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OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Special Exception filed on behalf of Stilling Properties, LLC, legal owner and Two Farms, Inc., lessee ("Petitioners"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") as follows: (1) to approve a waiver; (2) to permit the redevelopment of a portion of the site in a riverine floodplain; and (3) to allow grading, paving, installation of a sidewalk and sign, concrete curb and gutter, stormwater management facility, storm drain, landscaping and other site work improvements within the floodplain. A Petition for Special Exception was filed to use the property for a fuel service station on an individual site.

Jeff Bambridge, professional engineer Joshua Sharon, landscape architect Matthew Bishop, traffic engineer Mark Keeley and Jason Stilling attended the public hearing in support of the requests. David H. Karceski, Esq. and A. Neill Thupari, Esq. represented the Petitioners. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR) and Department of Planning (DOP). Neither agency opposed the requests.

ORDER RE	CEIVED FOR FILING
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The subject property is approximately 1.153 acres in size and is zoned BL-AS, with an extremely small portion zoned DR 5.5. All proposed improvements would be in the BL-AS zoned portion of the site. The property was previously zoned BL, but during the 2016 Comprehensive Zoning Map Process the property was rezoned to BL-AS. Petitioners' Ex. 3.

At present there is a liquor store and automotive service garage at the property. Petitioners would raze those structures and construct a Royal Farms Store with gasoline pumps, convenience store and carry-out restaurant. Such a use(s) is permitted by special exception in the BL-AS zone.

SPECIAL HEARING

The special hearing pertains to a waiver of certain requirements pertaining to a riverine floodplain on the property. As shown on the plan, only a small portion of the 100-year floodplain is located on the subject property, and no structures or buildings are proposed in that location. Instead, Petitioners propose to install within the floodplain landscaping and curb, gutter, sidewalk and utility improvements along Harlem Lane. The County Code (BCC §32-4-414) permits such infrastructure items to be located within the floodplain, as noted in a November 29, 2017 memorandum from the Director of Department of Public Works (DPW). Petitioners' Ex. 8. That agency did not object to the waiver request and the petition for special hearing will therefore be granted.

SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate*, *LLC*, 451 Md. 272, (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances

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showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use.

Messrs. Sharon, Bishop and Keeley (each of whom was accepted as an expert) testified via proffer the Petitioners satisfied each of the requirements set forth in the B.C.Z.R. §502.1. They each also opined the adverse impacts of this special exception use would be no greater at this location than it would be at other BL-AS zoned sites. As such the petition for special exception will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 5th day of December 2017, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing as follows: (1) to approve a waiver; (2) to permit the redevelopment of a portion of the site in a riverine floodplain; and (3) to allow grading, paving, installation of a sidewalk and sign, concrete curb and gutter, storm water management facility, storm drain, landscaping and other site work improvements within the floodplain, as shown in detail on the site plan admitted as Petitioners' Exhibit 1A, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Special Exception to use the subject property for a fuel service station on an individual site be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt
 of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that
 proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date
 hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for
 whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to
 return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioners shall have five (5) years from the date hereof in which to utilize the special exception.
- 3. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must submit for approval by Baltimore County landscape and lighting plans for the site.

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Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

Good Afternoon,

I am the President of the Ingleside Neighborhood Association of Catonsville, Inc. I am writing as a concerned community organization regarding hearing 2018-010-SPHX at 6126-32 Edmondson Avenue. The addresses 6126-6132 Edmondson Avenue are within the boundaries of our neighborhood association (see attached map). On December 1st, Two Farms Inc. (a property management division for Royal Farms) was granted a special exception by the Office of Administrative Hearings to move forward with this project. This project could not be built on this site by-right, therefore requiring the administrative hearing. I found out about project from a board member of the Academy Heights Civic Association in the evening of January 4, 2017 (after the 30 day appeal/comment window). This involves properties currently housing 2 auto repair facilities and a liquor store. I provide the following information regarding this project.

- 1. The Ingleside Neighborhood Association of Catonsville, Inc. was not contacted at all, even though we are legally registered with the county as the neighborhood association representing this area. We definitely an interested party.
- 2. While apparently there was a sign about the hearing according to the document produced by the Office Administrative Hearings. No one in the community has (to the best of my knowledge) has seen the sign and the business owners (who are tenants in those buildings and also work on site) also did not see a sign. For a sign that is required to be posted for 20 days prior the hearing, this tells me that the sign was not post conspicuously. Furthermore, the tenant business owner of the liquor store at 6124, "Mr. O" did not find out until a few days ago that anything was going to happen to the site, when his landlord informed him that his lease was not being renewed, essentially becoming month-to-month. He has also not seen any signs.
- 3. Two Farms, advertised the legal notice only in the Jeffersonian, a Towson area newspaper that does NOT have distribution in the Catonsville area. The local newspaper for Catonsville is the Catonsville Times.
- 4. On the Opinion and Order it states that there were no parties present that were opposed the project. This in itself is suspicious.
- 5. According to Cathy Engers at Councilman Tom Quirk's office, the hearing notice on the County's website may not have been posted until 12/1/2017 (the day of the meeting), since the website is updated semi-monthly. This does not represent a good-faith effort to inform the public about the hearing.

The Ingleside Neighborhood Association is requests the following.

- 1. Please provide the dates and the specific location where the sign were posted on these 3 properties?
- 2. Please let us know the proper newspaper where these postings are to be made? Is it common to post these notices in newspapers that do not circulate in an affected community?
- 3. We would like to know why there was not enough time given to have to hearing placed on the county's website <u>prior</u> to the day of the hearing?
- 4. We would like to know why our neighborhood association (the association registered with the county to represent this area) was not properly notified regarding this hearing.
- 5. We would like to know why the adjoining neighbors were not properly notified of this hearing.
- 6. We request site plans and all documentation provided to the Office of Administrative Hearings for Baltimore County from Two Farms, Inc. and a parties representing Two Farms, Inc. regarding hearing # 2018-010-SPHX

Enclosed are following documents: the Opinion and Order for the Special Exception, the Newspaper Certificate, the Certificate of Posting, and a map of our neighborhood's boundaries.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Special Exception filed on behalf of Stilling Properties, LLC, legal owner and Two Farms, Inc., lessee ("Petitioners"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") as follows: (1) to approve a waiver; (2) to permit the redevelopment of a portion of the site in a riverine floodplain; and (3) to allow grading, paving, installation of a sidewalk and sign, concrete curb and gutter, stormwater management facility, storm drain, landscaping and other site work improvements within the floodplain. A Petition for Special Exception was filed to use the property for a fuel service station on an individual site.

Jeff Bambridge, professional engineer Joshua Sharon, landscape architect Matthew Bishop, traffic engineer Mark Keeley and Jason Stilling attended the public hearing in support of the requests. David H. Karceski, Esq. and A. Neill Thupari, Esq. represented the Petitioners. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR) and Department of Planning (DOP). Neither agency opposed the requests.

The subject property is approximately 1.153 acres in size and is zoned BL-AS, with an extremely small portion zoned DR 5.5. All proposed improvements would be in the BL-AS zoned portion of the site. The property was previously zoned BL, but during the 2016 Comprehensive Zoning Map Process the property was rezoned to BL-AS. Petitioners' Ex. 3.

At present there is a liquor store and automotive service garage at the property. Petitioners would raze those structures and construct a Royal Farms Store with gasoline pumps, convenience store and carry-out restaurant. Such a use(s) is permitted by special exception in the BL-AS zone.

SPECIAL HEARING

The special hearing pertains to a waiver of certain requirements pertaining to a riverine floodplain on the property. As shown on the plan, only a small portion of the 100-year floodplain is located on the subject property, and no structures or buildings are proposed in that location. Instead, Petitioners propose to install within the floodplain landscaping and curb, gutter, sidewalk and utility improvements along Harlem Lane. The County Code (BCC §32-4-414) permits such infrastructure items to be located within the floodplain, as noted in a November 29, 2017 memorandum from the Director of Department of Public Works (DPW). Petitioners' Ex. 8. That agency did not object to the waiver request and the petition for special hearing will therefore be granted.

SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. Schultz v. Pritts, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The Schultz standard was revisited in Attar v. DMS Tollgate; LLC, 451 Md. 272, (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances

showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use.

Messrs. Sharon, Bishop and Keeley (each of whom was accepted as an expert) testified via proffer the Petitioners satisfied each of the requirements set forth in the B.C.Z.R. §502.1. They each also opined the adverse impacts of this special exception use would be no greater at this location than it would be at other BL-AS zoned sites. As such the petition for special exception will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 5th day of December 2017, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing as follows: (1) to approve a waiver; (2) to permit the redevelopment of a portion of the site in a riverine floodplain; and (3) to allow grading, paving, installation of a sidewalk and sign, concrete curb and gutter, storm water management facility, storm drain, landscaping and other site work improvements within the floodplain, as shown in detail on the site plan admitted as Petitioners' Exhibit 1A, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Special Exception to use the subject property for a fuel service station on an individual site be and is hereby GRANTED.

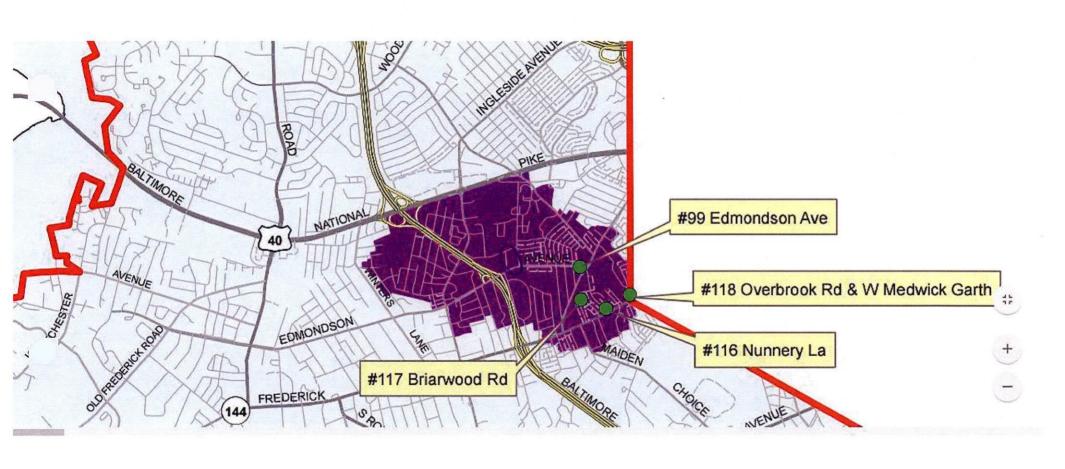
The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioners shall have five (5) years from the date hereof in which to utilize the special exception.
- 3. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must submit for approval by Baltimore County landscape and lighting plans for the site.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

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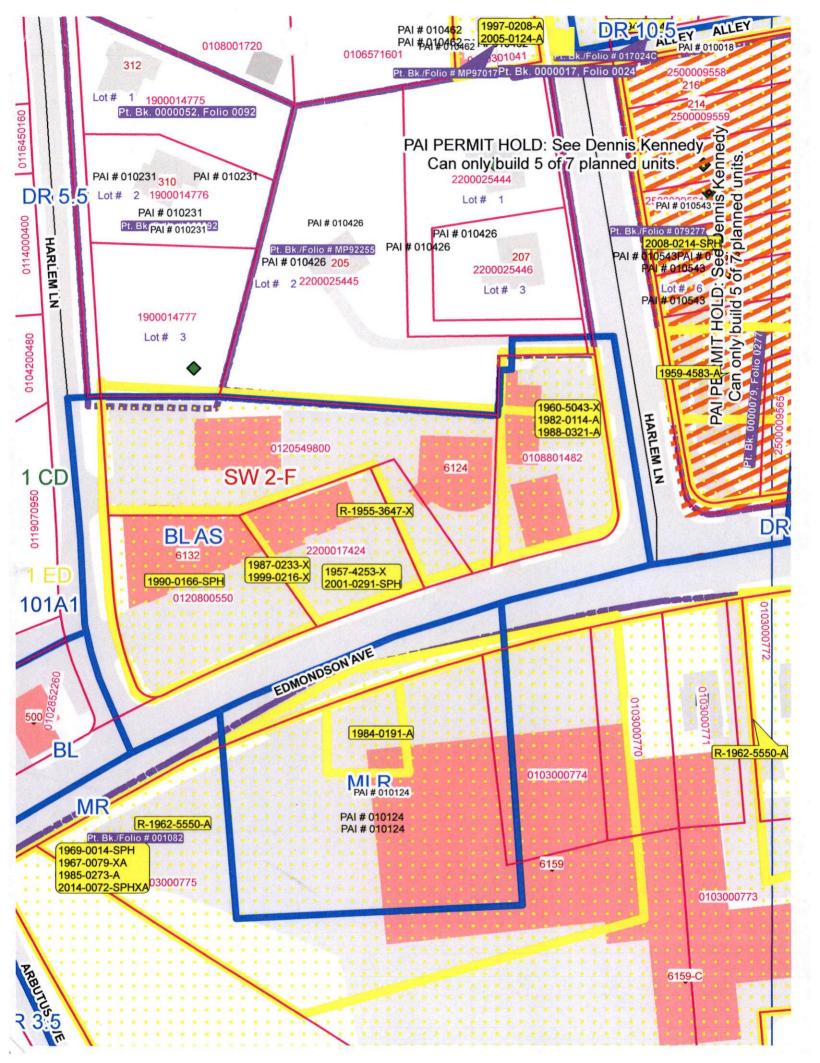

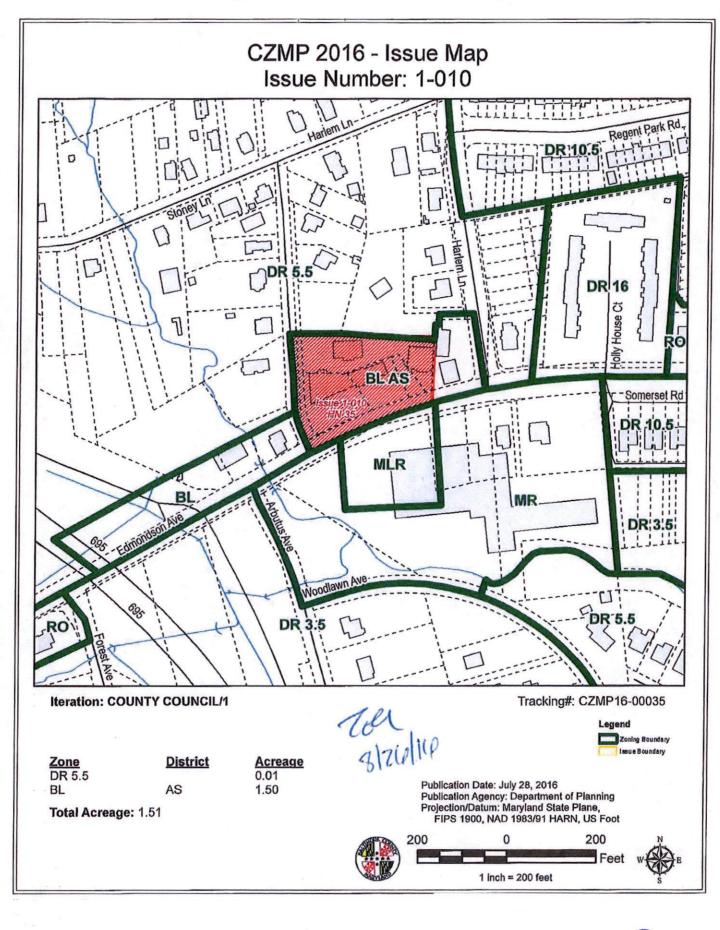

This is a Special Exception to use the property for a fuel service station on an individual site proposed to be Royal Farms #302.

The project site as shown on the "Plan to Accompany Petition for Special Hearing and Special Exception" dated November 17, 2017, is entirely outside of the special flood hazard area as shown on the Federal Emergency Management Agency, FEMA, Flood Insurance Rate Map, FIRM, Panel 2400100388F effective date September 26, 2008.

A portion of the site is within the 100-year floodplain as delineated in the Maiden Choice Watershed Study dated April, 1984, on file with the County. However, the portion of the site located within the floodplain area was road, sidewalk, utilities and paving prior to development and will be reconfigured after development but will still be the same use. No buildings or new payement areas will be in the floodplain area.

Baltimore County Code Sections 32-4-414 (c) (2) states "Development in a floodplain prohibited; exceptions. The County may not permit development in a riverine floodplain except for: The installation of a pond, culvert, bridge, street, utility, or drainage facility that the county finds is not detrimental to floodplain management programs."

The Department of Public Works takes no exception with this development for this reason.

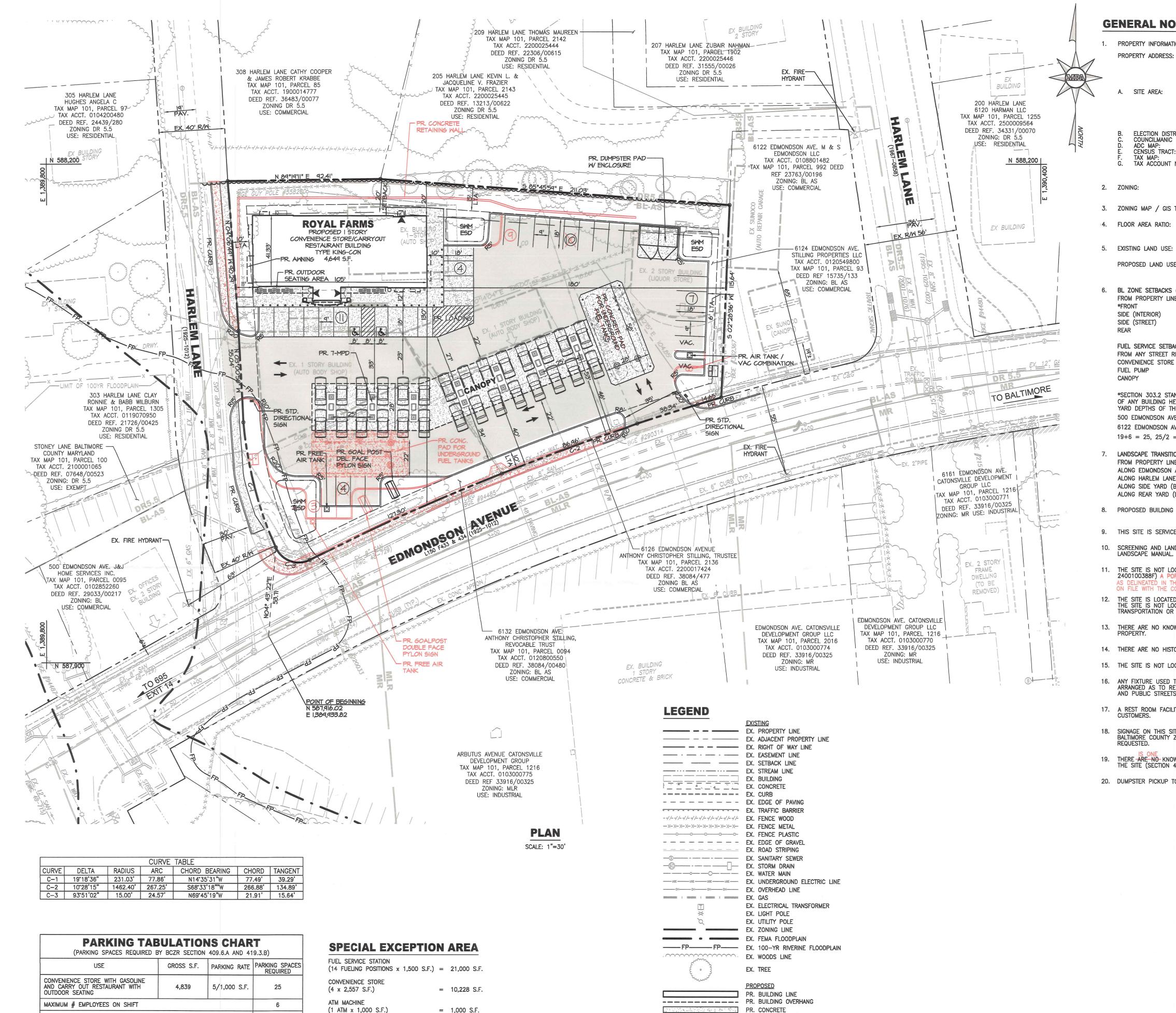

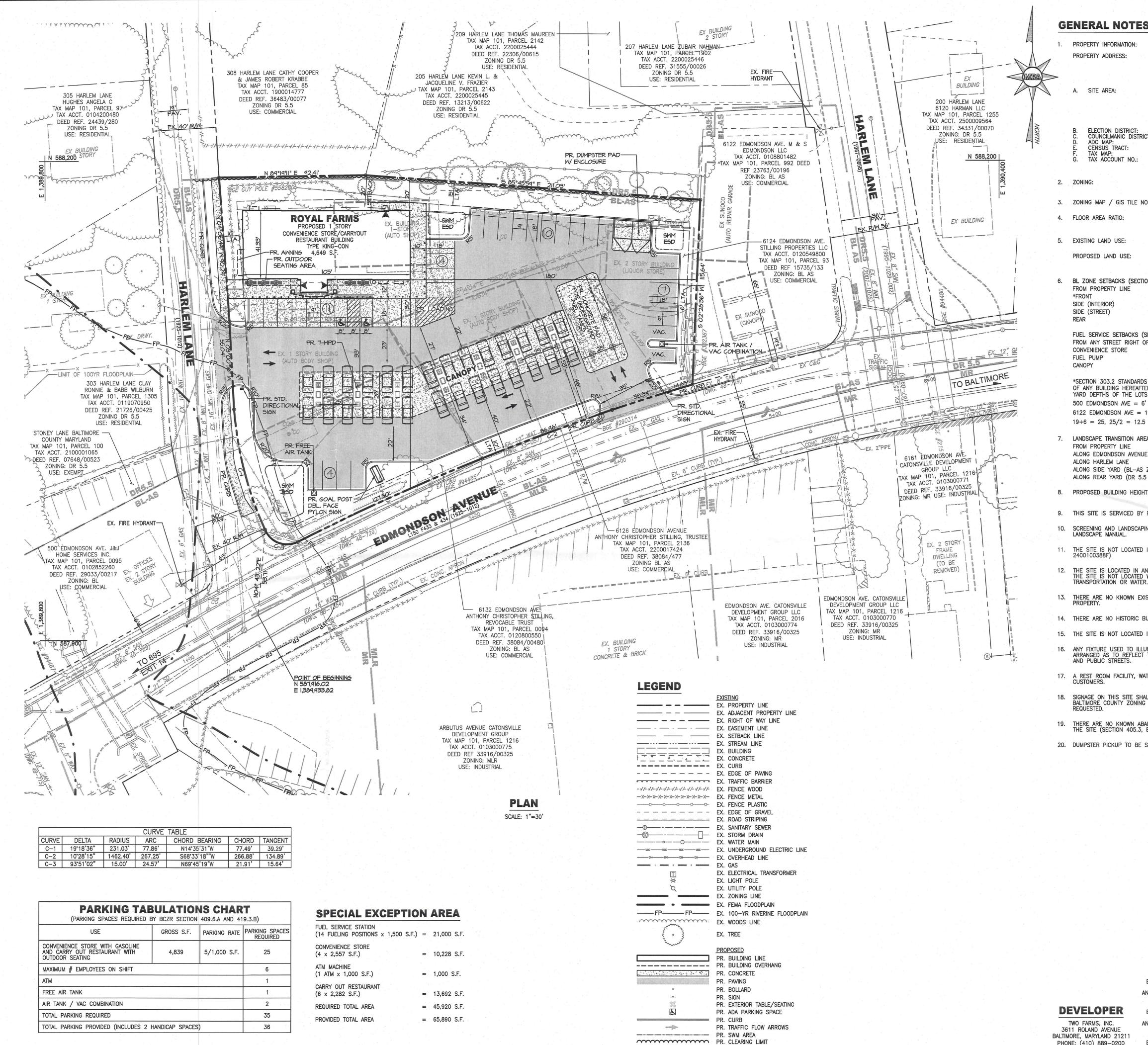

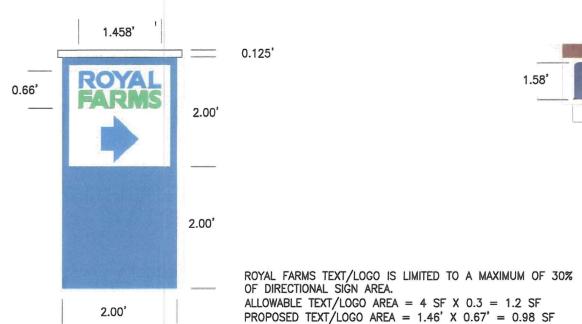
