OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by GGCV Real Estate, LLC, legal owner of the subject property and Palio-Foundry Row, LLC, lessee ("Petitioners"). The Petition seeks variance relief from § 450.4 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: (1) To allow a total of seven enterprise signs (wall-mounted, canopy, blade structural types) for a tenant with three separate facades within a multi-tenant building in lieu of the four enterprise signs permitted (two canopy and two wall-mounted); and (2) To allow a wall-mounted enterprise sign for a tenant within a multi-tenant building to exceed the permitted sign/face area of two times the length of the wall defining the space occupied by the separate commercial entity (south façade without an exterior entrance--320 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 160 sq. ft.). A two-sheet site plan was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1A & 1B.

Michael Gibbons and landscape architect Michael Pieranunzi appeared in support of the petition. David H. Karceski, Esq. represented the Petitioners. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comment was received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"). That agency did not oppose the requests.

The site is approximately 39.159 acres in size and zoned BM. This case involves the mixed use project known as Foundry Row, located at the intersection of Reisterstown and Painters Mill Roads. The center features retail, residential, office and services uses, and the lessee recently opened an Italian-themed restaurant known as "Palio." The zoning request concerns signage for this tenant.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

This large tract has irregular dimensions and a significant grade change across the site. As such the property is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to provide appropriate signage for this new restaurant. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 20th day of June, 2018, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance pursuant to § 450.4 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR"): (1) To allow a total of seven enterprise signs (wall-mounted, canopy, blade structural types) for a tenant with three separate facades within a multi-tenant building in lieu of the four enterprise signs permitted (two canopy and two wall-mounted); and (2) To allow a wall-mounted enterprise sign for a tenant within a multi-tenant building to exceed the permitted sign/face area of two times the length of the wall defining the space occupied

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by the separate commercial entity (south façade without an exterior entrance--320 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 160 sq. ft.), be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

1. Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for variance to permit seven enterprise signs (wall-mounted, canopy, and blade structural types) for a tenant with three separate facades within a multi-tenant building in lieu of the four enterprise signs permitted and to permit wall-mounted enterprise signs for a tenant within a multi-tenant building to exceed the permitted sign/face area of two times the length of the wall defining the space occupied by the separate commercial entity.

A site visit was conducted on May 10, 2018. The site is located within the Foundry Row complex. The restaurant is currently being built-out internally and is not freestanding. The Department was initially concerned with the size of the mural style signs extending the entire length of the upper façade. After meeting with the petitioner's representative, Mr. David Karceski, it was decided to decrease the overall length of the signs in order to allow for more of a brick framing. Updated graphics were provided on May 31, 2018 showing the signs with a decreased length and are contained herein.

The Department of Planning does not oppose the request relief conditioned upon the following:

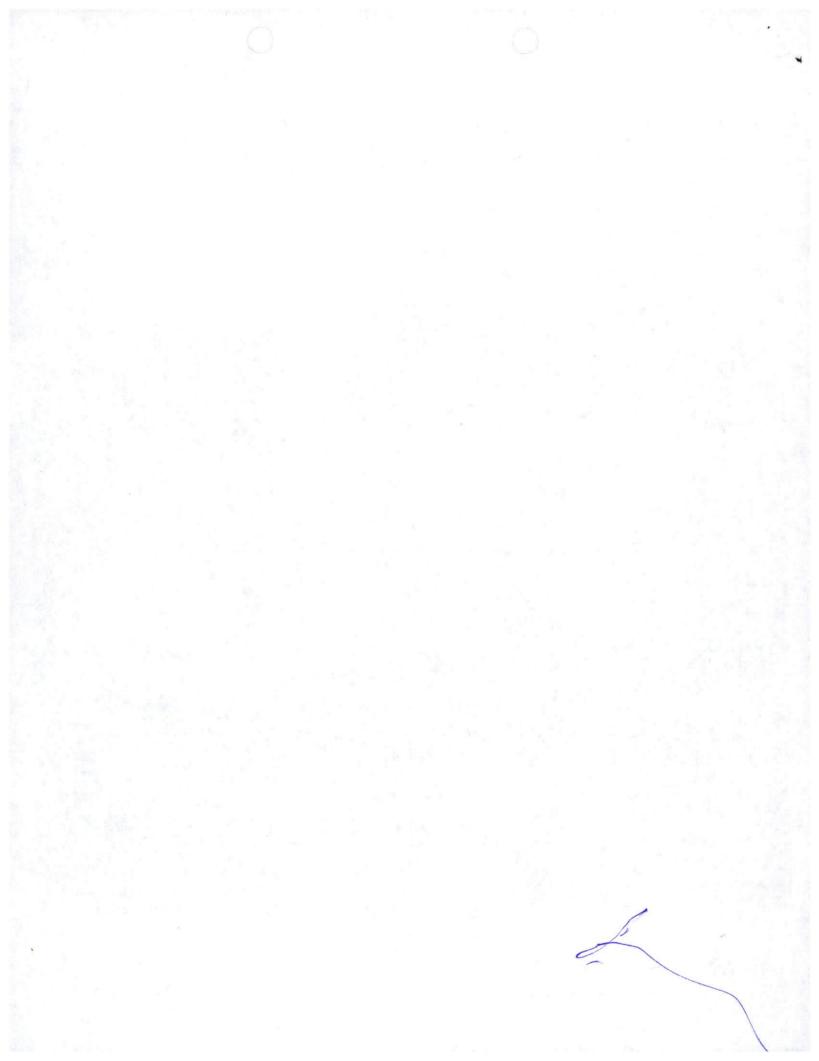

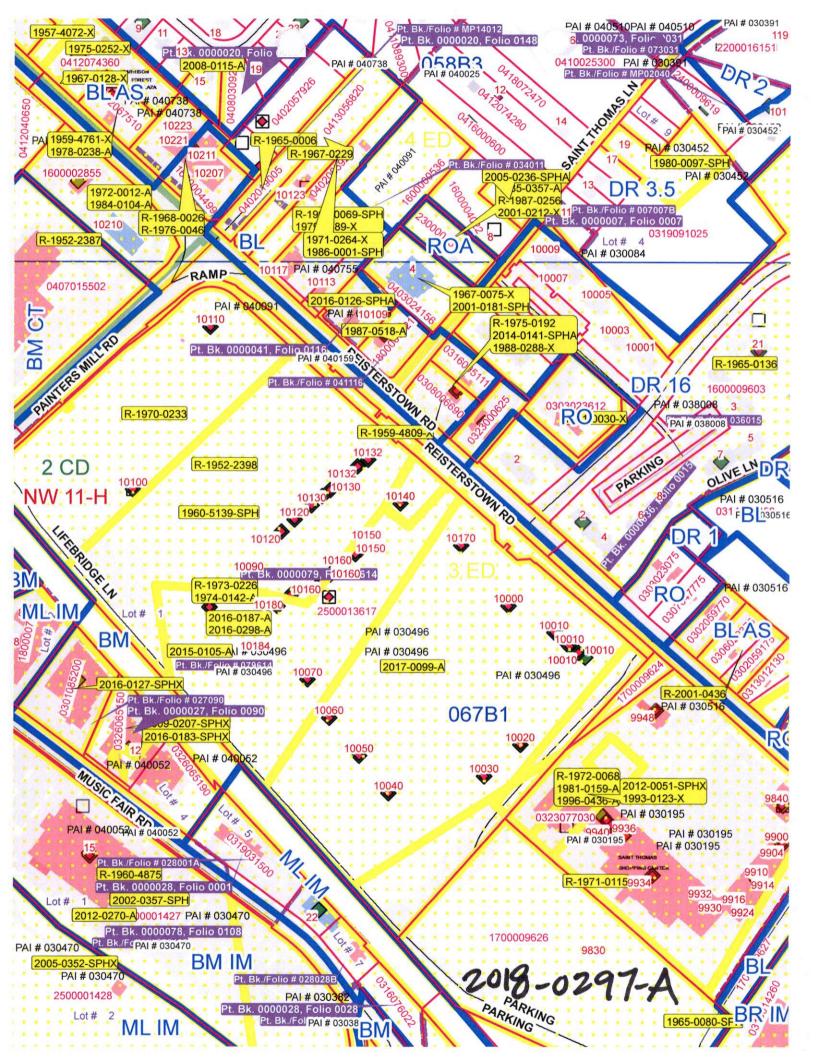

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by GGCV Real Estate, LLC, owner of the subject property and Zoes Maryland, LLC, lessee ("Petitioners"). The Petitioners are requesting Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) to permit a total of 5 wall-mounted enterprise signs in lieu of the 3 permitted by way of the variance granted in Case No. 2016-0298-A, as follows: (A) On the southeast wall, 2 wall-mounted enterprise signs in lieu of the permitted one wall-mounted and one canopy sign with sign areas/faces of 112 and 5 sq. ft. instead of the permitted 63 and 0 sq. ft. (Sign Nos. 1 and 2); (B) On the northeast wall, 2 wall-mounted enterprise signs in lieu of the permitted one wall-mounted and one canopy sign with sign area/faces of 105 and 105 sq. ft. instead of the permitted 60 and 63.58 sq. ft. (Sign Nos. 3 and 4); and (C) On the northwest wall, 1 wall-mounted enterprise sign with a sign area/face of 98 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 56 sq. ft. (Sign No. 5). A two-sheet site plan was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1A & 1B.

Landscape architect Michael Pieranunzi and Keith Miller appeared in support of the petition. David H. Karceski, Esq. represented the Petitioners. There were no Protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the

B.C.Z.R. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from .

County review agencies.

The subject property is approximately 49.5 acres and is zoned BM. The Foundry Row shopping center is located at the site, and is a mixed-use development featuring retail, restaurants and office space. This case involves one tenant at the center, Zoës Kitchen, which proposes to install at its restaurant certain signage for which zoning relief is required.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioners have met this test. The large property has irregular dimensions and a significant (+/-60 ft.) grade change across the site, as shown on the grading plan submitted as Petitioners' Exhibit 5. As such it is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to install the proposed signs. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of Baltimore County and community opposition. In addition, the proposed signs are tasteful and will not cause "visual clutter," and the Department of Planning noted they are in compliance with the pattern book approved in the Foundry Row development case.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 9th day of December, 2016, by the Administrative

Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance to permit a total of 5 wall-mounted

enterprise signs in lieu of the 3 permitted by way of the variance granted in Case No. 2016-0298-A, as follows: (A) On the southeast wall, 2 wall-mounted enterprise signs in lieu of the permitted one wall-mounted and one canopy sign with sign areas/faces of 112 and 5 sq. ft. instead of the permitted 63 and 0 sq. ft. (Sign Nos. 1 and 2); (B) On the northeast wall, 2 wall-mounted enterprise signs in lieu of the permitted one wall-mounted and one canopy sign with sign area/faces of 105 and 105 sq. ft. instead of the permitted 60 and 63.58 sq. ft. (Sign Nos. 3 and 4); and (C) On the northwest wall, 1 wall-mounted enterprise sign with a sign area/face of 98 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 56 sq. ft. (Sign No. 5), be and is hereby GRANTED.

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance on behalf of GGCV Real Estate, LLC, owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). Petitioner is requesting Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) §450.4 as follows: (1) To permit wall-mounted enterprise signs accessory to each of the commercial entities of multi-tenant retail buildings C1, C2, C3, D, E, F1, F2, G, H, I, K and L on the side and rear facades without customer entrances and with a maximum face area for each façade of two times the length of that façade; (2) To permit a wall-mounted joint identification sign with a maximum face area of 3,916 sq. ft. in lieu of the permitted 480 sq. ft. (12% of area of wall upon which sign is erected); and (3) To permit projecting enterprise signs accessory to each of the commercial entities of multi-tenant retail buildings C1, C2, C3, D, E, F1, F2, G, H, I, K, and L with visible structural framework and supporting elements to extend 6 ft. from the wall to which they are attached in lieu of the required 4 ft. extension and to extend 6 ft. into the curb face over a sidewalk or walkway in lieu of the required 1 ft. A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1A & 1B.

Civil engineer Troy Slevin and Gustavo Rango (on behalf of the owner) appeared in support of the petition. Jason T. Vettori, Esq. represented the Petitioner. The Petition was

advertised and posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. No protestants or interested citizens attended the hearing. There were no substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments received from any of the County agencies.

The subject property is zoned BM and is known as the Foundry Row Shopping Center. The site is approximately 50 acres and will contain a variety of retail and commercial establishments.

This case concerns signage for retail and commercial tenants that will occupy space at the center.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioner has met this test. The large site is irregularly shaped and is therefore unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted, Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty because it would be unable to provide appropriate signage for existing and prospective tenants. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of Baltimore County and/or community opposition.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>18th</u> day of July, 2016, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") §450.4 as follows: (1) To permit wall-mounted enterprise signs accessory to each of the commercial entities of multi-tenant retail buildings C1, C2, C3, D, E, F1, F2, G, H, I, K and L on the side and rear facades without customer entrances and with a maximum face area for each façade of two times the length of that façade; (2) To permit

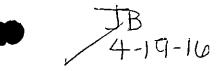

There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. No substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received.

The subject property is zoned BM and is the site of the Foundry Row shopping center. The petition concerns wall-mounted enterprise signs for the new Wegman's store which will open in the near future. Counsel explained the "sign package" proposed for the store is identical to that approved for the Wegman's location at Hunt Valley Towne Center, which has been very successful

since it opened several years ago.

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance on behalf of the legal owner of the subject property. This case concerns only the signage proposed for the Foundry Row project. As is often the case with large commercial projects (the Foundry Row project encompasses nearly 50 acres and will have 425,000 square feet of commercial/office space) a variety of sign variances are sought, and the Petition identified the relief sought with respect to each of the sign types proposed for the site.

The Petitioner is requesting Variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (B.C.Z.R.) as follows:

Wall-Mounted Enterprise Signs:

- 1. Pursuant to §450.4 Attachment 1.5(d)(vi) to permit three (3) wall-mounted enterprise signs for LA Fitness (Building 1) in lieu of the permitted one (1) such sign per entity with a separate exterior customer entrance (two (2) of which do not have customer entrances); and
- 2. Pursuant to §450.4 Attachment 1.5(d)(v) to permit wall-mounted enterprise signs for LA Fitness (Building 1) with a maximum area/face of up to 350 square feet in lieu of the permitted 320 square feet (i.e. two times the length of the wall (160 feet) containing the exterior entrance and defining the space occupied by the separate commercial entity); and

Freestanding Joint Identification Signs:

1. Pursuant to §450.4 Attachment 1.7(b)(vi) to permit up to 3 freestanding joint identification signs per frontage on Reisterstown Road and Painters Mill Road for 1 Sign

- A and 2 Sign B or Sign C's (or, in the alternative, up to 2 freestanding joint identification signs per frontage on Reisterstown Road and Painters Mill Road (as well as the one at the corner of Reisterstown Road and Painters Mill Road)); and
- 2. Pursuant to §450.4 Attachment 1.7(b)(ix) to permit freestanding joint identification signs fronting on Reisterstown Road and Painters Mill Road with up to 9 lines of copy in lieu of the maximum of 5 lines of copy; and

Freestanding Directory Sign:

- 1. Pursuant to §§450.4 Attachment 1.4 & 450.7.A.1 to permit a freestanding directory sign with:
 - a. Lettering indicating the names and locations of occupants up to 12 inches high in lieu of the maximum permitted 2 inches high; and
 - b. Other lettering indicating the "identity" (as defined in B.C.Z.R. §450.3) of the shopping center up to 4 feet high in lieu of the maximum permitted 3 inches high; and

Joint Identification Signs with Changeable Copy:

1. Pursuant to §§450.4 Attachment 1.1©(vi), 450.6.B.3 and/or 450.7.B to permit up to 4 joint identification signs with up to 50% of the face area devoted to changeable copy (and to confirm that what is labeled on sheet 3 of 3 on the plan as Joint Identification Sign C constitutes a freestanding changeable copy sign erected as an integral part of an otherwise permitted freestanding joint identification sign which is permitted to have up to 50% of the face area devoted to changeable copy (i.e. up to 43 s.f. is permitted if the face area is 86 s.f.))

A three-sheet site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1A-1C, and it contains further details regarding the site and the design and location of the proposed signs.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the requests was Kim Potember, Authorized Representative of GGCV Real Estate LLC. Michael Pieranunzi, a landscape architect accepted as an expert, provided testimony (via proffer) in support of the variance requests. Lawrence Schmidt, Esquire from Smith, Gildea & Schmidt, LLC, represented the Petitioner. No Protestants or interested citizens attended the hearing. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the B.C.Z.R. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Department of Planning (DOP) dated December 11, 2014.

To obtain variance relief requires a showing that:

- (1) The property is unique; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel, 407 Md. 53, 80 (2008).

Petitioner has met this test. As noted earlier, the property is nearly 50 acres and has irregular dimensions; i.e., it is shaped like a pan handle lot. Both of these attributes make the property unique. If the B.C.Z.R. were strictly interpreted the Petitioner would suffer a practical difficulty, given it would be unable to install the signage as proposed.

While at first blush it might seem the signage is excessive, on closer examination I believe the relief sought is both reasonable and consistent with the signage featured at other prominent retail and commercial projects. When you consider that along this stretch of Reisterstown Road each fast food outlet or other small business has its own freestanding sign (see Exhibits 4A-4F), the five freestanding signs proposed for this 50 acre site, which will have 15 or more individual buildings/retailers, seems reasonable indeed. I also find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R., and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the lack of County and/or community opposition.

The DOP did not oppose the relief, and it believed the proposed signage presents "a consistent aesthetic for the entire project." The DOP's ZAC comment identified four proposed conditions regarding the location of the freestanding signs. After consulting with the DOP, the Petitioner prepared a redlined sign variance plan (Exhibits 2A-2C) which identified the precise location of each freestanding sign, and thus that agency's concerns have been addressed. The

DOP also reviewed and approved sign elevations with logos and font/typeface details for proposed anchor tenants (including LA Fitness and Wegmans), and the signs will be attractive and constructed of high quality materials. See Exhibits 3A & 3B.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this 2nd day of January, 2015, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance seeking relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") as follows:

Wall-Mounted Enterprise Signs:

- 1. Pursuant to §450.4 Attachment 1.5(d)(vi) to permit three (3) wall-mounted enterprise signs for LA Fitness (Building 1) in lieu of the permitted one (1) such sign per entity with a separate exterior customer entrance (two (2) of which do not have customer entrances); and
- 2. 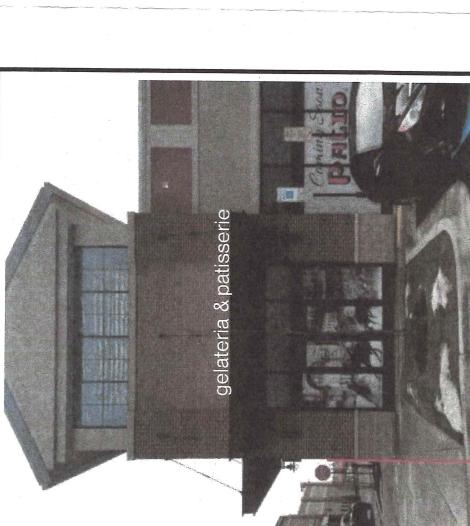
SIDE ELEVATION

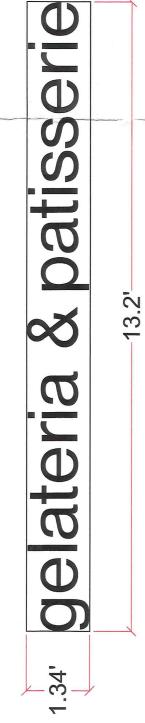
