OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) as Petitions for Special Exception and Variance filed for property located at 8776 Philadelphia Road. Petitions were filed by David Preller, Jr., Esq. on behalf of Ferraro & Spanellis, LLC, legal owner of the subject property. The Special Exception petition per Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) §§ 230.3, 259.2.B and 419.1 seeks to use the property for a full service car wash. The Petition for Variance seeks the following: (1) to permit three (3) drying spaces which do not adjoin and have direct access to an aisle; and (2) to permit 71 parking spaces in lieu of the required 77 spaces for a combined restaurant/tavern and full service car wash. A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the hearing in support of the petitions was Christos Spanellis and David Billingsley. No protestants or interested citizens attended the hearing. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. There were no substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments received from any of the County agencies.

The subject property is approximately 1.58 acres and is zoned BL-AS and BL. The site is improved with a restaurant/tavern (known as Dellis' Restaurant) and--until recently--several other commercial buildings. These buildings have been razed and Petitioner proposes to construct a car

wash which would be operated in conjunction with the restaurant/tavern. In fact, Petitioner sought and was granted exactly the same relief in 2009. See Case No. 2009-0260-XA. Unfortunately, due to the economic downturn the project was stalled and the special exception lapsed under B.C.Z.R. §502.3, which necessitated the new case filing.

SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. Schultz v. Pritts, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The Schultz standard was revisited in People's Counsel v. Loyola College, 406 Md. 54 (2008), where the court emphasized that a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use. Here, Mr. Billingsley opined Petitioner satisfied all requirements set forth in B.C.Z.R. §502.1, and I concur. The site is large enough to accommodate both businesses, and the surrounding uses are predominately commercial. As such, I do not believe the car wash would have a detrimental impact upon the neighborhood and the petition will be granted.

VARIANCE

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- 1. It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- 2. If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Petitioner has met this test. The property is irregularly shaped and is therefore unique. If the B.C.Z.R. were strictly interpreted Petitioner would suffer a practical difficulty since it would be unable to operate the proposed car wash. Finally, I find that the variances can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of Baltimore County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, this 5th day of January, 2017, that the Petition for Special Exception pursuant to B.C.Z.R. §§ 230.3, 259.2.B and 419.1 to use the property for a full service car wash, be and is hereby GRANTED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance pursuant to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.): (1) to permit three (3) drying spaces which do not adjoin and have direct access to an aisle; and (2) to permit 71 parking spaces in lieu of the required 77 spaces for a combined restaurant/tavern and full service car wash, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

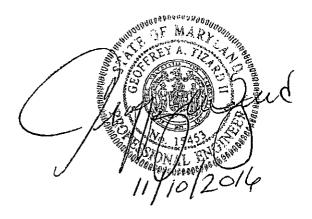

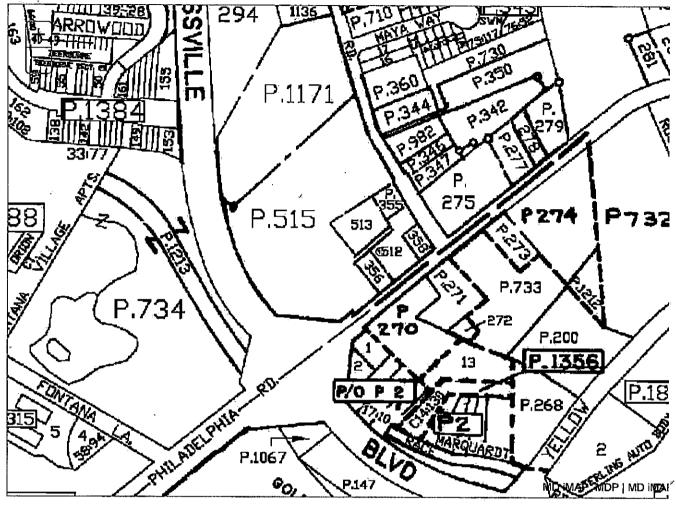

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner for consideration of Petitions for Special Exception and Variance filed by Christos Spanellis on behalf of Ferraro and Spanellis, LLC, the legal property owner. The Special Exception is requested to use the property for a full service car wash. The Variance request is from Sections 409.4.B.1, 409.6.A.2 and 419.3.B.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit 3 drying spaces which do not adjoin and have direct access to an aisle, and to permit 71 parking spaces in lieu of the required 78 parking spaces for a combined restaurant/tavern and full service car wash. The subject property and requested relief are more fully described on the site plan which was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the Special Exception and Variance requests was Christos Spanellis on behalf of Ferraro and Spanellis, LLC (hereinafter "Petitioners"). Also appearing in support of the requested relief were Robert Infussi with Expedite LLC, Petitioners' land use consultant who assisted in the filing of the Petitions, and David Billingsley with Central Drafting & Design, Inc., the firm that prepared the site plan¹. There were no Protestants or other interested persons in attendance at the hearing.

 $^{^{1}\,}$ The site plan was sealed by Geoffrey A. Tizard, II, a registered professional engineer.

The testimony and evidence in the case was proffered by Mr. Billingsley and revealed that the subject property has a somewhat irregular, rectangular shape and contains 2.55 acres zoned B.L. and B.L.-A.S. The property is located on the northwest corner of Ridge Road and Philadelphia Road (MD Rte. 7) in the Rosedale area of Baltimore County. The property is situated approximately one mile northeast of Interstate 695 and north of Pulaski Highway (U.S. 40). As shown on the State Tax Map that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 2, the property actually consists of five parcels identified as Parcel 355, Parcel 356, Parcel 358, Parcel 512, and Parcel 513. These parcels were acquired by Petitioners collectively in 2006, as indicated by the Real Property Data Search printouts that were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibits 3A through 3E, and the accompanying Deed that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibits 4. Although part of one large property, each parcel has its own tax account number and legal description.

The subject property is improved with a number of buildings that are depicted in both the aerial photograph and the topographical map that were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibits 5 and 6, respectively. In addition, these buildings are delineated on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 7. Unlike Petitioners' Exhibit 1, this site plan emphasizes the existing improvements and labels the buildings "A" through "G," and shows them as crosshatched figures superimposed on the site plan. Building "A" is an existing one-story structure that is almost 4,000 square feet and used as a restaurant/tavern. This building is located in the B.L. zoned portion of the property. Buildings "B" and "C" are existing single-family dwellings that are in less than stellar condition and are currently vacant. Building "D" is an empty garage and Buildings "E" and "F" are existing storage buildings. Building "G" is an existing office building that is currently rented by a

construction company whose lease ends in July 2009 and will be vacant thereafter. These buildings are located in the B.L.-A.S. zoned portion of the property.

Petitioner, Mr. Spanellis, has extensive experience in the restaurant business and has owned and run the existing restaurant, known as Dellis' Restaurant, for years. On the other hand, his partner, Mr. Ferraro, has extensive knowledge and experience owning and operating car washes, with a number of facilities in Maryland and New Jersey. At this juncture, Petitioners desire to continue the existing restaurant/tavern use on the property and add a full service car wash as well. As shown on the site plan (Petitioners' Exhibit 1), Petitioners' plans would involve razing the other existing buildings (not including the restaurant building) and constructing a 3,420 square foot full service car wash, to be located on the southwest portion of the property. Petitioners also intend to add more parking spaces and create landscape buffers and internal landscape islands where there is virtually no landscaping on the property presently.

In order to use the land for a car wash, Petitioners are in need of special exception relief. Petitioners are also in need of variance relief because as part of the car wash use, it is planned that 3 of the 6 drying spaces next to the car wash would not adjoin and have direct access to an aisle. Moreover, variance relief is needed because the existing use of the property for a restaurant/tavern and the planned use for a car wash necessitate a change in the parking requirements for the site. Although the site presently has 52 parking spaces and this would be increased significantly to 71 spaces pursuant to Petitioners' planned reconfiguration of the site, these changes would alter the parking requirements and would create a need for 78 total parking spaces.

In support of the requested relief, Mr. Billingsley referenced the site plan and indicated that following construction of the planned improvements, the layout of the site would be greatly

enhanced, both from an aesthetic and also a safety perspective. Presently, there is no specific means of ingress and egress on Ridge Road, in that the paving merely transitions from the road to the subject property and vehicles can enter and exit in a somewhat disorganized, haphazard manner; however, with the planned improvements, a large island will be placed on the property along Ridge Road and curb and gutter will be added, with specific entry/exit areas. In addition, as shown on the site plan, with the removal of surplus buildings, the parking would be reconfigured in some areas and traffic flow within the property would be improved. Petitioners have also allotted enough stacking spaces (26) and drying spaces (6) for the car wash to account for peak hours of use, and all spaces would meet the requirements for parking and drive aisle sizes and widths. As to the car wash itself, Petitioners plan to construct an attractive one-story building to complement the existing restaurant building. As shown on the rendering and elevation drawings that were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 8, the building would have several architectural features, including a pitched style roof and large builtin dormers with an abundance of glass throughout.

Addressing the relevant criteria for special exceptions found at Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R., Mr. Billingsley provided expert testimony, indicating that the use of the subject property for a planned car wash would not be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of the locale, would not create congestion on the roads or streets or create a potential hazard from fire or other danger, would not overcrowd the land (and would in fact result in less crowding with the removal of surplus buildings), would not interfere with provision of public services or with adequate light or air, and would not be inconsistent with impermeable surface provisions or be detrimental to the environmental or natural resources of the site. Finally, Mr. Billingsley indicated the use of the property for a car wash would not be inconsistent with the property's

zoning classification. In fact, Mr. Billingsley recounted that the property was once zoned entirely B.L.; however, during the 2008 Comprehensive Zoning Map Process ("CZMP"), Petitioners requested and were granted a change in the zoning for the area outside of the restaurant building to include the A.S. district overlay specifically in order to develop the site for a car wash.

With regard to the variance requests, Mr. Billingsley directed the undersigned to the site plan and the area designated for the drying spaces. He indicated that as planned, 3 of the 6 spaces would not adjoin and have direct access to an aisle, but would be placed directly behind the 3 spaces that do adjoin and have access to an aisle. He explained that once a vehicle exited the car wash, an attendant would direct customers to pull into the next open drying space -- either one of the 3 in the front or one of the 3 directly behind. Other attendants would dry the vehicles and send customers into the aisle and on their way. This would be a relatively constant movement with vehicles entering and leaving the drying spaces continuously. Hence, Mr. Billingsley indicated the lack of drying spaces adjoining or having direct access to an aisle would be alleviated by the attendant monitoring the flow. As to the variance for the number of parking spaces, Mr. Billingsley reiterated that the property presently has 52 spaces and this would be increased to 71 spaces -- an increase of approximately 36%. And although this increase would still be short 7 spaces, Mr. Billingsley indicated the planned 71 spaces would be more than sufficient, mainly because there would be little overlap between the restaurant/tavern use and the planned car wash use. The restaurant is typically open from 11:00 AM to 2:00 AM, with a good lunch clientele, but with its busiest period occurring during and after dinner. On the other hand, the car wash would open at 8:00 AM and close at 6:00 PM.² As a result, during the time the

The site plan indicates the hours of operation for the car wash would be 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM; however, Mr. Billingsley and Petitioner Mr. Spanellis assured that the car wash would normally close by 6:00 PM.

restaurant would begin its busiest period, the car wash would be closed, while during mornings and afternoons when the car wash would be busiest, the restaurant typically would not have as many customers.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are contained within the case file. The comments received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM) dated May 4, 2009 indicate that the property must comply with the Regulations for the Protection of Water Quality, Streams, Wetlands and Floodplains, and development of the property must comply with the Forest Conservation Regulations. Comments were received from the Office of Planning dated June 9, 2009 which indicate that Petitioner met with the Planning Office during the 2008 Comprehensive Zoning Map Process and on the subject plan addressed all comments and concerns raised then. Additionally, it is understood that this proposal will be subject to County review and comment as a development plan. It does not appear that this plan as drafted undermines the special exception criterion found in Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R., nor the spirit and intent of the designated zoning.

Turning first to the requested special exception for a full service car wash, I am persuaded to grant the requested relief. The use regulations for the B.L. (Business, Local) Zone are found in Section 230 of the B.C.Z.R. Section 230.3 sets forth uses when permitted as special exceptions and include a car wash. Section 259.1 of the B.C.Z.R. refines the use, height, area, and other regulations applicable to a zone by superimposing a district overlay in certain areas of the zone. In this case, a portion of the subject property has been superimposed by the A.S. district overlay, as shown on the site plan. Pursuant to Section 259.2.B, "[t]he A.S. District may be applied within the urban-rural demarcation line (URDL) to certain parcels of land zoned B.L., B.M. or B.R., which are appropriate for uses dominated by the parking and servicing of

automobiles or characterized by frequent parking turnover, such as fuel service stations and car wash operations. (emphasis added). In addition, Section 419.1 of the B.C.Z.R. states that full service car washes are permitted by special exception in the A.S. district. The testimony and evidence indicates that the proposed use for a car wash would not negatively impact the special exception criteria found in Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R., and there is no evidence to suggest that the use would have any adverse effects above and beyond those inherently associated with such a special exception use irrespective of its location within the zone (See, People's Counsel for Baltimore County v. Loyola College in Maryland, 406 Md. 54, 956 A.2d 166 (2008) and Schultz v. Pritts, 291 Md. 1, 432 A.2d 1319 (1981)).

In regard the variance requests, based on the testimony and evidence, I find special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land or structure which is the subject of the variance requests. The property is located in an area dominated by commercial uses, especially to the south and east, but is also bordered by residential zoning to the north. There is also a mix of zoning, including B.L., B.L.-A.S., R.O., M.L.-I.M., and D.R.5.5. In addition, as shown on the site plan, the car wash requires 14 parking spaces, which are provided, and the restaurant/tavern requires 64 spaces, of which 57 are provided for a total of 71 spaces provided. I agree with Petitioners that the existing restaurant use and proposed car wash are uses that would be fairly distinct from each other and would generally not overlap for parking purposes. As a practical matter, under the circumstances this would provide adequate parking for the site. In addition to more spaces than before, the newly proposed parking configuration will be safer and provide better flow, in particular from Ridge Road. The entry to and exit from the property at Philadelphia Road will also be controlled to make ingress and egress safer. These are the

kinds of peculiar circumstances that make the regulations impact this property disproportionately compared to others in the district. Therefore I find the property unique in a zoning sense.

I further find that strict compliance with the Zoning Regulations for Baltimore County would result in practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship. The planned car wash is a use that is specifically authorized per the A.S. district overlay. Petitioners' plans would also result in a streamlining of the uses on the property into two popular, stand-alone uses, rather than the disordered uses characterized by the existing buildings on the property. Denying the variance requests would inhibit a beneficial use of the property.

Finally, I find these variance requests can be granted in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of said regulations, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. Indeed, the property on the whole will be vastly improved by the reconfigured entryways on Philadelphia Road and Ridge Road, and landscaping that has been nonexistent for decades will be provided, resulting in attractive external buffers (including a six foot high wood privacy fence along the southwest side of the property) and internal islands.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on these petitions held, and after considering the testimony and evidence offered, I find that Petitioners' Special Exception request and the Variance requests should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County, this // day of June, 2009 that Petitioners' request for Special Exception pursuant to Sections 230.3, 259.2.B, and 419.1 of the B.C.Z.R. for a full service car wash be and is hereby GRANTED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioners' Variance requests from Sections 409.4.B.1, 409.6.A.2 and 419.3.B.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to

permit 3 drying spaces which do not adjoin and have direct access to an aisle, and to permit 71 parking spaces in lieu of the required 78 parking spaces for a combined restaurant/tavern and full

service car wash be and are hereby GRANTED.

The granting of the above relief shall be subject, however, to the following conditions:

1. Petitioners may apply for any permits required and be granted same upon receipt this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

2. Development of the property must comply with the Regulations for the Protection of Water Quality, Streams, Wetlands and Floodplains (Sections 33-3-101 through 33-3-120 of the Baltimore County Code). This Code may apply if any streams, wetlands, or floodplains exist off-site and will result in a buffer extending onto the subject property.

3. Development of this property must comply with the Forest Conservation Regulations (Sections 33-6-101 through 33-6-122 of the Baltimore County Code).

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

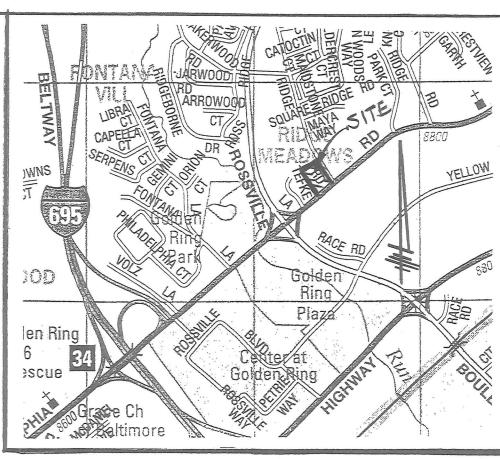
