OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by John & Colby Celmer, the legal owners of the subject property ("Petitioners"). The Petition seeks variance relief from Sections 1A04.3.A and 301.1 A of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") to permit a structure (dwelling) with a height of 43 ft. and an open porch/stair with a side yard of 6 ft. in lieu of the maximum permitted 35 ft., respectively. A site plan was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

David Billingsley and John Celmer appeared in support of the petition. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS"), Bureau of Development Plans Review ("DPR") and the Department of Planning ("DOP"). None of the reviewing agencies opposed the requests.

The site is approximately 16,017 sq. ft. in size and zoned RC-5. The waterfront lot is unimproved, and is shown as Lot 71 on the 1921 Plat of Bowleys Quarters. Petitioners propose to construct a single-family dwelling on the lot but require variance relief to do so given the significant setbacks imposed by the RC 5 regulations.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief: and
- If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty (2)or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

This lot is narrow (50') and deep (approximately 320') and is therefore unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to construct the proposed dwelling. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of community and/or Baltimore County opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 13th day of April, 2018, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance to permit a structure (dwelling) with a height of 43 ft. and an open porch/stair with a side yard of 6 ft. in lieu of the maximum permitted 35 ft., respectively, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed. Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must comply with Critical Area and flood protection regulations.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

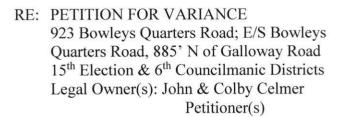

 Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands;

The subject property is located within a Limited Development Area (LDA) and a Modified Buffer Area (MBA) and is subject to Critical Area requirements. The applicant is proposing to construct a dwelling with greater height than permitted and reduced side yard setbacks. The lot is waterfront, and the proposed dwelling must meet all LDA and MBA requirements, including lot coverage limits and afforestation requirements. The plan states the property is 16,017 square feet but the tax records indicate the lot size is 13,504 square feet. Once the correct acreage is determined, lot coverage is limited to a maximum of 31.25%, with mitigation required for any lot coverage between 25% and 31.25%. 15% afforestation is required; the total amount of trees will depend on the correct acreage. Based on the site plan provided, it does not appear that the proposed dwelling location meets the MBA requirements. If the lot coverage, afforestation, and MBA requirements can be met, then the relief requested by the applicant will result in minimal adverse impacts to water quality.

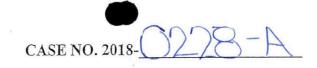

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed by Henry Roesner, owner of the subject property, and Patrick C. Kerr and Linda T. Kerr, as Contract Purchasers. The Petitioners request special hearing relief and a series of variances from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit development of the subject property with a single-family dwelling. Specifically, relief is requested from Section 1A04.3.B.1.a of the B.C.Z.R. to approve the subject property as an undersized lot and to determine that density will not be affected by the proposed development. In addition, variance relief is requested from Section 1A04.3.B.2.b to permit side yard setbacks of 10 feet each in lieu of the minimum required 50 feet, and from Section 1A04.3.A to allow a building height of 36'11-1/8" in lieu of the maximum allowed 35 feet. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request were Henry Roesner, owner of the property, Patrick C. Kerr, who has contracted to purchase the property, Doug DuVal, Architect, and Anthony J. DiPaula, Esquire, attorney for the Petitioners. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is a rectangular shaped waterfront parcel located with frontage on Seneca Creek and the northeast side of

Bowleys Quarters Road in Middle River. The property is an unimproved parcel, also known as Lot 71 of Bowleys Quarters Plat No. 2, which was recorded in the Land Records on May 26, 1921, well prior to the adoption of the first set of zoning regulations in Baltimore County. As is often the case with older subdivisions, many of the lots in this community are undersized and do not meet current width and/or area requirements for development. Mr. & Mrs. Kerr have contracted to purchase the property and are desirous of developing the lot with a single-family dwelling. However, given the narrow width and small area of the lot, the requested zoning relief is necessary. In addition, a variance from height limitations is requested given the proposed construction in a designated flood hazard area. Finally, special hearing relief is requested to approve the subject lot as undersized and a determination that density will not be affected by the proposed development.

In this regard, testimony disclosed that Henry Roesner at one time owned three adjacent lots, namely Lots 71, 72 and 73 of Bowleys Quarters. Mr. Roesner resided on the middle lot (Lot 72) in the dwelling known as 923 Bowleys Quarters Road, until that home was destroyed by Hurricane Isabel in 2003. Mr. Roesner recently sold Lot 73 to another party and has contracted to sell Lot 71 to the Petitioners.

As shown on the site plan, the subject property is 51.16 feet wide and approximately 320 feet deep, and contains a gross area of 0.3677 acres, (16,017 sq.ft.) more or less, zoned R.C.5. The R.C.5 regulations require a minimum lot area of 1.5 acres, and setbacks of no less than 50 feet to any property line. Thus, it is clear that the property could not be developed without the requested zoning relief. In support of the request, Counsel for the Petitioners noted that the property has been a duly recorded lot of record since 1921. Moreover, the proposed development will be compatible with the pattern of development in the neighborhood and will provide setbacks consistent with other houses in the community.

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, I am persuaded that relief should be granted. To deny relief would result in a practical difficulty for the Petitioners and prohibit reasonable use of the property for a permitted purpose. As noted above, many of the

lots are similar in area and width as the subject property. Moreover, the proposed dwelling will be consistent with the pattern of development in the neighborhood and meets the spirit and intent of Section 307 of the B.C.Z.R. and Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995). In this regard, the Office of Planning had requested that certain conditions be imposed to the grant of any relief to insure compliance with the R.C.5 zoning regulations and development standards. However, just prior to the start of the hearing, building elevation drawings of the proposed dwelling were submitted to the Office of Planning who provided an amended comment. That comment indicates they support the Petitioners' proposal and find same to be in accordance with the spirit and intent of the R.C.5 regulations and performance standards.

I further find that the subject property meets the requirements of Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R. and that the proposed development will not result in any increase in density. There were no adverse comments submitted by any County reviewing agency and no one appeared in opposition to the request. To the contrary, the community supports the proposal as evidenced by the letter received from the Bowleys Quarters Improvement Association. Thus, it appears that relief can be granted without detrimental impact to the surrounding locale. However, as conditions to this approval, the proposed dwelling shall be constructed substantially in accordance with the building elevation drawings reviewed and approved by the Office of Planning. Moreover, due to the property's waterfront location, the proposed construction must comply with Federal Flood Insurance regulations and Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas requirements as set forth in the Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments submitted by the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management and the Development Plans Review Division of the Department of Permits and Development Management, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on these Petitions held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this day of September 2005 that the Petition for Special Hearing seeking approval of the

subject property as an undersized lot and a determination that density will not be affected by the proposed development, pursuant to Section 1A04.3.B.1.a of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) be and is hereby GRANTED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from Section 1A04.3.B.2.b to permit side yard setbacks of 10 feet each in lieu of the minimum required 50 feet, and from Section 1A04.3.A to allow a building height of 36'11-1/8" in lieu of the maximum allowed 35 feet for a proposed single-family dwelling, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restrictions:

- 1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, the Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.
- 2) The proposed dwelling shall be constructed substantially in accordance with the building elevation drawings reviewed and approved by the Office of Planning.
- 3) Compliance with the ZAC comments submitted by DEPRM and the Bureau of Development Plans Review relative to Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas regulations and all other appropriate environmental, floodplain and B.O.C.A. regulations for the protection of water quality, streams, wetlands and floodplains. Copies of those comments have been attached hereto and are made a part hereof.
- 4) When applying for any permits, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order

The Bureau of Development Plans Review has reviewed the subject zoning item and we have the following comment(s).

The flood protection elevation for this site is 10.4.

In conformance with *Federal Flood insurance* Requirements, the first floor or basement floor must be at least 1-foot above the flood plain elevation in all construction.

The property to be developed is located to tidewater. The developer is advised that the proper sections of the *Baltimore County Building Code* must be followed whereby elevation limitations are placed on the lowest floor (including *basements*) of residential (commercial) development.

The building engineer shall require a permit for this project.

The building shall be designed and adequately anchored to prevent flotation, collapse or lateral movement of structure with materials resistant to flood damage.

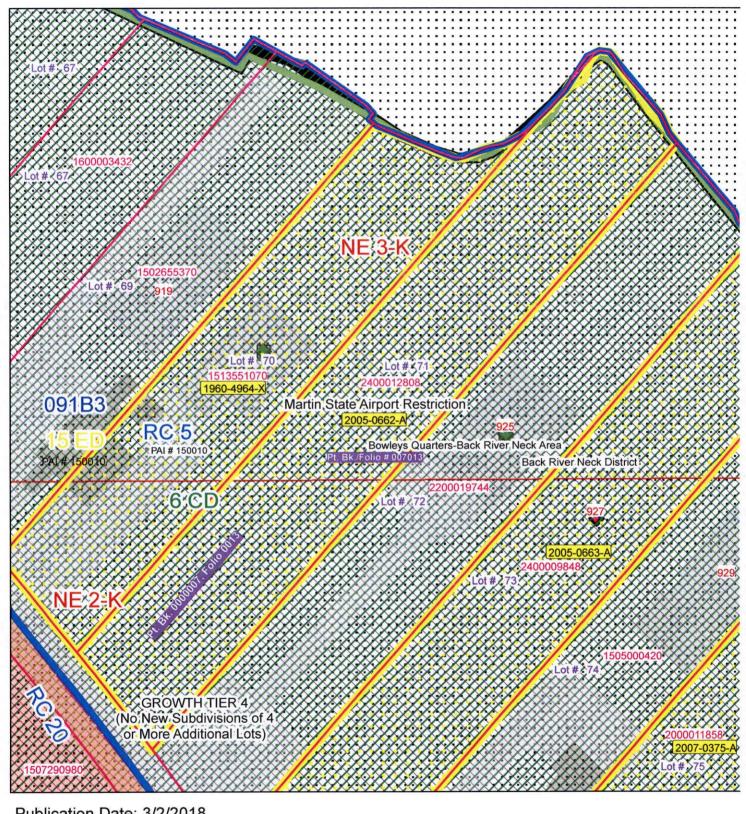
Flood resistant construction shall be in accordance with requirement of B.O.C.A. International Building Code adopted by the county.

The minimum right of way for all public roads in Baltimore County is 40-foot. Setback shall be modified accordingly.

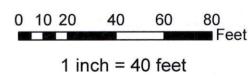

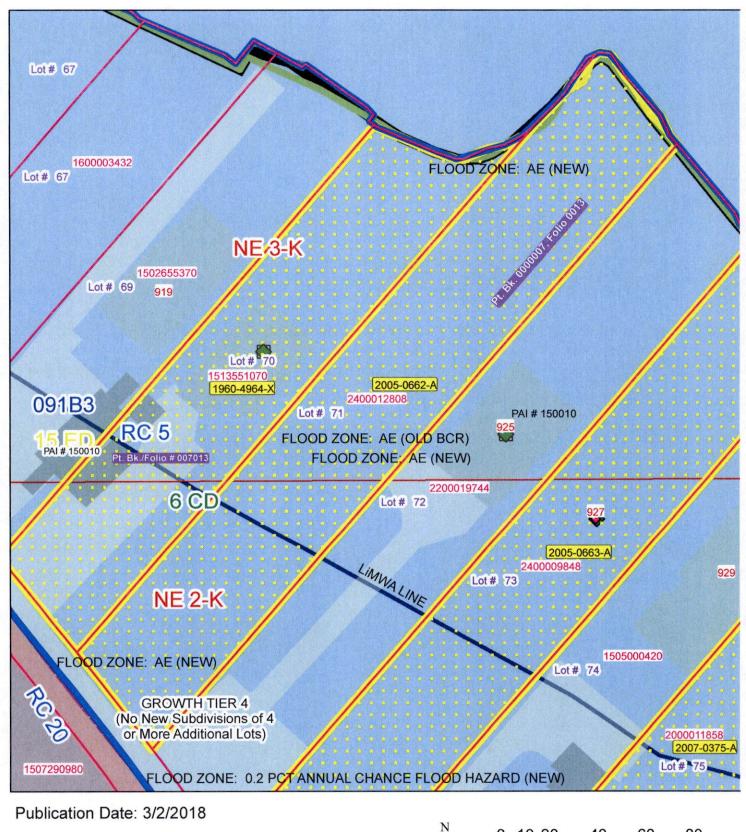

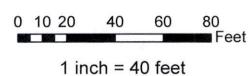
Flood Hazard Areas



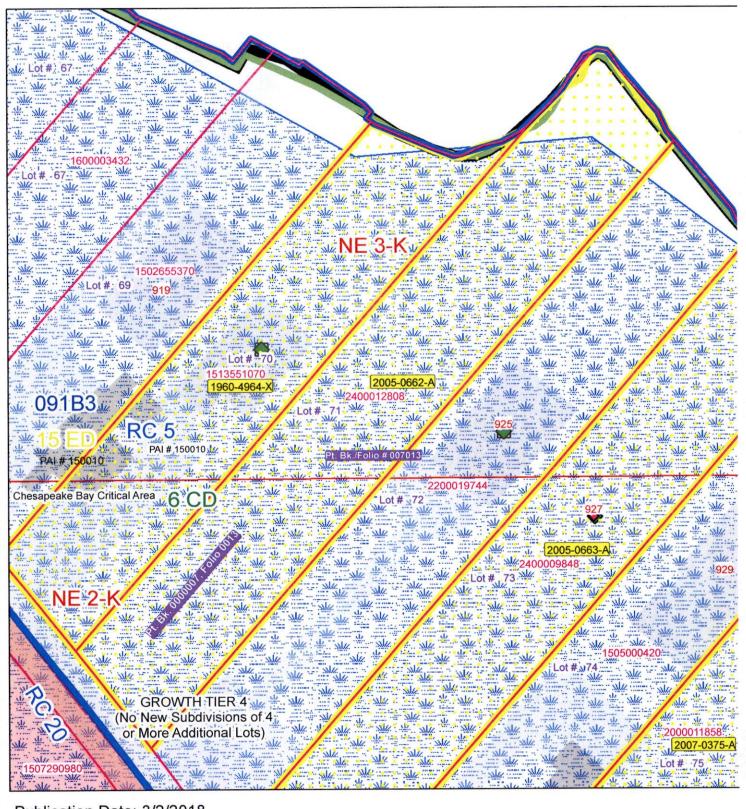

Chesapeake Bay Critica, Area

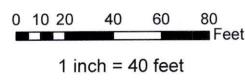

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed by Henry Roesner, owner of the subject property, and Patrick C. Kerr and Linda T. Kerr, as Contract Purchasers. The Petitioners request special hearing relief and a series of variances from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit development of the subject property with a single-family dwelling. Specifically, relief is requested from Section 1A04.3.B.1.a of the B.C.Z.R. to approve the subject property as an undersized lot and to determine that density will not be affected by the proposed development. In addition, variance relief is requested from Section 1A04.3.B.2.b to permit side yard setbacks of 10 feet each in lieu of the minimum required 50 feet, and from Section 1A04.3.A to allow a building height of 36'11-1/8" in lieu of the maximum allowed 35 feet. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing in support of the request were Henry Roesner, owner of the property, Patrick C. Kerr, who has contracted to purchase the property, Doug DuVal, Architect, and Anthony J. DiPaula, Esquire, attorney for the Petitioners. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is a rectangular shaped waterfront parcel located with frontage on Seneca Creek and the northeast side of

Bowleys Quarters Road in Middle River. The property is an unimproved parcel, also known as Lot 71 of Bowleys Quarters Plat No. 2, which was recorded in the Land Records on May 26, 1921, well prior to the adoption of the first set of zoning regulations in Baltimore County. As is often the case with older subdivisions, many of the lots in this community are undersized and do not meet current width and/or area requirements for development. Mr. & Mrs. Kerr have contracted to purchase the property and are desirous of developing the lot with a single-family dwelling. However, given the narrow width and small area of the lot, the requested zoning relief is necessary. In addition, a variance from height limitations is requested given the proposed construction in a designated flood hazard area. Finally, special hearing relief is requested to approve the subject lot as undersized and a determination that density will not be affected by the proposed development.

In this regard, testimony disclosed that Henry Roesner at one time owned three adjacent lots, namely Lots 71, 72 and 73 of Bowleys Quarters. Mr. Roesner resided on the middle lot (Lot 72) in the dwelling known as 923 Bowleys Quarters Road, until that home was destroyed by Hurricane Isabel in 2003. Mr. Roesner recently sold Lot 73 to another party and has contracted to sell Lot 71 to the Petitioners.

As shown on the site plan, the subject property is 51.16 feet wide and approximately 320 feet deep, and contains a gross area of 0.3677 acres, (16,017 sq.ft.) more or less, zoned R.C.5. The R.C.5 regulations require a minimum lot area of 1.5 acres, and setbacks of no less than 50 feet to any property line. Thus, it is clear that the property could not be developed without the requested zoning relief. In support of the request, Counsel for the Petitioners noted that the property has been a duly recorded lot of record since 1921. Moreover, the proposed development will be compatible with the pattern of development in the neighborhood and will provide setbacks consistent with other houses in the community.

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, I am persuaded that relief should be granted. To deny relief would result in a practical difficulty for the Petitioners and prohibit reasonable use of the property for a permitted purpose. As noted above, many of the



lots are similar in area and width as the subject property. Moreover, the proposed dwelling will be consistent with the pattern of development in the neighborhood and meets the spirit and intent of Section 307 of the B.C.Z.R. and Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995). In this regard, the Office of Planning had requested that certain conditions be imposed to the grant of any relief to insure compliance with the R.C.5 zoning regulations and development standards. However, just prior to the start of the hearing, building elevation drawings of the proposed dwelling were submitted to the Office of Planning who provided an amended comment. That comment indicates they support the Petitioners' proposal and find same to be in accordance with the spirit and intent of the R.C.5 regulations and performance standards.

I further find that the subject property meets the requirements of Section 304 of the B.C.Z.R. and that the proposed development will not result in any increase in density. There were no adverse comments submitted by any County reviewing agency and no one appeared in opposition to the request. To the contrary, the community supports the proposal as evidenced by the letter received from the Bowleys Quarters Improvement Association. Thus, it appears that relief can be granted without detrimental impact to the surrounding locale. However, as conditions to this approval, the proposed dwelling shall be constructed substantially in accordance with the building elevation drawings reviewed and approved by the Office of Planning. Moreover, due to the property's waterfront location, the proposed construction must comply with Federal Flood Insurance regulations and Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas requirements as set forth in the Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments submitted by the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management and the Development Plans Review Division of the Department of Permits and Development Management, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on these Petitions held, and for the reasons set forth above, the relief requested shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Zoning Commissioner for Baltimore County this day of September 2005 that the Petition for Special Hearing seeking approval of the

subject property as an undersized lot and a determination that density will not be affected by the proposed development, pursuant to Section 1A04.3.B.1.a of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) be and is hereby GRANTED; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from Section 1A04.3.B.2.b to permit side yard setbacks of 10 feet each in lieu of the minimum required 50 feet, and from Section 1A04.3.A to allow a building height of 36'11-1/8" in lieu of the maximum allowed 35 feet for a proposed single-family dwelling, in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit 1, be and is hereby GRANTED, subject to the following restrictions:

- 1) The Petitioners may apply for their building permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, the Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until the 30-day appeal period from the date of this Order has expired. If an appeal is filed and this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.
- 2) The proposed dwelling shall be constructed substantially in accordance with the building elevation drawings reviewed and approved by the Office of Planning.
- 3) Compliance with the ZAC comments submitted by DEPRM and the Bureau of Development Plans Review relative to Chesapeake Bay Critical Areas regulations and all other appropriate environmental, floodplain and B.O.C.A. regulations for the protection of water quality, streams, wetlands and floodplains. Copies of those comments have been attached hereto and are made a part hereof.
- 4) When applying for any permits, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order

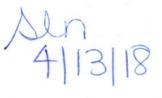
