



The Petitioners herein request a special hearing to approve a 1. 7. 7. 1 44 Class "A" child care center.

Testimony by the Petitioners indicated that the owners purchased and moved into a large house which they considered ideal for a Class "A" child care center. They propose the establishment of a center for no more than 12 children, including their own children, under six years of age. There would be no more than four employees; hours would not extend beyond 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday. An extensive parking pad on Forest Hill Avenue would enable three or four vehicles to park for drop off/ pick up of children and to turn around. No sign is planned. The owner/ operator received her education in the field from the Community College of Baltimore.

Several neighbors and the President of Lochearn Improvement Association spoke in protest. There is a tremendous amount of traffic on Liberty Road. Forest Hill Avenue has no sidewalks and is very narrow. There is not ample space to park and turn around. Deep concern was expressed for the fragile balance in the Liberty Road area. In addition, fear was expressed that approval of a Class "A" child care center at this location would set a precedent for the granting of numerous special exceptions, hearings and variances, and would lead to rezoning in this area for uses other than

5) Upon reasonable requests/complaints, zoning enforcement inspectors may make unannounced internal inspections to verify the number of children for whom care is being provided.

6) All drop off/pick up of children shall be from Forest Hill Avenue.
