**OPINION AND ORDER** 

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of a Petition for Special Hearing filed on behalf of Glen Arm Properties I, LLC, legal owner ("Petitioner"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: (1) to approve access to the local street or collector street through an existing right-of-way instead of an in-fee strip; and (2) to allow the continued use of an existing 1,440 ft. right-of-way access strip for up to three (3) lots. A site plan was marked and admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Frank Pommett and Bernadette Moskunas appeared in support of the petition. Timothy M. Kotroco Esq., represented the Petitioner. Several neighbors attended the hearing to obtain additional information about the request. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS), the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR) and the Department of Planning (DOP).

Petitioner purchased in 2016 a thirty-two (32) acre parcel of land on Glen Arm Road. The property was improved with a single-family dwelling, although it was in poor condition and suffered extensive fire damage. Mr. Pommett testified he owns a farm nearby, and that he intends for the immediate future to continue farming the subject property. Ultimately, Mr. Pommett indicated he and the other two members of the ownership entity plan to subdivide the property and construct three single-family dwellings. Petitioner would rebuild the dwelling previously owned by the Horner family and would construct two additional single-family dwellings. Mr. Pommett testified the dwellings would be situated near one another on the tract and that each of the three lots created in the minor subdivision process would be approximately ten (10) acres in size. As discussed at the hearing, both the BCZR and Maryland's Sustainable Growth and Agricultural Preservation Act of 2012 would limit to three (3) the number of dwellings on the subject property.

But this case does not concern the proposed minor subdivision. Rather, Petitioner seeks special hearing relief merely to confirm it has the right to continue using the "farm road" to access the subject property. Neighbors indicated the "road" is in extremely poor condition and during heavy storms there is considerable run-off from this driveway, and debris and sediment is washed onto Glen Arm Road and neighboring properties. As discussed at the hearing, Petitioner will be required during the minor subdivision process to improve the condition of the driveway and (along with Baltimore County and the existing owners who use this driveway) remedy the excessive stormwater run-off from this steep and unpaved driveway.

Under Baltimore County Code (BCC) section 32-4-409(b)(1) an owner proposing to access an interior lot(s) by a panhandle driveway is required to provide an "in-fee strip of land for access to the local street." But the law contains an "exception" when "a right-of-way has been established before the submission" of the plan. BCC §32-4-409(c). In that case, the ALJ can approve access to the local street "through the existing right-of-way instead of an in-fee strip." *Id.* Ms. Moskunas ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

testified the driveway has been in use in its current location for over 60 years, and deeds were submitted to substantiate this fact. As such, Petitioner is entitled to use this existing right-of-way to access the three (3) proposed building lots.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 7th day of May, 2018 by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing: (1) to approve access to the local street or collector street through an existing right-of-way instead of an in-fee strip; and (2) to allow the continued use of an existing 1,440 ft. right-of-way access strip for up to three (3) residential building lots, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

- Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioner must comply with the ZAC comment submitted by the DEPS, a copy of which is attached hereto.

Any appeal of this decision must be filed within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

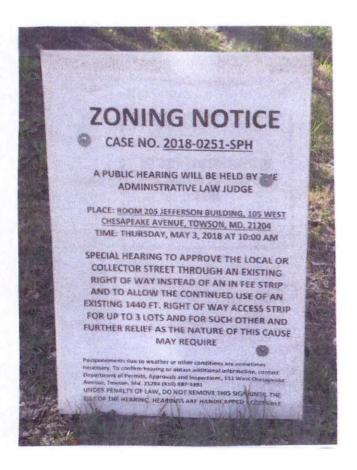

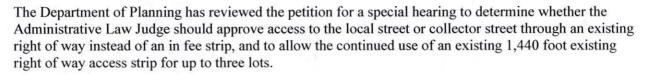

1. Any driveway/road improvements to take place within the future Forest Buffer Easement area will require an alternatives analysis.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Special Hearing filed by the owners of the subject property, Eben C. Eck, and his wife, Joan K. Eck. The Petitioners request a special hearing pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to approve a waiver to allow the non-density transfer of 1.24 acres (Parcel A) between the same owners, Joan and Eben Eck. In addition, approval of a waiver from Section 32-4-409(c) of the Baltimore County Code (B.C.C.), to allow a panhandle strip to access the local street through a right-of-way in lieu of an in-fee strip; and finally to approve a waiver from Section 32-4-409(f)(2) of the B.C.C. to allow three (3) lots utilizing an existing private access easement to the local public street in lieu of the required in-fee ownership. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted, which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing and testifying on behalf of the Petitioner was Bruce E. Doak with Gerhold, Cross & Etzel, Ltd., the consultants who prepared the site plan for this property and Eben Eck, owner and site developer. Also appearing in support of the petition was Walter E. Carr, an adjacent property owner to the west whose 21 acres borders the subject site.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is an irregular shaped tract located 500 feet to the south of Westminster Pike (Rte. 140) and just east of Gores Mill Road in Reisterstown. The property contains a gross area of 18.893 acres, more or less, zoned R.C.4 and currently undergoing a minor subdivision process. The Petitioners are desirous of subdividing one of the three separate lots of record, which they have owned for over five years, to create three building lots for proposed single-family dwellings.

As shown on the site plan, the Petitioners reside on Parcel No. 939, improved with a two-story dwelling, wood shed and driveway. Parcel No. 992 to the rear (south) of the residential property contains a barn. The unimproved Parcel No. 660, which is the subject of this hearing, is undergoing the subdivision process and consists of 16.36 acres. The Eck's propose to enhance the size and configuration of Parcel No. 992 on which the barn is located by means of a non-density transfer. They first propose to subdivide Parcel No. 660 into three lots. Lot 1 will be 1.91 acres, Lot 2, the conservancy lot, subject to B.C.Z.R. Section 1A03.5a - the Conservancy Area Standards – will be 11.39 acres and Lot 3 - 1.81 acres. Following the proposed subdivision as noted, the Petitioners will transfer the remainder of Parcel No. 660 (1.24 acres shown as Parcel A and presently planted with evergreen trees as shown on Petitioners' Exhibits 2L through 2Q) to the residential and barn parcel, with no density remaining. Thus, after creating the lots and the transfer, Petitioners would wind up with the same number of density units which they had before the transfers occurred. In my judgment, the conveyance will not be detrimental to the health, safety, or general welfare of the locale and is entirely consistent with the R.C.4 zoning and watershed protection use of the subject and adjacent properties.



Also at issue in the instant case, is the proposed access. In this regard, it is noted that for many years the Petitioners have utilized an existing 12' wide right-of-way through the property owned by the Reisterstown Bible Church to access their properties. Special Hearing relief is requested to determine whether the proposed lots can utilize the same access, in lieu of the in-fee access required by the B.C.C. In response to the Zoning Advisory Comment (ZAC) received from the Bureau of Plans Review, Petitioners will receive an in-fee conveyance of a 40' wide x 500' long strip or parcel from the Reisterstown Bible Church to provide access to the existing Eck dwelling and proposed Lots 1-3 of the minor subdivision. This will provide a 40' wide easement and allow for the driveway widening to 16' from Westminster Pike to the Eck property. From there, a 30' wide right-of-way with a 16' paved driveway and minimum curve radius of 30' will run an additional length of 400' to the tee-turnaround and access to the three new proposed lots.

The B.C.C. provides that all access to public roads occur via in-fee strips of land; however, Section 32-4-409(c) thereof allows access via an existing right-of-way instead of an in-fee strip where same has been established before the development plan is submitted. There is no dispute that the subject right-of-way driveway has been established and is currently in use. Additionally, there were no adverse ZAC comments submitted by any County reviewing agency. I am, therefore, of the opinion, after consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, that the requested relief can be granted and find that the proposed access is appropriate in this instance given the fact that it has existed for many years and will be widened, improved and is proposed to serve only three additional lots.

- 1) ADVISORY: This Order approves the requested special hearing but does not address the proposed subdivision. The Petitioners subdivision proposal to create the proposed three (3) lots must be submitted to the Development Review Committee for consideration and processing.
- 2) The resulting non-density transfer so created shall be used for agricultural purposes. There is no development potential for this non-density parcel.
- 3) Prior to the conveyance of any building lots, the Petitioners shall prepare a covenant (use in common and maintenance agreement for the access road) from Westminster Pike (Rte. 140) to and including the 30' x 70' tee turnaround at the end of the use in common driveway to include as parties the Petitioners residence on Parcel 939 and the three lots to be created through the minor subdivision process. Said agreement shall be reviewed and approved by the trustees of the Reisterstown Bible Church and then recorded with the record plat for each of the proposed dwellings.
- 4) The Petitioners shall provide trash and mail pads at Westminster Pike.

- 6) The development of this property must comply with the forest conservation regulations (Sections 33-6-101 through 33-6-122) of the Baltimore County Code).
- Prior to the issuance of any building permits, the Petitioners shall landscape the 40' right-of-way in accordance with a landscape plan to be prepared and showing trees along the right-of-way, and to be reviewed and approved by the Reisterstown Bible Church.
- 8) When applying for a building permit, the site plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

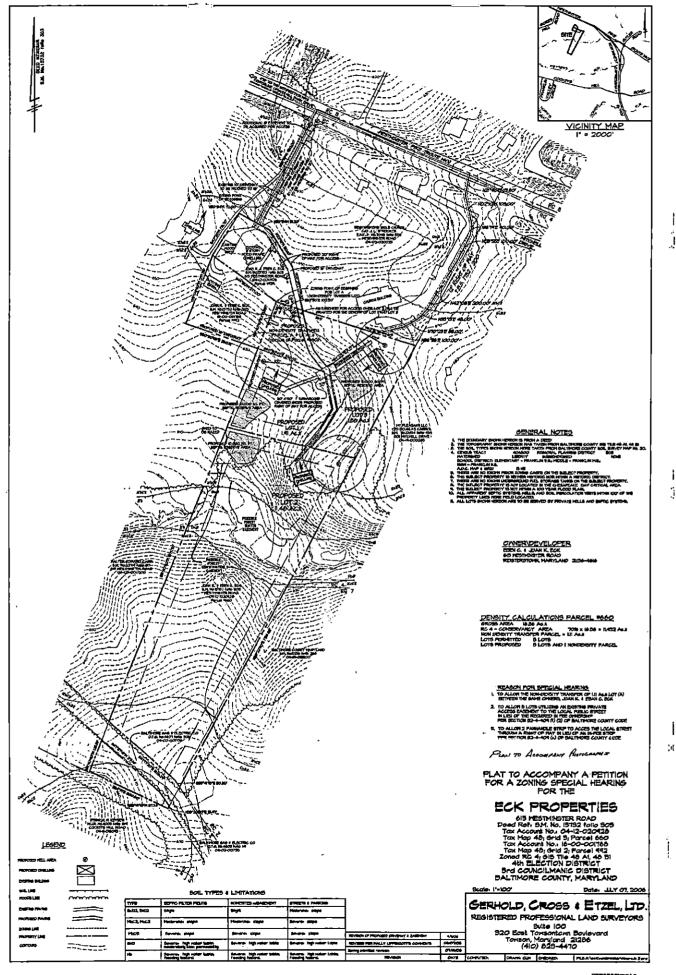

#### § 32-4-409. - PANHANDLE DRIVEWAYS.

- (a) In general.
  - (1) The county may only allow a panhandle lot:
    - (i) To achieve better use of irregularly shaped parcels;
    - (ii) To avoid development in environmentally sensitive areas;
    - (iii) Where the lot will not be detrimental to adjacent properties; and
    - (iv) Were the lot will not conflict with efforts to provide for public safety and general welfare.
  - (2) The county may only allow a panhandle driveway where necessary to provide access to interior lots where a public road is neither feasible nor desirable.
- (b) In-fee strip; required.
  - (1) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, the county may permit a panhandle lot if the lot includes an in-fee strip of land for access to the local street.
  - (2) Panhandle fee strips shall be a minimum of:
    - (i) 20 feet in width to serve one lot;
    - (ii) 12 feet in width per lot where two lots are involved;
    - (iii) 10 feet in width per lot where three or more lots are involved; or
    - (iv) 12 feet in width per lot where there are two or more lots in a development that is within the metropolitan area where public water and sewer services are available, planned, or considered.
- (c) Same; exception. In cases where a right-of-way has been established before the submission of the Development Plan, the Hearing Officer may approve access to the local street or collector street through the existing right-of-way instead of an in-fee strip.
- (d) Panhandle driveways.
  - (1) A single panhandle driveway may serve up to five dwellings, three of which may be on internal lots not adjacent to the local street or collector street.
  - (2) Panhandle driveways serving lots greater than 20,000 square feet may serve five internal lots plus two dwellings on the front lots adjacent to the panhandle driveway and the local street or collector street.
  - (3) Front lots are not required to be part of the panhandle driveway development.
  - (4) Notwithstanding the provisions of § 32-4-107 of this title, the requirements of this subsection may not be waived.
- (e) Length of panhandle in DR and RC zones.
  - (1) In a DR zone, the panhandle length may not exceed 500 feet.
  - (2) In an RC zone, the panhandle length may not exceed 1,000 feet.
  - (3) The maximum permitted length of a panhandle is subject to variance under § 307 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations.
- (f) Panhandle driveways serving multiple lots.
  - (1) For panhandle driveways serving more than one lot, the developer shall note on the record plat any covenants that provide for common use and maintenance of the panhandle driveway and culvert.

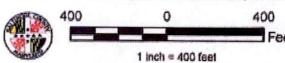

### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Special Hearing filed by the owners of the subject property, Eben C. Eck, and his wife, Joan K. Eck. The Petitioners request a special hearing pursuant to Section 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to approve a waiver to allow the non-density transfer of 1.24 acres (Parcel A) between the same owners, Joan and Eben Eck. In addition, approval of a waiver from Section 32-4-409(c) of the Baltimore County Code (B.C.C.), to allow a panhandle strip to access the local street through a right-of-way in lieu of an in-fee strip; and finally to approve a waiver from Section 32-4-409(f)(2) of the B.C.C. to allow three (3) lots utilizing an existing private access easement to the local public street in lieu of the required in-fee ownership. The subject property and requested relief are more particularly described on the site plan submitted, which was accepted into evidence and marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the requisite public hearing and testifying on behalf of the Petitioner was Bruce E. Doak with Gerhold, Cross & Etzel, Ltd., the consultants who prepared the site plan for this property and Eben Eck, owner and site developer. Also appearing in support of the petition was Walter E. Carr, an adjacent property owner to the west whose 21 acres borders the subject site.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property is an irregular shaped tract located 500 feet to the south of Westminster Pike (Rte. 140) and just east of Gores Mill Road in Reisterstown. The property contains a gross area of 18.893 acres, more or less, zoned R.C.4 and currently undergoing a minor subdivision process. The Petitioners are desirous of subdividing one of the three separate lots of record, which they have owned for over five years, to create three building lots for proposed single-family dwellings.

As shown on the site plan, the Petitioners reside on Parcel No. 939, improved with a two-story dwelling, wood shed and driveway. Parcel No. 992 to the rear (south) of the residential property contains a barn. The unimproved Parcel No. 660, which is the subject of this hearing, is undergoing the subdivision process and consists of 16.36 acres. The Eck's propose to enhance the size and configuration of Parcel No. 992 on which the barn is located by means of a non-density transfer. They first propose to subdivide Parcel No. 660 into three lots. Lot 1 will be 1.91 acres, Lot 2, the conservancy lot, subject to B.C.Z.R. Section 1A03.5a - the Conservancy Area Standards - will be 11.39 acres and Lot 3 - 1.81 acres. Following the proposed subdivision as noted, the Petitioners will transfer the remainder of Parcel No. 660 (1.24 acres shown as Parcel A and presently planted with evergreen trees as shown on Petitioners' Exhibits 2L through 2Q) to the residential and barn parcel, with no density remaining. Thus, after creating the lots and the transfer, Petitioners would wind up with the same number of density units which they had before the transfers occurred. In my judgment, the conveyance will not be detrimental to the health, safety, or general welfare of the locale and is entirely consistent with the R.C.4 zoning and watershed protection use of the subject and adjacent properties.



Also at issue in the instant case, is the proposed access. In this regard, it is noted that for many years the Petitioners have utilized an existing 12' wide right-of-way through the property owned by the Reisterstown Bible Church to access their properties. Special Hearing relief is requested to determine whether the proposed lots can utilize the same access, in lieu of the in-fee access required by the B.C.C. In response to the Zoning Advisory Comment (ZAC) received from the Bureau of Plans Review, Petitioners will receive an in-fee conveyance of a 40' wide x 500' long strip or parcel from the Reisterstown Bible Church to provide access to the existing Eck dwelling and proposed Lots 1-3 of the minor subdivision<sup>1</sup>. This will provide a 40' wide easement and allow for the driveway widening to 16' from Westminster Pike to the Eck property. From there, a 30' wide right-of-way with a 16' paved driveway and minimum curve radius of 30' will run an additional length of 400' to the tee-turnaround and access to the three new proposed lots.

The B.C.C. provides that all access to public roads occur via in-fee strips of land; however, Section 32-4-409(c) thereof allows access via an existing right-of-way instead of an in-fee strip where same has been established before the development plan is submitted. There is no dispute that the subject right-of-way driveway has been established and is currently in use. Additionally, there were no adverse ZAC comments submitted by any County reviewing agency. I am, therefore, of the opinion, after consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, that the requested relief can be granted and find that the proposed access is appropriate in this instance given the fact that it has existed for many years and will be widened, improved and is proposed to serve only three additional lots.

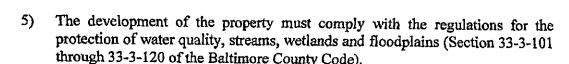

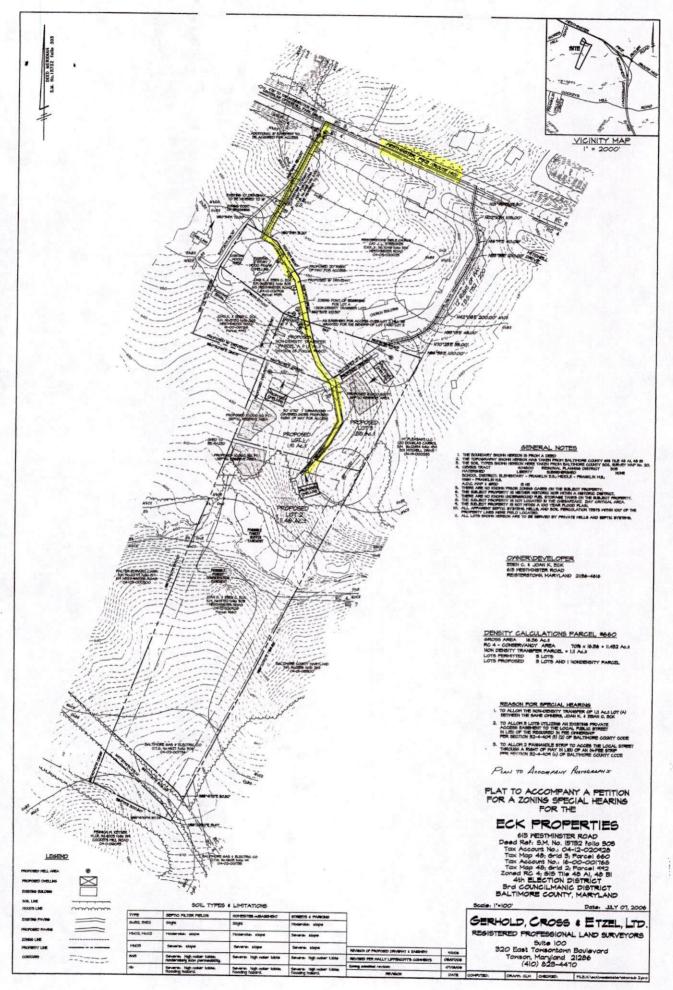

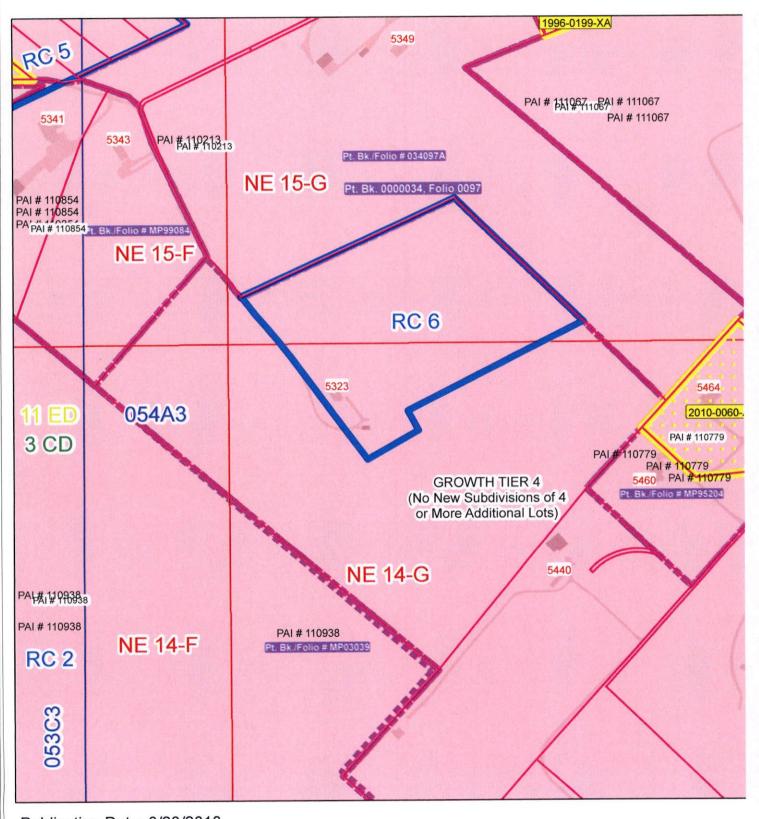
