### **CORRECTED OPINION AND ORDER**

By Order dated May 3, 2017 Petitioners were granted in the above case special hearing and variance relief. Having reviewed that correspondence I agree the May 3, 2017 Order should be corrected to read as follows:

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 3rd day of May, 2017, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") to permit a fuel service station canopy sign with electronic changeable copy components pursuant to B.C.Z.R. §450, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance from B.C.Z.R. §405.2 to permit a fuel service station in a planned shopping center to have fuel servicing spaces within 85 feet of a D.R., R.C. or R.A.E. zoned property, in lieu of the required 100 feet, be and is hereby GRANTED.

All other terms and conditions set forth in the original Order dated May 3, 2017 shall continue in full force and effect.

### **OPINION AND ORDER**

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of FP SUB LLC, legal owner and Weis Markets, lessee ("Petitioners"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to permit a fuel service station canopy sign with electronic changeable copy components pursuant to B.C.Z.R. §450. In addition, a Petition for Variance seeks to permit a fuel service station in a planned shopping center to be located on a lot that is within 0 ft. of a residentially zoned property in lieu of the required 100 ft. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 5.

Professional engineer Michael Gesell and Jack O'Hara & Alex Ororbia, Sr. (from Weis Markets) appeared in support of the requests. Caroline L. Hecker, Esq. and Justin Williams, Esq. represented the Petitioners. Two neighbors attended the hearing to express certain concerns with the requests. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR), noting landscape and lighting plans would be required.

The subject property is approximately 18.37 acres in size and is primarily zoned BR with small slivers of BL and DR 5.5. A large shopping center (166,322 sq. ft.) known as Fullerton Plaza was ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

Date\_5|3|17 By\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ constructed at the site in the 1970s. The former "anchor" tenant (K-Mart) closed its doors about 1 ½ years ago, and Weis Markets proposes to open a large (approximately 60,000 sq. ft.) grocery store in that space. As it has in many other locations, Weis proposes to open a fuel service station as an ancillary use to the grocery store. A fuel service station is permitted by right in the BR zone, since the DOP confirmed in a memorandum dated July 6, 2015 (See Exhibit 3) the Fullerton Plaza qualifies as a "planned shopping center." B.C.Z.R. §405.2.A.1.

### SPECIAL HEARING

The petition for special hearing concerns the request to display gasoline price information on the service station canopy. Similar requests have been made and approved in other zoning cases, and I do not believe the signage would have any adverse impact upon the community. As Petitioners note, state law requires retailers to display fuel price information, and also exempts such signage from the requirements of local zoning laws concerning the size and number of such signs permitted. As such, the special hearing request will be granted.

#### **VARIANCE**

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioners have met this test. The large site is irregularly shaped and was found to be "unique" in several prior zoning cases. See Case Nos. 1981-0130-A, 1982-0089-A and 2011-0343-A. As such a similar finding is appropriate in this case. Petitioners would experience practical difficulty of the ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILMOR

regulations were strictly interpreted because they would be unable to construct the fuel service station, which is permitted by right under the Regulations.

Though the variance request seeks a 0 ft. setback from a residential zone boundary, this is due to the wording of the applicable regulation (B.C.Z.R. §405.2) which states "no part of the **lot** [may be] within 100 feet of a residentially zoned property." To be conservative Petitioners considered the "lot" to be the entire shopping center parcel, which has for many years directly abutted a residential zone. The reality is the service station itself will be over 40 ft. from the residential zone while the fuel pumps will be located at least 98 ft. from the residential zone boundary. Finally, certain conditions will be included in the order below to help ensure that granting the request will not have a detrimental impact upon the community.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>3rd</u> day of May, 2017, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") to permit a fuel service station canopy sign with electronic changeable copy components pursuant to B.C.Z.R. §450, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance to permit a fuel service station in a planned shopping center to be located on a lot that is within 0 ft. of a residentially zoned property in lieu of the required 100 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

- 2. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must submit for approval by the Baltimore County landscape architect landscape and lighting plans for the site.
- 3. The fuel service station may not have hours of operation which extend beyond those of the Weis grocery store. In other words, the fuel service station must be closed at such times as the grocery store is also closed.
- 4. Petitioners shall erect a fence no less than 6 feet in height along the boundary to screen the site from nearby dwellings.
- 5. The fuel service station must turn off all exterior lighting when it is closed for business.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

Dear Judge Beverungen,

I am requesting an amendment to the Order issued in this case due to its referencing an out-of-date County Code.

Although I was interested in this case and reviewed the file, I did not attend the hearing as I saw nothing to oppose or comment on.

Toward the top of page 3, there is a statement that the BCZR §405.2 states

"'no part of the lot [may be] within 100 feet of a residentially zoned property",

which, of course, is ambiguous.

In fact, the County Council, in Bill 87-16 passed December 19, 2016 and effective 45 days later, corrected this by changing the words "part of the lot is" to read "fuel servicing spaces are", so the variance required and granted here is really much less. Copy of Bill attached.

The plan submitted for this case shows the fuel servicing space to be 87.44 ft from the adjacent property zoned DR 3.5.

Thus, the 2nd part of the Order on page 3 should read: "...in a planned shipping center to have a fuel servicing space that is located within 85 ft of a residentially zoned property in lieu of the required 100 ft ...".

This should also help to alleviate the concerns of the many residents who submitted a petition opposing any relief in set-back from their properties.

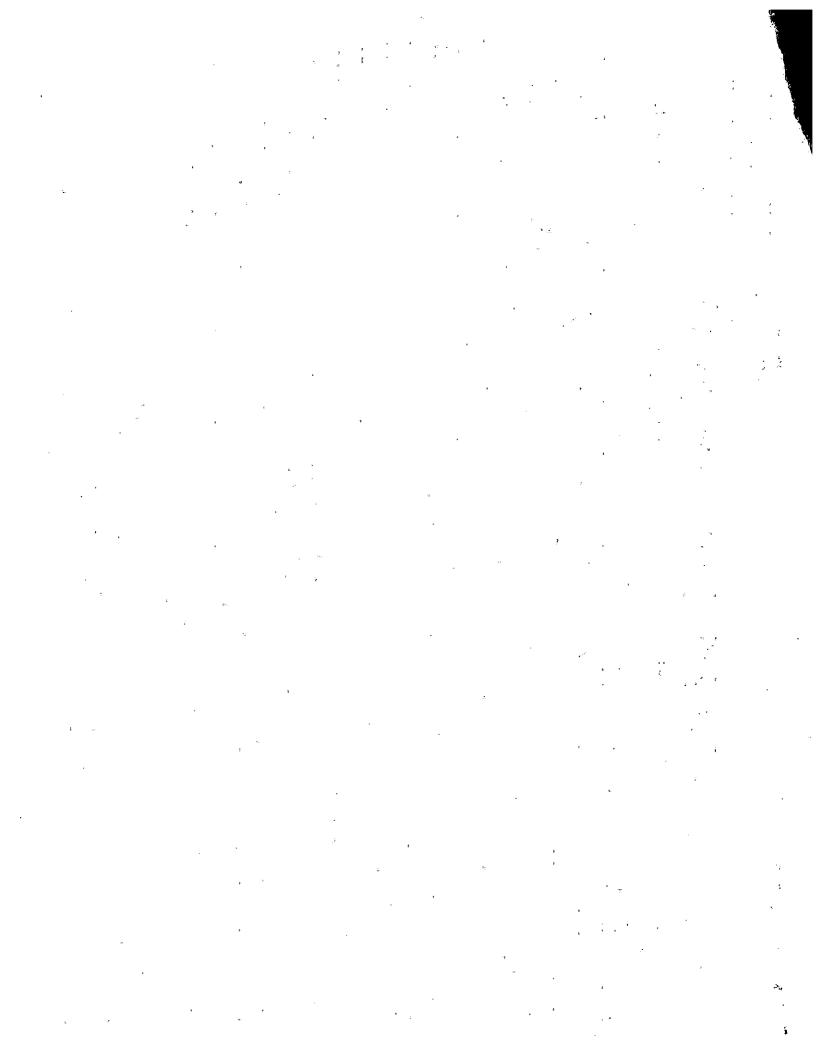

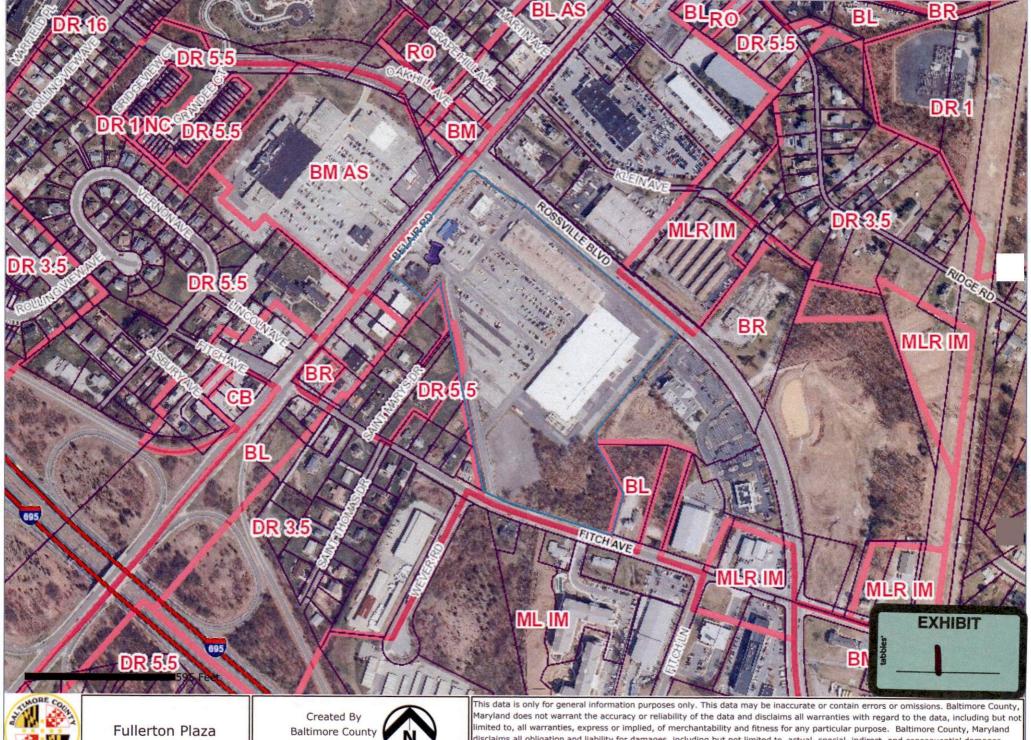

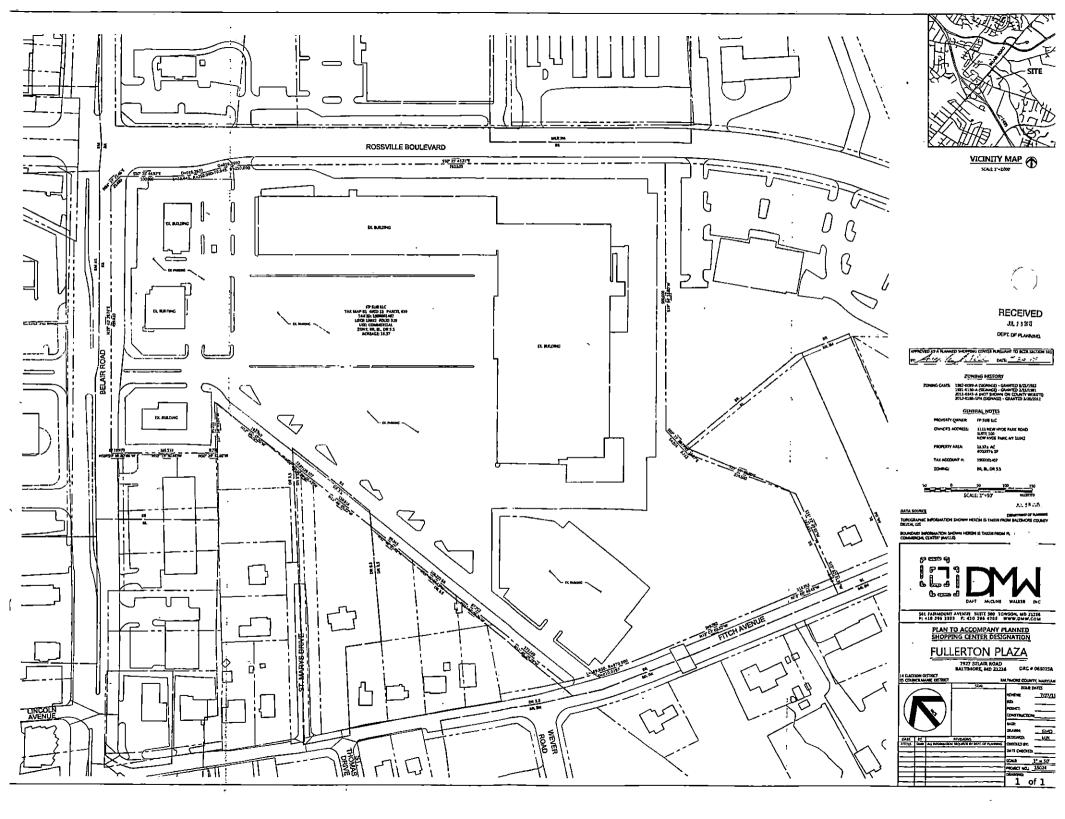

## Weis Market to take over a former Kmart in Parkville next year

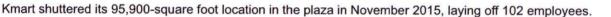

The chain this summer completed a takeover of five former Mars Super Markets in Baltimore County after that grocer announced it was closing down. The new Weis stores are in Essex, Arbutus, Carney and two in Dundalk.

The Parkville location at 7923 Belair Rd. will help to rejuvenate that shopping plaza that was built in the 1970s, Marks said. Other tenants in the plaza include an IHOP, Hair Cuttery and Salvo Auto Parts.

Kimco purchased the property in July 2014 for \$1.3 million.

The new Weis market in Fullerton Plaza will have extra features than other Weis locations: a 1,000-item produce department, a deli and cafe and an in-store sushi counter as well as a full-service pharmacy and a gasoline pump out front.

It is expected to open in late 2017.

"This shopping center is ready for a change," Marks said, in a statement. "When I called a meeting of community leaders from this area, they were clearly interested in improvements to this aging part of the Belair Road corridor. I look forward to the completion of this project."

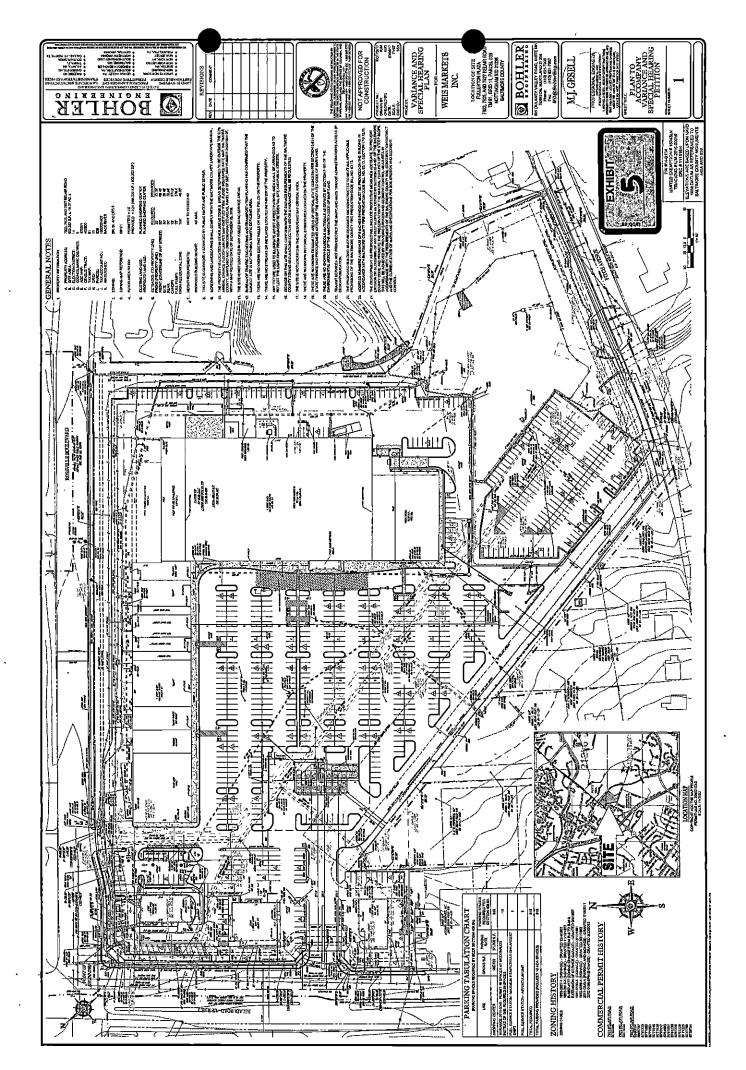

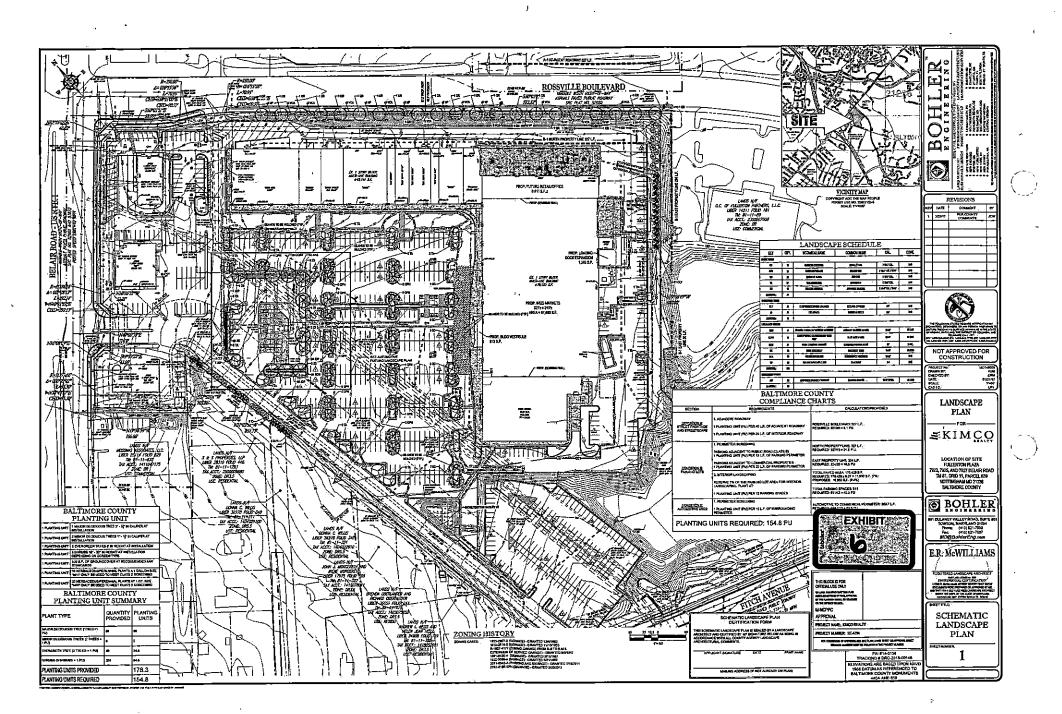

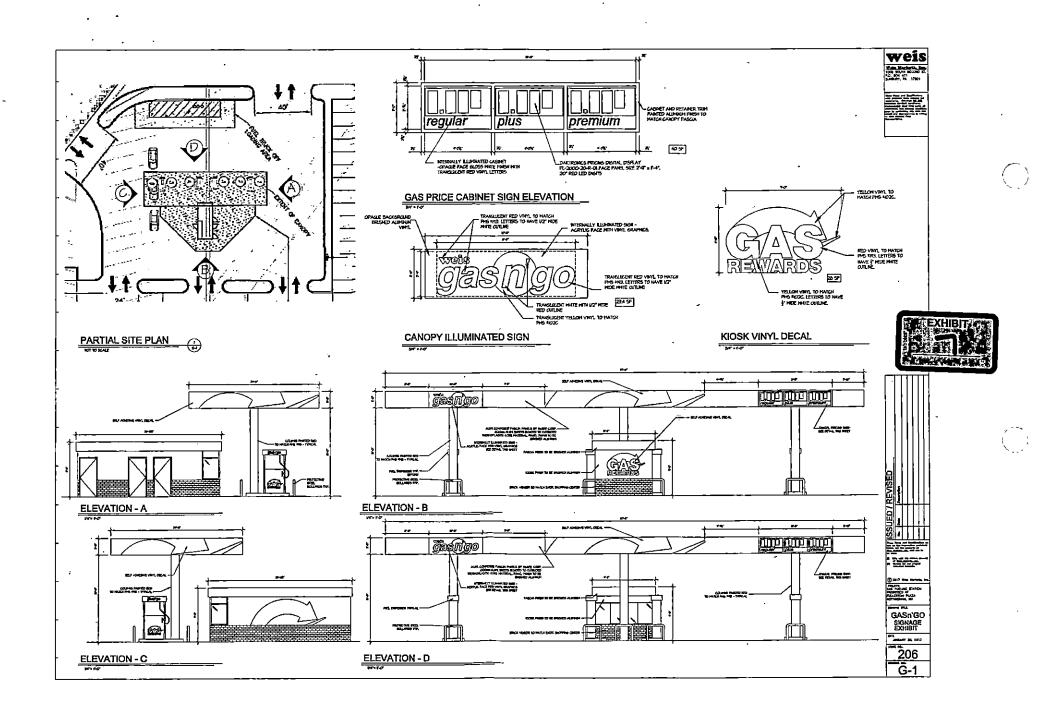

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a requested Special Hearing and Variance filed by the legal owners of the subject property, Westview Investment, LC, et al., by and through Robert A. Hoffman, attorney at law. The special hearing request is for property located at 5780 Baltimore National Pike. Specifically, the Petitioners are requesting to amend a previously approved site plan in Case No. 99-238-SPHA. In addition to the special hearing request, a variance is being requested from Section 405.2.A of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.), to allow a fuel service station in a planned shopping center to be located on a lot that is within 0 ft. of a residentially zoned property in lieu of the required 100 ft. In addition, a variance from Section 409.6 of the B.C.Z.R., to allow 2,381 parking spaces in lieu of the required 3,587 parking spaces is also being requested. Finally, the Petitioners are requesting a variance from Sections 405.4.A.2.b and 405.4.A.2.c of the B.C.Z.R. to waive the requirement to provide a landscape transition area on the subject property.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the special hearing and variance request was Rob Hoffman, attorney at law, representing the Petitioners. There were no protestants in attendance.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the site of this request, is the Westview Mall located on the north side of Baltimore National Pike, just west of Ingleside Avenue in the Catonsville area of Baltimore County. The subject property is improved with large retail uses, such as Lowe's Home Improvement Store, containing 135,000 sq. ft. and the Value City Department Store, containing 188,000 sq. ft. There are other commercial operations on the property. At the present time, the owners of the property propose to locate a Sam's Wholesale Club on the property as shown on Petitioners' Exhibit 1A, the site plan of the property. The Petitioners propose to demolish a portion of the mall and construct a new building consisting of 130,421 sq. ft. wherein the Sam's Club will be located. The proposed Sam's Club will also operate a fuel service station on their parking area, adjacent to the club itself. A small lot of ground has been set aside whereupon the gas pumps will be located. In order to proceed with the construction of this new Sam's Club and the installation of these gas pumps, the special hearing and two of the variance requests are necessary.

The first variance requested by the Petitioners is to allow the fuel service station to be located within 0 ft. of a residentially zoned property line in lieu of the required 100 ft. However, a review of the site plan clearly indicates that the lot set aside whereupon the service station will operate is located in excess of 100 ft. from the nearest residentially zoned property. Therefore, it is not necessary for the Petitioners to request that particular variance and, therefore, the variance shall be dismissed as moot. The remaining variances are necessary and shall be granted to allow the Petitioners to install the fuel service station on the property as shown on Petitioners' Exhibit

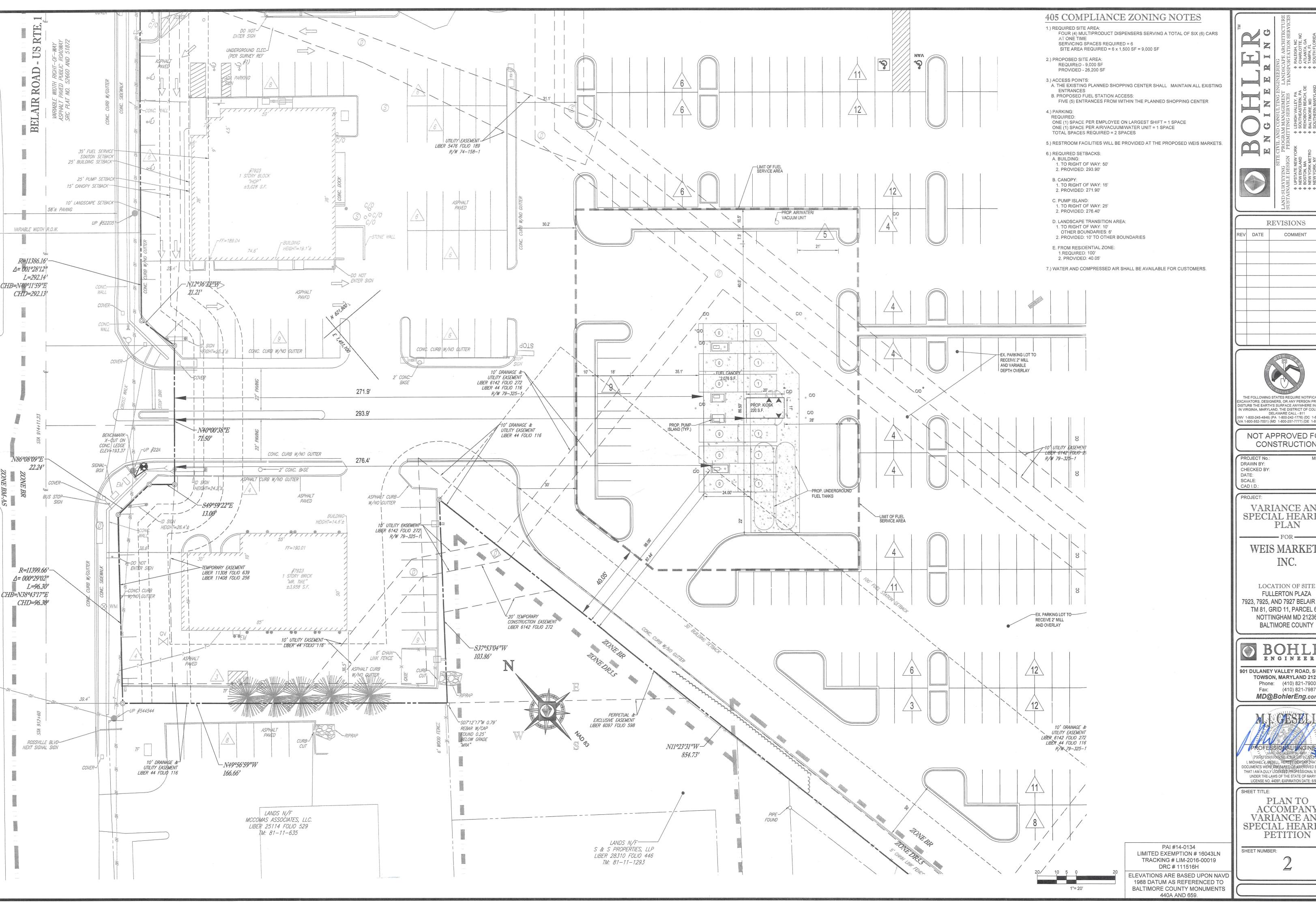
