OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County for consideration of a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owners of the property, James R. Morgan and Elizabeth M. Bidinger ("Petitioners"). The Petitioners are requesting Variance relief pursuant to § 400.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit an accessory structure (pool) to be located in the front yard in lieu of the required rear yard. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

The Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. A ZAC comment was received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS"), dated October 12, 2017, indicating Petitioners must comply with certain environmental regulations as set forth in Article 33 of the Baltimore County Code ("B.C.C."). In addition, DEPS noted that Ground Water Management must review any proposed building permits, since the site is on well and septic.

The Petitioners having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on October 7, 2017, and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioners have filed the supporting affidavits as required by § 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code ("B.C.C."). Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Administrative Law Judge, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of § 307.1 of the B.C.Z.R. Furthermore, strict compliance with the B.C.Z.R. would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioners.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the Baltimore County Code and the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.
