OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County for consideration of a Petition for Administrative Variance filed by the legal owners of the property, Henry R. and Nancy C. Abrams ("Petitioners"). The Petitioners are requesting Variance relief pursuant to §§ 1B02.3.B and 504 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), and from § 1B01.2.C.4 of the 1970 BCZR, to allow construction of a building addition for attached residential garage located within a Residential Transition Area ("RTA") to have a front yard setback from centerline of street of 39 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 55 ft. and to amend the latest Final Development Plan ("FDP") for the Glusman Property, Lot 5 only. The subject property and requested relief is more fully depicted on the site plan that was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

The Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. There were no adverse ZAC comments received from any of the County reviewing agencies.

The Petitioners having filed a Petition for Administrative Variance and the subject property having been posted on February 9, 2018, and there being no request for a public hearing, a decision shall be rendered based upon the documentation presented.

The Petitioners have filed the supporting affidavits as required by § 32-3-303 of the Baltimore County Code ("BCC"). Based upon the information available, there is no evidence in the file to indicate that the requested variance would adversely affect the health, safety or general welfare of the public and should therefore be granted. In the opinion of the Administrative Law Judge, the information, photographs, and affidavits submitted provide sufficient facts that comply with the requirements of § 307.1 of the BCZR. Furthermore, strict compliance with the BCZR would result in practical difficulty and/or unreasonable hardship upon the Petitioners.

Pursuant to the posting of the property and the provisions of both the BCC and the BCZR, and for the reasons given above, the requested variance should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>2nd</u> day of **March**, **2018**, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Administrative Variance seeking relief from §§ 1B02.3.B and 504 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"), and from § 1B01.2.C.4 of the 1970 BCZR, to allow construction of a building addition for attached residential garage located within a RTA to have a front yard setback from centerline of street of 39 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 55 ft. and to amend the latest FDP for the Glusman Property, Lot 5 only, be and is hereby GRANTED.

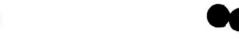

ADMINISTRATIVE ZONING VARIANCE REQUEST 7606 CURVING LANE AFFIDAVIT

EXISTING CONDITIONS:

Henry and Nancy Abrams are owners and occupants of the property at 7606 Curving Lane in the Towson area of Baltimore County known as Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property" subdivision, approved in 1984. The dwelling was in existence at the time of subdivision approval. The property is improved with a 1-story with lower level single-family residential dwelling originally constructed in 1952 with an addition constructed in 2010. The property is not the subject of any zoning violation.

PROPOSED CONDITIONS:

It is proposed to construct an addition on the northerly front and side of the house for an attached 2-car residential garage with front porch extension, as well as a small addition in the side yard for additional closet space. See attached Site Plans Z-1 and Z-2 and Architectural sketches.

PREVIOUS DEVELOPMENT AND SUBDIVISION:

The property is known as Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property", which subdivision was approved and recorded in 1984. The property was zoned D.R. 3.5 at that time. See attached County Review Group (C.R.G.) Plan IX-339 approved on June 23, 1983. See attached First Amended Final Development Plan of the "Glusman Property" dated January 7, 1981 and revised March 23, 1984. See attached record plat of "Glusman Property" recorded June 27, 1984.

YARD SETBACKS:

Per B.C.Z.R. Section 1B02.3.B, the standards applicable to existing developments shall be as prescribed by the zoning regulations applicable to such use at the time the plan was approved. Therefore, the minimum standards shall be those in effect per old 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4. and based upon the vested D.R. 3.5 zoning.

The existing dwelling is a Group I use located within a Residential Transition Area (R.T.A.). Per attached Table for Group I Use and D.R. 3.5 Zoning, the minimum standards are:

Minimum Distance from Building to Centerline of Street = 55 ft. > 39 ft. proposed *

Minimum Rear Yard Depth = 30 ft. < 46 ft. existing

Minimum Side Yard Width = 10 ft. = 10 ft. proposed

Minimum Sum of Side Yard Widths = 25 ft. < 25 ft. proposed



* A variance is requested from B.C.Z.R. Section 1B02.3.B. and 504 (and 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4) to allow construction of a building addition for attached residential garage located within a Residential Transition Area to have a front yard setback from centerline of street of 39 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 55 ft, and to amend the latest FDP for the Glusman Property, Lot Sonly.

RESIDENTIAL TRANSITION AREA:

Per First Amended Final Development Plan of the "Glusman Property" approved March 29, 1984, the entire site is located within Residential Transition Area (Note # 11). The existing use is single-family residential dwelling which is the same use on all adjacent lots. Therefore the applicable minimum building setback requirements are those specified in Table within old 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4.

PRACTICAL DIFFICULTY AND HARDSHIP:

The property owners / residents have a need for a residential garage within which to store and charge their hybrid vehicles. The proposed garage is situated in the proposed location due to the proximity to the main dwelling entrance and the topography of the site. The location of the garage will utilize the existing driveway adjacent to the main dwelling entry at the covered front porch, and the elevation of the proposed garage will be similar to that of the existing driveway. This is the ideal location for a garage on this lot.

Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property" is unique in that the dwelling was in existence at the time of subdivision. The front yard setback to centerline of Curving Lane cannot be altered since it was an existing condition in 1984 at the time the lot was created.

Alternately, if the garage were to be placed on the opposite southerly side of the house, then it would preclude any access to the rear yard area for future maintenance of the dwelling, and that location would not be a practical location for access into the house due to its distance from the front entry and the change in grade from that location to the front entry. A variance would still be necessary at this southern location.

The owners / occupants have reviewed this proposed residential garage with all neighbors along Curving Lane and Ruxton Road, and all have consented to this proposal. It should be noted that there are other locations in the neighborhood of similarly placed residential garages with regard to location and distance to street, including the detached garage directly across the street.

Strict compliance with the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations would cause unreasonable hardship upon the property owners by not allowing them to construct a residential garage in the most practical location.

ADMINISTRATIVE ZONING VARIANCE REQUEST 7606 CURVING LANE AFFIDAVIT

EXISTING CONDITIONS:

Henry and Nancy Abrams are owners and occupants of the property at 7606 Curving Lane in the Towson area of Baltimore County known as Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property" subdivision, approved in 1984. The dwelling was in existence at the time of subdivision approval. The property is improved with a 1-story with lower level single-family residential dwelling originally constructed in 1952 with an addition constructed in 2010. The property is not the subject of any zoning violation.

PROPOSED CONDITIONS:

It is proposed to construct an addition on the northerly front and side of the house for an attached 2-car residential garage with front porch extension, as well as a small addition in the side yard for additional closet space. See attached Site Plans Z-1 and Z-2 and Architectural sketches.

PREVIOUS DEVELOPMENT AND SUBDIVISION:

The property is known as Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property", which subdivision was approved and recorded in 1984. The property was zoned D.R. 3.5 at that time. See attached County Review Group (C.R.G.) Plan IX-339 approved on June 23, 1983. See attached First Amended Final Development Plan of the "Glusman Property" dated January 7, 1981 and revised March 23, 1984. See attached record plat of "Glusman Property" recorded June 27, 1984.

YARD SETBACKS:

Per B.C.Z.R. Section 1B02.3.B, the standards applicable to existing developments shall be as prescribed by the zoning regulations applicable to such use at the time the plan was approved. Therefore, the minimum standards shall be those in effect per old 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4. and based upon the vested D.R. 3.5 zoning.

The existing dwelling is a Group I use located within a Residential Transition Area (R.T.A.). Per attached Table for Group I Use and D.R. 3.5 Zoning, the minimum standards are:

Minimum Distance from Building to Centerline of Street = 55 ft. > 39 ft. proposed

Minimum Rear Yard Depth = 30 ft. < 46 ft. existing

Minimum Side Yard Width = 10 ft. = 10 ft. proposed

Minimum Sum of Side Yard Widths = 25 ft. < 25 ft. proposed



* A variance is requested from B.C.Z.R. Section 1B02.3.B. and 504 (and 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4) to allow construction of a building addition for attached residential garage located within a Residential Transition Area to have a front yard setback from centerline of street of 39 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 55 ft.

RESIDENTIAL TRANSITION AREA:

Per First Amended Final Development Plan of the "Glusman Property" approved March 29, 1984, the entire site is located within Residential Transition Area (Note # 11). The existing use is single-family residential dwelling which is the same use on all adjacent lots. Therefore the applicable minimum building setback requirements are those specified in Table within old 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4.

PRACTICAL DIFFICULTY AND HARDSHIP:

The property owners / residents have a need for a residential garage within which to store and charge their hybrid vehicles. The proposed garage is situated in the proposed location due to the proximity to the main dwelling entrance and the topography of the site. The location of the garage will utilize the existing driveway adjacent to the main dwelling entry at the covered front porch, and the elevation of the proposed garage will be similar to that of the existing driveway. This is the ideal location for a garage on this lot.

Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property" is unique in that the dwelling was in existence at the time of subdivision. The front yard setback to centerline of Curving Lane cannot be altered since it was an existing condition in 1984 at the time the lot was created.

Alternately, if the garage were to be placed on the opposite southerly side of the house, then it would preclude any access to the rear yard area for future maintenance of the dwelling, and that location would not be a practical location for access into the house due to its distance from the front entry and the change in grade from that location to the front entry. A variance would still be necessary at this southern location.

The owners / occupants have reviewed this proposed residential garage with all neighbors along Curving Lane and Ruxton Road, and all have consented to this proposal. It should be noted that there are other locations in the neighborhood of similarly placed residential garages with regard to location and distance to street, including the detached garage directly across the street.

Strict compliance with the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations would cause unreasonable hardship upon the property owners by not allowing them to construct a residential garage in the most practical location.

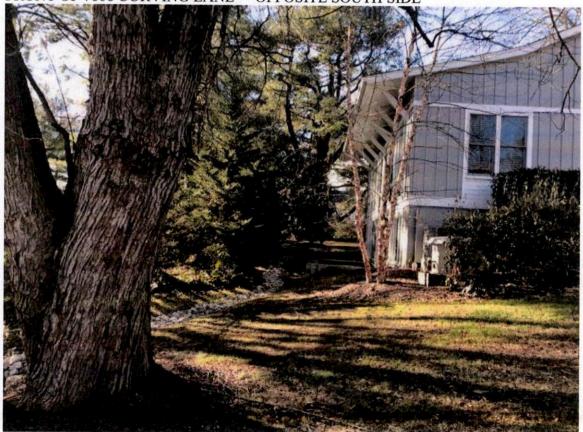

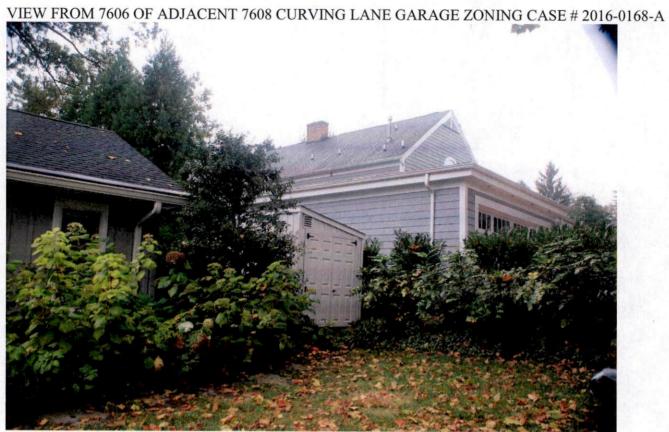


FRONT OF 7606 CURVING LANE - OPPOSITE SOUTH SIDE

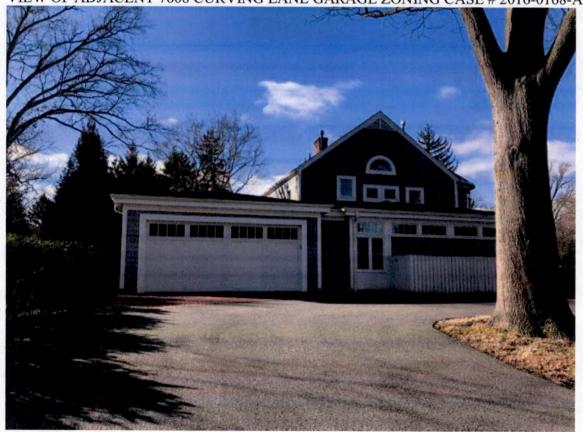




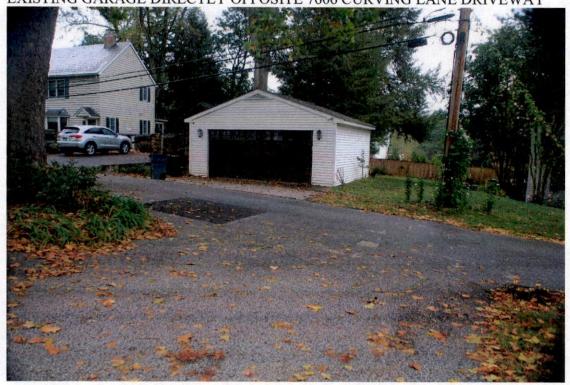




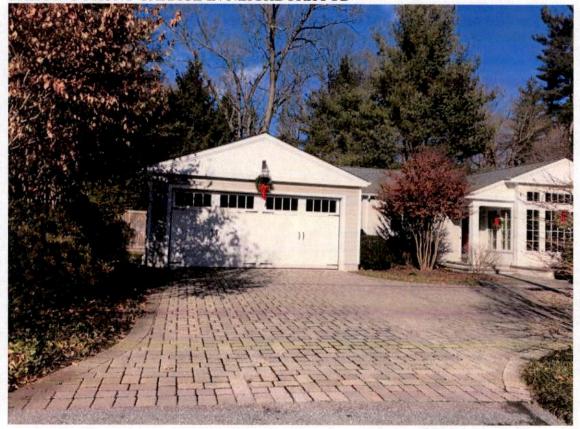

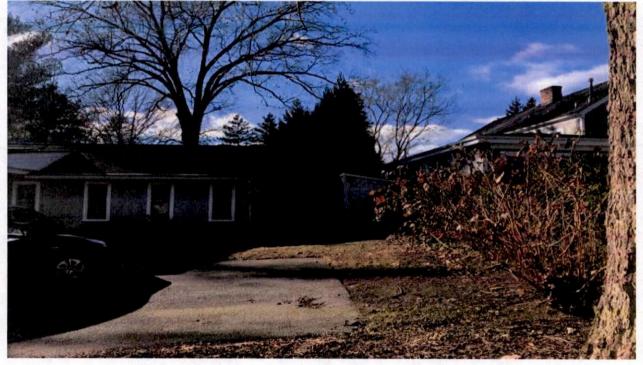

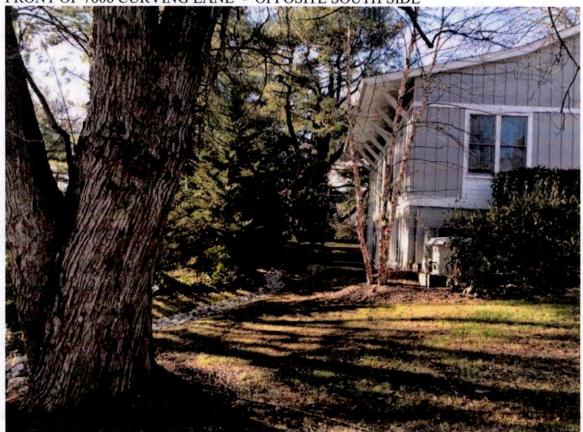

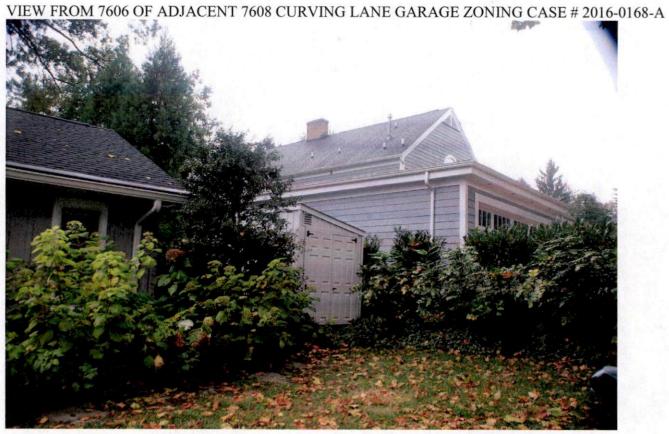

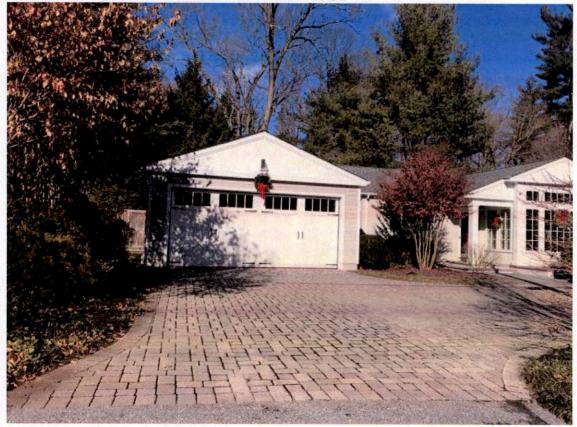

ADMINISTRATIVE ZONING VARIANCE REQUEST 7606 CURVING LANE AFFIDAVIT

EXISTING CONDITIONS:

Henry and Nancy Abrams are owners and occupants of the property at 7606 Curving Lane in the Towson area of Baltimore County known as Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property" subdivision, approved in 1984. The dwelling was in existence at the time of subdivision approval. The property is improved with a 1-story with lower level single-family residential dwelling originally constructed in 1952 with an addition constructed in 2010. The property is not the subject of any zoning violation.

PROPOSED CONDITIONS:

It is proposed to construct an addition on the northerly front and side of the house for an attached 2-car residential garage with front porch extension, as well as a small addition in the side yard for additional closet space. See attached Site Plans Z-1 and Z-2 and Architectural sketches.

PREVIOUS DEVELOPMENT AND SUBDIVISION:

The property is known as Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property", which subdivision was approved and recorded in 1984. The property was zoned D.R. 3.5 at that time. See attached County Review Group (C.R.G.) Plan IX-339 approved on June 23, 1983. See attached First Amended Final Development Plan of the "Glusman Property" dated January 7, 1981 and revised March 23, 1984. See attached record plat of "Glusman Property" recorded June 27, 1984.

YARD SETBACKS:

Per B.C.Z.R. Section 1B02.3.B, the standards applicable to existing developments shall be as prescribed by the zoning regulations applicable to such use at the time the plan was approved. Therefore, the minimum standards shall be those in effect per old 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4. and based upon the vested D.R. 3.5 zoning.

The existing dwelling is a Group I use located within a Residential Transition Area (R.T.A.). Per attached Table for Group I Use and D.R. 3.5 Zoning, the minimum standards are:

Minimum Distance from Building to Centerline of Street

Minimum Rear Yard Depth

Minimum Side Yard Width

Minimum Sum of Side Yard Widths

= 55 ft. > 39 ft. proposed

= 30 ft. < 46 ft. existing

= 10 ft. = 10 ft. proposed

= 25 ft. < 25 ft. proposed



* A variance is requested from B.C.Z.R. Section 1B02.3.B. and 504 (and 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4) to allow construction of a building addition for attached residential garage located within a Residential Transition Area to have a front yard setback from centerline of street of 39 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 55 ft.

RESIDENTIAL TRANSITION AREA:

Per First Amended Final Development Plan of the "Glusman Property" approved March 29, 1984, the entire site is located within Residential Transition Area (Note # 11). The existing use is single-family residential dwelling which is the same use on all adjacent lots. Therefore the applicable minimum building setback requirements are those specified in Table within old 1970 BCZR Section 1B01.2.C.4.

PRACTICAL DIFFICULTY AND HARDSHIP:

The property owners / residents have a need for a residential garage within which to store and charge their hybrid vehicles. The proposed garage is situated in the proposed location due to the proximity to the main dwelling entrance and the topography of the site. The location of the garage will utilize the existing driveway adjacent to the main dwelling entry at the covered front porch, and the elevation of the proposed garage will be similar to that of the existing driveway. This is the ideal location for a garage on this lot.

Lot 5 of the "Glusman Property" is unique in that the dwelling was in existence at the time of subdivision. The front yard setback to centerline of Curving Lane cannot be altered since it was an existing condition in 1984 at the time the lot was created.

Alternately, if the garage were to be placed on the opposite southerly side of the house, then it would preclude any access to the rear yard area for future maintenance of the dwelling, and that location would not be a practical location for access into the house due to its distance from the front entry and the change in grade from that location to the front entry. A variance would still be necessary at this southern location.

The owners / occupants have reviewed this proposed residential garage with all neighbors along Curving Lane and Ruxton Road, and all have consented to this proposal. It should be noted that there are other locations in the neighborhood of similarly placed residential garages with regard to location and distance to street, including the detached garage directly across the street.

Strict compliance with the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations would cause unreasonable hardship upon the property owners by not allowing them to construct a residential garage in the most practical location.

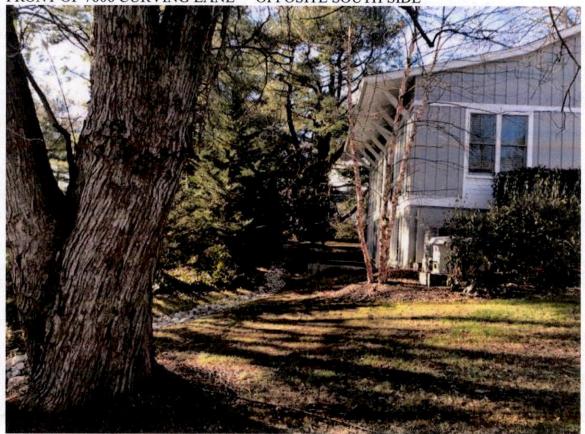
