OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County for consideration of a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owner of the property, Jay M. King ("Petitioner"). The Petitioner is requesting Variance relief pursuant to § 400.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R."), to permit an accessory structure (detached garage) with a height of 25 ft. in lieu of the required 15 ft. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

The Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. A ZAC comment was received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS), dated July 19, 2017, indicating "Ground Water Management must review any proposed building permit(s) for a garage, since the property is served by well and septic (and the septic tank is near the proposed location for the garage)." In addition, a ZAC comment was received from the Department of Planning (DOP), dated July 26, 2017, indicating it had no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief conditioned upon the following: "The proposed structure shall not be used as a residence or for commercial purposes."

The Petitioner having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on July 13, 2017, and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioner has filed the supporting affidavits as required by § 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code (B.C.C.). Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Administrative Law Judge, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of § 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, strict compliance with the B.C.Z.R. would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioner.

Although the Department of Planning did not make any recommendations related to the accessory structure (detached garage) height and usage, I will impose conditions that the garage shall not be converted into a dwelling unit or apartment, not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, kitchen or bathroom facilities, or used for commercial purposes.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 4th day of August, 2017, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from § 400.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R."), to permit an accessory structure (detached garage) with a height of 25 ft. in lieu of the required 15 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at his own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioner or subsequent owners shall not convert the accessory structure (detached garage) into a dwelling unit or apartment. The accessory structure (detached garage) shall not contain any sleeping quarters, living area, and kitchen or bathroom facilities.
- 3. The accessory structure (detached garage) shall not be used for commercial purposes.
- 4. Petitioner must comply with the ZAC comments submitted by DEPS, dated July 19, 2017, and DOP, dated July 26, 2017; copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

I'm looking to construct a 40' x 26' detached garage that has 2 car bays and 1 utility room with an additional storage / office area above the utility room. I currently have a Jeep and a Trailer that require 9' doors for them to fit in the garage. The utility room will be used as a personal dog kennel area and will lead into a fenced in area in the back yard to exercise my 2 dogs. I want to use the space above the utility area as an office / craft area and for storage. To get the Head Clearance in the storage area at the top of the stairway I need to go above the 15' Roof Ridge height regulation. I have the wall height of 6' at the top of the stairway to start the roof trusses and with an 8/12 pitch and a partial cathedral ceiling we were able to get the 8' ceiling height on most of the storage space. This put us at 24'-2" to the top of the Roof Ridge.

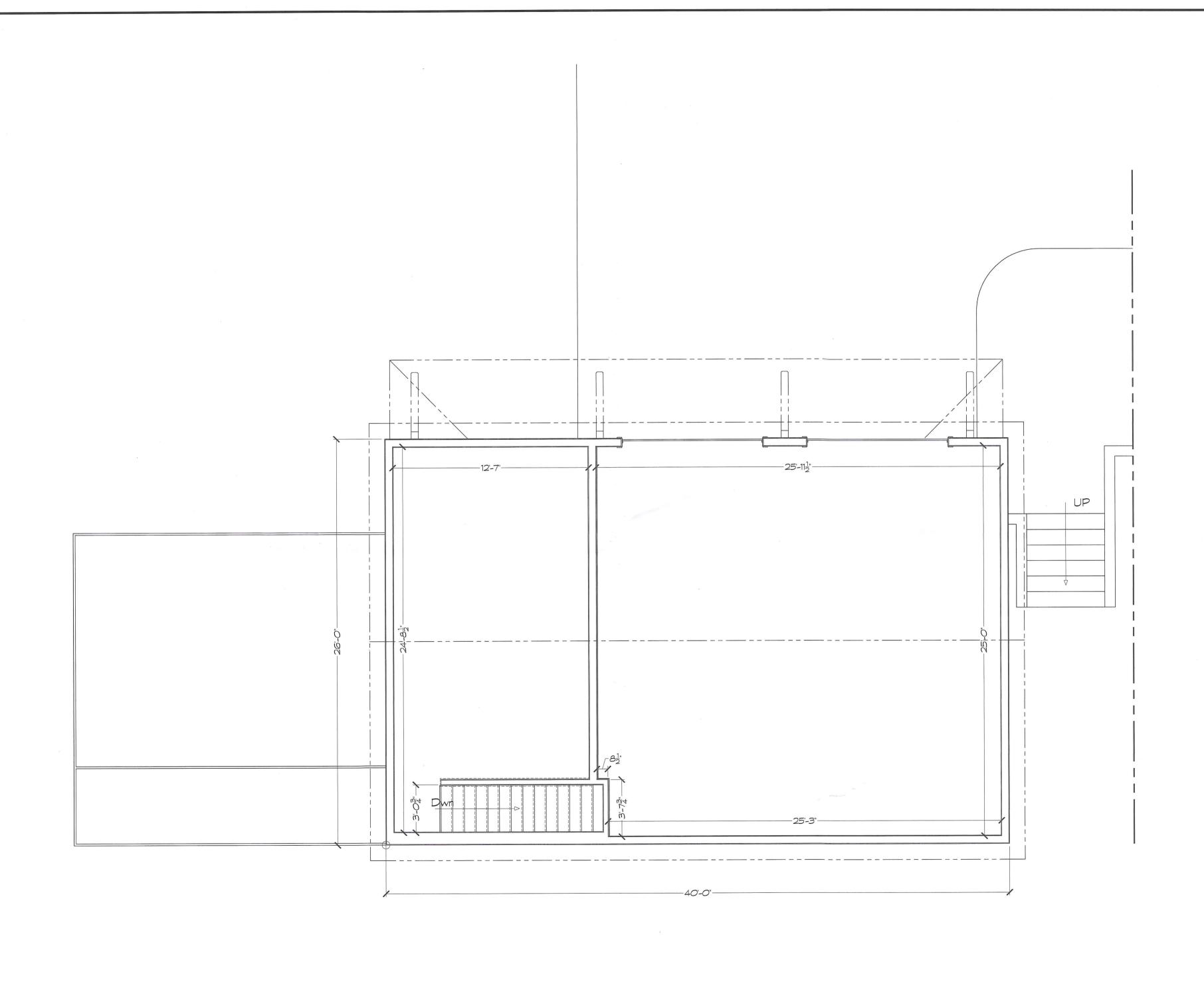

GARAGE 2nd FLOOR PLAN

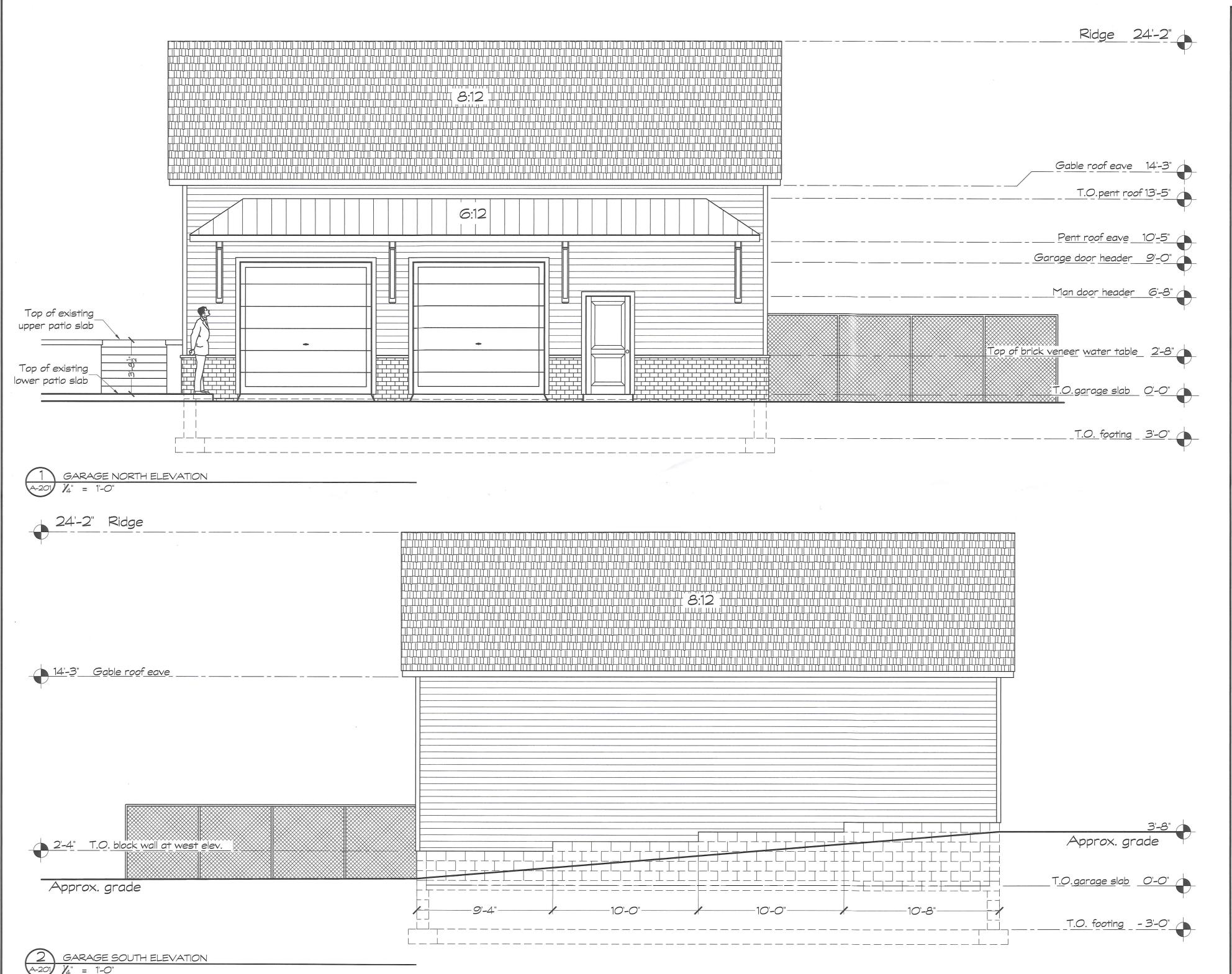

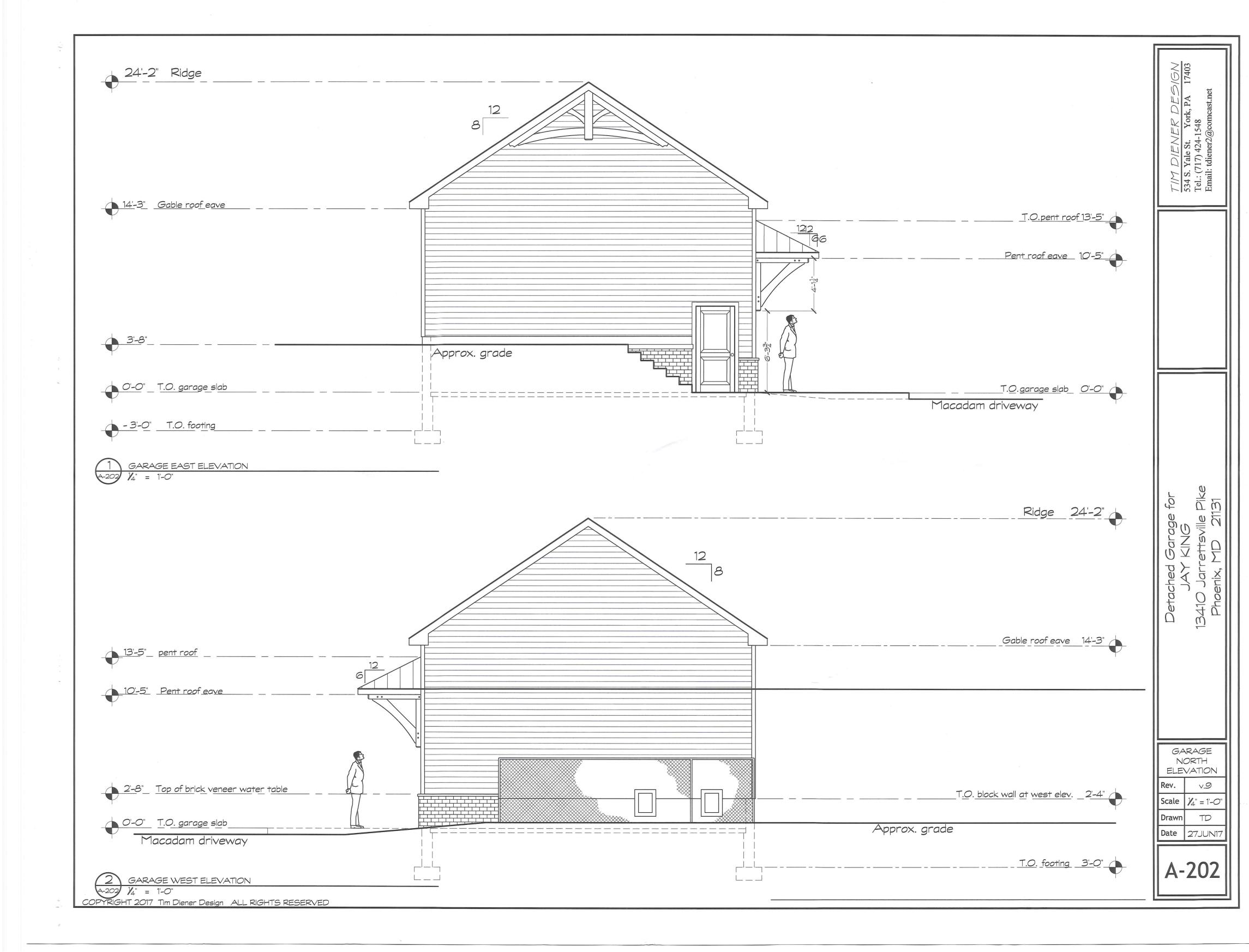

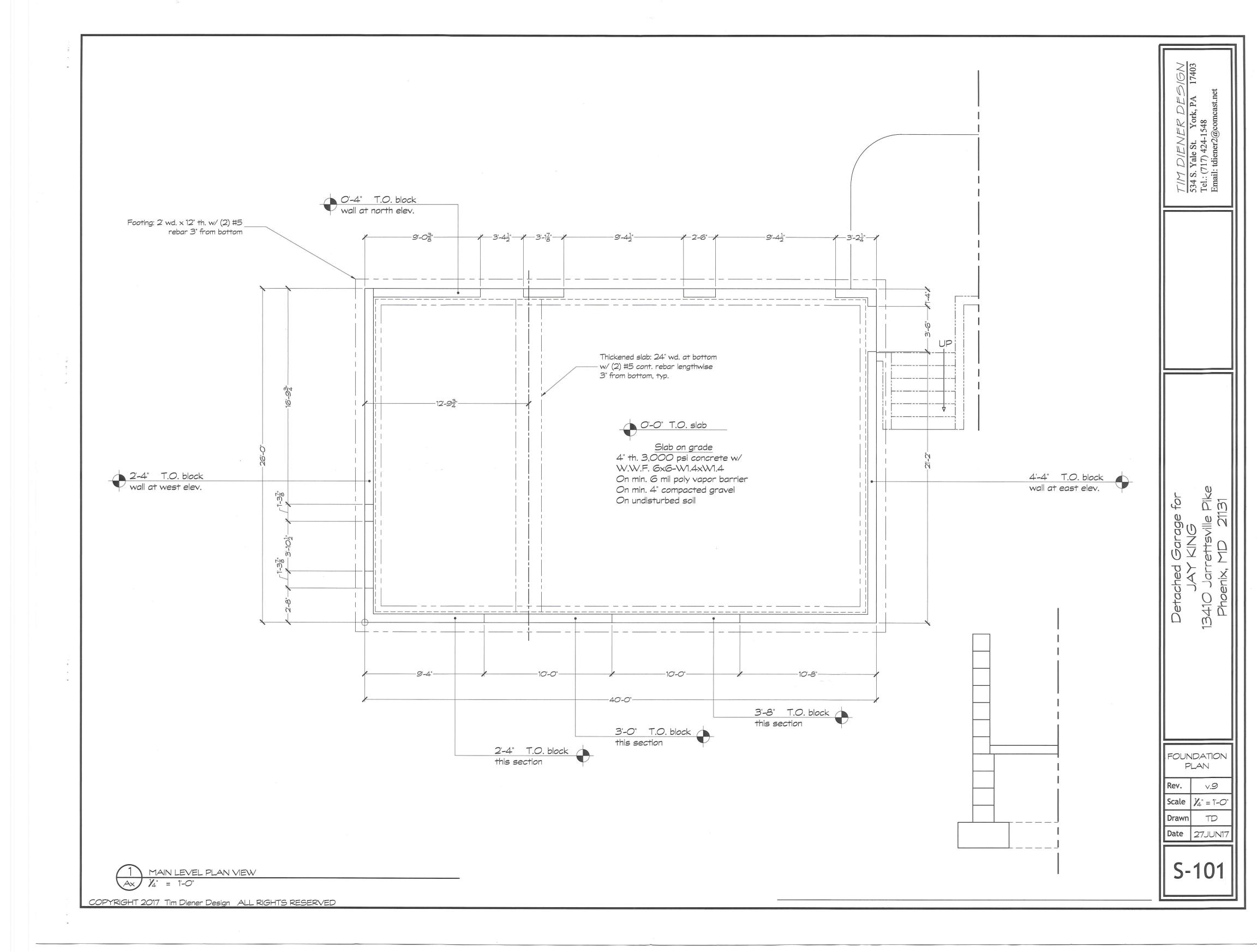
