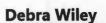

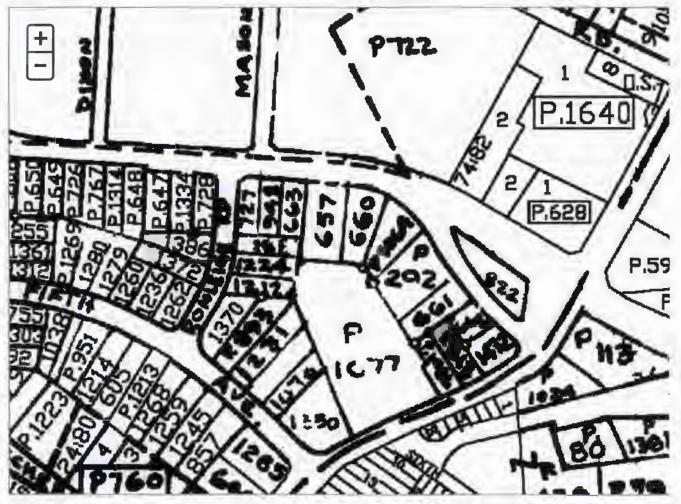

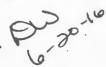

However, based on our review of this entrance location as it relates to the SHA construction project (BA1465167) at the intersection of Joppa Road & MD 147, the current proposed entrance location provides for the highest level of safety and capacity and is therefore the SHA's preferred location for that entrance.
