### **OPINION AND ORDER**

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by Richard & Cathy Stryjewski, legal owners of the subject property ("Petitioners"). The Petition seeks variance relief from §§ 1B02.3.C.1, 301.1 and 303 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: (1) to permit a replacement dwelling with a front yard (water side) and rear yard (street side) setbacks of 39 ft. and 39 ft., respectively (for a double frontage lot) in lieu of the minimum required averaged setback of 40 ft. (for both); (2) to permit side yard setbacks of 7 ft. and 8 ft., respectively, in lieu of the minimum required 10 ft.; and (3) to permit an open projection (deck) setback of 21 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 30 ft. A site plan was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Richard Stryjewski and professional engineer William Bafitis appeared in support of the petition. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"), the Bureau of Development Plans Review ("DPR") and the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability ("DEPS").

The site is approximately 7,400 square feet in size and zoned DR 5.5. The property is ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING

improved with a modest single family dwelling which has been owned by Petitioners' family for over 60 years. Petitioners now use the property as a weekend retreat, but they plan to raze the existing dwelling and construct a new, larger single family dwelling on the lot.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The waterfront lot is narrow and deep, and the property is therefore unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to construct the new single family dwelling. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of Baltimore County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>29<sup>th</sup></u> day of **May**, **2018**, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance: (1) to permit a replacement dwelling with a front yard (water side) and rear yard (street side) setbacks of 39 ft. and 39 ft., respectively (for a double frontage lot) in lieu of the minimum required averaged setback of 40 ft. (for both); (2) to permit side yard setbacks of 7 ft. and 8 ft., respectively, in lieu of the minimum required 10 ft.; and (3) to permit an open projection (deck) setback of 21 ft. in lieu of the minimum required 30 ft., be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time

is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

- 2. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must comply with critical area and flood protection regulations.
- 3. As noted in the DOP's ZAC comment, Petitioners shall not be permitted to use or store items on the County-owned property adjacent to the subject property.
- 4. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners shall be required to install a vegetative buffer extending southeasterly 25 ft. from the existing fence.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for a variance to permit a replacement dwelling with a front yard (water side) and rear yard (street side) setbacks of 39 feet and 38 feet, respectively (for a double frontage lot) in lieu of the minimum required averaged setback of 40 feet (for both); and to permit a side yard setback of 7 feet and 8 feet respectively, in lieu of the minimum required 10 feet, and to permit an open projection (deck) setback of 21 feet in lieu of minimum required 30 feet.

A site visit was conducted on April 6, 2018. The site is improved with an existing 1 story building with additional impervious surfaces to be removed.

The Department of Planning has no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief conditioned upon the following:

- Unless it can be demonstrated that a safety issue is raised, the Department recommends the proposed dwelling be situated such that the required 40' structure setback with an open projection having a setback of 22' on the waterfront side be established. The proposed structure should also hold the required 10' side setback on that side adjacent to #9032 (#9028?) Hinton Ave. This would result in setback deficiencies of 37' street side and 5' on the southwest side of the building which the Department can support. In doing so the bulk of the structure and its inherent impacts on the adjacent residential property is mitigated to the extent possible.
- The Department advises that the subject property lies adjacent to a county-owned public shore access. Historically, these public spaces have been encroached upon and improperly used, often by neighboring landowners. The applicant shall not use the county property for storage and shall make no improvements that would encroach upon this public space. Install vegetative plantings that will not impede sight distance upon maturity, extending southeasterly 25' from the existing fence, inside of and along the N 53 Deg. 03'07" W 148.00' line.
- Confirm the address of the adjacent property.

The subject property is located within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area. According to BCZR Section 500.14, no decision shall be rendered on any petition for special exception, zoning variance, or zoning special hearing for a property within the Critical Area until the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (EPS) has provided written recommendations describing how the proposed request would:

1. Minimize adverse impacts on water quality that result from pollutants that are discharged from structures or conveyances or that have run off from surrounding lands;

The subject property is located within a Limited Development Area (LDA), and is subject to Critical Area lot coverage requirements. Critical Area lot coverage differs from BCZR lot coverage and is defined in Natural Resources Article §8-1802(a)(17), as follows:

- (17) (i) "Lot coverage" means that percentage of total lot or parcel that is:
- 1. Occupied by a structure, parking area, driveway, walkway, or roadway; or
- 2. Covered with gravel, stone, shell impermeable decking, a paver, permeable pavement, or any manmade material
- (ii) "Lot coverage" includes the ground area covered or occupied by a stairway or impermeable deck.
- (iii) "Lot coverage" does not include:

- 1. A fence or wall that is less than 1 foot in width that has not been constructed with a footer;
- 2. A walkway in the buffer or expanded buffer, including a stairway, that provides direct access to a community or private pier;
- 3. A wood mulch pathway; or .
- 4. A deck with gaps to allow the water to pass freely.

The petitioner is requesting to permit a replacement dwelling with front yard, rear yard and side yard setback reductions, and an open projection setback reduction, all in lieu of the minimum required setbacks. In order to minimize impacts on water quality, the applicant must comply with the LDA lot coverage requirements. The property is also located within a Modified Buffer Area (MBA), which further restricts impervious surfaces and structures within 100 feet landward of mean high water (100 foot buffer). Any building permits or plans received by DEPS for review will include application of the LDA and MBA regulations, therefore, by allowing the items requested by the petitioner, impacts on water quality will be minimized.

2. Conserve fish, wildlife, and plant habitat; and

The current development proposal for the property will be reviewed for application of the LDA and MBA requirements, which will improve buffer functions, and conserve fish, wildlife and plant habitat in Back River and the Chesapeake Bay.

3. Be consistent with established land use policies for development in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area which accommodate growth and also address the fact that, even if pollution is controlled, the number, movement and activities of persons in that area can create adverse environmental impacts.

The items requested will be consistent with established land use policies, provided that the applicants meet any LDA and MBA requirements applicable to the proposal. The request, if granted, will minimize environmental impacts.

I apologize for the delay, but thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above-referenced Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) case included on the agenda for its April 9, 2017 meeting. See the attachment for more details.

Based on the information provided by Baltimore County, the State Coordinating Office of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) offers the following comments for consideration by the ZAC:

- 1. The proposed residence will be in two flood zones, Zone AE (EL 5) and Zone AE (EL 7). The more restrictive flood zone prevails for floodplain management and insurance purposes, so Zone AE (EL 7).
- 2. Baltimore County has a 2 foot freeboard requirement for new structures in the tidal AE zones, so the lowest floor must be elevated to or above 9.0 feet NAVD 88.
- 3. It appears the proposed residence will be sited outsize the Coastal A Zone (CAZ) as defined by the Limit of Moderate Wave Action (LiMWA) line. If this is not correct, additional foundation requirements apply to account for wave action.
- 4. All other requirements of the County Codes pertaining to flood openings in enclosures, elevating electrical and mechanical equipment, use of flood resistant materials, anchoring fuel tanks, etc. apply.

See the attached maps for reference. The first map was created using the Maryland Flood Risk Application on <a href="http://mdfloodmaps.net/">http://mdfloodmaps.net/</a>. The second was created on <a href="https://msc.fema.gov/portal">https://msc.fema.gov/portal</a> and is a portion of the effective Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), Panel No. 2400100560G dated May 5, 2014.
