OPINION AND ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Now pending is a Motion for Reconsideration filed by Elmer Mack, who resides at 18 Bellclare Circle, two houses away from the subject property. The motion recites a lengthy history of water supply and sewerage (i.e., environmental) issues in the vicinity of the subject property. The motion alleges the wells serving homes in this vicinity, and the private sewage disposal systems serving 14 & 16 Bellclare Circle, are inadequate and pose public health concerns. Strictly speaking, the motion does not identify any zoning issues concerning the variance request in the above case, which seeks to locate an in-ground pool in the side yard of the dwelling in lieu of the required rear yard.

In every Baltimore County zoning case the petition for relief is circulated to several county agencies seeking comment and input concerning the propriety of the zoning request. One such agency is the Baltimore County Department of Environment Protection and Sustainability (DEPS), which reviews and approves (provided they meet all State and County regulations) all well and septic systems in the county. By memorandum dated June 6, 2017, DEPS indicated it "has no comment on the above-referenced zoning item." See attached memorandum. Had there been a safety or health concern with the well and/or septic system, DEPS would have noted that in their zoning comment. As such, I will defer to the expertise of that agency and deny the motion.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) as a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owners of the property, Amanda B. Coleman and Justin Phelps ("Petitioners"). The Petitioners are requesting variance relief from § 400.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a proposed in-ground pool (accessory structure) located in the side yard in lieu of the required rear yard. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. There were no adverse ZAC comments submitted by any of the County reviewing agencies. A letter of opposition was received from a neighbor, and is discussed below.

The Petitioners having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on June 9, 2017, and there being no formal request for a public hearing (which must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$60.00), a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioners have filed the supporting affidavits as required by Section 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code (B.C.C.). Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in

the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Administrative Law Judge, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of Section 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, strict compliance with the B.C.Z.R. would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioners.

In a letter dated June 14, 2017, Elmer Mack (who lives at 18 Bellclare Circle) indicated he opposed the variance request. Mr. Mack opined the proposed location of the pool would negatively effect his property value and be an eyesore. Based on the plan, the pool will be located 216 ft. from Bellclare Circle. In these circumstances, I do not believe the pool would be an eyesore, if in fact it would even be clearly visible from the street. As for the negative impact on property values, no evidence was provided other than Mr. Mack's personal opinion.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>29th</u> day of **June**, **2017**, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from § 400.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a proposed in-ground pool (accessory structure) located in the side yard in lieu of the required rear yard, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

 Petitioners may apply for their appropriate permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

The HORORABLE Judge John Beverungen

Petioner, in the above matter, requests for the Honorable Judge to RECONSIDER granting the above Varince Request, and states for the following reasons: that besides the obvious reasons that this swimming pool installation on the side of this residence would be an 'eyesore' and a add a devaluation to the property values here, that this property has many-many problems. These many problems here would cause Petioner (me) a loss of the basic standard of use of my property and an enjoyment of life that e is entitled to. This Variance approval would be long lasting and would be severly costly to me and other neighbors here, now and in the future.

In a conversation with Rob Powell, of Baltimore County Dept of Environmental Protection, he stated that this entire Bellclare Circle sub-division has a major water supply problem and also a major problem with the sewage systems here due to the heavy clay soil composition.

In an effort to be neighborly, Petioner sent four (4) letters to the Phelps (see exh. # 1), plus a letter and a phone call to his father (the father was listed initially as the property owner) to bring some of this information to the Phelps attention. The Phelps outright refused to respond to these letters (emphasis added). This indifferent attitue by the Phelps provides a good example of how the Phelps would respond, in the future, if they had an unfortunate occurence with either the use of their intended swimmming pool, or the operation of any of the three (3) water wells located on their property.

14 BELLCLARE CIRCLE, HISTORY/BACKGROUND

There are three (3) property owners that have their water wells on # 14 Bellclare Circle property (see exh. # 2). # 14 Bellclare Circle property size is less than two (2) acres..... This would not be allowed today.

#14 Bellclare Circle (owners: J. Phelps) has two other neighbors #12 Bellclare Circle (Owners: M. Gonano) & #10 Bellclare Circle(owners: K. Barrow) water wells on located on their property, for a total of three (3) water wells here....To further complicate matters, there are another two (2) home owners water wells using this same fragile underground water aqualifer, (#16 & #18 Bellclare Circle), for a total of five (5) water wells. These five (5) residential water wells are located within @ 35-45 yards of each other.

The water well for # 16 Bellclare Circle is less than fiftyeen (15) yards away from the three (3) water wells on #14 Bellclare Circle (see exh. # 3)......This also certainly would not be allowed today.

This property, #14 Bellclare Circle, is a well noted problem property for failing many 'perc tests', and having poor water availability...This was stated to me by Rob Powell of Balto. Co.

Back in @ 1950, the original builders (the Cantazaro Bros.) of these @ 24 homes in this development could not get #14 Bellclare Circle to pass a 'perc test'. This property was sold 'undeveloped' to Vince Martin. Mr. Martin also purchased # 16 Bellclare Circle at this time. Vince Martin had his house built on #16 Bellclare Circle, and used # 14 Bellcare Circle, an unimproved lot as a play ground for his son. Over the years, as reported to me by Vince Martin, he tried to have # 14 Bellclare Circle pass a 'per test', and it FAILED every time.

Later on in @ the early 1990's, Vince Martin tried to induce me into purchasing his house #16 Bellclare Circle, with the caveat that a purchaser here had to also purchase the unimproved lot of # 14 Bellclare Circle, with the known caveat that # 14 Bellclare Circle would not pass a 'perc test'. Around about this same early-1990 time period, me, as a next door neighbor and good friend of both the Martins, was invited to witness a 'perc test' here, performed on # 14 Bellclare Circle, wherein this 'perc test' FAILED again (emphasis added).

In the early 1990's, Vince Marting called Rob Powell of Baltimore County and they got together, and some how a Building Permit was issued for # 14 Bellclare Circle.---????? . Mr. Martin went on to build his retirement home, at the far back end of this proerty, with only he and his wife living here, until they passed away.

ADDED WATER USE:

The property owners of # 16 Bellclare Circle, the Shepherds, not only increased the water demand of an already fragile water system with their over-populated home operation, but also this same fragile water system is further compromised by their use of their property as an overstaffed home office and their hosting large scale camp recuitment events....See photo # 4 attached, showing just half (50%) of the Shepherds visitors for a camp recruitment event at their residence on this day. Shown here are the cars of these visitors to the Shepherd property which were parked illegaly on anothers neighbors lawn at # 13 Bellclare Circle without the property owners consent. The property owner here, needed Balto. Co. Police to remove these vehicles from his lawn.

The Shepherds, are operators of a summer boys camp in Maine. Back in @2001 they spent over \$300,000 to increase the size of their house from three (3) bedrooms to six (6), bedrooms, plus (see exh. # 5 & 5a). A year or two (1-2), after this, they had many-many sewage backups in their basement due to the many bodies using their property. The Shephers finally upgraded their failing sewage system.

After applying for a permit to upgrade their sewage system, Rob Powell of Baltimore County spends extensive time in designing and supervising the installation of a 'surface mounted' alternate experimental sewage system. Rob Powell is 'sandbagged', actually intentionaly lied to, by the Shepherds, in the design of this alternate experimental sewage system. At this time this home owner declares that they are only operating with the original three (3) bedrooms. When in fact, they just increased their residence to six (6) bedrooms, with multiple beds in each of these bedrooms. The Shepherds sign an agreement with Baltimore County (see exh. # 6). that their are residence has only three (3) bedrooms, and this is what Rob Powell designs for....FYI, A sewage system design is determined by the number of bedrooms in a residence.

At this time there are ten (10) people living in the Shepherd residence, plus an additional four (4) full time employees working in this home office. FYI, only one (1) person is allowed to work in a home office.

This increase to six (6) bedrooms, puts another major demand on this already fragile water system here. This fragile water system is further at risk by the Shepherds' continuing in their use of their property for hosting large scale camp recuitment events. In addition, they have camp employees sleeping, sitting up in chairs, as there are no beds available. Adding to this, his parents visit here regularly with their mini-mobile home, (see exh.#7). Where they are seen darting in and out of the Shepherds residence, in their bathrobes, after taking their showers in the Shepherds residence...The Shepherds are 'campers', and after approaching them about the extended water use here Mr. Shepherd states: "F**k the neighbors".

The Shepherds' new surface mounted alternate experimental sewage system is described as being a 'sand mound' sewage system. This severely over worked and grossly undersize sewage system is located only fifty (50') feet from the property line of #14 Bellclare Circle., and @ 50-100 ft. from the Phelps intended swimming pool.

In @ mid-2006's, # the underground water line for #12 Bellclare Circle was cleaned with caustic chemicals and these chemicals found there way into my house and my drinking water supply, at #18 Bellclare Circle. Also, at this same time # 10 Bellclare Circle had the same problem with these caustic chemicals showing up in their drinking water. This shows/proves that all five (5) residential water wells here for #10, #12, #14, #16, & #18 Bellclare Circle, are located within @ 50 yards of each other, and share this same fragile underground water aqualifer. Additionally, the water well for # 16 Bellclare Circle is located less than fifteen (15) yards away from the three (3) water wells located on # 14 Bellcare Circle.

....Shortly after the Shephers' sewage system update for #16 Bellclare Circle, I noticed a five (5") PVC discharge pipe (without the 5" black PVC pipe), at the edge of my property, hidden partially out of sight, discharging a liquid onto my property and flooding out my 'leach' field (see exh. # 8))....

This caused a sewage backup in my house.... After seeing this hidden 5" PVC pipe at the edge of my property, I inquired of Rob Powell about his design of this sewage system for #16 Bellclare Circle. He stated that he designed this sewage system for three (3) bedrooms. Rob Powell stated that he failed to do a walk thru inspection of the Shepherds' residence to verify that the Shepherds' were only operating with three (3) bedrooms that they stipulated.

Rob Powell continued that the Shepherds' were not only operating recklessly, but that it was not a question 'if the Shepherds' experimental sewage system was going to fail, but the question was **WHEN!!**

After this, I filed a complaint withh Balto. Co. Zoning enforcement which was rejected. In the process, Zoning lost, 35-50 of my photos that documented all of this activity. It is my opinion, that as long as Arnold Jablon is employed by Balto. Co. and /or associated with the Zoning Board that my complaints about this will always be rejected. Arnold Jablon was this home owners representative when he was not associated with Balto. Co.

This doubling of the size of this residence (# 16 Bellclare Circle) and this new demand here for a swimming pool for # 14 Bellcare Circle would put this already fragile water aqualifer at even greater risk. Petioner as a home owner whose property is greatly at risk here, I have no other option than to strongly object to the installation of a swimming pool at #14 Bellclare Circle, and this variance request. The water demand here by adding a swimming pool to #14 Bellclare Circle would be comparable to adding another, or a fifth,(5th) water well to # 14 Bellclare Circle. The Shepherds' residence/camp operation would most definetly add to this water demand here..

Should the Phelps have a water discharge from their intended swimming pool, then this pool water would travel, in a straight shot down hill to the Shepherds already over worked sand mounted sewage system, where this combination of swimming pool water and sand encrusted sewage would continue in a straight shot down hill onto my property, and flooding out my leach field and contaming my water well.— (see exh. #9)

The water use for the maintence of a swimming pool here, due to evaporation, summer start up & winter closing, regular topping off, shower useage, general pool water loss, water chemical inbalance, storm water loss, plus other misc. hidden costs would require another three (3) page letter here, and greatly add to the water useage here.

ROAD NOISE:

While this issue is indirectly related to this Variance issue, it is worth mentioning that shortly prior to this home owner purchasing this property, that 90% of the neighbors here supported the installation of a sound wall. This Phelps greatly benefit from the installation of this sound wall as the sound measurement tests done for these twelve (12) affected homes show that that their house had the worst sound problem from the Rt # 83 road and car noise. Federal surveys show that the most effected by this loud road noise are younsters (there are two pre-school children here), and that the Phelps have the only vehicle with a notable loud muffler noise from their muscle car..... Also, a study published in The Lancet found an increase in dementia risk for folks who live close to areas with heavy traffic. This could be because high levels of air pollution and noise have the potential to eat away at the brain's connective tissues

The drainage culvert built for this sound wall is can not be reached by the owners of # 14 Bellclare Circle due to being blocked by their topography and this sound wall.

SWIMMING POOL WATER USE/REQIUREMENT

The property owners of # 14 Bellclare Circle, the Phelps, a very young couple with two (2) preschool boys, in all probability have never owned a house with a private water well (or two on their property). Also they in all probability have never owned a house in an area which has a well noted poor water supply system.

Next, the Phelps, have in all probability, never owned a house with a swimming pool, much less swimming pool in such a weak water supply area.......The water use here for such requirements as water use for TOPPING OFF the pool water due to water evaporation, water use for SUMMER START UP and WINTER CLOSING, water use for REGULAR POOL CHEMICAL MAINTENCE, etc. is certainly not within the Phelps thinking today. The Phelps total lack of responsibility in not reponding to four (4) simple neighborly letters, letters sent in an effort to make matters easier for them with their properties many -many problems, well shows that a swimming pool ownership here today, would be a highly questionable item for them and their family.

For these above stated reasons Petioner requests that this Varince be DENIED.

Justin,

I have tried to contact you over the summer months, and apologetically left word with your Dad to have you contact me. There are some new developments here with, which possibly affect both of our properties, and may help to explain the failure of your water well pump, and other undiagnosed problems yet to come..... Your water well pump replacement has my concerns as your water well pump saw very limited service since it was installed originally back in the early 1990's. With only two (2) persons basically drawing water on it, it saw very limited use over the years.. In addition, it sat unused for @ three-four (3-4) years, between two property transfers before you purchased this residence....In comparison, I brought my house back in 1988 and it only has two (2) persons drawing water on it. As of todate I have not needed to replace my water well pump.

The five (5) water wells here (the three on your property), to include the Shepherds and mine, in this very precarious area for water, are located only 35-55 yards apart...I situation today which Baltimore County, or other Maryland counties would not allow.....Back in 2006, when the property (#12 Bellclare) next to you was sold, the owner had to have his water well (one of the ones located on your property) cleaned as part of the conditions of sale....The trace chemicals from this water well cleaning showed up in my drinking water. It left a distinctive odor and taste to our water, as well as the other water well on your property for #10 Bellclare. Obviously, had you been in residence here back then, then these chemicals would have showed up in your drinking water, proving how all of us share a very fragile underground water aquifer.

The attached letters provide a history of my concerns with our mutual neighbors, the Shepherds, and their operation of an over staffed and illegal home office with this fragile water condition. Today, the Shepherds have 3-4 employees working here in their home office. Baltimore County only allows one (1) employee working in a home office...To complicate matters further here, the Shepherds have a six (6) bedrooms residence, operating on a grossly undersized Alternate Experimental Sewage System, which they recently had updated back in 2006. At that time, they claimed that they were operating only a three (3) bedroom residence. FYI, a sewage system size is determined by the number of bedrooms in a residence....The Shepherds residence, with it's over limit home office use and undersize septic system is an accident waiting to happen, and you will probably be the first to notice it......The Shepherds undersize septic system borders your property, under your bedroom windows.

This Alternate Experimental Sewage System, required that the Shepherds sign off on a land easement agreement, with a provision for follow up inspections. However this residence never had a follow up inspection as the inspector thought that it would be most foolish (an expensive) for a property owner to install or update a septic system that was grossly undersized.

Justin, as person who witnessed the several failed 'Perc' test done on your property, and who helped purchase and install the Leyland Cypress trees on your property, I know these properties here and limitations all too well...I believe that it would be to our mutual benefit to meet and discuss all of this. In addition, I have several Baltimore County Dept. of the Environment planning documents showing all of

our water wells, the Shepherds Septic Well Easement Agreement, and related photos which I would be willing to share with you. You may not think that these matters are important today, but I will not be around forever and in the future they may possibly save you a lot of time and money.....Again, give me a call......(410) 728-1333 (shop).....(410) 771-8129 (home).

Enclosed is the design specification package for the proposed sewage disposal system repair for your property. Please note that the replacement system is a low pressure dosing system, requiring that the contractor installing the system not only be licensed by Baltimore County to install sewage disposal systems but also be certified by Maryland Department of Environment to install sand mounds. This requirement is necessary as the design and installation of the pressurized perforated piping system is more detailed than the normal sewage pump system and closely aligns the pressurized systems used in sand mound systems.

Because of a slightly slower soil percolation rate, the system will be classified as an alternative low pressure dosing system. Consequently, an Agreement and Easement must be signed by all parties and recorded in land records for Baltimore County before the permit to construct the system can be issued. Please fill out and sign the attached form and return to this office for processing and signatures.

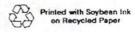

AGREEMENT AND EASEMENT FOR INSTALLATION OF AN ALTERNATIVE ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM

THIS AGREEMENT is made this Aday of Moy among the hereinafter referred to as "Owner" the Baltimore County	
hereinafter referred to as "Owner", the Baltimore County	•
Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management hereinafter collectively referred to	0
as the "County", and the Maryland Department of the Environment, hereinafter referred to as the	
"Department".	
WHEREAS, Owner owns a tract of land located on 16 Belle Aze Circle. Shares MD 21157 in the 12 Election District of Baltimore County, Maryland, and the deed to same is recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County, Maryland in Liber SM no. 8974 folio 697	Ĺ

WHEREAS, Owner's land is unsuitable for the installation of a conventional on-site sewage disposal system and owner has requested the Department's approval to install an alternative system of sewage disposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- A. Owner must install and maintain a water meter on the incoming side of the water system or an event counter on the sewage pumping system.
- B. Owner hereby grants to the Department and the County the right to enter upon the property at any reasonable time for access to the system to make periodic inspections and the Owner agrees to provide any information and data requested and needed by the Department to develop accurate and thorough test results.
- C. Owner acknowledges and agrees that the proposed alternative system is not conventional technology and that his or her participation is voluntary. Owner agrees that there shall be no liability on the part of the County or Department to Owner if this alternative systems fails.
- D. Owner acknowledges and agrees that neither the County nor the Department nor any of its agents or employees, either officially or individually, underwrites the operation of any system approved by them.
- E. The Owner will devote such care and effort to the maintenance of the system so that a system maifunction is not the result of poor maintenance, faulty operation, or neglect.
- F. The Owner acknowledges that approval of this waste disposal system does not guarantee the County's approval to construct future expansions of or additions to the dwelling structure.
- G. The Owner agrees, that, should the system be determined by the Department to pose a threat to the public health, safety or comfort, the Department may order any necessary changes or corrections and the Owner agrees to pay for all such changes or corrections. System modifications may include requirements for pretreatment of wastes by installing a recirculationg sand filter; aereation system, etc.
- H. The Owner agrees to contact both the Water Management Administration, Individual Septic Systems & wells Program and the County at lest forty-eight (48) hours prior to system installation, so that the Department may lay out the system in the field with the contractor. The Owner must install this system according to the plans and specifications approved by the Department and any changes required by the Department as a result of the field layout. If installation deviates substantially from the approved plans or changes such that experimental data will be comprised or

reduced, the Owner agrees to pay for all necessary corrections.

- I. This agreement shall run with the land and binds the Owner, his heirs, successors, assigns except that the provisions of paragraph A & B shall be binding for a period of 5 years only after installation of the system and occupation of the home. Owner further agrees that he shall inform in writing any purchaser or lessee of the property that the system may require maintenance or other attention. The Owner agrees to record this agreement in the land records of Baltimore County.
- J. This agreement shall not be construed to limit any authority of the Department to protect the public health, safety or comfort or to issue any other orders to take any other action which is now or may hereafter be within is authority.
- K. This agreement may be voided at the discretion of the Department if the system construction is not completed within six (6) months of the effective date of this agreement.
- L. This agreement contains the entire agreement and understanding between the County and the Owner and the Department. There are not additional terms other than as contained in this agreement. This agreement may not be modified except in writing signed by each of the parties or by their authorized representatives.

M. The laws of the State of Maryland govern the provisions of all transactions pursuant to this agreement.

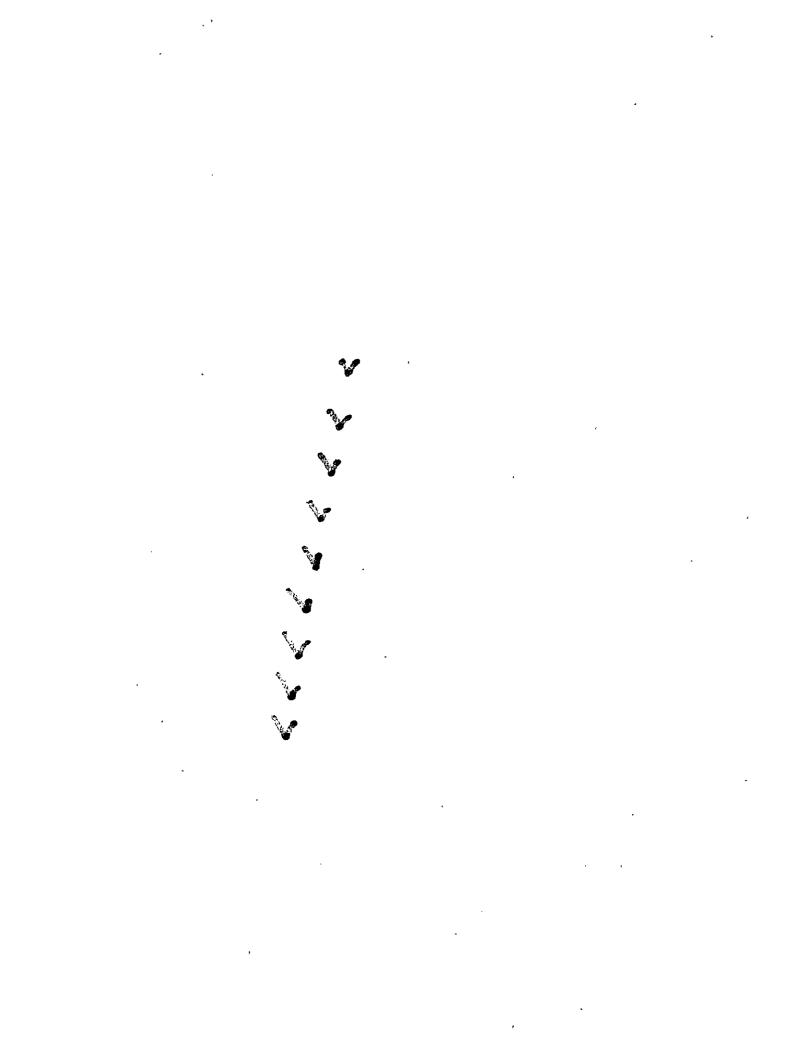
PRESSURE DISTRIBUTION ON SLOPING SITES 4 wide treach bottom

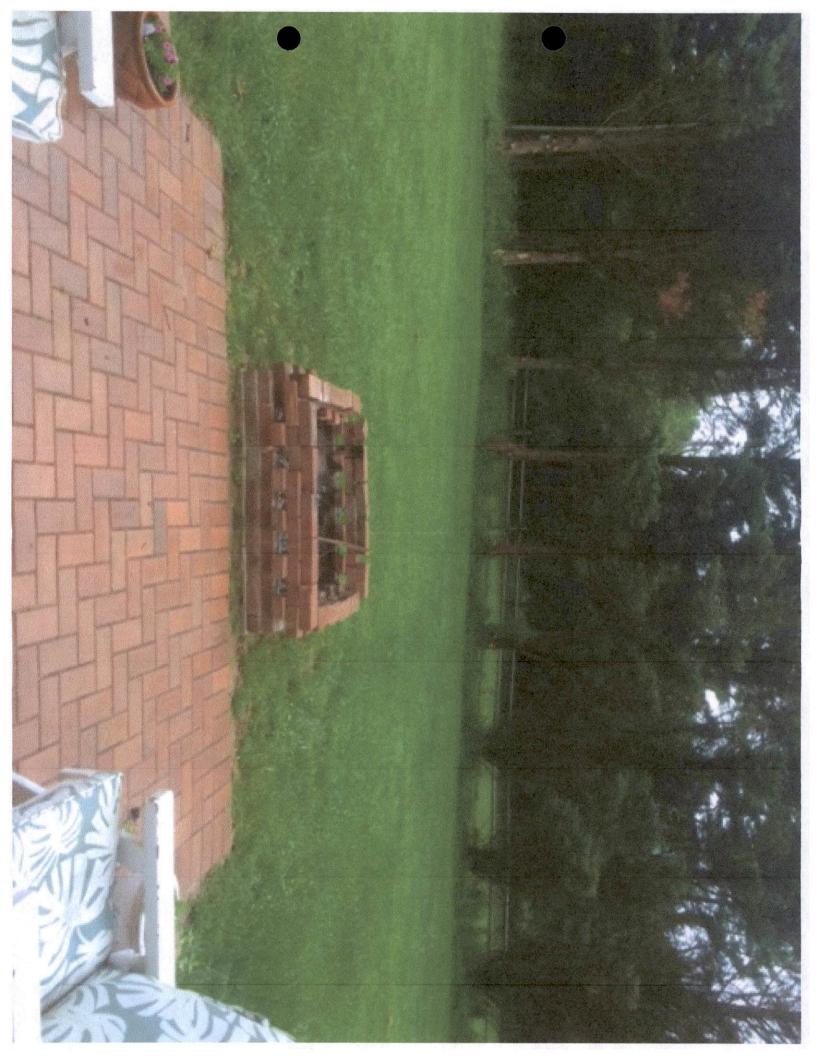

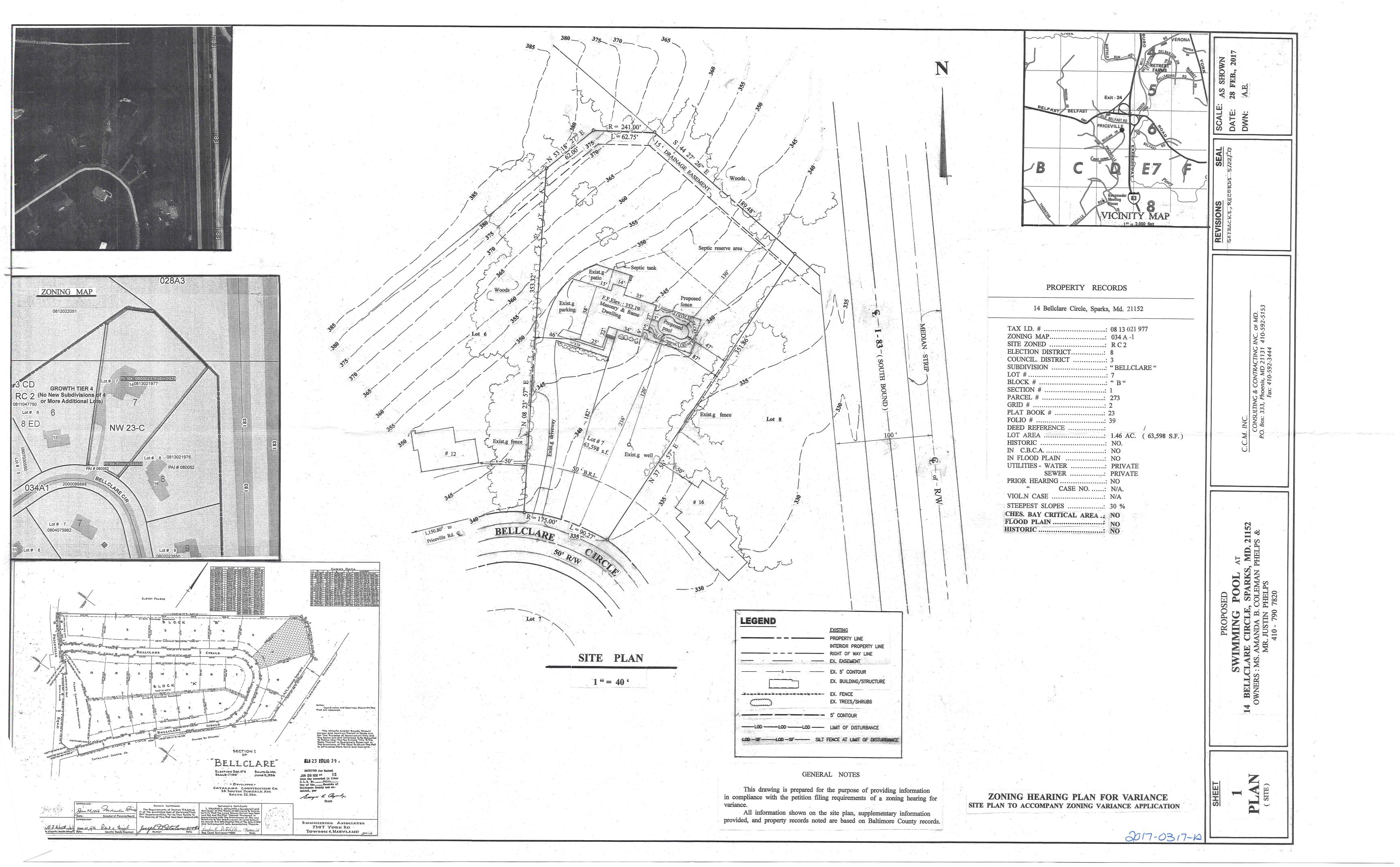


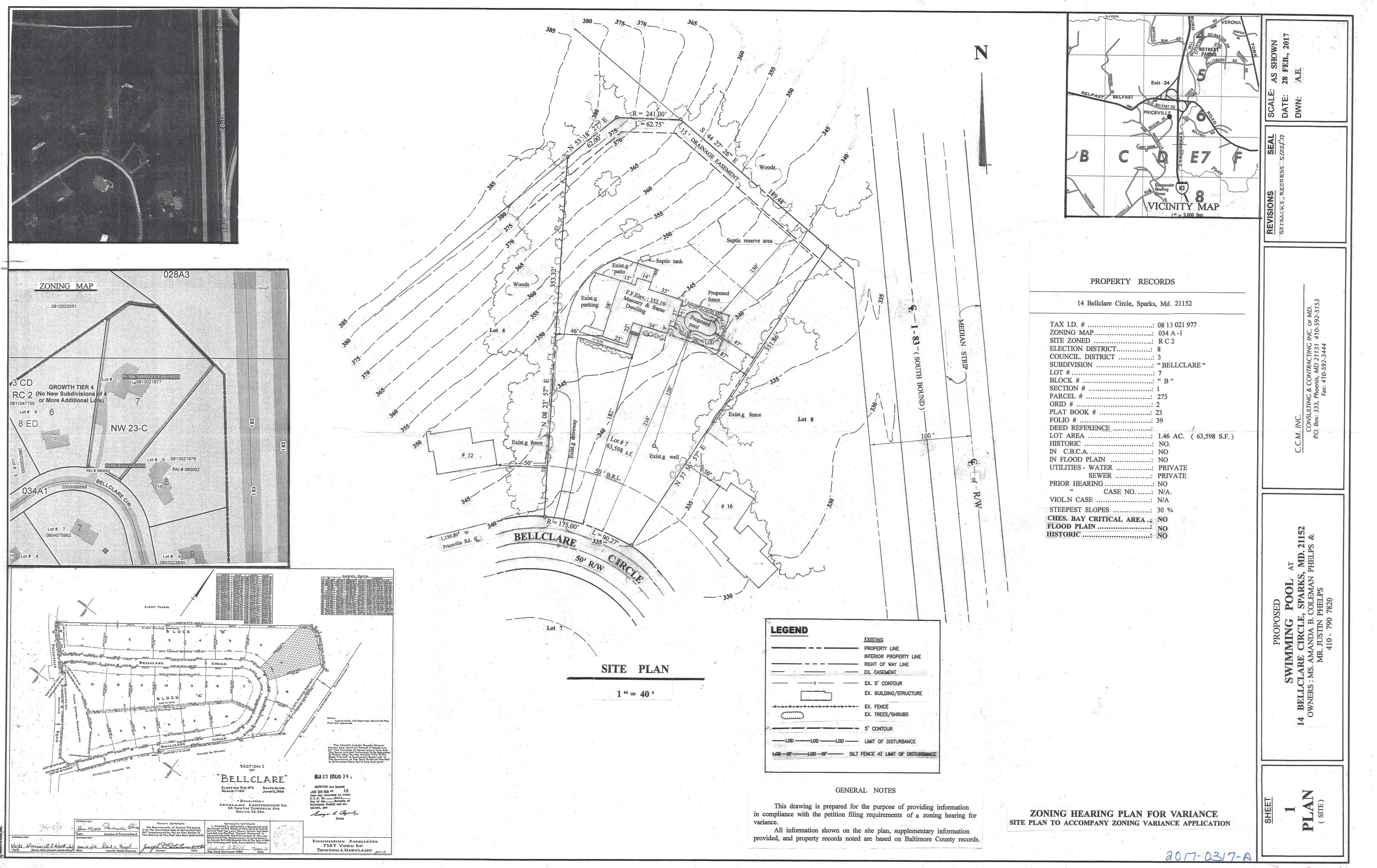
