This is in response to your letter to Arnold Jablon, Director of Permits, Approvals and Inspections, who has authorized this reply. Based on the information contained in your letter, the available zoning records and my conversation with Mr. Carl Richards, Zoning Supervisor, the following has been determined.

- 1. The subject property is currently zoned RC-5 (Resource Conservation Rural Residential) per Baltimore County Zoning Map no 098C3.
- 2. The red lined plan represents moving the proposed dwelling away from the western property line which reduces the approved 33 ft., setback to 29 ft. Regretfully, the proposed modification is not within the spirit and intent of hearing case 2017-0132-A. Should you not agree with this decision, you may request a determination by Special Hearing before the Administrative Law Judge to amend the previously approved case 2017-0132-A or apply for another variance.

Dear Mr. Jablon,

This letter is a request for your approval and concurrence that the enclosed "red-lined" plan meets the spirit and intent of the approved site plan presented and approved in the above referenced zoning case.

Per the zoning order, Judge Beverungen granted the following: (1) to permit a replacement dwelling with a 40 ft. setback to the centerline of a road in lieu of the required 75 ft. and to permit side yard setbacks of 4 ft. and 33 ft. in lieu of the required 50 ft. for each side; (2) to permit a setback of 9 ft. for an open projection (deck) in lieu of the required 37.5 ft. and (3) to permit a building coverage of 31.35% in lieu of the maximum 15%.

At the time of the hearing, we presented written documents from adjoining neighbors indicating they were not opposed to the project. As that is still the case with the property located at #2722 Holly Beach Road, the neighbors at #2716 are voicing concern. Prior to the public hearing we met with Mr. and Mrs. Sobus in an attempt to resolve any issues with the proposed replacement dwelling. They felt as though their concerns with the zoning hearing for #2710 Holly Beach Road (abutting their western property line) fell on deaf ears. Therefore, we were doing our best to listen and address the concerns in order to create an amicable relationship.

The "red-lined" plan represents moving the proposed dwelling away from the western property line which reduces the approved 33 ft. setback to 29 ft. With this revision it decreases the relief sought and granted; namely, the 40 ft. to the centerline is now 44 ft., the 4 ft. setback is now 5 ft. and the 9 ft. open projection setback is 15 ft.

We hope that you agree with our interpretation that the proposed modification meets the spirit and intent of Zoning Case No. 2017-0132-A and provide a letter of written confirmation of your agreement.

We have enclosed, with this letter, a "red-lined" variance plan, an approved copy of Mr. Beverungen's order and a check for the \$20 processing fee for the spirit and intent letter.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by John & A. Renee Whelehan, owners of the subject property ("Petitioners"). The Petitioners are requesting variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R) as follows: (1) to permit a replacement dwelling with a 40 ft. setback to the centerline of a road in lieu of the required 75 ft, and to permit side yard setbacks of 4 ft. and 33 ft. in lieu of the required 50 ft. for each side; (2) to permit a setback of 9 ft. for an open projection (deck) in lieu of the required 37.5 ft.; and (3) to permit a building coverage of 31.25% in lieu of the required 15%. A site plan was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Owners John & Renee Whelehan and Bernadette Moskunas with Site Rite Surveying, Inc., appeared in support of the petition. There were no Protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Department of Planning (DOP) and the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS). Neither agency opposed the requests and the concerns identified in their comments will be included as conditions in the Order below. The Bureau of Development Plans Review noted a tidal floodplain exists on the property, although the proposed improvements are not within the floodplain area.

ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

CASE NO. 2017-0132-A

The property is approximately 0.57 acres and is zoned RC 5. The property is improved with a single-family dwelling constructed in 1924. Petitioners propose to raze that structure and in its place (and in roughly the same footprint) construct a new single-family dwelling. To do so variances are required.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioners have met this test. The property is irregularly shaped and the lot was created by the Plat of Broring Point (Ex. 2), which was recorded before adoption of the B.C.Z.R. As such, it is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to construct a modern dwelling on the lot. Finally, I find that the variances can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of community and/or Baltimore County opposition. In addition, both of the adjoining neighbors indicated they were not opposed to the project. Ex. 5.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 20th day of January, 2017, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance: (1) to permit a replacement dwelling with a 40 ft. setback to the centerline of a road in lieu of the required 75 ft. and to permit side yard setbacks of 4 ft. and 33 ft. in lieu of the required 50 ft. for each side; (2) to permit a setback of 9 ft. for an open projection (deck) in lieu of the required 37.5 ft.; and (3) to permit a building coverage of 31.25% in lieu of the maximum 15%, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must comply with the Critical Area regulations.
- 3. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must satisfy the performance standards for the RC 5 zone, as determined in the sole discretion of the DOP.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

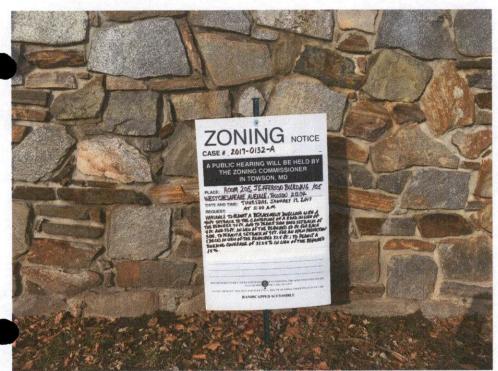

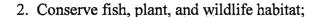

EPS has reviewed the subject zoning petition for compliance with the goals of the Statemandated Critical Area Law listed in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, Section 500.14. Based upon this review, we offer the following comments:

1. Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands;

The subject property is located within a Limited Development Area (LDA) and a Modified Buffer Area (MBA) and is subject to Critical Area requirements. The applicant is proposing to construct a replacement dwelling with reduced roadside and side yard setbacks, an open deck with a 9-ft. setback, and building coverage, as defined by Zoning, of 31.25% in lieu of the required 15%. The proposed development must meet LDA and MBA requirements for lot coverage. Based on a property area above mean high water of 21,000 square feet, the maximum Critical Area defined lot coverage allowance for this property is 31.25% with mitigation for any new amount over 25%. If the applicant can meet these requirements, and meet all mitigation requirements for lot coverage and buffer impacts, the relief requested can result in minimal adverse impacts to water quality. Critical Area Lot coverage is defined in State of Maryland Natural Resources Article §8-1802(a)(17).



This is a waterfront property located near the mouth of Middle River with the required Critical Area buffer covering the majority of the property. The proposed setback relief would allow the applicant to meet the MBA requirements for location of the dwelling and for minimization of buffer impacts. 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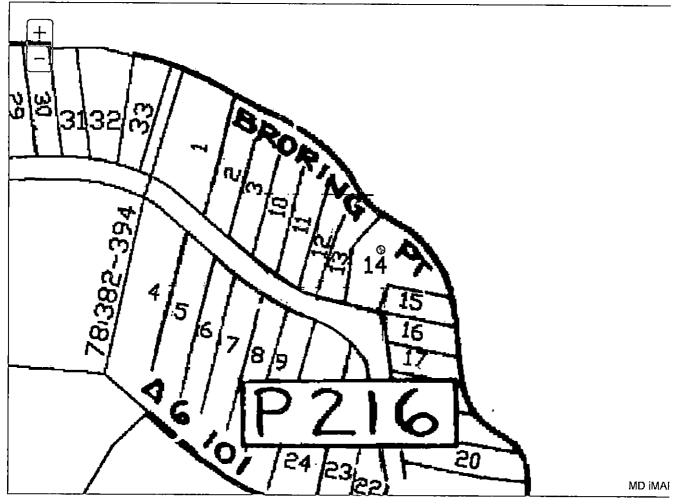
