OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Special Exception filed on behalf of MD Transportation Authority, Lodge 34 of Fraternal Order of Police (FOP), legal owner and Prime Tower Development, LLC, lessee ("Petitioners"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") to amend a special exception granted in Case No. 1975-0233-SPHX to exclude area for new telecommunications facility from original SPHX approval. A Petition for Special Exception was filed to permit a new telecommunications facility with a 107 ft. tall monopole on a portion of the property.

John Behnke and Tim Schindler attended the public hearing in support of the requests. Greg Rapisarda, Esq. represented the Petitioners. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from any of the reviewing county agencies.

The subject property is approximately 8.86 acres in size and is zoned DR 2. In 1975, the FOP was granted a special exception to operate their union hall (i.e., a "community building" in ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

zoning parlance) on the property. This case concerns a 2,500 sq. ft. area of the site, which would contain a telecommunications tower within a fenced enclosure. Petitioners submitted a five-sheet site plan which was marked and admitted as Exhibit 1.

The plan contains additional information and detail concerning the precise location on the site of the tower and fenced enclosure, which will contain certain equipment used in conjunction with the tower. As shown on the plan the enclosure and tower will accommodate at least three carriers/providers, and all setback requirements will be satisfied. At its June 27, 2017 public meeting, the County's Tower Review Committee conditionally approved, by unanimous decision, Petitioners' request to construct the 107-ft. tall tower. Petitioners sent via priority mail with confirmed delivery explanatory letters and a copy of the site plan to both the Windlass Run Improvement Association and Essex Middle River Civic Council. Neither association responded to the correspondence or filed with the OAH an objection to the requests.

SPECIAL HEARING

As noted above, the special hearing request seeks to amend the site plan submitted in connection with a 1975 zoning case. In that case, the property owner (one of the Petitioners herein) obtained a special exception which permitted the construction of a community building on the subject property, which is used to host police union activities. Presumably the entire 8.86 acre site was considered the special exception area, and counsel explained the special hearing request would in essence remove therefrom a 2,500 sq. ft. area in which the tower and enclosure would be located. This is a reasonable request and will prevent a scenario where there are overlapping special exceptions, which is arguably prohibited by B.C.Z.R. §102.2.

SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate, LLC*, 451 Md. 272, (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use.

Here, Mr. Behnke testified via proffer that Petitioners satisfied each of the requirements set forth at B.C.Z.R. §§ 426 & 502.1, and no evidence was offered in opposition to that testimony. As such, and being mindful of the presumption provided by Maryland law, I believe the petition for special exception should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this **23rd** day of **October 2017**, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing to amend the special exception granted in Case No. 1975-0233-SPHX to exclude a 2,500 sq. ft. area (50 ft. x 50 ft.) as shown on the site plan for a new telecommunications facility, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Special Exception to permit a new telecommunications facility with a 107 ft. tall monopole on a 2,500 sq. ft. portion of the property, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for NG

whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

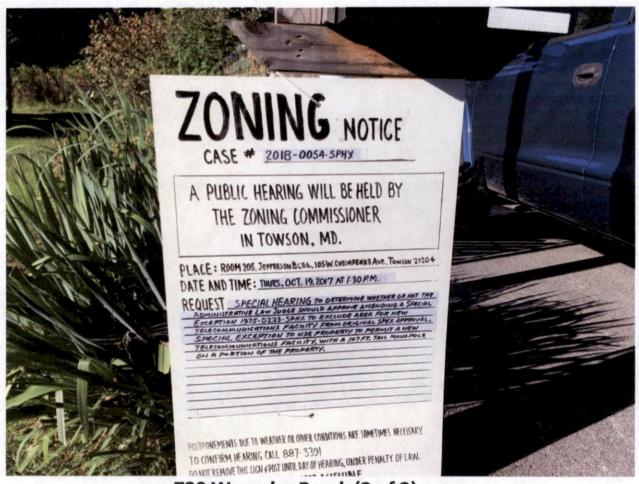

Prime Tower Development, LLC ("Prime") is proposing a new telecommunications facility with a 107' monopole (105' monopole w/ 2' lightning rod) within a fenced 50' x 50' equipment compound (the Facility) on a portion of the Lodge 34 of the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) property at 730 Wampler Road, Middle River, Maryland 21220 (the "Property").

This document and attached Exhibits provide a justification for Prime's proposal and an explanation for how and why this proposal meets and exceeds the requirements in the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (BCZR). This information, as well as clarifying evidence to be presented at an upcoming public hearing support the County's approval of Prime's (1) Petition for Special Hearing to remove the area for the Facility from case no. 1975-0233 SPHX and (2) Petition for a Special Exception to permit the Facility on a property zoned DR-2. I. Summary

Today, there is an unprecedented demand for reliable wireless voice communications and wireless data services. Increasingly, people want to relinquish land lines and rely solely on their mobile phones. Meeting that desire requires reliable service over broader areas without gaps and dropped calls. Additionally, mobile devices are increasingly being used for transmitting and receiving wireless data through smart phones. As a result, a robust wireless network is essential for emergency and nonemergency wireless communications that have become necessary for everyday quality of life, business and commerce, and public safety through Enhanced 911 (E911) technology.

Prime works with its carrier clients to continuously review and assess the infrastructure needed to handle the quality and volume of calls and data. Through this process, carrier clients identified the vicinity near the Property as an area in needs of a monopole for new coverage and additional wireless services. RF Propagation Maps illustrating the current coverage deficiencies are attached at Tab 1. In addition, there are no existing towers or structures that can accommodate wireless antennas, which means that a new structure – i.e. the Facility – is needed. The Tower Review Committee agreed, finding a need for coverage and a need for the Facility because there are "no existing structures within one mile of the [Property]." The TRC Memo recommending approval of the Facility is attached at Tab 2.

II. The Property, FOP Lodge 34, and Proposed Facility

The Property is 8.86 acres in the DR-2 zoning district and home to FOP Lodge 34. FOP Lodge 34 is permitted by special exception as a community building or similar civic use in the DR-2 district. BCZR § 1B01.1.C.4. In 1975, the FOP Lodge was approved as a special exception in Case No. 1975-2033 SPHX. Prime and FOP Lodge 34 are bound through an Option and Lease Agreement (Lease), which provides, among other things, for the lease of 2,500 square feet for the Facility. A copy of the Lease with the financial terms redacted is attached at Tab 3.

The Facility will be situated on a portion of the Property and the 107' tall monopole will be situated within a 50' x 50' equipment compound that will be surrounded by an 8' tall fence. The Zoning Drawings (ZDs) are attached at Tab 4. The Facility accommodate at least three wireless service providers and allow for new and better wireless coverage in the area. RF plots show that the location of the Facility will provide carriers, including Sprint and T-Mobile, with the infrastructure necessary to improve their wireless networks. RF Propagation Maps illustrating the expected improved coverage are attached at Tab 5.

III. Zoning Relief Sought

A. Special Exception

The Facility is permitted by special exception in the DR-2 zone under BCZR § 1B01.1.C.24 and § 426.5 with evidence showing compliance with BCZR § 426.4, § 426.6, and § 426.9.

B. Special Hearing

Because the Property was subject to a special exception (1975-0233 SPHX), Prime seeks a special hearing, if necessary, to amend case 1975-0233 SPHX to (1) exclude the portion of the Property to be used for the Facility (see Lease at Tab 3 and ZDs at Tab 4) or (2) determine compliance with BCZR § 102.2 because neither the FOP Lodge nor the Facility will share yard space required for either SPEX use.

IV. Community Outreach

After consulting with the County, Prime determined that the Property was located in or near the boundaries and jurisdiction of two community associations: (1) SX Middle River Civic Council and (2) Windlass Run Improvement Association. On May 18, 2017, Prime mailed each association a letter about the proposed Facility and providing contact information in case there were any questions or concerns. There was no response to those initial letters. On June 30, 2017, Prime sent each association a second letter by priority mail with confirmed delivery, a letter with more details and enclosing a copy of the site plan. To date, Prime has not gotten any response to its letters or proposal. A copy of the letters dated May 18, 2017, and June 30, 2017, including the site plan attachments and USPS delivery confirmations, are attached at Tab 6.

V. Compliance with BCZR §§ 426, et seq.

Each applicable zoning provision from the BCZR is listed below. Prime's statement of compliance is below each provision (in italics).

§ 426.2 Legislative policy for wireless telecommunications antennas and towers.

It is the intent of Baltimore County that:

A. Antennas should be placed on existing towers, buildings and structures, including those of public utilities, where feasible; and

Prime assessed the area in need of coverage and confirmed that there are no existing towers, buildings, or structures that could accommodate wireless antennas and satisfy the minimum coverage objectives. The TRC confirmed that "there are no existing structures within one mile of the [Facility]." See TRC Memo, p. 3 of 4, at Tab 2.

- B. If a new tower must be built, the tower should be:
 - 1. Constructed to accommodate at least three providers;

The proposed monopole is designed to hold 3 carriers. <u>See the Tower Elevation</u> <u>drawing, Sheet A-2, on the ZDs at Tab 4.</u> Please note that Prime is also submitted 12 signed and sealed copies of the ZDs (11" x 17") with this filing package.

2. Erected in a medium- or high-intensity commercial zone when available; and

Prime conducted due diligence on potentially available commercial zones when it was conducting due diligence on existing structures. Unfortunately, the Property and surrounding areas are all zoned Density Residential and there are no commercial properties nearby. The TRC confirmed this on p. 2 of 4, at Tab 2. A copy of the GIS zoning map from the Zoning office is attached at Tab 7.

3. Located and designed to minimize its visibility from residential and transitional zones.

The location of the Property and the location of the Facility within the Property is designed to maximize the natural screening and minimize the visual impact from residential and transitional zones. See the Site Plan attached as Exhibit 4.

§ 426.3. - N/A

§ 426.4. Tower Review Committee

A. There is a Tower Review Committee in Baltimore County.

- D. In addition to any other fees required, an applicant for a building permit or a special exception shall pay a separate processing fee to the County. The County Administrative Officer shall establish the amount of the fee.
- E. Committee review.
 - 1. Prior to submitting a petition for a special exception or an application for a building permit for a tower, a petitioner or an applicant shall meet with the Committee. The Committee shall meet with the petitioner or the applicant within 45 days after a written request for a meeting is submitted.
 - 2. The petitioner or the applicant shall submit to the Committee:
 - a. Information detailing the maximum number of providers and antennas the proposed tower can support.
 - b. Any other relevant technical information requested by the Committee.
 - 3. The Committee shall review the information submitted by the petitioner or the applicant and evaluate the proposed tower with regard to the legislative policy under Section 426.2.
 - 4. The Committee may provide advisory comments to the Zoning Commissioner or the Code Official concerning the proposed tower.

Primate applied to the TRC and its application was reviewed at the meeting on June 27, 2017. After a detailed review and public meeting, the TRC, "by unanimous decision, Conditionally Approves and Recommends [Prime] to construct a new 107-ft tall tower as proposed..." See TRC Memo, p. 3 of 4, at Tab 2.

§ 426.5. Location and height restrictions for wireless telecommunications towers.

In this section, the following words have the meanings indicated:

- A. "R" means by right.
- B. "SE" means by special exception.
- C. The column for antennas refers to antennas located on a tower, building or structure legally existing prior to the installation of the antenna even if the tower, building or structure was approved by special exception.
- D. The height of a tower is measured from the base of the tower to the tip of the tower or the tip of the highest antenna on the tower, whichever distance is greater.

The Property is zoned DR 2 which permits the proposed monopole by special exception. The proposed monopole will measure a maximum of 107' AGL, which includes a 105' tall monopole and a 2' lightning rod. See Tower Elevation Drawing, Sheet A-2, on the ZDs at Tab 4.

§ 426.6. Setback requirements for wireless telecommunications towers.

A. Setbacks.

1. A tower shall be set back at least 200 feet from any other owner's residential property line.

The proposed Facility will meet and exceed the minimum 200' setback requirement. The monopole's closest setback is 222.3' to the rear property line (S/SW) and the next closest setback is 272.9' to a side property line (W/NW). See Site Plan, Sheet A-0, on the ZDs at Tab 4.

2. A structure housing equipment for a tower shall meet the minimum setback requirements from any other owner's property or zone line.

The setback requirements for the DR-2 zone can be found in BCZR § 1B01.2.C. There is no specific setback requirement for an accessory use, but the setback for a "nonresidential principal building" is 60' (front), 30' (side), and 40' (rear). BCZR § 1B01.2.C.a.

All equipment cabinets will be located within the fenced 50'x 50' compound and will be setback, at a minimum, of nearly 200' from the closest property line at the rear (S/SW). See the Site Plan in the ZDs at Tab 4.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 102.2 of these regulations, if multiple structures housing equipment for a tower are located on the same owner's property, a yard or setback is not required between the structures.

The Facility and all of its related equipment will be located on the Property, which is owned by FOP Lodge 34.

- B. Except as required by the Federal Aviation Administration:
 - 1. Stroboscopic lights are not permitted on a tower.

Prime is not proposing any lighting. Prime applied to the FAA, which determined that "marking and lighting are not necessary" for the proposed 107' tall monopole. <u>The FAA</u> Determination of No Hazard to Air Navigation are attached at Tab 8.

2. The tower, antenna and supporting lines shall be neutral in color.

The proposed monopole will be the standard matte gray finish and the Facility will be surrounded by a neutral gray chain link fence.

- C. If a tower is located in a residential or transitional zone, any structure housing equipment for the tower shall be:
 - 1. Screened in accordance with the Landscape Manual, Class "A" screening requirements.
 - 2. Faced with a material compatible with buildings or structures surrounding the tower.

The Property is surrounded by mature trees and wooded area. The Facility will be setback well inside of the Property and surrounded on all sides by existing mature trees and wooded areas and will be thoroughly and naturally screened in a manner that is at least equivalent to the Landscape Manual, Class "A" screening requirements.

In addition, Prime hired BC Architects and Engineers (BC) to conduct a balloon test and visual impact survey. BC flew a large red helium balloon to a height of 107' from the location of the proposed monopole. While the balloon was flying, BC drove around the Property and surrounding neighborhoods to search for the balloon and take pictures as evidence of whether the balloon (or monopole) would be visible or not from the surrounding areas. Because of the deep setbacks, surrounding mature woods, and other factors such as topography, the large red balloon flying at 107' AGL was barely visible from any of the surrounding areas. The Visual Impact Survey, Photos, and Photosimulations are attached at Tab 9.

Given the natural screening, and the lack of visibility from the balloon test and visual impact survey, Prime does not believe that additional screening or landscaping is necessary, and that the Facility's visual appearance, as proposed, is compatible with other buildings in the general vicinity. If necessary, however, Prime is willing to add additional screening or landscaping as may be required by the County.

D. Upon completion of a tower and every five years after the date of completion, the owner of the tower shall submit to the Code Official written certification from a professional engineer verifying that the tower and any structure housing equipment for the tower meets all applicable Building Code and safety requirements.

Prime will comply with this requirement.

E. The owner of a tower shall submit annually to the Tower Coordinator written certification of the number of providers and antennas on the tower.

Prime will comply with this requirement.

§ 426.8. Unsafe or hazardous conditions.

A. The owner of a tower and any structure housing equipment for the tower shall maintain the tower and any structure in good working condition and correct any unsafe or hazardous conditions, which may include:

- 1. Conditions caused by vandalism.
- 2. Flaking or worn exterior paint.
- 3. Illegal or improper occupancy of the tower or structure.
- B. The provisions of this section shall be enforced in accordance with Article 3, Title 6 of the Baltimore County Code.

Prime will comply with this requirement.

§ 426.9. Additional conditions for towers permitted by exception.

Towers permitted by special exception shall meet the requirements of this section.

- A. A petitioner shall have the burden of demonstrating that:
 - 1. The petitioner has made a diligent attempt to locate the antenna on an existing tower or nonresidential building or structure;

Prime conducted due diligence to determine whether there were any existing structures that could serve as viable co-location opportunities for wireless antennas and found none. The TRC confirmed this determination. See TRC Memo at Tab 2. In addition, last year, T-Mobile (and Eco Site) submitted an application for a facility at the Property because they too could find no existing structures viable for co-location. See TRC Memo at p. 1 at Tab 2. The evidence is clear that there are no other viable existing structures in this area and a new monopole and Facility are necessary.

- 2. Due to the location, elevation, engineering, technical feasibility or inability to obtain a lease or ownership of a location elsewhere, the construction of a tower at the proposed location is warranted;
- The Property is 8.86 acres and surrounded by much smaller residential parcels. In addition, the Property has been operating as a quasi-commercial use (i.e. community building or similar civic association) for nearly 35 years. In short, the Property is the best location for the Facility and the only possible location for the infrastructure necessary to provide the surrounding residential neighborhoods with reliable wireless coverage that includes emergency and non-emergency

wireless services. These facts, as well as the significant distances from adjacent properties and adjacent to and surrounded by existing mature woods and trees, make this location ideally suited for the Facility as compared to elsewhere in the zone.

3. To the extent technically feasible, the tower has been designed to accommodate antennas of at least two other providers; and

This proposed monopole is designed to accommodate three carriers. See ZDs at Tab 4.

4. The height of the tower is no higher than what is required to enable present and future co-location of other providers.

The height of the proposed monopole is the minimum height needed to achieve Sprint's minimum coverage objectives. <u>See RF Plots w/ expected coverage at Tab 5</u>. In addition, the TRC concurred with this finding. <u>See TRC Memo at Tab 2</u>.

- B. The Zoning Commissioner shall review the petitioner's submittal with regard to the legislative policy under Section 426.2.
- C. In a residential or transitional zone, a tower shall meet the following additional requirements:
- 1. A petitioner shall have the burden of demonstrating that:
 - a. There is no available, suitable site for the tower in a medium or high intensity commercial zone, identifying with particularity any sites considered; or
 - b. Due to topographical or other unique features, the proposed site is more consistent with the legislative policy under Section 426.2 than a site in an available medium or high intensity commercial zone.

As detailed above, there are no suitable sites for a new monopole in a medium or high intensity commercial zone. Because of this, and the fact that the Property is the largest and most appropriate property in the area that needs coverage, no other sites were considered.

2. A tower in an R.C. Zone shall be located on a lot of at least five acres. In all other residential or transitional zones, a tower shall be located on a lot of at least three acres.

The Property is zoned DR-2 and is not located in an RC zone.

3. In granting a special exception, the Zoning Commissioner, or Board of Appeals upon appeal, shall impose conditions or restrictions as provided in Section 502.2. In addition, the Commissioner shall require that the tower be disguised as a structure or natural formation, such as a flagpole, steeple or tree, which is found, or likely to be found, in the area of the tower unless the Commissioner finds that the requirement is not reasonable or advisable for the protection of properties surrounding the tower.

Prime hired Environmental Corporation of American (ECA) to conduct the federally required review and analysis under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Under federal law, the NEPA study will need to be completed prior to construction. Although the NEPA study hasn't been completed to date, ECA completed a preliminary assessment and concluded that (1) the Facility will not be constructed in a Wilderness Area, Wildlife Preserve, or Floodplain and (2) will not likely impact any historic properties, Indian religious sites, wetlands, and/or other NEPA categories. The preliminary NEPA from ECA dated July 14, 2017 and is attached at Tab 10.

The TRC specifically noted that "no historical landmarks appear to be nearby" and thee "existing tree-line will offer additional natural screening. <u>See TRC Memo, p. 3 at Tab 2</u>.

The visual impact survey illustrates that the proposed monopole will barely be visible off of the Property and, to the extent that it is visible, will have little, if any, impact on the surrounding areas. See visual impact survey and photosimulations at Tab 9.

Consequently, the visual impact of the tower will be de minimis, if it exists at all. For these reasons, no stealthing is necessary because the monopole design will be "stealthed" by the totality of the factors contributing to this project.

§ 502.7. Wireless telecommunications towers.

These provisions are not applicable to the Facility because it is not (1) over 200 feet in height, (2) located in an RC zone, and (3) located within a designated scenic viewshed. Regardless, and as shown in the <u>Visual Impact Survey attached as Tab 9</u>, the proposed Facility will not interfere with or be detrimental to any viewshed elements.

VI. Conclusion

For the reasons set forth above, in the attached supporting documents, and the application package submitted to the County, Prime respectfully requests that Baltimore County grant the requested special exception relief and, if necessary, grant he special hearing relief to either (1) exclude the Facility from the original special exception (1975 – 0233 SPHX) or (2) find that both the FOP Lodge and Facility can co-exist without sharing space.

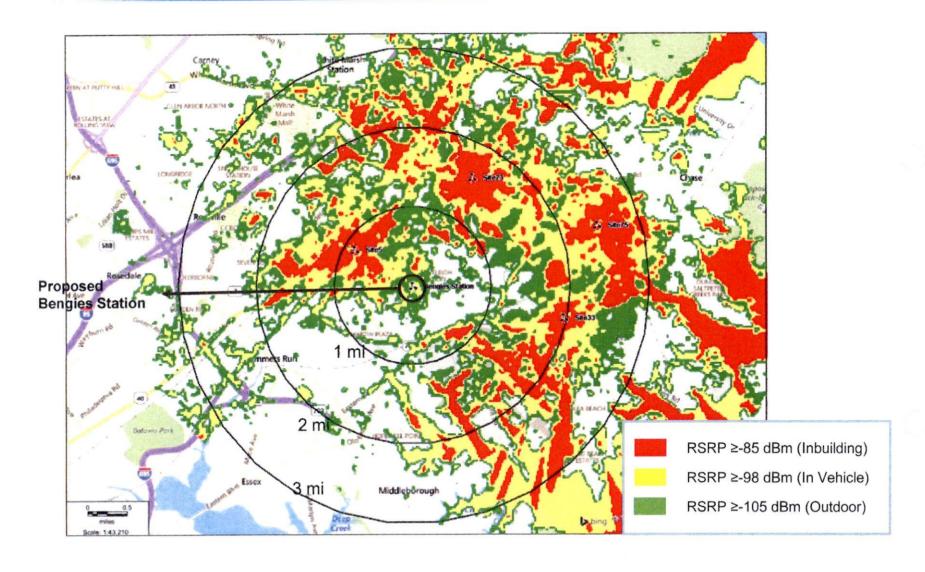

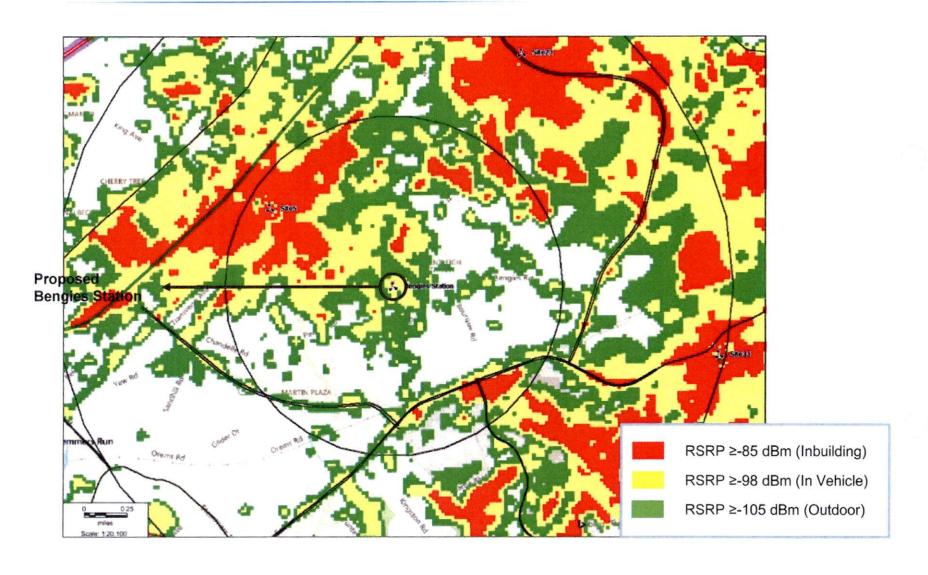
RF Propagation Map of Current Coverage

The Tower Review Committee (TRC) met with a representatives of Prime Tower Development (PTD), LLC on June 27, 2017, and discussed their formal site application, which was received by the TRC by the deadline of June 6, 2017.

PTD's is the 2nd applicant to approach the TRC vying for the 730 Wampler Rd location. ECO Sites, LLC (ECO) previously in December 2016 applied for the proposed location and received TRC approval in the recommendation memo dated 03/03/17; however, it was later learned that ECO does not have a signed lease with the property owner, whereas PTD does in fact have a signed agreement with the property owner.

PTD has shown that the proposed site is in the interest of Sprint, and is needed to improve coverage and capacity which is lacking in the targeted area.

The TRC's assessment of the application is as follows:

The proposed monopole designed tower structure, with an overall height of 107' including all appurtenances, would be constructed by PTD at the proposed Middle River location in Councilmanic District #6.

Pursuant to the PTD site application, the TRC is submitting the following advisory comments to the Development Review Committee (DRC) of the Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections (PAI), in accordance with Article #4 — Section #426 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations:

Antennas should be placed on existing towers, buildings, and structures, including those of public utilities, where feasible.

Findings:

Alternative collocation sites were not explored by PTD's RF engineer, because no existing antenna structures were available within a 1 mile radius of the proposed site that could serve the target area.

> If a tower must be built, the tower should be: Constructed to accommodate at least three providers.

Findings:

PTD has shown in supplemental drawings submitted to the TRC along with the application that their proposed 107' monopole tower is designed to support, starting from Sprint at the top position, a minimum of two additional wireless service providers, each 10' apart.

It should be noted that upon construction the tower is subject to a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) ruling, which mandates that once a structure is approved and constructed, the structure may be increased in height or width by up to an additional 20-ft for collocation purposes, and a local government cannot deny and must approve.

In the case of this application, however, extending the height of the tower would be denied by the FAA, based on its notification that no tower higher than 107' would be acceptable in the proposed location, due to the tower's proximity to Martin State Airport.

The County Attorney is a recommended resource for a proper interpretation of the relevant FCC laws and rulings.

> Erected in a medium or high intensity commercial zone when available.

Findings:

The proposed site location is in a DR-2 (Density Residential) zone, with adjacent property zoning of DR-2, as well.

Per preliminary engineering drawings, aerial photography, and other information presented to the TRC by PTD, the tower meets the setback requirement of at least 200' from residential property lines on all sides.

Due to the zoning of the property, a Special Exception hearing will be required.

> Located and designed to minimize its visibility from residential and transitional zones.

Findings:

The proposed tower will be on property with a very large overall size of approximately 8.86 acres, and no historical landmarks appear to be nearby. The site compound will be fenced in, and the existing tree-line will offer additional natural screening.

PTD's proposed 107' monopole, especially its upper portions, will be visible to some residents. Documented proof of PTD's attempts to reach out to the community was included with their application, but as of the date of the TRC review remained unanswered by their community contacts.

Conclusion:

We, the TRC, agree that applicant PTD has provided documentation to effectively demonstrate the need for a new telecommunications tower site to be constructed as preferred in the location of 730 Wampler Rd, Middle River, MD 21220.

Based on Applicant PTD's presentation and burden of proof to the TRC, and all of the above findings, the TRC agrees that there are no existing structures within one mile of the of the proposed site which would sufficiently address Sprint's RF requirements. Therefore, the proposed new tower site is necessary to expand Sprint coverage and capacity in the target area for both in-vehicle and in-building end users.

It should be noted that PTD submitted, post-meeting, an affidavit signed by the property owner as proof of their business commitment. Also, note that the TRC Coordinator recalled during a phone conversation, that ECO seemed to indicate that they planned to abandon their project and move on from their approved TRC application; however, an email to ECO requesting the status of their project for written verification produced no reply.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Tower Review Committee, by unanimous decision, Conditionally Approves and Recommends the Applicant PTD to construct a new 107-ft tall tower as proposed; however, subject to any prevailing Zoning requirements, as well as to any Legal requirements in the event of a site dispute with previous applicant ECO.

The TRC requests that the advisory comments provided herein be forwarded to the Development Review Committee for further processing.

Optionee may at Optionee's sole cost and expense procure an abstract of title or a commitment to Issue a policy of title insurance on the Premises. In the event that Optionee objects to any defect or cloud on title to the Premises, Optionee may declare this Agreement to be void and of no further force or effect whereupon this Option shall become null and void and there shall be no further liability of Optionee to Optionor; and

- (b) If Optionor is not an individual, then Optionor is duly organized, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of its state of organization or formation, and is duly qualified as necessary to transact business in the state where the Property is located. Optionor has the power and authority to execute, deliver and be bound by the each and every term of this Agreement and neither the execution and delivery of this Agreement, nor the consummation of the transactions contemplated herein, will conflict with, constitute and event of default under, or result in a breach of any term, condition or provision of (i) Optionor's certificate of incorporation, by-laws, partnership agreement or operating agreement, as applicable, or (ii) any other agreement to which Optionor is a party or by which Optionor is bound; and
- (c) There are no pending or threatened legal, regulatory or administrative actions including bankruptcy or insolvency proceedings under any state or federal law, or any other suits, claims or causes of action against Optionor which may adversely affect Optionor's ability to perform under this agreement, or which may otherwise affect the Premises; and
- (d) The Premises are not presently subject to an option, lease, or other contract which may adversely affect Optionor's ability to fulfill its obligations under this Option, and Optionor covenants and agrees that Optionor shall not grant an option or enter into any contract which will affect the Premises until this Option expires or is terminated by Optionee; and

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- 8. <u>Inspections and Investigations.</u> Optioner hereby grants to Optionee, its officers, agents, employees, independent contractors, and prospective licensec(s) and sublessec(s) the right and privilege to enter upon the Premises at any time after the date of this Option, to perform or cause to be performed test borings of the soil, environmental audits, and engineering studies, and to conduct a survey of the Premises. Optionor shall provide Optionee with all necessary keys and access codes to the Premises if needed for ingress and egress, and Optionee shall not unreasonably interfere with Optionor's use of the Premises in conducting these activities.
- 9. Further Acts. Optioner shall cooperate with Optionee in executing all documents necessary to protect Optionee's rights under this Option or Optionee's use of the Premises and shall take such action as Optionee may reasonably require to effect the intent of this Option. Optionor hereby irrevocably appoints Optionee or Optionee's agent as Optionor's agent to file applications on behalf of Optionor with federal, state, and local governmental authorities which applications relate to Optionee's intended use of the Premises including, but not limited to, land use and zoning applications. Optionor agrees to cooperate with Optionee in obtaining, at Optionee's expense, all licenses, permits and other regulatory nuthorizations ("Government Approvals") associated with Optionee's Intended Use (as defined below) of the Premises.

(a) Lessee shall have the right, at Lessee's sole cost and expense, to creet, maintain, demolish and reconstruct, and restore, replace, and reconfigure on the Premises improvements, personal property, and facilities, including without limitation, towers, structural tower base(s), radio transmitting and receiving antennas, communications equipment, equipment cabinets and shelters, and related facilities (collectively, the "Tower Facilities"). The Tower Facilities shall remain the exclusive property of the

Lessee shall remove all of the above-ground portions of the Tower Facilities following any termination of this Lease. Lessor grants Lessee the right to clear all trees, undergrowth, and other obstructions, and to trim, cut, and keep trimmed and cut all tree limbs which may interfere with or fall upon the Tower Facilities or Premises during the Initial Term or any Renewal Term. Lessor grants Lessee a non-exclusive easement in, over, across and through other real property owned by Lessor as reasonably required for construction, installation, maintenance, and operation of the Tower Facilities. - 11. <u>Subleases</u>. 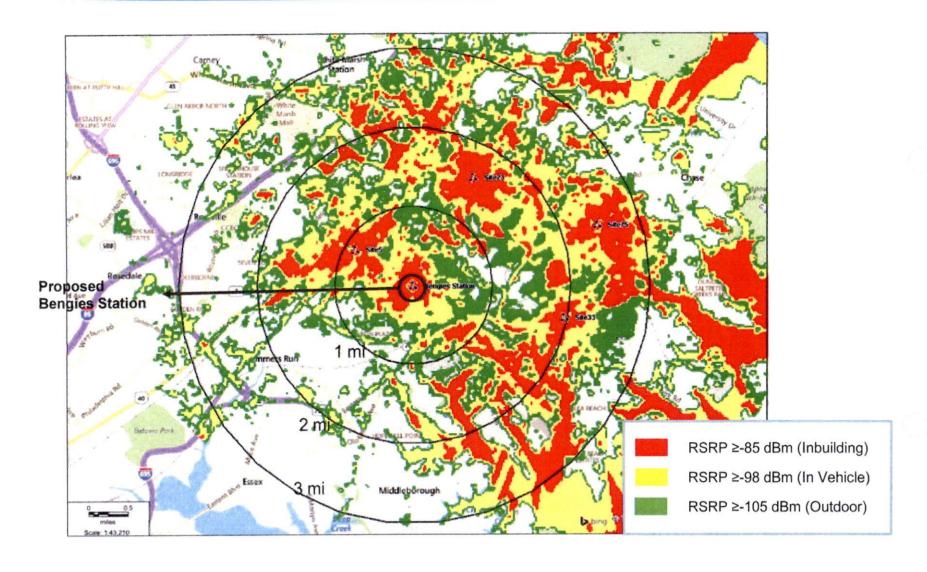

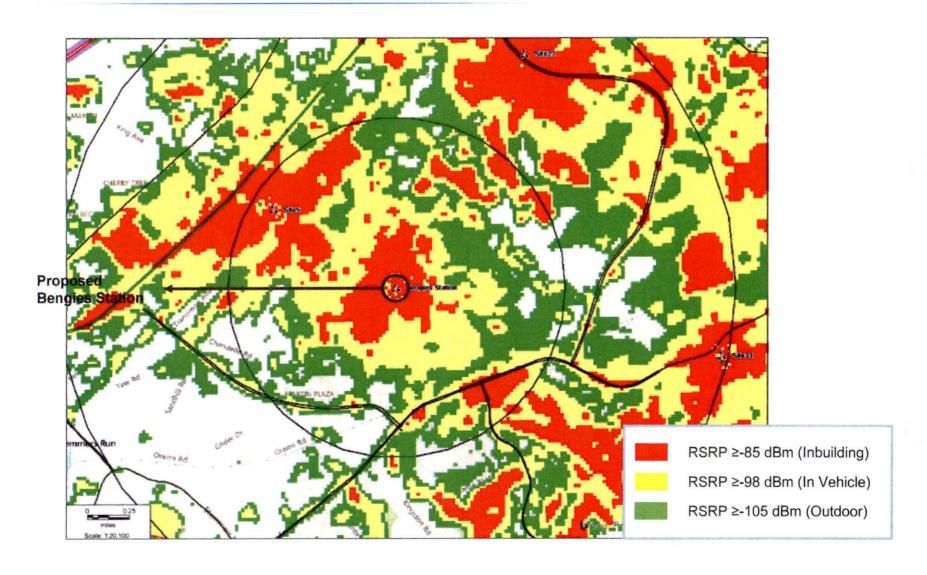
RF Propagation Map of Expected Coverage at 104'

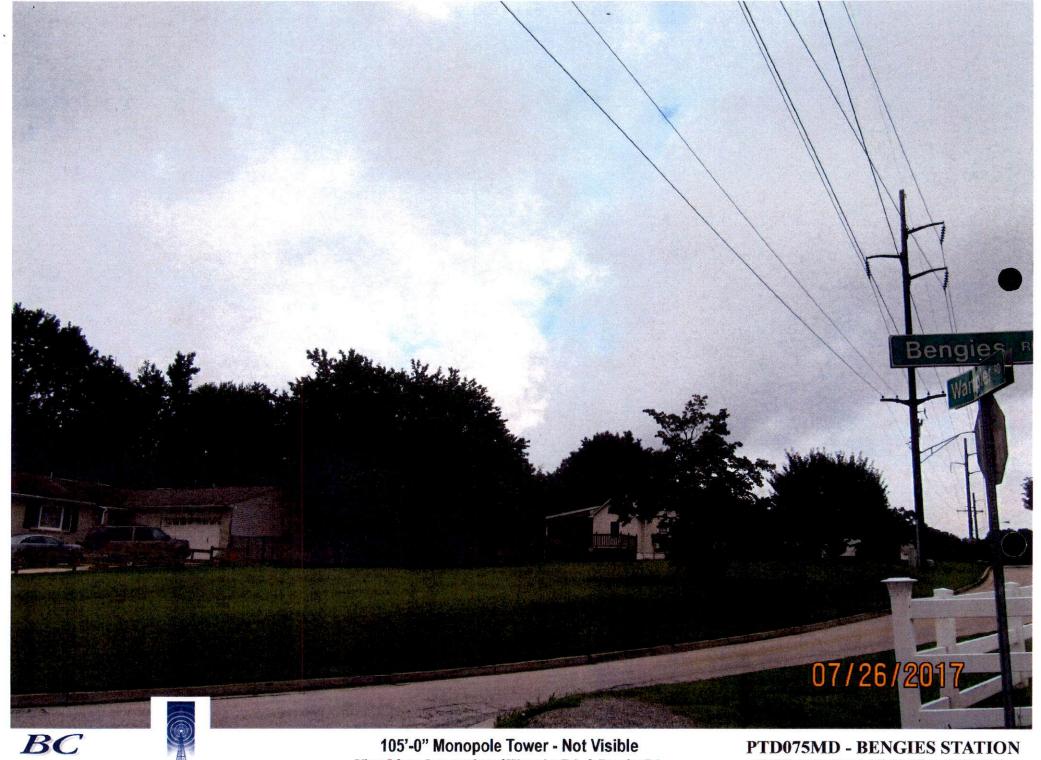






View 3 from Intersection of Wampler Rd. & Salvatore Rd.



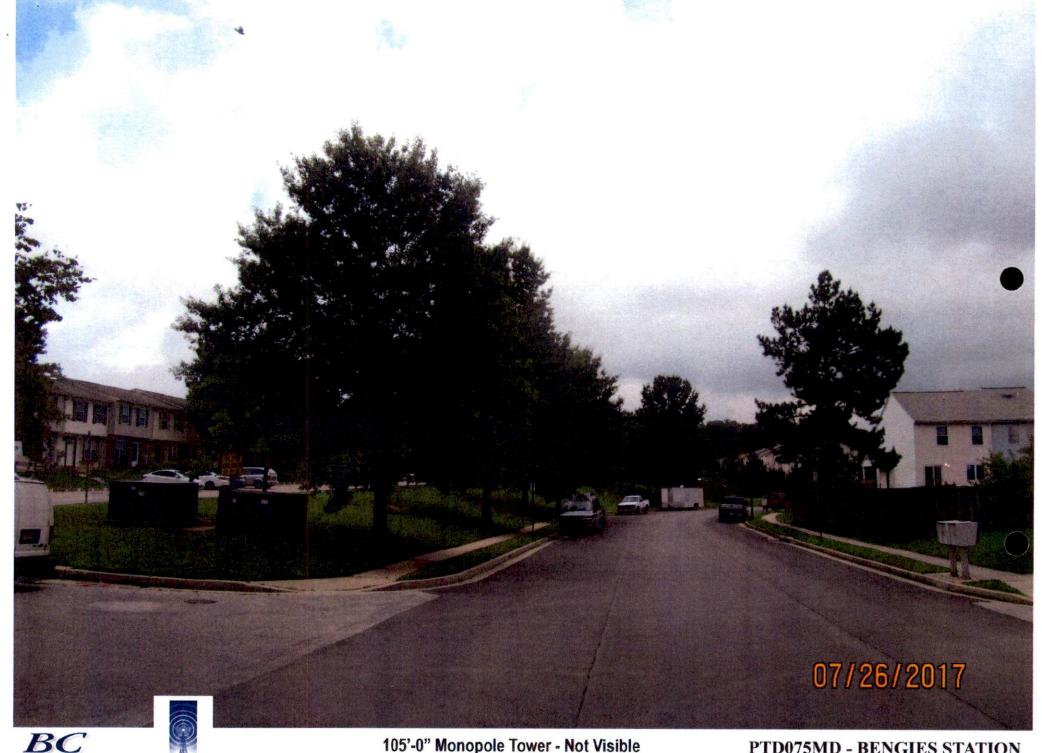

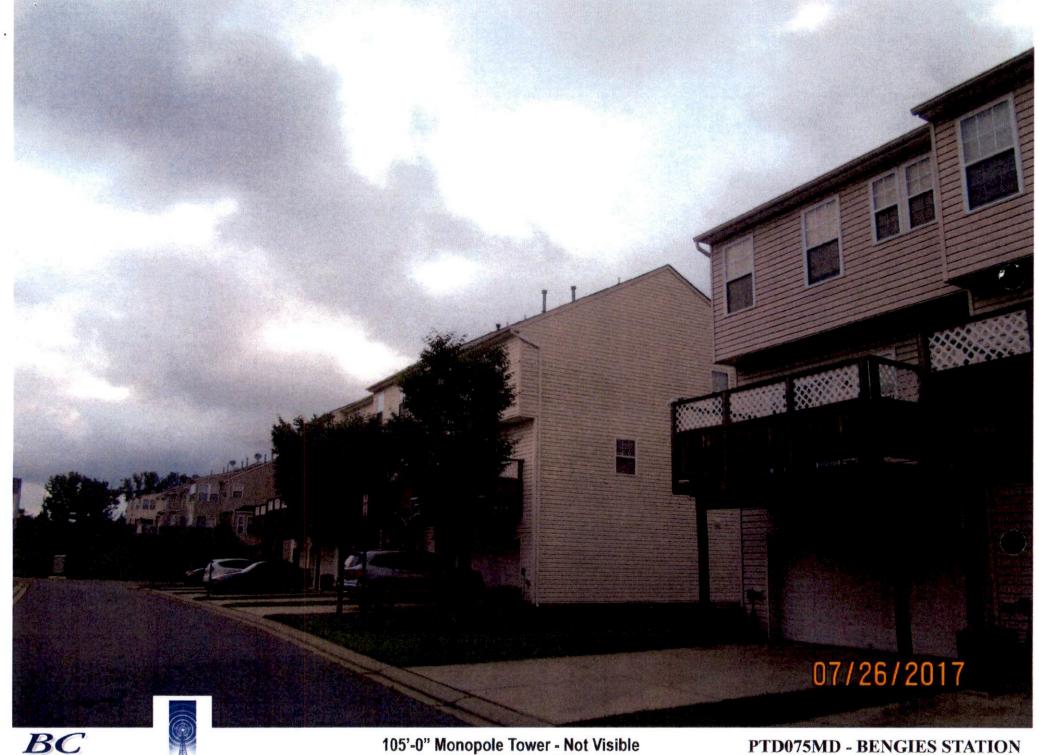

Environmental Corporation of America (ECA) has been retained by Prime Tower Development, LLC., to provide a FCC NEPA Environmental Checklist report for a federal undertaking. The undertaking includes the construction of a proposed 107-foot overall height monopole telecommunications structure and associated equipment.

In accordance with FCC Rules and Regulations contained in 47 CFR Sections 1.1301 through 1.1319, evaluation of the impacts to the following FCC NEPA categories is required prior to construction. These include Wilderness Areas, Wildlife Preserves, federally listed, endangered, or threatened species, Historic Properties, Indian Religious Sites, Floodplains, and Wetlands and Waters. In addition, the FCC requires that towers taller than 200 feet in height complete the Antenna Structure Registration (ASR) process.

ECA has found no evidence that the proposed tower facility would be constructed in a Wilderness Area, Wildlife Preserve, or Floodplain. Analysis of species, Historic Properties, Indian Religious Sites, and Wetlands and Waters is currently being conducted; however, based on initial research it is unlikely the construction of the proposed facility would impact any of these NEPA categories. In addition, Prime Tower Development, LLC., will file an ASR application with the FCC.

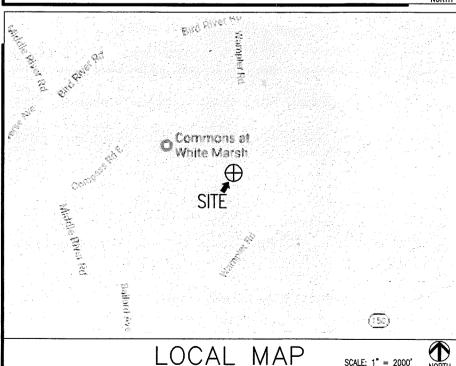
