OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) as Petitions for Special Exception and Variance filed for property located at 10811 Pulaski Highway. The Petitions were filed on behalf of Eben Limited Partnership, LLLP, legal owner and Show & Tell of White Marsh, lessee ("Petitioners"). The Special Exception petition seeks approval to use the subject property for a used motor vehicle sales area separated from sales agency building. The Petition for Variance seeks approval: (1) for parking to be within 0 ft. of the public right-of-way in lieu of the required 10 ft.; and (2) to allow display of vehicles to be within 0 ft. of the public right-of-way in lieu of the front setback of requirement of 15 ft. in front of the 52 ft. front setback required. A site plan was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the hearing in support of the petitions was professional engineer Rick Richardson. Steven R. Freeman, Esq. represented the Lessee. Several members of the community, represented by John Gontrum, Esq., expressed concern regarding certain aspects of the case. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations (BCZR). Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Department of Planning (DOP), the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS), and the Bureau of Development Plans Review ("DPR").

The subject property is approximately 1.52 acres in size and is zoned BR-AS. The history of the site was discussed at the hearing and it appears a special exception for a used car sales lot was granted in 1995, although it was terminated in 2004 at the owner's request. A service garage (window tinting) also operated at the site in prior years. At present, the Lessee seeks special exception approval for a used car sales facility, and a service garage (permitted by right in the BR-AS zone) would also be operated on the site.

#### SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Under Maryland law, a special exception use enjoys a presumption that it is in the interest of the general welfare, and therefore, valid. *Schultz v. Pritts*, 291 Md. 1 (1981). The *Schultz* standard was revisited in *Attar v. DMS Tollgate*, *LLC*, 451 Md. 272 (2017), where the court of appeals discussed the nature of the evidentiary presumption in special exception cases. The court again emphasized a special exception is properly denied only when there are facts and circumstances showing that the adverse impacts of the use at the particular location in question would be above and beyond those inherently associated with the special exception use. No evidence was presented to suggest the inherent adverse impacts associated with a used car sales facility would be more pronounced at this location, and thus the petition will be granted.

#### <u>VARIANCE</u>

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- 1. It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The property has irregular dimensions and is therefore unique. If the BCZR were strictly interpreted Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty since they would be unable to use the subject property for a used motor vehicle sales facility. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety, and general welfare. Conditions will be included in the order below to help ensure that the potential impacts upon the community are minimized.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, this 19th day of February, 2019, that the Petition for Special Exception to use the subject property for a used motor vehicle sales area separated from sales agency building, be and is hereby GRANTED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petition for Variance: (1) for parking to be within 0 ft. of the public right-of-way in lieu of the required 10 ft.; and (2) to allow display of vehicles to be within 0 ft. of the public right-of-way in lieu of the front setback of requirement of 15 ft. in front of the 52 ft. front setback required, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt
of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that
proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date
hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for
whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to
return the subject property to its original condition.

2. Petitioners must within 15 days of the date hereof submit to Baltimore County and Mr. Gontrum an amended site plan indicating the property will be used for a service garage. The amended plan must also show the off-street parking required for the service garage use (in addition to the spaces proposed for inventory/customer parking associated with the used car sales operation).

 Damaged and/or disabled motor vehicles may not be kept at the site unless they are stored within an enclosure satisfying the requirements set forth at BCZR §405A.

- 4. Unless permitted following a public hearing, Petitioners shall not use the area at the rear of the site which adjoins Ebenezer Road, as shown on the site plan with the notations "NO CAR STORAGE IN THIS AREA IS PERMITTED" and "EXISTING AREA NOT PAVED."
- 5. Petitioners must comply with the ZAC comments of the DOP, DEPS & DPR, copies of which are attached hereto and are expressly incorporated herein.
- 6. Tractor trailer trucks, car carriers and similar vehicles may not be kept on site for a period in excess of 48 hours.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for Special Exception to use the property for a used motor vehicle sales area separated from the sales agency building and the petition for variance to allow parking to be within 0' of the public right of way and to allow display of vehicles to be within 0' of the public right of way in lieu of the required 10' and 15' in front of the 52' front setback respectively.

A site visit was conducted on June 20, 2018. The site is currently utilized as a service garage. Several "U-Haul" vehicles were observed on site.

The Department has no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief conditioned upon the following:

- The plan is not clear as to the disposition of the existing service garage use to include vehicle rentals. Petitioners must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Administrative Law Judge that the combined uses can function successfully within the conditions established in BCZR §502.1. Parking calculations shall account for all uses and calculated accordingly. The plan shall indicate specifically the location and limits of the used motor vehicle sales area, the parking area dedicated to the U-Haul operation and the parking area dedicated to the service garage use.
- There shall be no display of vehicles for sale within the Rte. 40 r-o-w. Install bollards along the Pulaski Highway frontage to provide a separation between the special exception use area and said r-o-w.
- Any storage of damaged or disabled vehicles shall meet the requirements of BCZR §405A.
- Install "Enter only" and "Exit only" signs at appropriate locations along the Rte. 40 frontage.
- There shall be no temporary signage along the Rte. 40 frontage.
- Provide screening in the area of the dumpster to the satisfaction of the Baltimore County Landscape Architect.

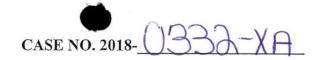

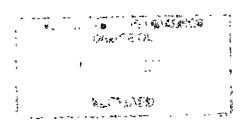

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Amended Order.

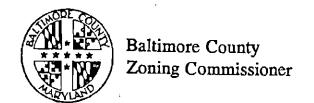

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Hearing filed by the legal owner of the subject property, the Eben limited Partnership and the lessee of the property, "D & L Window Tinting". The special hearing and variance requests involve property located at 10811 Pulaski Highway in the Middle River area of Baltimore County. The Petitioner is requesting permission to amend a previously approved site plan to show the relocation of the existing used car office and existing shed and the proposed extension to the existing service garage. The variance request is to permit a front yard setback of 44 ft. for a used car office and 44 ft. for a proposed addition to the existing service garage on a dual highway in lieu of the required 50 ft. and a 4 ft. setback between existing buildings in lieu of the required 60 ft., and to amend the site plan in Case No. 95.043.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the requests were Wes Gray, representing D & E Window Tinting, Paul Lee, the professional engineer who prepared the site plan of the property, and Frank Borgerding, attorney at law, representing the Petitioner. There were no profestants or others in attendance.

Testimony and evidence indicated that the property, which is the subject of this request, consists of 1.327 acres of land, more or less, zoned BR-AS. The subject property has been used by D & L Window Tinting for many years. They operate a used car sales facility and a window

tinting business at this location. They propose to construct a one-story addition on the existing window tinting building and other modifications as shown on the site plan submitted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit No. 1. In order to proceed with these modifications, the special hearing and variance are necessary.

An area variance may be granted where strict application of the zoning regulations would cause practical difficulty to Petitioners and their property. McLean v. Soley, 270 Md. 208 (1973): To prove practical difficulty for an area variance, the Petitioners must meet the following:

- 1) whether strict compliance with requirement would unreasonably prevent the use of the property for a permitted purpose or render conformance unnecessarily burdensome;
- 2) whether a grant of the variance would do a substantial justice to the applicant as well as other property owners in the district or whether a lesser relaxation than that applied for would give sufficient relief; and,
- 3) whether relief can be granted in such fashion that the spirit of the ordinance will be observed and public safety and welfare secured.

Anderson v. Bd. Of Appeals, Town of Chesapeake Beach, 22 Md. App. 28 (1974).

After due consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, it is clear that practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship will result if the variance and special hearing are not granted. It has been established that special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the property which is the subject of this request and that the requirements from which the Petitioners seek relief will unduly restrict the use of the land due to the special conditions unique to this particular parcel. In addition, the relief requested will not cause any injury to the public health, safety or general welfare, and meets the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing held on the petitions and for the reasons given above, I believe that the special hearing and variance requests should be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the variance request, to permit a front yard setback of 44 ft. for a used car office and 44 ft. for a proposed addition to the existing service garage on a dual highway in lieu of the required 50 ft. and a 4 ft. setback between existing buildings in lieu of the required 60 ft., and to amend the site plan in Case No. 95-043-X, be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

And the Petitioner having satisfied the concern of People's Counsel by filing with the Board an Amended Plat to accompany the Petition for Special Exception;

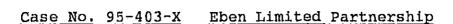
And said Amended Plat specifically limiting the Special Exception relief to the portion of the site as set forth graphically on said Amended Plat and in the text of the General Notes and Comments;

#### FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before the Deputy Zoning Commissioner as a Petition for Special Exception for that property known as 10811 Pulaski Highway, located in the vicinity of White Marsh in Cowenton. The Petition was filed by the owner of the property, Eben Limited Partnership, by Kirk Salvo, and the Contract Purchaser, R. West Gray, II, through their attorney, James A. Pine, Sr., Esquire. The Petitioners seek a special exception for a used motor vehicle outdoor sales area, separate from the sales building. The subject property and relief sought are more particularly described on the site plan submitted and marked into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Appearing at the hearing on behalf of the Petition were R. West Gray, IT, Contract Purchaser, Eugene F. Raphel, Registered Land Surveyor who prepared the site plan for this property, and James A. Pine, Sr., Esquire, attorney for the Petitioners.

Testimony and evidence offered revealed that the subject property consists of 1.327 acres, more or less, zoned B.R.-A.S., and is improved with an automobile window tinting business and macadam paved parking area. The Contract Purchaser wishes to utilize the paved portion of the site for a used motor vehicle outdoor sales area, leaving the rear portion of the site, which is wooded and/or grassy, in its natural state. The Petitioners

will use the existing building as its used automobile sales office and continue to operate the automobile window tinting business therefrom. The Petitioners submitted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibit 3, a copy of the lease agreement for the subject property, which reflects that the only portion of the property that will be used for automobile sales is that which is already improved.

It is clear that the B.C.Z.R. permits the use proposed in a B.R.-A.S. zone by special exception. It is equally clear that the proposed use would not be detrimental to the primary uses in the vicinity. Therefore, it must be determined if the conditions as delineated in Section 502.1 are satisfied.

The Petitioner had the burden of adducing testimony and evidence which would show that the proposed use met the prescribed standards and requirements set forth in Section 502.1 of the B.C.Z.R. The Petitioner has shown that the proposed use would be conducted without real detriment to the neighborhood and would not adversely affect the public interest. The facts and circumstances do not show that the proposed use at the particular location described by Petitioner's Exhibit 1 would have any adverse impact above and beyond that inherently associated with such a special exception use, irrespective of its location within the zone. Schultz v. Pritts, 432 A.2d 1319 (1981).

The proposed use will not be detrimental to the health, safety, or general welfare of the locality, nor tend to create congestion in roads, streets, or alleys therein, nor be inconsistent with the purposes of the property's zoning classification, nor in any other way be inconsistent with the spirit and intent of the B.C.Z.R.

After reviewing all of the testimony and evidence presented, it appears that the special exception should be granted with certain restrictions as more fully described below.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property, and public hearing on this Petition held, and for the reasons given above, the relief requested in the special exception should be granted.

- 1) The Petitioners may apply for their use permit and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, the relief granted herein shall be rescinded.
- 2) Prior to the issuance of any occupancy permits, the Petitioners shall submit a landscape plan for review and approval by the Baltimore County Landscape Architect.
- 3) The special exception granted herein is limited to that portion of the subject property which is already developed, as shown on Petitioner's Exhibit 1. The remaining portion of the site shall remain in its natural, wooded or grassy state.
- 4) When applying for a use permit, the site plan and landscaping plan filed must reference this case and set forth and address the restrictions of this Order.

#### FINAL ORDER

The matter came before the Administrative Law Judge on May 2, 2018, for a hearing on a Code Inspections and Enforcement Citation ("Citation"), for specified violation(s) of the Baltimore County Code or Zoning Regulations. The Citation names the owners of record, as published in the Maryland State Tax Assessment Database, as Respondents. The Citation was served upon Respondent(s) in a manner consistent with Section 3-6-205(c)(2) of the Baltimore County Code ("BCC"). The Citation, which is included in the case file and is incorporated herein by reference, proposes a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,800.00.

The following persons appeared for the Hearing: Kirk Salvo, Respondent/Property Owner, David Cole, Attorney for Mr. Salvo, Mo Jadoo, Respondent/Tenant, Benjamin Hiaasen Attorney for Mr. Jadoo, Robert Ramadka, Complainant, and Assistant County Attorney, Marissa L. Merrick, on behalf of Baltimore County.

Based on the testimony, photographs, documents and other exhibits I find for the reasons stated at the conclusion of the hearing Baltimore County has proven by a preponderance of the evidence that Respondent(s) is in violation of the ordinances or regulations set forth in the civil Citation.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2018, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County that a civil penalty of \$2,800.00 be imposed and suspended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent(s) shall cease outside storage of inoperative vehicles and largest trailer on the property by May 16, 2018.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent(s) shall file for a special exception hearing for all remaining zoning violations by May 16, 2018, and shall continue timely pursuit of the special exception in good faith.

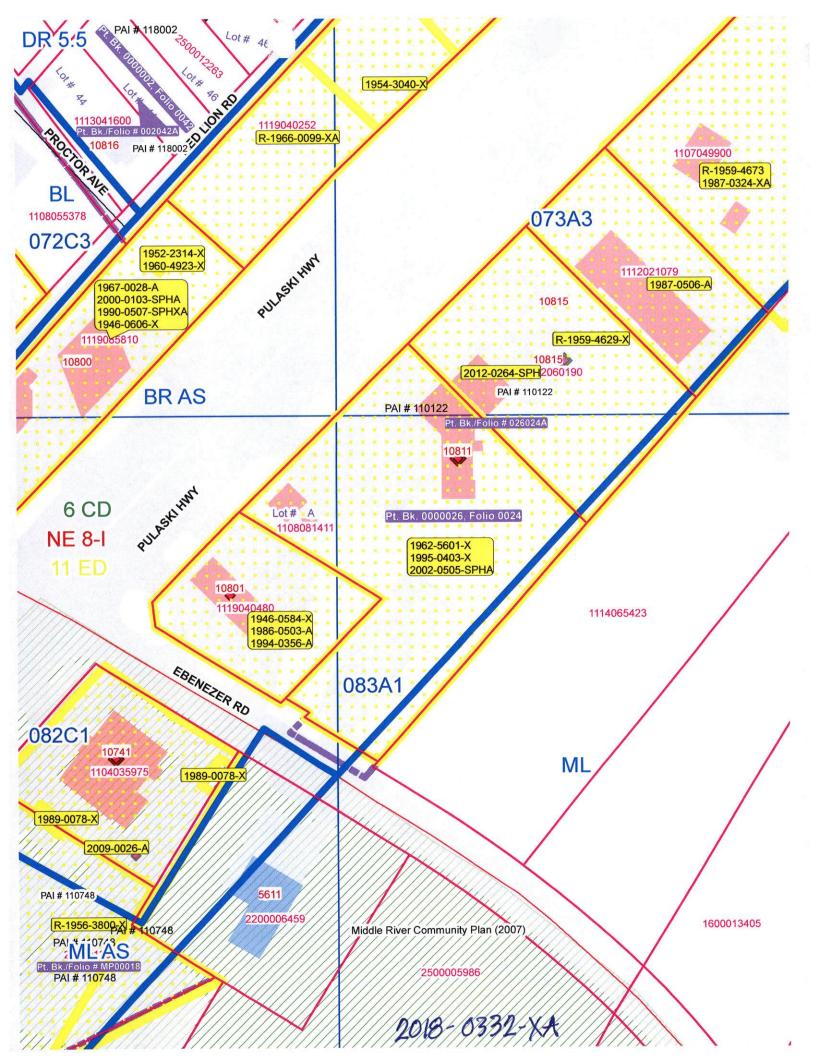

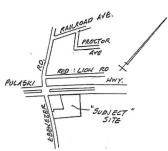
