This case comes to the Board of Appeals upon appeal by Petitioners from the December 3, 2015 decision of Administrative Law Judge John Beverungen to deny front yard and side yard setback variances, as revised, for a garage addition at their residence, a single-family detached dwelling in an area zoned D.R. 2. As shown in the attached photos, the dwelling is substantial and attractive, with a very nice off-street parking pad.

Upon review of the record and BCZR Sec. 307.1, there does not appear any unique characteristic of this property which results in practical difficulty. Indeed, the attached SDAT data indicates the dwelling was built in 1975, and there has been a longstanding residential use.

Our office recently participated in another case involving a request for front yard setback variance for a garage/pool house at 6200 Glen Falls Road on property zoned R.C. 6. The Board of Appeals denied the variance in its February 22, 2016 majority opinion, panel member Andrew Belt concurring in the result. Petition of Richard Folio, Case No. 2015-185-A. In view of similar issues here, it appears incumbent on us to bring this case to the Board's attention.

In Folio, we filed a detailed post-hearing memorandum. We found a predominance of case law denying area variances for additions and/or accessory buildings: Easter v. Mayor & City Council 195 Md. 395 (1950); Carney v. City of Baltimore 201 Md. 130 (1952); Burns v.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) as a Petition for Variance filed for property located at 7209 Verbena Road. Petitioners are requesting variance relief from Sections 205.2 and 205.3 of the 1969 Edition of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.): (1) to permit a front yard setback of 24 ft. from the front lot line in lieu of the required 40 ft. and a front yard setback of 50 ft. from the centerline of Verbena Road in lieu of the required 65 ft.; and (2) to permit a side setback of 3 ft. in lieu of the required 15 ft.

This matter was originally filed as an Administrative Variance, with a closing date of October 19, 2015. On October 14, 2015, neighbors Michael and Yelena Shirkin requested a hearing, which was held on Monday, November 30, 2015 at 10:00 AM in Room 205 of the Jefferson Building, 105 West Chesapeake Avenue, Towson. Adam Rosenblatt, Esq. represented the Petitioners and J. Carroll Holzer, Esq., represented the neighbors. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations.

The subject property is approximately 18,200 square feet and is zoned DR 2. The property is improved with a single family dwelling constructed in 1975. Petitioners purchased the property in July, 2015, and would like to construct a garage addition, as shown on the elevation drawings marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 2. To do so, variance relief is required.

As discussed at the hearing, the Petitioners modified somewhat their original variance request (which was opposed by the Department of Planning (DOP)) to increase the front and side setbacks proposed. The DOP submitted a revised comment wherein that agency opined that the "site plan represents a good faith response on the part of the petitioner to recommendations made by the Sector Planner." I concur, but that is insufficient to justify a variance.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity necessitates variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioners have not satisfied these requirements. Mitchell Kellman, who was accepted as an expert in land use and the zoning regulations, testified the property is trapezoidal in shape, but many of the lots in the vicinity are similarly shaped. While there is a slight grade change across the site, as noted by Mr. Kellman, that condition exists on other properties in the area as well. Finally, to the extent there is any hardship, I believe it is self-imposed. Petitioners purchased the house recently and could have investigated beforehand whether a variance would be required to construct an attached garage. Had they done so, they would have learned that a variance would be required, and they could have (as many purchasers do) made the contract contingent upon the grant of the variance.

I am sympathetic to the Petitioners' plight, and recognize that there are inconsistencies in the County's variance procedure and process. On the one hand, owners of dwellings (in which they reside) are permitted to obtain an "administrative variance" permitting a relaxation of the height, setback or area zoning regulations. B.C.C. § 32-3-303. While the law purports to require

that a petitioner establish (by way of an affidavit) that the property is unique and that she will experience a practical difficulty if the regulations were strictly construed, the reality is that 95% or greater of these requests are granted without much scrutiny. And that is often the case as well

for "unopposed" variance requests for which public hearings are held.

But the reality is the procedure is quite different when, as here, neighbors or the community oppose the request and through counsel or otherwise insist upon a rigorous application of the variance standard. In those circumstances, the petitioner faces an uphill battle. In fact, I was unable to locate a Maryland appellate court opinion from the last twenty years which upheld the grant of a variance. Under Maryland law, variances should be granted "sparingly" since it is "an authorization for [that] ... which is prohibited by a zoning ordinance." Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md.

App. 691, 699 (1995).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>3rd</u> day of December, 2015 by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance from B.C.Z.R. (1969 Ed.) Sections 205.2 and 205.3: (1) to permit a front yard setback of 24 ft. from the front lot line in lieu of the required 40 ft. and a front yard setback of 50 ft. from the centerline of Verbena Road in lieu of the required 65 ft.; and (2) to permit a side setback of 3 ft. in lieu of the required 15 ft., be and is hereby DENIED.

Because a primary function of the variance process is to assure a property owner has some basic or fundamental use of the property, such as the dwelling here, it would be a rare case where the evidence could justify a variance for an addition or accessory use. Judge Beverungen accurately identified that where there is neighborhood opposition to a variance, "... the petitioner faces an uphill battle." Judge Beverungen continued, on page 3,

"In fact, I was unable to locate a Maryland appellate court opinion from the last twenty years which upheld the grant of a variance."

We agree with Judge Beverungen.

The Court of Appeals did affirm the grant of a side yard setback variance in McLean v. Soley 270 Md. 208 (1973). But Judge Cathell saw this case as an outlier in Cromwell v. Ward. There are also some variance cases under the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area law, but the standards there are different.

Thank you for your consideration. We are sending a copy of this letter directly to Petitioners, Floyd and Renay Rothstein, because they filed the appeal, without counsel of record at the ALJ level, Adam Rosenblatt, Esquire. We are sending a courtesy copy to Mr. Rosenblatt. While he has not entered his appearance at the CBA level, he has not filed a withdrawal of appearance either. We are unsure whether he is still in the case.
