OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of a Petition for Special Hearing filed on behalf of Sharon K. Hall, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") to approve the construction of a single-family dwelling on an undersized lot (14,467 sq. ft. in lieu of the required 20,000 sq. ft.) pursuant to Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R.

Sharon Hall and professional engineer William Bafitis appeared in support of the petition. Timothy M. Kotroco, Esq., represented the Petitioner. Several neighbors attended the hearing and opposed the request. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Department of Planning (DOP). That agency indicated it had "no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief." A site plan was marked and admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

It is important to note at the outset this is not a variance case; the only request is for a special hearing. This is more than a matter of semantics. Unlike a variance request under B.C.Z.R. §307, a special hearing request to approve an undersized lot under B.C.Z.R. §304 does not require Petitioner to show her property is unique in any way or that she would experience a practical difficulty or hardship if this request was denied. A neighbor referred to a previous zoning order ORDER RECEIVED FOR PRIVIOUS 2001 in a previous zoning order.

issued by the undersigned (Case No. 2017-0313-A) concerning another property in this community wherein the request was denied. That was a variance case, and the petition was denied because the property was determined not be unique. In this case, Petitioner does not need to show her property is unique.

Instead, and as discussed at the hearing, B.C.Z.R. §304 (entitled "Use of Undersized Single-Family Lots") was designed to address the scenario in this case; i.e., where a lot of record, by virtue of a subsequent down-zoning, becomes undersized or deficient, preventing the owner from erecting a house thereon. In *Mueller v. People's Counsel*, 177 Md. App. 43 (2007), the court of special appeals described the two methods by which an owner in Baltimore County may receive permission to construct a dwelling on an undersized lot: B.C.Z.R. §307 (Variances), which requires a showing of uniqueness and practical difficulty, and B.C.Z.R. §304, which does not. *Id.* at 87.

Based on the testimony and exhibits presented at the hearing I believe Petitioner satisfies each of the three requirements enumerated in B.C.Z.R. §304, although I believe the last element merits further discussion. First, the two lots owned by Petitioner were created by a subdivision plat recorded before 1955. Pet. Ex. 3. Second, all other height and area requirements (i.e., other than lot size) are satisfied, and Petitioner is not requesting any variances for yard setbacks or height of any proposed dwelling. Finally, I do not believe Petitioner owns sufficient adjoining land to comply with the lot area requirement.

Jack Amhrein, on behalf of the Perry Hall Improvement Association, noted Petitioner could relocate the property boundary in such a fashion that the building lot would be larger than 14,467 sq. ft. as proposed. I agree, and while I am cognizant of Petitioner's desire to continue using the pool in the rear of her home, I believe (as noted by several of the neighbors) that the pool may

have to be removed or relocated to allow for a larger lot size. Petitioner submitted an exhibit (Pet. Ex. 9) showing at least 25 homes in the community are constructed on lots less than 20,000 sq. ft. in size, although as the neighbors point out only two of those homes were constructed within the last twenty-five years when the current zoning regulations were in place. Even so, only five of the lots shown on Exhibit 9 are larger than 16,000 sq. ft., and a restriction will be included below to require the building lot in this case to be no smaller than that.

There are also significant factual distinctions between this case and the 2017 zoning case referenced above where the variance petition was denied. The petitioner in that case, Wadkins Construction, Inc., purchased the property at 5301 Bush Street on October 28, 2016, and filed the variance petition immediately thereafter. Ms. Hall, the petitioner in this case, has owned and lived at this property for over 40 years, and testified she will continue to live in her home.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>21st</u> day of **March**, **2018** by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing to approve the construction of a single-family dwelling on an undersized lot (16,000 sq. ft. in lieu of the required 20,000 sq. ft.) pursuant to Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

- Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at her own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioner shall within 30 days of the date hereof submit to the Office of Administrative Hearings a redlined site plan showing a reconfiguration of the proposed "new lot line" which will result in an undersized lot of not less than 16,000 sq. ft.

- 3. Petitioner must obtain approval from the Baltimore County Development Review Committee (DRC) of a lot line adjustment as proposed on the site plan, pursuant to BCC §32-4-106(a)(1)(viii).
- 4. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioner must submit for approval to the DOP building elevations of the proposed dwelling.

Any appeal of this decision must be filed within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for a special hearing to allow an in-law apartment in a detached accessory structure and the petition for a variance to permit an in-law apartment in an accessory structure with a total square footage of 1872 square feet in lieu of the permitted 1200 square feet.

A site visit was conducted on 2/27/2018. The property is the subject of prior zoning case 2016-0321 SPHA (0321). The Department has a copy of a Declaration of Understanding for 2125 Benson Mill Road in its file.

Between zoning cases 2016-0248-A and 2016-0321-SPHA the petitioner received permission to construct an accessory structure 34' x 88' with total height on 18' on half of the structure and 23' on the other half of the structure. A bathroom facility was permitted in the accessory structure. At the time, the proposed accessory structure was larger than the principal residence. OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by Christopher Corey, Esq., on behalf of Wadkins Construction, Inc., the legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). Petitioner is requesting variance relief from § 1B02.3.C.1 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") as follows: (1) For Lot 2 as shown on the site plan, to permit a minimum lot width of 94.61 ft. in lieu of the required 100 ft.; (2) For Lot 2 as shown on the site plan, to permit a minimum net lot area of 18,922 sq. ft. in lieu of the required 20,000 sq. ft.; (3) If necessary, for Lot 1 as shown on the site plan, to permit a side yard setback of 35 ft. along the Winkler Street right-of-way line, in lieu of the 40 ft. front yard setback requirement; and (4) For such other and further relief as may be required by the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) for Baltimore County. A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 11.

Professional land surveyor Kenneth J. Wells appeared in support of the petition. Christopher Corey, Esq. represented the Petitioner. Several members of the community opposed the requests. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Department of Planning (DOP). That agency did not oppose the requests but suggested certain façade treatments would

be required for the proposed dwellings.

The site is approximately 0.89 acres in size and zoned DR 2. A single-family dwelling was constructed on the property in 1951, although Petitioner has since razed that structure, which was apparently in very poor condition. The subject property is comprised of all of Lot 8 and a portion of Lot 7 as shown on the Plat of Forge Acres (recorded in 1948). Petitioner's Exhibit 4. The properties were the subject of Development Review Committee (DRC) Item DRC #042214-LLA wherein a lot line adjustment was granted in 2014. Petitioner's Exhibit 2. This lot line adjustment (as shown on the DRC Plan admitted as Exhibit 10) created Lot 1 and Lot 2 as shown on the redlined site plan. Petitioner proposes to construct a single-family dwelling and garage on each lot but requires variances to do so.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Based on a review of the site plan and the testimony of Mr. Wells, I do not believe the property is "unique" as that term is used in Maryland case law. In the zoning context "unique" has a "customized meaning" to include shape, topography, subsurface conditions, environmental factors, historical significance, etc. North v. St. Mary's County, 99 Md. App. 502, 512 (1994). The lots are rectangular in shape and are very similar to other lots in the vicinity. There simply are no unique or defining attributes of the property that would support a finding of uniqueness.

In a contested variance case the petitioner faces an uphill battle. Indeed, I was unable to locate a Maryland appellate court opinion from the last twenty years which upheld the grant of a

variance. Under Maryland law, a variance should be granted "sparingly" since it is "an authorization for [that] ... which is prohibited by a zoning ordinance." Cromwell, 102 Md. App. at

699. As such, I believe the petition must be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 11th day of July, 2017, by the Administrative Law

Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from § 1B02.3.C.1 of the

Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R") as follows: (1) For Lot 2 as shown on the site

plan, to permit a minimum lot width of 94.61 ft. in lieu of the required 100 ft.; (2) For Lot 2 as

shown on the site plan, to permit a minimum net lot area of 18,922 sq. ft. in lieu of the required

20,000 sq. ft.; and (3) If necessary, for Lot 1 as shown on the site plan, to permit a side yard setback

of 35 ft. along the Winkler Street right-of-way line, in lieu of the 40 ft. front yard setback

requirement, be and is hereby DENIED.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed by the owners of the subject property, Michael A. and Deborah J. Brazil. The Petitioners request a special hearing to confirm that the construction of a dwelling on a lot in a recorded subdivision is exempt from the provisions of Sections 259.4 through 259.9 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) (Honeygo Regulations), or, in the alternative, a variance from the applicable Honeygo Overlay District Standards to permit this lot to be developed with a single family dwelling, pursuant to Section 259.8 of the B.C.Z.R. In addition, the Petitioners request a variance from Section 1B02.3.C.1 of the B.C.Z.R. to permit a side yard setback of 10 feet in lieu of the required 15 feet, and a rear yard setback of 30 feet in lieu of the required 40 feet. The subject property and relief sought are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing in support of the request were Mr. & Mrs. Brazil, property owners, Mickey Cornelius, traffic engineer, and Howard L. Alderman, Jr., Esquire, attorney for the Petitioners. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is a v-shaped parcel, containing a gross area of approximately 2 acres, more or less, zoned D.R.2H, and is located on the south side of Bush Street in Perry Hall. The property is actually comprised of three lots; namely, Lots 4, 9 and 10 of Forge Acres, which is an older subdivision that was recorded in the Land

Records of Baltimore County in 1948. The recording and approval of subdivision plats at that time did not require the various County approvals that are mandated by law today. A copy of the subdivision plan was submitted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 2.

In any event, the property has been in Mr. Brazil's family for nearly 30 years and was acquired by the Petitioners about 4 years ago. The Petitioners are desirous of developing the property with a single family dwelling. Due to the site constraints associated with this property, and it's location in the Honeygo District, the Petitioners request special hearing and variance relief, as noted above. As to the variance request, it is to be noted that the property has areas of forests, wetlands, and a significant number of environmental constraints, including being partially located The Petitioners have had extensive negotiations with the Department of in a floodplain. Environmental Protection and Resource Management (DEPRM) and as a result, the proposed area of disturbance has been limited. Specifically, the Petitioners cannot build in the forest buffer, floodplain, or wetlands areas. Thus, the building envelope is limited to only a portion of Lot 10, which is located to the rear of the parcel, a significant distance from Bush Street. As shown on the plan, the house will be sited with a 30-foot rear setback and a 10-foot side yard setback in lieu of the required 40 feet and 15 feet, respectively. It was indicated that these setbacks were a direct result of the environmental constraints associated with this property and DEPRM's requirement that any building be located in the area shown on the Environmental Constraints Map No. 4.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented, I am persuaded to grant the variance from setback requirements. The Petitioners have shown that the relief requested complies with the requirements of Section 307 of the B.C.Z.R. Moreover, it is clear that there will be no detriment to the health, safety or general welfare of the surrounding locale.

The Petition for Special Hearing presents an interesting question. As noted above, the property is located in Perry Hall within the Honeygo District of Baltimore County and as such, would normally be subject to the requirements contained in Sections 259.4 through 259.9 of the B.C.Z.R. It is to be noted that Section 259.7 of the B.C.Z.R. does list certain exemptions from those regulations; however, the situation presented here is not directly identified therein. A Zoning

Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Department of Permits and Development Management (DPDM) in which they noted that "The plat which recorded Lot 10 was filed for approval in 1948. This plat does not have a Planning Commission or Board approval. Without this approval, we are at a loss to qualify 'the applicant' as exempt, although due to the fact that this is a lot in a build-out subdivision with public sewer and water, we feel an exemption is appropriate." I agree. Surely, it was the intent of the Honeygo regulations to provide guidance and regulation for the proposed subdivision of vacant land. To the contrary, this is an in-fill lot in a previously recorded subdivision. The natural features of the site and environmental constraints associated therewith prohibited any development on the subject lot for many years. In my judgment, the property should be exempt from the Honeygo regulations. Thus, the Petition for Special Hearing shall be granted, and that portion of the variance request seeking relief from the Honeygo regulations set forth in Section 259.8 of the B.C.Z.R. shall be dismissed as moot. It should also be noted that a letter from the Perry Hall Improvement Association indicated that they have no objections to the requested relief, and "urges" its approval.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on these Petitions held, and for the reasons set forth herein, the relief requested shall be granted, as set forth below.

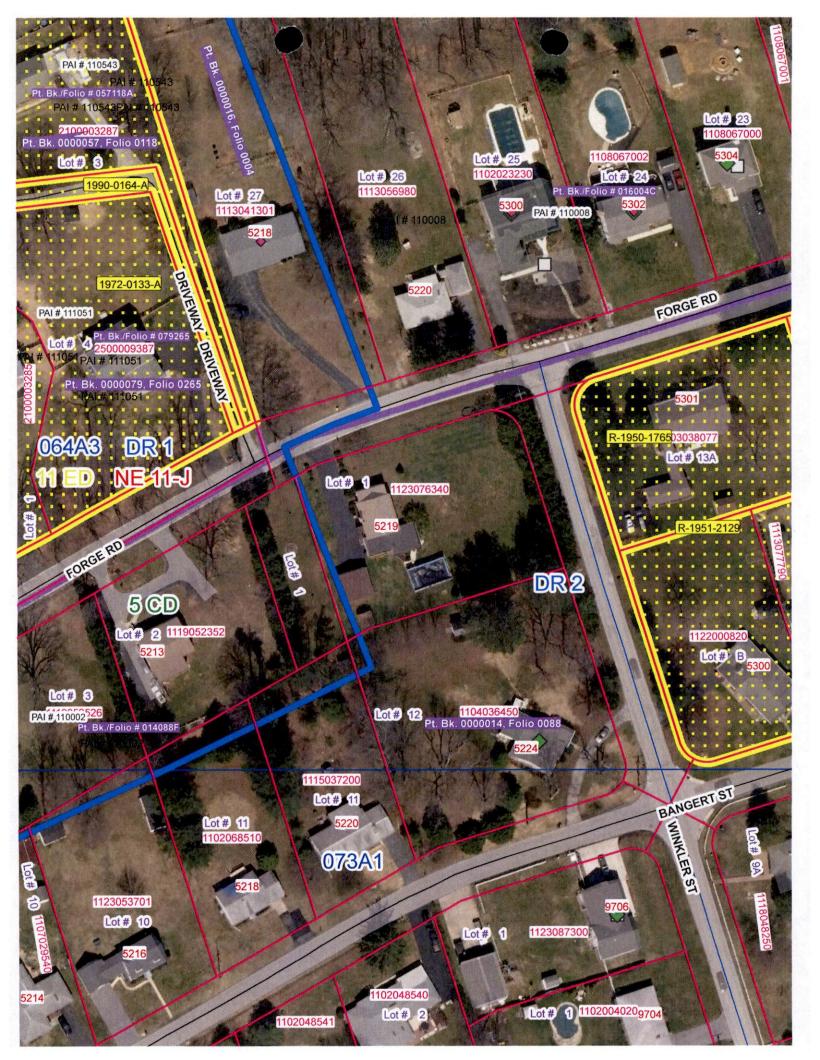

I am strongly against granting approval for developing this undersized lot. Allowing this will pave the way for future development of the existing undersized lots, which we, the community, do not want.

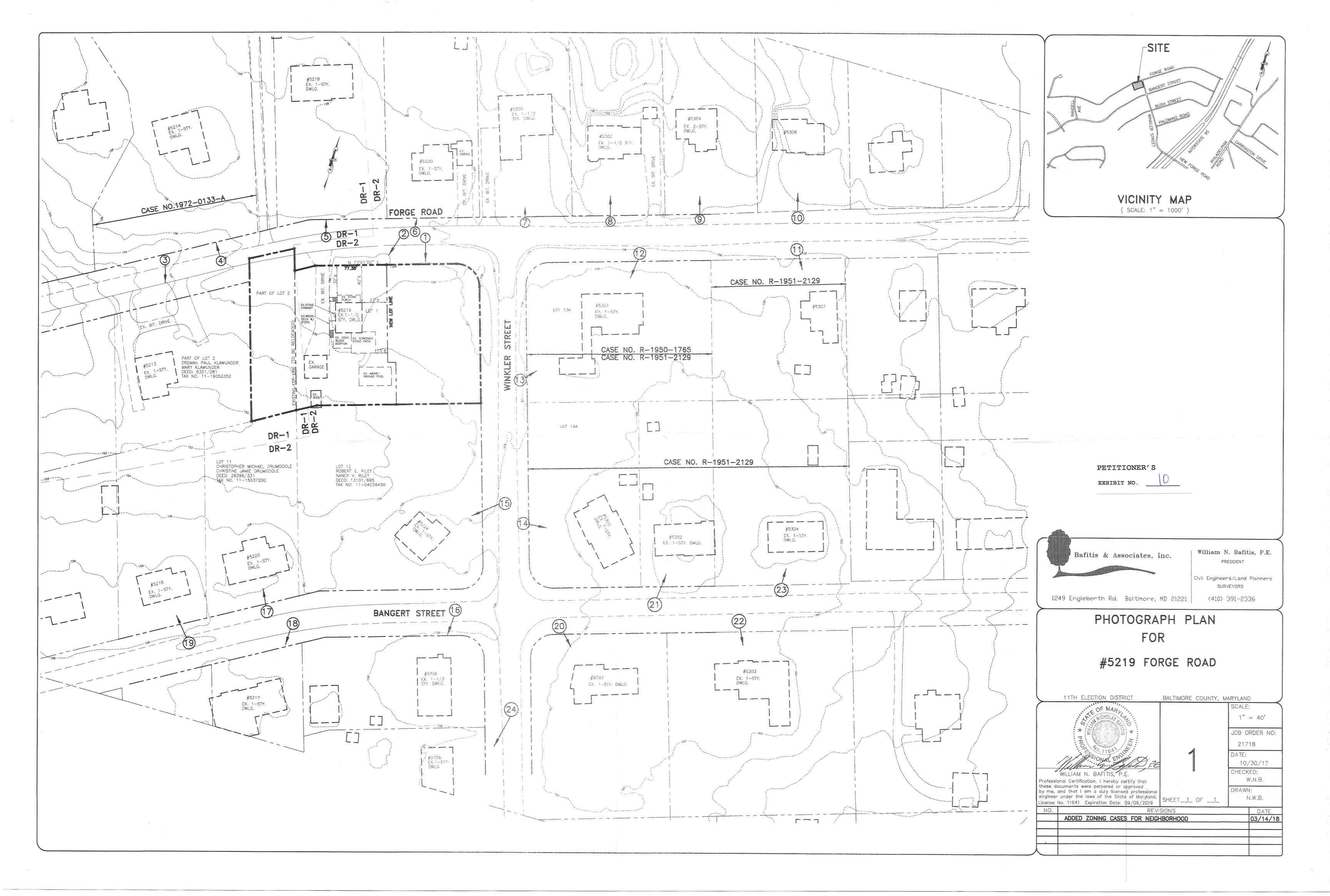

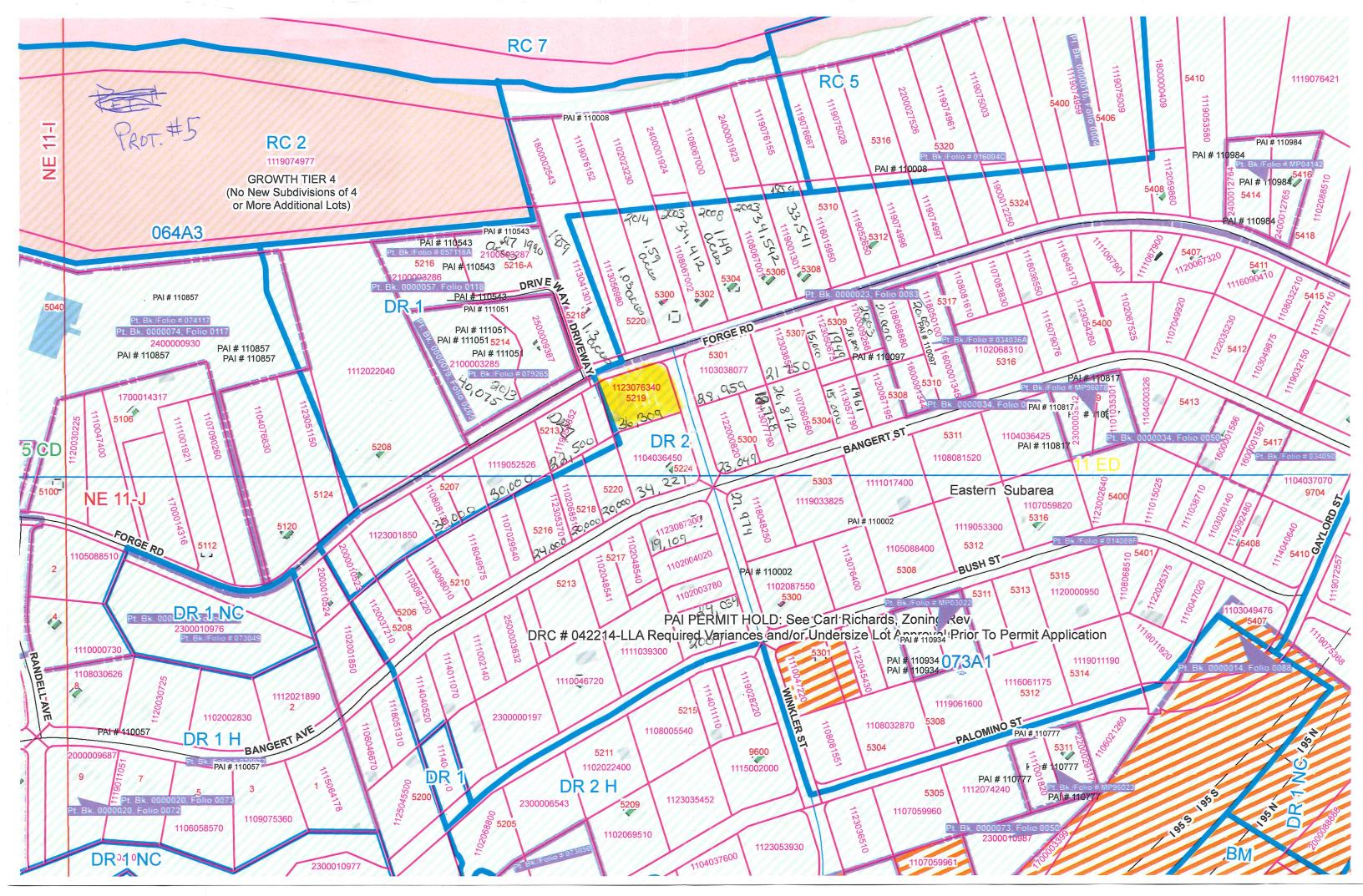


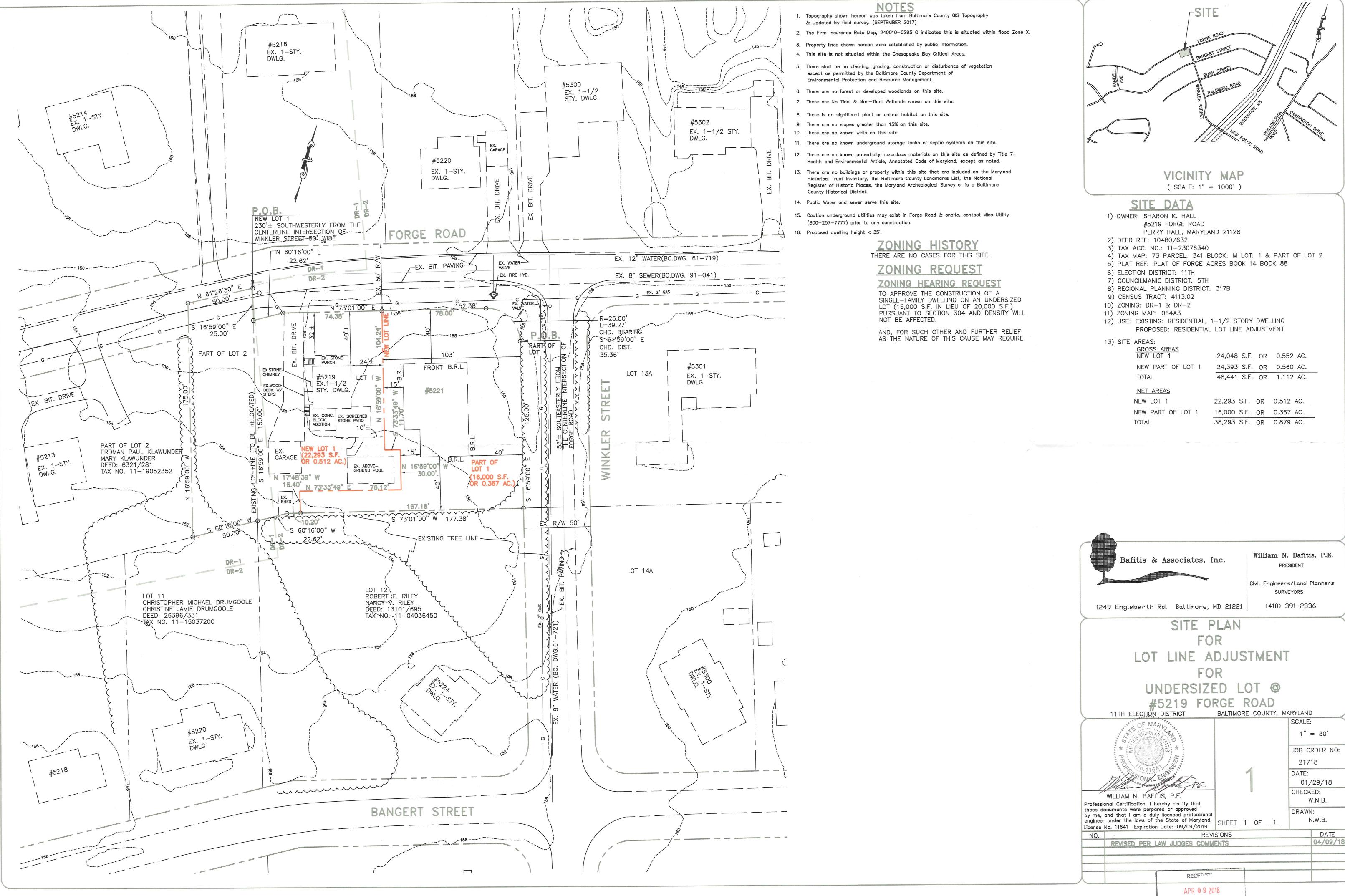
