#### OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of a Petition for Special Exception filed on behalf of Delores White-Rose, legal owner and Forefront Power, LLC, lessee ("Petitioners"). The Special Exception was filed pursuant to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to use the property for a 1,980 kilowatt (kW) A/C ground-mounted solar facility.

Kelsey Crane, Brian Maliszewski, Delores White-Rose, Shana Beiger and professional engineer Andrew Miller appeared in support of the petition. Lawrence E. Schmidt, Esq. represented the Petitioners. Cathy Wolfson, of the Greater Patapsco Community Association, attended the hearing and opposed the request. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Department of Planning (DOP), the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR) the State Highway Administration (SHA), and Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS). None of the reviewing agencies opposed the requests.

The subject property is approximately 16.75 acres and is zoned RC-2. The property is unimproved and is situated along Old Court Road in the Granite area. Forefront proposes to install on the property 6,822 solar panels which would be enclosed within a fence. The enclosure area

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would be approximately 9.81 acres in size. The panels would be 6-8 feet in height and would be set back a minimum of 50 ft. from any property boundary.

#### Special Exception

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate, LLC*, 451 Md. 272 (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use.

Professional engineer Andrew Miller testified via proffer the facility would be unmanned and would generate no noise or traffic. While not required under County law, Forefront undertook a "glare analysis" and determined the project would satisfy Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) standards. Those standards are designed to ensure a pilot's vision is not obscured by glare, and while they are not applicable in this case it is helpful to know the project would satisfy those rigorous standards. Mr. Miller opined Petitioner satisfied the requirements of B.C.Z.R. §502.1.

A landscape plan has not yet been approved for this project, although Petitioners submitted a proposed plan (Ex. 2) which reflects that substantial vegetative buffers would be installed around the periphery of the site, and Mr. Miller did not believe the solar panels would in fact be visible to motorists on Old Court Road. A chain-link fence will also enclose the panels, and Forefront representatives indicated they would be amenable to installing slats or sheeting on the fence to soften its appearance.

Ms. Wolfson stated her association met and voted to object to the proposal, based solely upon the anticipated (negative) visual impact the project will have on the community. Solar panels certainly do not improve the view shed in a rural area; a forest or open field would have more aesthetic appeal. But the County Council recently enacted legislation (Bill 37-17) which permits such facilities in the RC zones, and the petition cannot be denied based on aesthetics. In special exception parlance, the lack of visual appeal is an inherent negative impact of the use, and the Council is presumed to have been aware of this when it enacted the legislation. Without proof that the use would have non-inherent impacts at this location I believe the petition should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 7th day of December, 2017, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Exception to use the property for a 1,980 kilowatt (kW) A/C ground-mounted solar facility in accordance with Section 4E-102 of Baltimore County Council Bill No. 37-17, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioners must obtain from SHA an entrance or access permit.
- 3. Petitioners must comply with the ZAC comments of the DOP, DPR & DEPS, copies of which are attached.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

#### Stormwater Design Guidance - Solar Panel Installations

Revisions to Maryland's stormwater management regulations in 2010 require that environmental site design (ESD) be used to the maximum extent practicable (MEP) to mimic natural hydrology, reduce runoff to reflect forested wooded conditions, and minimize the impact of land development on water resources. This applies to any residential, commercial, industrial, or institutional development where more than 5,000 square feet of land area is disturbed. Consequently, stormwater management must be addressed even when permeable features like solar panel installations exceed 5,000 square feet of land disturbance.

Depending on local soil conditions and proposed imperviousness, the amount of rainfall that stormwater requirements are based on varies from 1.0 to 2.6 inches. However, addressing stormwater management does not mean that structural or micro-scale practices must be constructed to capture and treat large volumes of runoff. Using nonstructural techniques like disconnecting impervious cover reduces runoff by promoting overland filtering and infiltration. Commonly used with smaller or narrower impervious areas like driveways or open roads, the Disconnection of Non-Rooftop Runoff technique (see pp. 5.61 to 5.65 of the 2000 Maryland Stormwater Design Manual<sup>1</sup>) is a low cost alternative for treating runoff in situations like rows of solar panels.

When non-rooftop disconnection is used to treat runoff, the following factors should be considered:

- The vegetated area receiving runoff must be equal to or greater in length than the disconnected surface (e.g., width of the row of solar panels)
- · Runoff must sheet flow onto and across vegetated areas to maintain the disconnection
- Disconnections should be located on gradual slopes (≤ 5%) to maintain sheetflow. Level spreaders, terraces, or berms may be used to maintain sheetflow conditions if the average slope is steeper than 5%. However, installations on slopes greater than 10% will require an engineered plan that ensures adequate treatment and the safe and non-erosive conveyance of runoff to the property line or downstream stormwater management practice.
- Disconnecting impervious surfaces works best in undisturbed soils. To minimize disturbance and compaction, construction vehicles and equipment should avoid areas used for disconnection during installation of the solar panels.
- Groundcover vegetation must be maintained in good condition in those areas receiving
  disconnected runoff. Typically this maintenance is no different than other lawn or landscaped
  areas. However, areas receiving runoff should be protected (e.g., planting shrubs or trees along
  the perimeter) from future compaction.

Depending on the layout and number of panels installed, the disconnection of non-rooftop runoff technique may address some or all of the stormwater management requirements for an individual project. Where the imperviousness is high or there is other infrastructure (e.g., access roads, transformers), additional runoff may need to be treated. In these situations, other ESD techniques or micro-scale practices may be needed to provide stormwater management for these features.

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#### Example 1 – Using Non-Rooftop Disconnection Where the Average Slope ≤ 5%

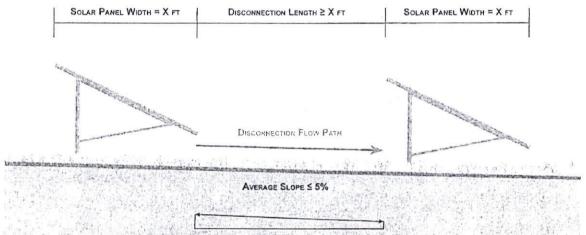


Figure 1. Typical Installation - Slope ≤ 5%

Several rows of solar panels will be installed in an existing meadow. The soils within the meadow are hydrologic soil group (HSG) B and the average slope does not exceed 5%. Each row of panels is 10 feet wide and the distance between rows is 20 feet. The rows of solar panels will be installed according to Figure 1 below. In this scenario, the disconnection length is the same as the distance between rows (20 feet) and is greater than the width of each row (10 feet). Therefore, each row of panels is adequately disconnected and the runoff from 1.0 inch of rainfall is treated.

#### Example 2 – Using Non-Rooftop Disconnection Where the Average Slope ≥ 5% but ≤ 10%

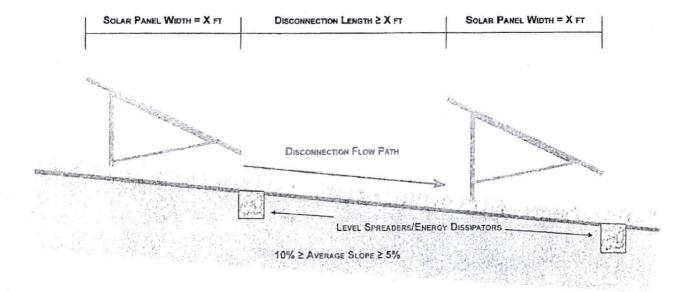


Figure 2. Typical Installation – Slope ≥ 5% but ≤ 10%

Several rows of solar panels will be installed in an existing meadow. The soils within the meadow are hydrologic soil group (HSG) B and the average slope is greater than 5% but less than 10%. Each row of panels is 10 feet wide and the distance between rows is 20 feet. The rows of solar panels will be installed as shown in Figure 2 below. The disconnection length is the same as the distance between rows (20 feet) and is greater than the width of each row (10 feet). However, in this example, a level spreader (typically 1 to 2-foot wide and 1 foot deep) has been located at the drip edge of each row of panels to dissipate energy and maintain sheetflow.

#### Discussion

To meet State and local stormwater management requirements, ESD must be used to the MEP to reduce runoff to reflect forested conditions. While all reasonable options for implementing ESD must be investigated, minimally, the runoff from 1 inch of rainfall must be treated. In each of the examples above, there may be additional opportunities to implement ESD techniques or practices and reduce runoff that should be explored. However, simply disconnecting the runoff from the solar panel arrays captures and treats the runoff from 1.0 inch of rainfall. Where imperviousness is low and soil conditions less optimal (e.g., HSG C or D), this may be sufficient to completely address stormwater management requirements. In more dense applications or in sandy soils, additional stormwater management may be required.

#### Conclusion

The primary purpose of Maryland's stormwater management program is to mimic natural hydrologic runoff characteristics and minimize the impact of land development on water resources. Any land development project that exceeds 5,000 square feet of disturbance, including solar panel projects, must address stormwater management. However, for solar panels, stormwater management may be provided in a cost-effective manner by disconnecting each row of panels and directing runoff over the vegetated areas between the individual rows.

# FOREST CONSERVATION DECLARATION OF PROTECTIVE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

THIS DECLARATION, made this day of the 2009, by Delores White and Vanessa Sue Adams, (the "Declarant"), and BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, A BODY CORPORATE AND POLITIC (the "County").

WHEREAS, the Declarant is the owner in fee simple of all that property situate and lying in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Election District of Baltimore County, Maryland, and more particularly described in a Deed dated July 12, 2001, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County in Liber 15450, folio 442, from Vivian Ann Bruce a/k/a Ann Bruce and William Ross Davidson, Jr. a/k/a William Davidson to Delores White and Vanessa Sue Adams, the ("Property"); and

WHEREAS, Code of Maryland Regulations, as amended (hereafter referred to as "COMAR") Section 08.19.05.02 requires the establishment of long-term protective measures for all land retained as forest, afforested or reforested areas defined in Md. Code Ann. Nat. Res. § 5-1601.

WHEREAS, the Baltimore County Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management ("DEPRM") has primary responsibility for developing and implementing a local forest conservation program within Baltimore County pursuant to Md. Code Ann. Nat. Res. § 5-1603; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the environmental quality of the area of the property, said area containing 2.642 acres (115,095 S.F.), more or less, as designated and shown as Forest Conservation Easement Area ("the "Forest Conservation Easement" on Baltimore County Bureau of Land Acquisition Drawing No. RWO-005-03, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, the Declarant desires to protect said Forest Conservation Easement by imposing covenants, conditions and restrictions which will bind the lots and the present and future owners thereof. The County shall have the legal right to enforce the covenants, conditions and restrictions as set forth herein together with the enforcement rights referenced in Section 4.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the benefits derived by the Declarant and its successors in interest, the said Declarant, for itself, its successors and/or assigns, does hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Except as provided for in an approved Forest Conservation Plan pursuant to § 33-6-110 of the Baltimore County Code, as amended (hereafter referred to as "The Code"):

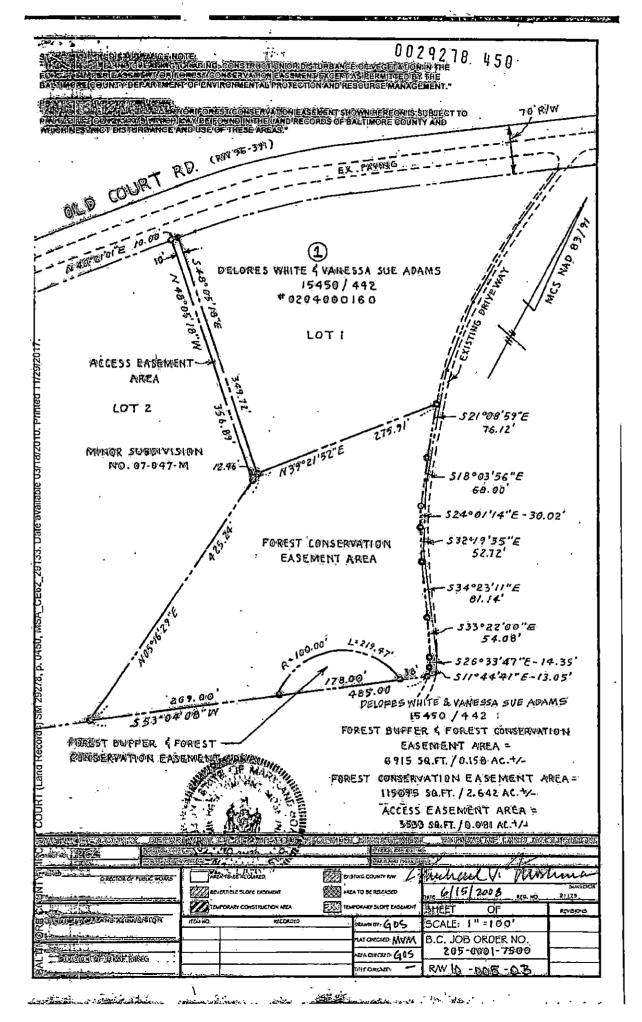

This Department has completed a review of the request for a variance from the Baltimore County Forest Conservation Regulations for the proposed activity on the above referenced property. This request proposes to allow sowing 2.8 acres of woody seed mix onsite in lieu of planting 4.5 acres of individual woody plants to address the afforestation required by the Forest Conservation Law for the proposed two lot minor subdivision.

The Director of DEPRM may grant a special variance to the Forest Conservation law in accordance with criteria outlined in Section 33-6-116 of the Baltimore County Code. There are six criteria listed in Subsection 33-6-116(d) and (e) that shall be used to evaluate the variance request. One of the criteria under Subsection 33-6-116(d) must be met, and all three of the criteria under Subsection 33-6-116(e) must be met, in order to approve the variance.

The first criterion (Subsection 33-6-116(d)(1) of the Code) requires that the petitioner show that the land in question cannot yield a reasonable return and all beneficial use of the property will be deprived if the requirement from which the special variance is requested is imposed. The proposed 21.1-acre subdivision requires 4.5 acres of afforestation, which requires a minimum performance security of \$49,005.00. In this case, full application of the law requiring installation of woody plants and posting of a significant performance security would result in an unwarranted financial hardship to the applicant due to unforeseen and unique circumstances. Therefore, we find that this criterion has been met in this specific case.

The second criterion (Subsection 33-6-116(d)(2) of the Code) requires that the petitioner show that his/her plight is due to unique circumstances and not the general conditions in the neighborhood. The plight is due to unforeseen and unique financial and legal constraints of the applicant, a single property owner solely responsible financially for a subdivision that is bond by legal conditions. Using a seed mix instead of woody specimens is due to this unique financial hardship rather than general conditions in the neighborhood. Therefore, we find that this criterion has been met.

The third criterion (Subsection 33-6-116(d)(3) requires that the petitioner show that the special variance requested will not alter the essential character of the neighborhood. The Forest Conservation Easement to be seeded will ultimately become forest. The area to be planted is located in the southeast corner of the properly on slopes adjacent to a Forest Buffer Easement. Furthermore, the proposed two-lot subdivision is designed to allow the central portion of the site approximately 10.5 acres to remain as a productive agricultural field. Therefore, we find that this criterion has been met.

The fourth criterion (Subsection 33-6-116(e)(1) of the Code) requires that granting the variance will not adversely affect water quality, both during construction and over the long term. We have determined that the proposed Forest Buffer Easement (FBE) and Forest Conservation Easement (FCE) area to be seeded is a priority planting area because of its close proximity to the stream system and steep slopes. Additionally, the FBE/FCE will be posted with permanent protective signage. Therefore, we find that granting of the special variance will not adversely affect water quality, and that this criterion has been met.

The fifth criterion (Subsection 33-6-116(e)(2) of the Code) requires that granting the special variance request does not arise from a condition or circumstance which is the result of actions taken by the petitioner. The petitioner has not taken any actions on the property prior to requesting this variance request. Therefore, this criterion has been met.

The sixth criterion (Subsection 33-6-116(e)(3) of the Code requires that the Director of DEPRM find that the special variance, as granted, would be consistent with the spirit and intent of Article 33 of the Baltimore County Code. Allowing seeding in lieu of planting individual trees would be consistent with the spirit and intent of the Forest Conservation Regulations because both methods will result in creating a forest that will be protected in perpetuity. Furthermore, there is also adequate seed source from nearby pioneer species of trees to aid in the succession of this Forest Buffer and Forest Conservation Easement area.

Based upon our review, this Department finds that all of the criteria have been met. Therefore, the requested variance is hereby approved, in accordance with Section 33-6-116 of the Baltimore County Code with the following conditions:

- 1. The 2.8 acre Forest Conservation Easement and Forest Buffer Easement as shown on the attached exhibit shall be seeded with a native woody tree and shrub mix. The specific seed mix, application rate, site preparation, seeding method, maintenance procedure and permanent protective signage must be detailed on a revised forest conservation plan (FCP) and submitted to this Department for approval prior to minor subdivision approval.
- 2. The Forest Conservation Easement (FCE) shall be permanently posted with "Forest Conservation-Do Not Disturb" signs as shown on the attached exhibit. Surveyed limits of the environmental easement shall be clearly marked in the field at the predetermined intervals with permanent below grade markers to facilitate identification of the easement limits by both homeowners and County staff. The aforementioned "Do Not Disturb" signs should be installed as "witness" posts near each marker location using metal posts as indicated on the FCP. The signs and

markers also must be installed by October 31, 2009 or prior to issuance of any building permits, whichever comes first. Details of the signs and markers are included on the second attachment.

- 3. Seeding of FCE shall be completed by October 31, 2009 and a consultant's report documenting the seed mix used, planting date, application rate and method of seeding shall be submitted by November 30, 2009.
- 4. A note must be added to all plans stating "A variance was granted by the Baltimore County Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management from Baltimore's Forest Conservation Law. Conditions were placed on this variance to reduce forest and water quality impacts including posting permanent protective signage and permanent monuments along the Forest Conservation/Forest Buffer Easement limit.
- 5. The Forest Buffer/Forest Conservation Easement shall be recorded along with the respective Declaration of Protective Covenants in Baltimore County Land Records via a right of way plat process prior to minor subdivision approval.
- 6. The granting of this variance does not exempt future development activities on the property from full compliance with Baltimore County Code Article 33. Environmental; Protection and Resource Management, Title 6. Forest Conservation.

It is the intent of this Department to approve this variance subject to the above conditions. Any changes to site layout may require submittal of revised plans and an amended variance request.

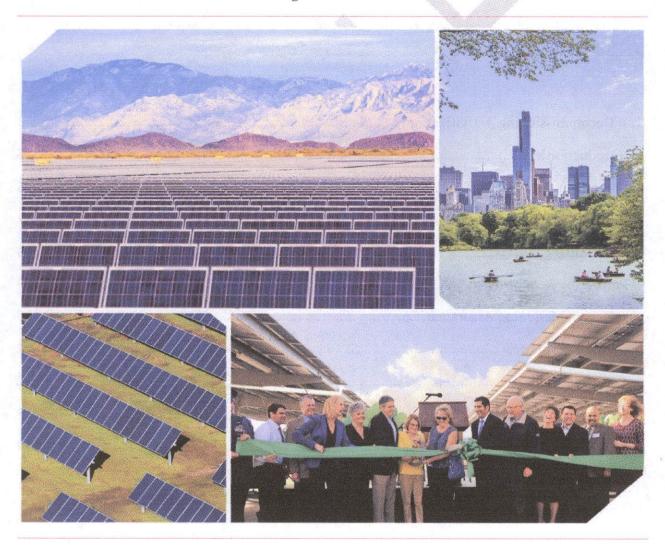

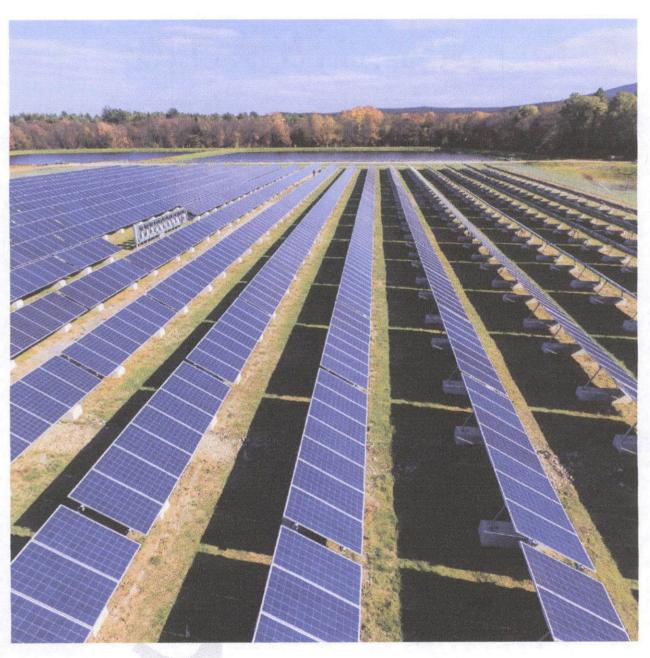
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# 1. Decommissioning Activities









## Introduction

The Decommission Plan (the "Plan") describes anticipated activities and process for decommissioning of the proposed facility following its useful life. The purpose of decommissioning is to restore the Property to a clean, safe and usable condition for continued use by the landowner.

Decommissioning consists of the removal of above-ground and below-ground facility components, management of excess materials and waste as well as the restoration of Project lands, as applicable. Activities are expected to take between 8-10 weeks but no longer than four-months.

Potential negative environmental effects from decommissioning of the facility will be mitigated through use of erosion and sediment control measures, limiting the use of heavy machinery (where possible), and maintaining a buffer from natural features. These control measures, as well as other mitigation measures used during construction will be re-implemented during the decommissioning phase and until the site is stabilized.

Future consultation will occur with the municipality prior to decommissioning to discuss preferences and commitments to restore the Project to its pre-construction condition or a similar state. All decommissioning and restoration activities will adhere to the requirements set forth by Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA) and will be in accordance with all applicable federal, state and local permitting requirements. As with the construction phase, an onsite manager responsible for safety will be present on-site (generally the contractor's project manager) while decommissioning activities are taking place.

The decommissioning plan is based on current procedures and experience. These procedures may be subject to revision based on new experiences and requirements over time. At the time of decommissioning, various options and procedures will be re-evaluated to ensure that decommissioning is safe and beneficial to the environment.

# **Equipment Removal**



A significant amount of the components of the Project will include recyclable or re-saleable components, including copper, aluminum, galvanized steel, and modules. Due to their resale monetary value, these components will be dismantled and disassembled rather than being demolished and disposed of.

Following coordination with the local utility company regarding timing and required procedures for disconnecting the Facility from the private utility, all electrical connections to the system will be disconnected and all connections will be tested locally to confirm that no electric current is running through them before proceeding. All electrical connections to the panels will be cut at the panel and then removed from their framework by cutting or dismantling the connections to the supports. Inverters, transformers, and switchgear will be lifted, secured onto flat beds, and transported off-site for processing.

Modules will be detached from the racking system and stacked for removal. However, in the event of a total fracture, the interior materials are silicon-based and may not be considered hazardous. Disposal of these materials at a landfill will be permissible.

The metal piling systems used to secure the PV system in the ground will be removed entirely and if full removal is not possible, then terminated at a depth greater than four-feet from grade or at bedrock whichever is shallower. The piling materials will be collected and recycled. Additionally, all associated metal mounting structures along with the metal perimeter fencing and gates will be removed and either reused or sent for recycling.

Grade slabs will be broken, removed, and disposed of off-site or recycled. Unless requested by the landowner for the access road to remain, materials from road construction will be removed, shipped off-site for either re-use or disposal. If necessary, the former road bed will be backfilled and graded with material native to the region to blend it with the immediately adjacent and existing topography.

Aboveground utility poles owned by the Project will be completely removed and disposed of off-site in accordance with utility best practices. Overhead wires will be removed from the area of the solar modules and terminated at the point of interconnection. Underground wiring at depths of less than four-feet will be removed and recycled.



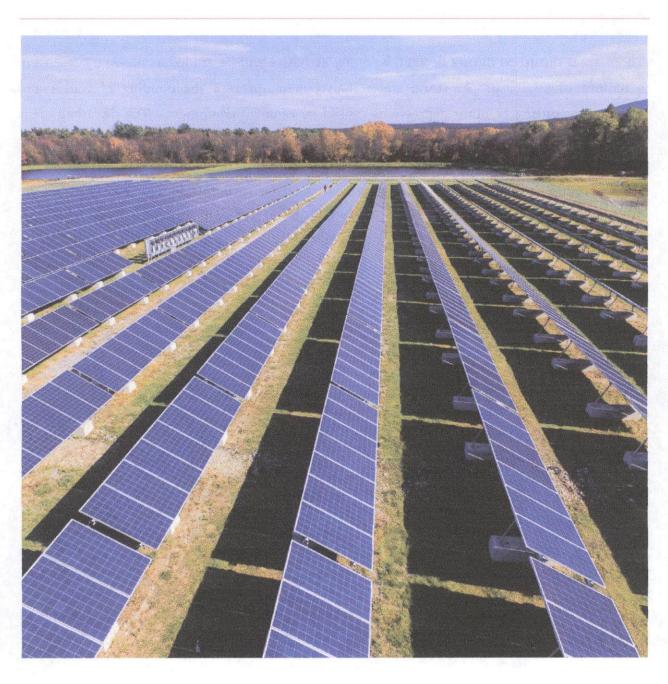
Prior to final demobilization, a final walkthrough of the Project area and the Property is completed to police for and ensure all debris is collected and removed.

# Site Restoration

Those areas disturbed during decommissioning activities will be graded as necessary to ensure a uniform slope for proper storm water management, prevent the ponding of waters and address any rutting or other depressions caused by removal equipment. The disturbed areas will then be seeded either by hand or via hydro seeding to reestablish vegetation compatible with the Property and region. It is anticipated that a seed mix native to the area will be used by the decommissioning contractor, unless the landowner instructs that they will begin using the property for agricultural purposes and will reestablish the area with agricultural vegetation.

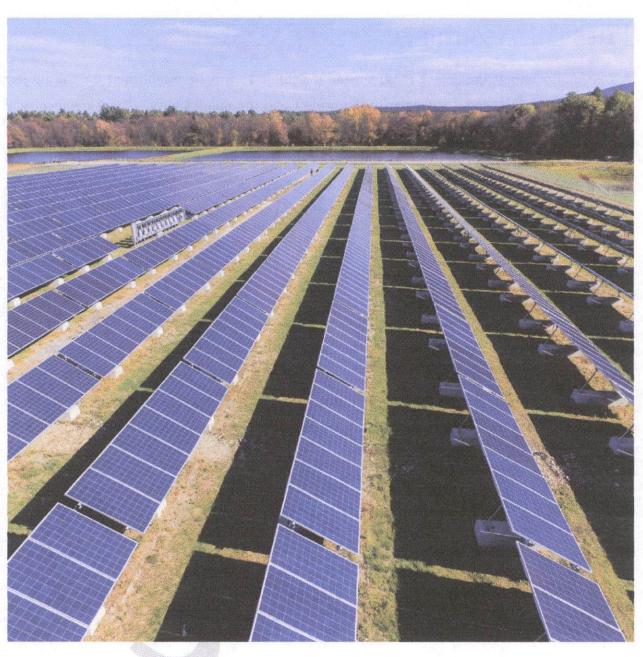
## Permitting & Approvals

Prior to the initiation of decommissioning activities, local code will be reviewed for applicability with decommissioning activities. The municipality will be consulted to confirm and applications made for appropriate permits and approvals, if any. At a minimum, it is anticipated that a new storm water pollution prevention plan (SWPPP) will be required along with a building permit. It is assumed that neither a new or revised site plan or special use permit would be necessary because decommissioning activities are associated with the originally issued approvals.

Throughout the decommissioning process, the municipality will be provided with regular updates and notice upon completing the restoration activities.

#### Form of Assurance

A Decommissioning Agreement ("Agreement"), Exhibit 1, will be established for the project entered into by the Operator/Owner of the project and the municipality. The Agreement will result in the Operator/Owner securing a bond as assurance. The bond will begin with and maintained for the duration term established in the Agreement. The bond will be maintained and updated according to the Agreement and remain in place through the completion of decommissioning activities at the Project. The amount and term of the bond will be established and agreed upon by both parties.

### Use of Assurance

In the event that the Operator/Owner fails to undertake decommissioning activities within the established period of the Agreement, the municipality shall have the right to undertake decommissioning activities and make a claim against the decommissioning assurance. In such circumstances, the municipality shall have such access to the Property as may be necessary to allow its qualified contractors to conduct decommissioning activities.

The amount of the bond or security shall be no less than one hundred ten percent (110%) of the cost of the removal of the solar energy system and restoration of the site, and shall be reviewed and adjusted at five (5)-year intervals upon request of the County; and

Further, prior to the end of each 5-year period after the establishment of the security, upon County's request, the Operator shall provide the County with an updated Removal Letter setting forth an updated estimate for the removal of such obsolete and or unused structures, which updated estimate shall be subject to review and approval by the County, which approval shall not unreasonably be withheld and the Security shall be changed to reflect the updated estimate approved by the County for such removal and restoration of the site;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises set forth below, and after good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

#### **SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF PREAMBLE**

The Preamble shall be incorporated into and become an enforceable part of this Surety Agreement.

#### **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This agreement shall be effective upon its execution by all parties hereto. This agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts.

#### SECTION 3. OBLIGATIONS, DUTIES, AND RIGHTS OF THE COUNTY

- a. Upon removal and decommissioning of the Solar Energy System, the Operator shall inform the County accordingly, in writing. Upon the County's determination that the Operator has decommissioned and removed the Solar Energy System and restored the Property as required under the Site Plan Approval, the County shall: (i) release the Operator from this agreement; (ii) issue a certificate of completion and release and (iii) return or release any unused portion of the Security to the Operator. A determination that the removal and restoration has been satisfactorily completed shall be in the reasonable discretion of the County. The Operator and its agents and consultants shall fully comply with all reasonable requests for inspections and information by the County and its agents.
- b. If the Operator fails to complete the required removal of the Solar Energy System and restoration of the Property within six (6) months of cessation of the Solar Energy System as set forth herein, the County shall be entitled to utilize the Security provided hereunder to the extent necessary, in the County's reasonable discretion, to complete the removal and restoration process. Any portion of the Security that is not utilized as set forth herein shall be returned to the Operator, less reasonable administrative costs. In the event that the County elects to obtain the Security, in whole or in part, as described in this paragraph, it shall notify the Operator accordingly, in writing and, within fourteen (14) days of such writing, the Security shall be paid to the County.

# SECTION 4. OBLIGATIONS, DUTIES, AND RIGHTS OF THE OPERATOR AND SURETY ENTITY

- a. The Operator shall deliver, to the County, suitable evidence of the establishment of the Security prior to the (tenth) 10<sup>th</sup> year of operation of the Solar Energy System. The County requires that the Operator obtain a Surety for the Security, with said Surety binding itself to a Surety Agreement with the County.
- b. Upon County's request, within thirty (30) days prior to the end of each five (5)-year period after the establishment of the Security, the Operator shall provide the County

with an updated Removal Letter setting forth an updated estimate for the removal of such obsolete and or unused structures and the Security shall be altered to reflect the updated estimate for such removal. The Operator shall deliver to the County evidence of the new balance of the Security, as aforesaid.

- c. The Operator agrees that the Security shall not be released except in accordance with the terms hereof.
- d. The Operator agrees that the Security shall not be released in full, unless another method of security is provided, until the removal and restoration has been satisfactorily completed as reasonably determined by the County and the County issued a Certificate of Compliance evidencing same.
- e. The Operator shall at all times provide the County forthwith (no more than forty five (45) days after transfer of title) with the name of the current Operator or Operators of the Solar Energy System.

#### SECTION 5. BINDING EFFECT

This agreement, and any amendments thereto, shall be binding on the Operator, the Operator's agents and representatives, and any successors to the Operator's title, interest, and rights in the parcel of land constituting this subdivision, including executors, administrators, devisees, heirs, successors and assigns of the Operator

#### SECTION 6. USE OF TERMINOLOGY

Use of the term "Operator" in this surety agreement is for convenience only and should not be considered as a limitation on those parties who may be subject to and bound by the provisions of this agreement and any amendments thereon. Use of the term "Site Planning County" or "County" in this covenant is for convenience only and may include agents or representatives of the Site Planning County.
