Dear Mr. Richards:

This office represents Kimco with regard to its shopping center at the York and Shawan intersection in Hunt Valley, Maryland. Kimco is proposing a two story addition to the existing building to serve as office space for its employees, specifically to be located on the north side of the space occupied by Giant Food.

Yesterday, the DRC granted Kimco's request for a (b) exemption for this development. At the DRC meeting, Mr. Merrey requested Kimco file this request for Spirit & Intent approval. Kimco has already filed a Plan to Accompany Zoning Relief related to this project. The hearing has not yet been scheduled but the case number has been assigned - 2017-0213-SPHA. Therefore, we are seeking an expedited decision for this S&I, and I am submitting a \$500 check with this request.

The property's zoning history is documented on the attached plan. Most recently, a petition for special hearing and variance was granted in Case 2016-0178-SPHA, confirming that a previously granted parking variance (Case 05-270-SPHA) is applicable to the current and future development as long as the minimum number of parking spaces approved by that variance is maintained for the shopping center, and granting a variety of sign variances. A copy of Case 2016-0178-SPHA is attached hereto. Carl Richards February 22, 2017 Page 2

Specifically, the reduction approved in that case was 117 spaces. As shown on the attached plan, Kimco is able to provide more spaces than required, taking into account this approved reduction. The total gross leasable area square footage approved by the DRC yesterday is 114,772 square feet. At 5 spaces per 1,000, 574 spaces would otherwise be required, but pursuant to the approved reduction of 117 spaces, 457 spaces are now required. Kimco is able to provide 483 spaces, and is thus able to provide 26 spaces more than required pursuant to the previously approved variance. Therefore, we respectfully request your office confirm that the now proposed parking is within the spirit & intent of the previously approved variance.

As shown on the attached plan, while a handful of parking spaces are proposed to be located within the future Shawan Road right of way, those spaces are not being counted toward satisfying any requirements. The proposed addition occupies one of the areas previously approved as an addition for Giant Food, which will no longer be constructed. The ground level square footage of the now proposed addition is very similar to the square footage of the addition previously approved.

There are no outstanding violations on the property. As stated above, I am attaching my firm's check in the amount of \$500.00 representing payment for this expedited request, a plan to accompany this request, a copy of the decision in Case 2016-0178-SPHA, and a copy of the petition recently filed (Case 2017-0213-SPHA). Thank you for your attention to this request.

#### OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Kimco Realty Corp., legal owner ("Petitioner"). The subject property is approximately 11.49 acres and is split-zoned BR (Business Roadside) and RC-6. The site contains the Shawan Plaza Shopping Center and all site improvements are located in the BR zoned portion of the property.

The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to confirm that the parking variance approved in Case No. 05-270-SPHA is applicable to the current and future development during the phased construction of the improvements as long as the minimum number of parking spaces approved by that variance is maintained for the shopping center.

In addition, a Petition for Variance seeks: (1) to permit wall mounted enterprise signs with a total square footage each of up to three (3) times the length of the wall to which the sign is affixed converted to square footage in lieu of the permitted two (2) times the length of the wall converted to square footage; (2) to permit two (2) wall-mounted enterprise signs on the front wall with a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted one (1) wall-mounted sign (Bldg.1, space 'E'); (3) to permit two (2) free standing joint identification signs with electronic reader board in lieu of the

permitted one (1) per frontage; and (4) to permit an electronic reader board with multiple lines of text in lieu of the permitted five (5) lines of text and with sign copy height less than the required eight (8) inches. At the hearing an amended petition was filed which included a fifth variance request pertaining to the signs at the Giant grocery store which were approved in Case No. 2011-0295-A. A four-sheet site plan with sign elevations was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1A-1D.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests was Michael Ogden on behalf of Kimco and professional engineer Michael Gesell, whose firm prepared the plans. Jennifer R. Busse, Esq. represented the Petitioner. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from any of the county agencies.

#### SPECIAL HEARING

Petitioner in 2005 (Case No. 2005-0270-SPHA) was granted variance relief under B.C.Z.R. §409.6.A.2, permitting 406 off-street parking spaces in lieu of the required 523 spaces. The plan (Ex. 1A, note 8) indicates 406 parking spaces are in fact provided at the site, although Mr. Gesell testified some of those spaces could in the future be relocated such that they would not be in exactly the same location as shown on the plan approved in the 2005 case. Counsel indicated special hearing relief was sought to simply confirm that relocating off-street parking spaces at the center—provided those spaces remain accessible to customers—was permissible as long as the same number of spaces is provided. This is a reasonable request and the petition for special hearing will be granted.

#### VARIANCES

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioner has met this test. The parcel is irregularly shaped and Mr. Gesell noted the shopping center sits approximately 15-20 feet lower than York Road, which limits to some extent a motorist's view into the site. As such the property is unique. Petitioner would experience practical difficulty if the regulations were strictly interpreted because it would be unable to provide appropriate signage for its current and future tenants. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>29<sup>th</sup></u> day of June, 2016, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to confirm that the parking variance approved in Case No. 05-270-SPHA is applicable to the current and future development during the phased construction of the improvements as long as the minimum number of parking spaces approved by that variance is maintained for the shopping center, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Petition for Variance: (1) to permit wall mounted enterprise signs with a total square footage each of up to three (3) times the length of the wall to which the sign is affixed converted to square footage in lieu of the permitted two (2) times the

length of the wall converted to square footage; (2) to permit two (2) wall-mounted enterprise signs

on the front wall with a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted one (1) wall-mounted sign

(Bldg. 1, space E'); (3) to permit two (2) free standing joint identification signs with electronic

reader board in lieu of the permitted one (1) per frontage; (4) to permit an electronic reader board

with multiple lines of text in lieu of the permitted five (5) lines of text and with sign copy height

less than the required eight (8) inches; and (5) to permit twelve (12) wall mounted enterprise signs

on a front wall with a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted one (1) wall-mounted sign (Bldg.

1, space 'A'), be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party.

If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

#### **OPINION AND ORDER**

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Stonehenge, LLC, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") to permit 60 parking spaces in the RC-6 zone. In addition, a Petition for Variance seeks: (1) To permit a building setback of 0.75 ft. in lieu of the required 25 ft. from the future right-of-way; (2) To permit direct access to parking spaces off of a vehicular travel way; (3) To permit a parking landscape setback of 0 ft. in lieu of the required 10 ft. from the future right-of-way; (4) To permit direct access to parking spaces on a street where the average daily traffic exceeds 800 vehicles; and (5) To permit one (1) wall mounted enterprise sign on the front wall without a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted zero (0) wall mounted signs. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Greg Reed and Dana Valenti (on behalf of the owner) and professional engineer Mike Gesell appeared in support of the requests. Jennifer R. Busse, Esq. represented the Petitioner. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC)

comments were received from the Department of Planning (DOP) and the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS). Neither agency opposed the requests.

The subject property is located at the intersection of York and Shawan Roads in Hunt Valley. The site is approximately 11.49 acres in size and is split-zoned BR and RC-6. The site is improved with a strip shopping center (i.e., Shawan Plaza Shopping Center) containing a Giant grocery store, restaurants and several other retail stores. Petitioner proposes to construct a two-story building which would adjoin the Giant food store along the northern boundary of the site. The first floor would contain 5,887 sq. ft. and the second floor would be 9,667 sq. ft. The building would serve as the regional headquarters for Kimco Realty, and would have approximately 60 employees.

This is somewhat of an unusual case, in that Petitioner seeks a building setback variance (as well as other variance requests) from a "future right-of-way." The 90 ft. right-of-way in question is shown on an April, 1988 CRG plan from when the site was first developed. But the right-of-way has never been dedicated to the County, so as a technical matter one could argue a building setback variance is not required since the proposed building would in fact be located more than 25 ft. from the existing "property line." B.C.Z.R. §238.1. Even so, Petitioner acknowledges the right-of-way (which could be used for an extension of Shawan Road) is shown on both the CRG plan and the Hunt Valley/Timonium Master Plan (which is incorporated into Master Plan 2020), so it believed the more prudent course was to include the setback variance request.

The original zoning petition did not include a request concerning the number of off-street parking spaces provided for the overall shopping center. Petitioner explained it was granted a variance in 2005 permitting 406 spaces in lieu of the required 523. And in 2015 it sought and obtained a declaration that the relief granted in 2005 was applicable to future construction and projects at the property. This is in accord with the general rule in zoning cases. 3 Rathkopf's The

Law of Zoning and Planning § 58:23 (4th ed.) (generally, a grant of a zoning variance runs with the land). Petitioner explained that the 2005 variance permitted a reduction of 117 spaces, and that in this case the deficit (i.e., 574 spaces required—463 provided) would be less than the 117 shortfall approved in 2005.

While that may be the case, Petitioner is proposing to construct a new building at the site which increases the number of parking spaces required beyond the number at issue in the 2005 case (i.e., 523). As such, as discussed at the hearing, I believe it is preferable to include an additional variance request here to permit 463 spaces in lieu of the required 574. This will more accurately reflect the current state of affairs and will assist others viewing the zoning and development history of the site. The Petition was so amended following the hearing at the suggestion of the undersigned.

#### SPECIAL HEARING

The special hearing request seeks approval for business parking in a residential zone. The parking spaces in question would be behind the shopping center and located in the RC-6 zone, which necessitates zoning relief. Petitioner originally sought approval for 60 off-street parking spaces, although following discussions with County review agencies the Petition was amended and requests approval for 36 spaces.

Mr. Gesell opined (via proffer) Petitioner satisfied the requirements of B.C.Z.R. §409.8, as well as the special exception standards which are incorporated into the aforementioned regulation. The undersigned reviewed with Petitioner the restrictions contained in B.C.Z.R. §409.8.B.2, and I believe the parking arrangement as proposed will satisfy these conditions. As such, the petition for special hearing will be granted.

#### **VARIANCE**

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioner has met this test. The property has irregular dimensions and is therefore unique. In addition, the property was found to be unique in several prior zoning cases. *See, e.g.*, Case Nos. 2016-0178-SPHA & 2011-0295-A. Petitioner would experience practical difficulty if the regulations were strictly interpreted because it would be unable to construct the proposed building. Finally, I do not believe granting the variance request would have a detrimental impact upon the community.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>14<sup>th</sup></u> day of **April**, **2017**, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to permit 36 parking spaces in the RC 6 zone, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petition for variance as follows: (1) To permit a building setback of 0.75 ft. in lieu of the required 25 ft. from the future right-of-way; (2) To permit direct access to parking spaces off of a vehicular travel way; (3) To permit a parking landscape setback of 0 ft. in lieu of the required 10 ft. from the future right-of-way; (4) To permit direct access to parking spaces on a street where the average daily traffic exceeds 800 vehicles; (5) To permit one (1) wall mounted enterprise sign on the front wall without a customer entrance in lieu of the permitted zero (0) wall mounted signs; and (6) to permit 463 parking spaces in lieu of the

required 574 (489 spaces will be provided, but the 26 spaces shown in the future right-of-way shall not be used for purposes of this calculation), be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

- 1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioner shall provide landscaping at the site as determined in the sole discretion of the Baltimore County landscape architect.
- 3. Petitioner must comply with the ZAC comment submitted by DEPS, a copy of which is attached.
- 4. Should Baltimore County decide to extend Shawan Road and acquire the 90 ft. right-of-way shown on the site plan, Petitioner would be responsible for removing at its own expense any parking spaces, landscaping or other improvements constructed in that right-of-way.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

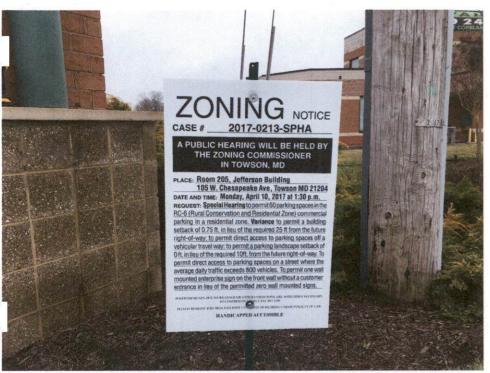

#### John:

The CRG plan from the 1980s did not require dedication and we have amended the plan a few times without addressing it. The proposal to build next to the right-of-way is probably not reason enough to require it now.

That being said, they have agreed that if the County ever decides to build the road, and if the County needs right-of-way to the line shown, they would remove their parking at their own cost. They are in the process of revising the CRG and we are requiring a note on the plan for them to do that.

In addition, the right-of-way shown is 90-feet wide. If the road were ever extended, a long bridge would be needed to get to Paper Mill Road. This bridge would probably not be wider than three lanes so there would be no reason to build five or six lanes at the shopping center and taper them down to three at the bridge. And therefore 90-feet is probably 25 or 30 feet too wide. This was my logic in not worrying about the parking encroachment and dedication of the right-of-way at this time.

Thanks, I will miss seeing everyone.

Yes, I decided to retire while I am still young, relatively speaking.

Dennis, I had a hearing in this case yesterday, wherein Kimco proposes to construct a building for its offices adjacent to the Giant food store in the Shawan Road plaza in Hunt Valley. The first variance sought is for a 0.75 ft. bldg.. setback from a "future right-of-way" in lieu of the required 25 ft. I understand the future ROW refers to a potential extension of Shawan Road, which ROW was shown on an approved CRG plan when this site was first developed. Counsel said the ROW was never dedicated to or accepted by the County, and that the County has not filed a condemnation case to acquire the ROW.

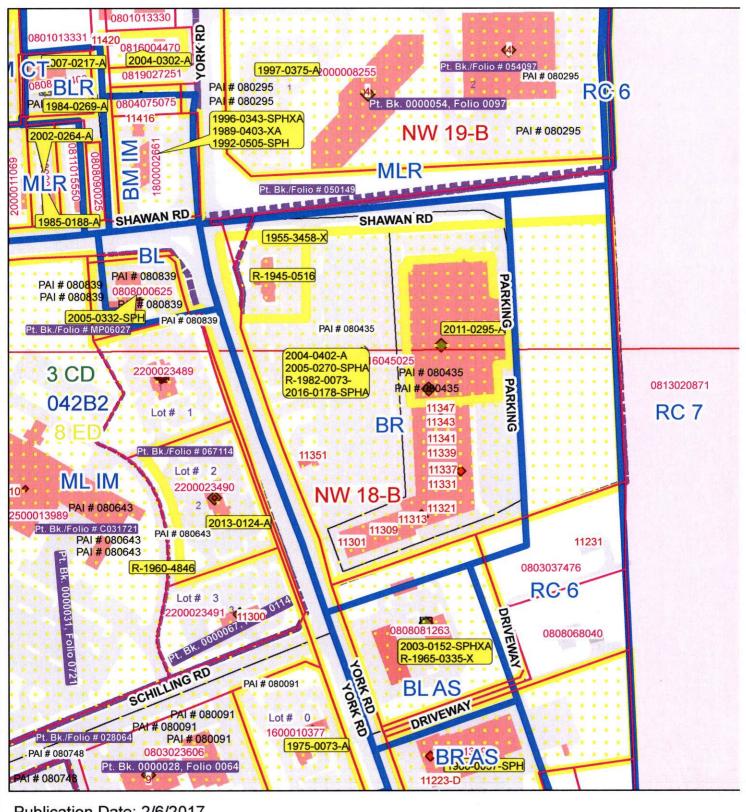
