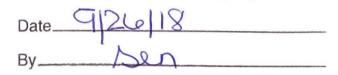

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by Kensington Associates, LLC, the legal owner of the subject property ("Petitioner"). Petitioner is requesting variance relief from the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: (A) Variances requested from Section 450.4 Attachment 1: (1) to permit one (1) wall-mounted enterprise sign affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (sign VV); (2) to permit seven (7) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate customer entrance (signs DD-JJ); (3) to permit six (6) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (signs U, WW, BBB, CCC, DDD and EEE); (4) to permit three (3) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (signs YY, ZZ and AAA); and (5) to permit a joint identification sign to display six (6) lines of text with a sign copy a minimum of five (5) inches in height in lieu of the permitted five (5) lines of text and required eight (8) inch height for sign copy (Sign HHH). (B) Variance requested from Section 450.5.B.1.a: (1) to permit enterprise signs on the non-vertical surface of an awning in lieu of on the vertical surface (signs BBB, CCC, DDD and EEE). (C) Variance requested from Section 450.5.9.c: (1) to permit two (2) signs on a mansard roof with a slope of 15 degrees that project 6.8 feet from their ORDER RECEIVED FOR FILING



surface in lieu of the requirement that the signs project no more than 4 feet from a mansard roof with a slope no less than 30 degrees (signs V and W). A site plan was marked as Petitioner's Exhibit 1.

Professional engineer Michael Gesell appeared in support of the petition. Justin Williams, Esq., represented Petitioner. No Protestants or interested citizens were in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. A substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comment was received from the Department of Planning ("DOP"). That agency did not object to the majority of the variance requests although it expressed concern regarding the size of one proposed sign. That aspect of the ZAC comment will be discussed below.

The site is approximately 11.89 acres in size and zoned BL. The property is improved with a large strip shopping center anchored by a Giant grocery store. There are also several standalone commercial buildings on the site, with banking, medical and office tenants. Petitioner is undertaking a substantial improvement project at the center, and this case concerns signage for the existing and proposed buildings.

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

The subject property has irregular dimensions and is therefore unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioner would experience a practical difficulty because it would be unable to construct the proposed signs. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with

the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of County and/or community opposition.

The DOP indicated it would support a sign (identified on the plan as sign YY) on Building 4 no larger than 12 square feet in area. Mr. Gesell noted the wall-mounted sign would be located at least 150 feet from the dwellings located on the other side of Wilkens Ave. Counsel also noted the proposed sign would be the same size as the 50 sq. ft. sign on that façade containing the address of the building (i.e., "4660 Wilkens Ave"). In these circumstances I do not believe a 50 sq. ft. sign would be excessive, especially considering it will be affixed to a large, 3-story commercial building. I will include a condition below restricting the hours during which the sign may be illuminated, which should help to ensure the sign does not have a negative impact upon nearby homes.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>26th</u> day of September, 2018, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance as follows: (A) Variances requested from Section 450.4 Attachment 1: (1) to permit one (1) wall-mounted enterprise sign affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (sign VV); (2) to permit seven (7) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate customer entrance (signs DD-JJ); (3) to permit six (6) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (signs U, WW, BBB, CCC, DDD and EEE); (4) to permit three (3) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (signs YY, ZZ and AAA); and (5) to permit a joint identification sign to display six (6) lines of text with a sign copy a minimum of five (5) inches in height in lieu of the permitted five (5) lines of text and required eight (8) inch height for sign copy (Sign HHH). Section 450.5.B.1.a: (1) to permit enterprise signs on the non-vertical surface of an awning in lieu of on the vertical surface (signs BBB, CCC, DDD and EEE). (C) Variance requested from Section 450.5.9.c: (1) to permit two (2) signs on a mansard roof with a slope of 15 degrees that project 6.8 feet from their surface in lieu of the requirement that the signs project no more than 4 feet from a mansard roof with a slope no less than 30 degrees (signs V and W), be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- 1. Petitioner may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Sign YY on Building 4 (as shown on the site plan admitted as Petitioner's Exhibit 1) may be illuminated only between the hours of 7 a.m. 8 p.m.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

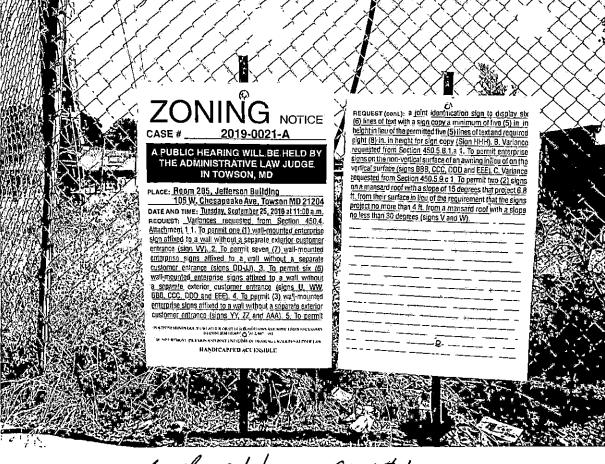

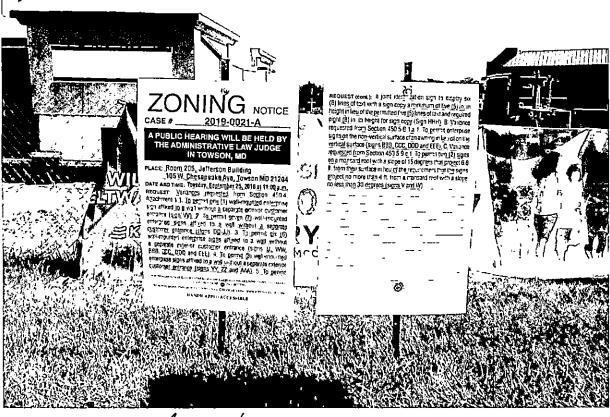

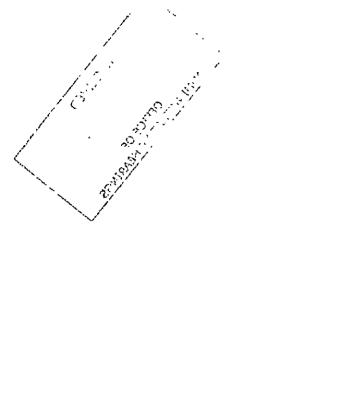

- The Department understands that the two existing freestanding signs on Wilkens Ave. are to be removed. The Department recommends removal occur prior to the issuance of any new sign permits.
- The Department understands that all signage attached to the southwestern façade of Building 3 (DD-II) will be of equal dimensions as shown on materials received by the Department on 9/21/2018. The Department recommends said signs be not more than 12 sq. ft. individually.
- The Department can support a sign YY on Building 4 having a maximum sq. footage of 12 feet
- The Department has no issue with the existing signage on Building 2 provided it is demonstrated that the structural type and location are consistent with BCZR § 450.5.B.7.

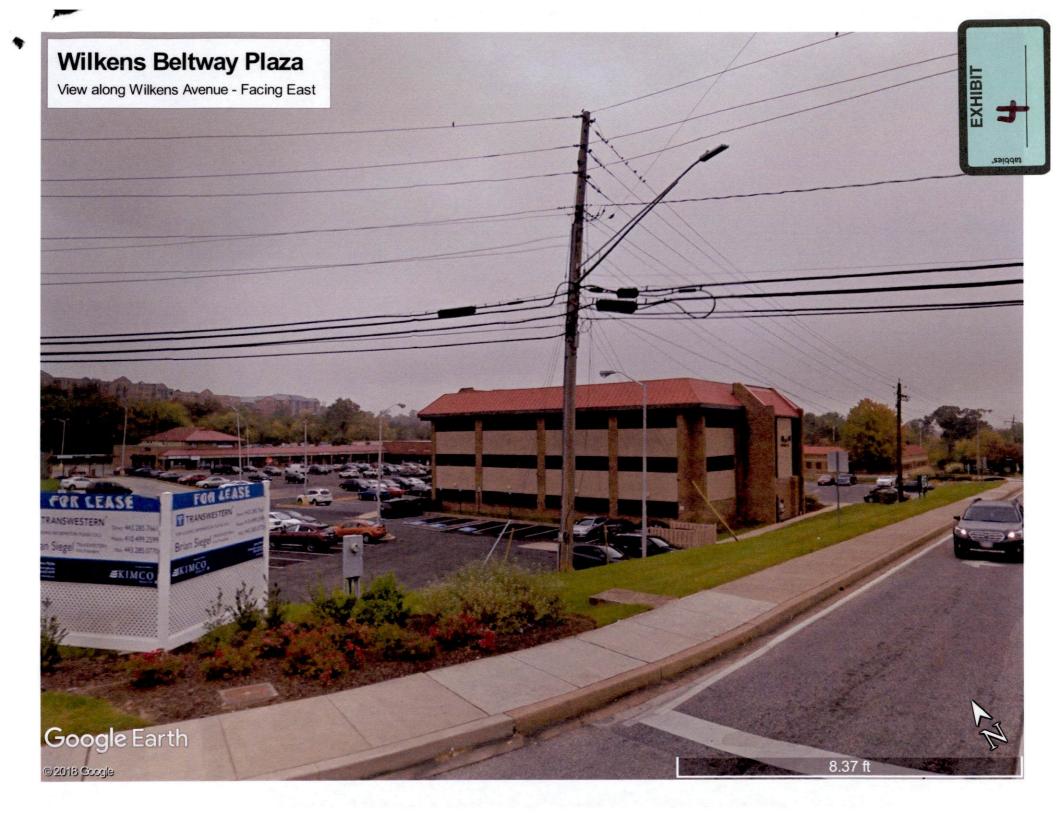

OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for consideration of Petitions for Special Hearing and Variance filed on behalf of Westland Gardens Co., et al., legal owners and J.C. Bar Properties, Inc., contract purchaser ("Petitioners"). The Special Hearing was filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to approve 2 stacking spaces for the drive through facility for a drug store (not including the space next to the transaction window), pursuant to B.C.Z.R. §409.10.A. In addition, a Petition for Variance seeks to allow 58 off street parking spaces in lieu of the required 74 parking spaces. A site plan was marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioners' Exhibit 1.

Andrew Stine, Carl Wilson and Joe Eisenhaner appeared in support of the requests. David H. Karceski, Esq. represented the contract purchaser. There were no protestants or interested citizens in attendance. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received from the Bureau of Development Plans Review (DPR) and the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability (DEPS). Neither agency opposed the requests.

The subject property is approximately 1.97 acres in size and zoned BL. (comprised of 22 individual lots) is improved with several dwellings which will be razed. The property



was zoned for residential use until 2016, at which point it was rezoned to BL during the comprehensive zoning process. Petitioners propose to construct a CVS pharmacy at the site. A pharmacy is permitted by right in the zone, although Petitioners require variance and special hearing relief to construct the proposed improvements.

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SPECIAL HEARING

The special hearing seeks to approve 2 stacking spaces for a drive-through pharmacy window. The Regulations are silent concerning the number of stacking spaces required for a drive-through pharmacy, which is a relatively recent phenomenon. CVS representatives indicated 2 spaces would be sufficient, and a similar request was approved in a previous zoning case involving a CVS pharmacy on Joppa Road. See Case No. 2016-0110-SPHA. As such, the special hearing request will be granted.

VARIANCES

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Petitioners have met this test. The property is irregularly shaped and there is a significant (i.e., 14 ft.) elevation change across the site. As such the property is unique. Petitioners would experience practical difficulty if the regulations were strictly interpreted because they would be unable to operate the new business at the location. Finally, as demonstrated by the lack of County and/or community opposition, I do not believe granting the requests would have a detrimental impact upon the community.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this <u>26th</u> day of April, 2017, by this Administrative Law Judge, that the Petition for Special Hearing filed pursuant to § 500.7 of the Baltimore County Zoning

Regulations ("B.C.Z.R) to approve 2 stacking spaces for the drive-through facility for a drug store (not including the space next to the transaction window), be and is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petition for variance to allow 58 off street parking spaces in lieu of the required 74 parking spaces, be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to and conditioned upon the following:

- Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must submit for approval by Baltimore County landscape and lighting plans for the site.
- 3. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must comply with the forest conservation provisions in the Baltimore County Code.
- 4. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must obtain an entrance permit from the State Highway Administration.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

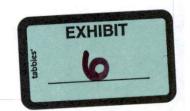
FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by Mike Cardany, agent and authorized signatory on behalf of the legal owner of the subject property, Kensington Associates, LLC, and the proposed contract lessee, Giant of Maryland, LLC, through one of its Senior Managers of Construction, Juan Carlos Vivas, and its attorney, Charles B. Marek, III, Esquire of Gildea and Schmidt, LLC. Petitioner is requesting Variance relief from Section 450.4 Attachment 1.5.d of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit 12 total wall-mounted enterprise signs for the existing Giant supermarket, 11 to be located on the front building face and 1 located on the side building face in lieu of the 1 permitted, and for such other and further relief as may be required by the Zoning Commissioner. The subject property and requested relief are more fully described on the site plan and signage details that were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibits 1 and 2, respectively.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the Petition were Ronald Brumbaugh, Senior Manager of Construction for Giant, Mark Johnston of Gutcheck, Little and Weber, the civil engineer for the project, and Alan Nethen of Gable Signs. Charles B. Marek, III, Esquire represented Petitioner at the hearing. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present

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at the hearing. As a preliminary matter, Mr. Marek requested an amendment to the Petition for Variance to reduce the wall mounted signage by one (1) sign along the front building face. The new request was for ten (10) signs on the front building face and one (1) on the side building face. This amendment, making the matter a lesser variance than requested and published, was granted.

Continuing with the Petition for Variance aspects of the relief requested, Mr. Marek proffered the evidence presented at the hearing, and the proffer and exhibits were accepted into the record of the case. The property in question is the "Wilkens Beltway Plaza" near the intersection of Wilkens Avenue and Maiden Choice Lane. To the north of the center is the Charlestown retirement community, to the west and south are office buildings and to the east is the Our Lady of Victory church and school. The property is accessed by three public streets that dead end into the center, Grouse Court, Pigeon Court and Elm Ridge Avenue. The site is approximately 8 acres and is zoned B.L. The site is improved with a multi-tenant retail building and two stand alone PAD sites. The Giant supermarket is the largest tenant in the site and considered the "anchor" store. In addition to being the anchor store, testimony revealed that Giant has a total of twelve (12) stores in Baltimore County and employs roughly 1200 people. The chain is an important economic driver of the County, as well as the State of Maryland, and works with local businesses and farms.

Giant is going through a global re-imaging of its stores, whereby the longstanding "big G" signage is being replaced with a "fruit-bowl" type logo and associated Giant lettering. As part of this change over from the old trademark to the new, Giant is upgrading not only the sign package, but also has allocated a significant sum to upgrade the interior of these stores. This re-imaging to the "fruit-bowl" logo and associated signage will take place not only in Baltimore County, but across Maryland, Virginia, Delaware any the other markets of Giant.

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Testimony also focused on the aspects particular to the property that make it appropriate for variance relief. The property in question is well hidden and buffered by its surroundings and the significant impaired visibility is noted in the Zoning Advisory Comment from the Office of Planning. The access from three public roads that dead end into the center is unusual as there is no frontage on the collector roads. Additionally, there is a significant grade change moving eastward from Maiden Choice Lane into the site and, combined with the significant vegetation, makes the center barely visible from one of the two traffic bearing roads. Likewise, the sightlines into property are also significantly impaired along Wilkens Avenue by the vegetation and office buildings surrounding the Giant. Pictures taken along Wilkens Avenue and Maiden Choice Lane were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibits 5 and 6 to demonstrate this limitation.

These peculiar aspects of the property work in concert to create a practical difficulty for the supermarket, which is the inability to adequately alert the customers to their presence in the center as well as their multitude of services. This leads to decreased economic vibrancy of the store and the center as a whole. In addition, due to the consolidation of uses under one roof, these stores with large building footprints (i.e. big box) are unable to adequately advertise their services. I believe that the granting of the variance is able to remedy this practical difficulty. Allowing multiple signs will give customers an opportunity to recognize the store from various points along their drive and not just one vantage point.

Moreover, the testimony and evidence also showed that the granting of the variance would be in the spirit and intent of the Zoning Regulations. The sign regulations do attempt to allow stores to adequately advertise their services, and I believe that this relief is in keeping with that and other goals of the signage regulations. Lastly customer recognition and identification of the

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stores is important as this re-imaging is occurring not just in Baltimore County, but throughout all of Giant's operation across counties and states, including Maryland, Virginia, Delaware and the District of Columbia.

The testimony also bears that the granting of the variance will be in the interest of the public. The new sign package will utilize light-emitting-diode (LED) technology for illumination, thereby reducing the energy consumption by roughly ninety percent (90%). The freestanding signage will also assist the flow of traffic as it will alert customers to the presence of the store and give them the time they need to properly and safely adjust their driving to accommodate their supermarket trip.

Finally, the Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. Comments were received from the Office of Planning dated November 5, 2010 which indicates that they have no objection to the requested variance. The modified signage appears to be more attractive than the existing signage. The proposed wall mounted signs will not be highly visible from the public right-of-way.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on the Petitions held, and for the reasons set forth above, the Petition for Variance as amended should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this ______ day of December, 2010 by this Deputy Zoning Commissioner that Petitioner's Variance request from Section 450.4 Attachment 1.5.d of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit 11 total wall mounted enterprise signs for the existing Giant supermarket, 10 to be located on the front building face and 1 located on the side building face in lieu of the 1 permitted be and is hereby **GRANTED**, subject to the following:

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1. Petitioner may apply for permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

II. EXISTING CONDITIONS - TESTIMONY FROM WILLIAM WEGMANN

- 1. Zoning Classification: B.L.
- 2. The Property is known as Wilkens Beltway Plaza and is located in the Arbutus area of Baltimore County. It has a total site area of 11.89 AC (517,869 SF) and is located at the intersection of Wilkens Avenue and Maiden Choice Lane in a mixed-commercial and residential area. The Center is accessed by three public streets that dead end into the center—Grouse Court, Pigeon Court, and Elm Ridge Avenue—and there are



significant grade changes moving northeast from the Maiden Choice Lane and Wilkens Avenue intersection.

- 3. To the immediate north of the center are relatively large forest buffer areas connected with the Charlestown Retirement Community, which is located north of the Property on Maiden Choice Lane. To the further east is the Our Lady of Victory School.
- 4. On the opposite side of Wilkens Avenue (MD Rt. 372), a 111' right-of-way, is a townhome community zoned D.R.10.5, and on the opposite side of Maiden Choice Lane, a county road with right-of-way width up to 100', is the Broadfield townhome community zoned D.R. 16.
- 5. On the opposite corner of the intersection from the Property is a site that was rezoned to B.L. during the 2016 CZMP Process. In Case No. 2017-218-SPHA, special hearing and variance approvals were granted in connection with the construction of a CVS pharmacy at that location.

- 6. Originally developed in the late 1970s and expanded with three low-rise office buildings and a bank facility in subsequent decades, Wilkens Beltway Plaza was somewhat ahead of its time as a suburban mixed-use office/retail center with multiple buildings on the perimeter of the Property.
- 7. The Shopping Center is anchored by a Giant supermarket. In Case No. 2011-137-A, the Deputy Zoning Commissioner granted Giant's request for sign variances to allow for the installation of upgraded signage that was proposed as part of their companywide re-imaging. Two "Giant" logo signs of 158-SF were approved, along with 8 other signs advertising their services/offerings (e.g., a 50-SF "Pharmacy" sign, and an 18-SF "Fresh Picked Produce" sign).

- 8. A couple of years ago, inspections indicated that the Property's easternmost office building, located at 817 Maiden Choice Lane, had structural deficiencies and required significant rehabilitation. Because of the weak demand for office use in this area of Baltimore County, Kimco decided to raze the 817 Maiden Choice Lane building along with the underutilized office building at 4600 Wilkens Avenue and undertake a \$4.5 million project to construct new retail buildings in their place, and make other upgrades to the Center.

i. In the course of the development approval process, Kimco representatives met with the local residential community to present their redevelopment plans. Feedback to the plans and elevations, which included proposed signage, were overwhelmingly positive, and on February 10, 2018, approval of a refinement to the development plan for the Shopping Center was granted.

- iii. The new buildings are shown on the plans as Building 3 and Building 6. Because of the significant grade change from Maiden Choice Lane into the Center, Building 3 has been designed to be entered from the interior of the site.
- iv. As a large mixed-use center at a significant intersection, the County design reviewers requested, and Kimco agreed, to a number of architectural upgrades in the design of Building 3 over what was initially proposed. For example, architectural treatments were added to the building so the rear would not look like a rear of a retail building. Because of the significant grade change, screening was added to the rooftop HVAC units to make the building visually appealing. Construction on Building 3 is 80% complete and is due for mid-October opening.
- v. At this time, Building 6 has not yet been designed and is several years from construction.

III. PROPOSED SIGNAGE/REQUESTED RELIEF – TESTIMONY FROM MICHAEL GESELL

1. The Site Plan in this case was prepared by Michael Gesell, a licensed professional engineer, an expert in the application of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR" or "Zoning Regulations") as to sign regulations. He has previously been qualified as an expert witness in Baltimore County zoning proceedings.

i. Exhibit 8 – Gesell, C.V.

2. The signage shown on the approved elevations requires certain variances, and Kimco submitted the instant request for approval of the variances for the new signage as well as to bring certain existing signage within the center into compliance. The full package of proposed and existing signage is shown on the Site Plan. In addition to new signage on the new buildings, a new freestanding joint-identification sign is proposed along Wilkens Avenue at Pigeon Court. Existing freestanding signs along Wilkens Avenue will be removed. New wall-mounted signs are also proposed on existing Building 4. The proposed signage has been reviewed by the Department of Planning and the local community.

- ii. In response to comments from the Department of Planning, the following changes have been made to the proposed sign package:
 - 1. Signs DD and II have been reduced in size to be consistent with the other signage on the rear façade of Building 3.
 - 2. The existing freestanding signage along Wilkens Avenue is identified as to be removed.

- 3. Regarding the specific relief requested, Petitioners request variance relief from the Zoning Regulations as follows:
 - i. Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 1.5(d)(VI) to permit one (1) wall-mounted enterprise sign affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (sign VV).
 - ii. Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 1.5(d)(VI) to permit seven (7) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate customer entrance (signs DD JJ).
 - iii. Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 1.5(d)(VI) to permit six (6) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (signs U, WW, BBB, CCC, DDD and EEE).
 - iv. Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 1.5(d)(VI) to permit three (3) wall-mounted enterprise signs affixed to a wall without a separate exterior customer entrance (signs YY, ZZ, and AAA).
 - v. Section 450.4 Attachment 1, 1.7(b)(IX) to permit a joint identification sign to display six (6) lines of text with a sign copy a minimum of five (5) inches in height in lieu of the permitted five (5) lines of text and required eight (8) inch height for sign copy (Sign HHH).
 - vi. Section 450.5.B.1.a to permit enterprise signs on the non-vertical surface of an awning in lieu of on the vertical surface (signs BBB, CCC, DDD, and EEE).
 - vii. Section 450.5.9.c to permit two (2) signs on a mansard roof with a slope of 15 degrees that project 6.8 feet from their surface in lieu of the requirement that the signs project no more than 4 feet from a mansard roof with a slope no less than 30 degrees (signs V and W).
 - 1. Per the Department of Planning's revised comment, this sign is not a roof sign, as prohibited by §450.5.B.7. This sign is attached to a mansard roof. The definition of mansard roof contained in Section 450.3 specifically defines it as "an architectural element having a

roof-like appearance which is above a building wall and has a slope of not less than 30 degrees measured from the lowest to the highest point of the mansard. Here, the roof is less than 30 degrees, but is still "mansard" in character and similar to the classic McDonald's mansard roof style.

IV. VARIANCE – LEGAL STANDARDS

1. Mr. Gesell would testify that the Property meets the standard for granting the necessary variances under Section 307.1 of the BCZR and the test in *Trinity Assembly of God v. People's Counsel*, 407 Md. 53, 80 (2008).

2. Legal standards:

BCZR Section 307.1 authorizes the Administrative Law Judge to "grant variances ... from sign regulations ... in cases where special circumstances or conditions exist that are peculiar to the land or structure which is the subject of the variance request and where strict compliance with the Zoning Regulations for Baltimore County would result in practical difficulty or unreasonable hardship... Furthermore, any such variance shall be granted only if in strict harmony with the spirit and intent of said height, area, off-street parking or sign regulations, and only in such manner as to grant relief without injury to public health, safety and general welfare.

3. Uniqueness/Special Circumstances:

As indicated in the Deputy Zoning Commissioner's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in Case No. 2011-137-A, the Property is well-hidden and buffered by its surroundings. The access to the site from three public roads that dead end into the center is unusual as there is no frontage the collector roads. Additionally, the significant grade change from both Maiden Choice Lane and Wilkens Avenue, which causes the site to sit below street level, combined with the significant vegetation on site, makes much of the center barely visible from traffic bearing roads.

4. Practical Difficulty or Hardship:

The unique aspects of the Property work in concert to create a practical difficulty for the tenants of the center, which is the inability to adequately alert the customers to their presence in the center while strictly complying with the sign regulations. This leads to decreased economic vibrancy of the entire mixed-use development. Additionally, if the variances are not granted as to the existing signs, Petition would suffer a hardship, as they would need to violate quiet enjoyment provisions of leases and dismantle signs that have been present for many years without complaint.

5. Spirit and Intent:

The granting of these variances is in harmony with the purpose of the Zoning Regulations. The sign regulations attempt to permit commercial entities to adequately advertise their services; the requested variances are necessary for the various tenants to do so. The significant \$4.5 million capital investment in the center will improve the general welfare of the surrounding neighborhood.

6. Without Injury to Public Health, Safety, and General Welfare:

The granting of the variances will not cause any injury to the public health, safety, or general welfare. The community fully supports the proposed improvements to the center.

V. RESPONSE TO UNADDRESSED PLANNING DEPARTMENT COMMENTS – KIMCO REPRESENTATIVE AND GESELL TESTIMONY

- 1. Per conversations with the Department of Planning following the issuance of their initial comment, the principal concern was the signage proposed on the elevations that face residentially-zoned areas (Building 3 West Elevation, Building 2 West Elevation, and Building 4 South Elevation). After further discussion with the Department of Planning, and following Kimco's agreement to reduce the size of the Building rear facing 3 signage, the Department of Planning's now supports the Building 3 and Building 2 signage variances. Because of the width and character of Maiden Choice Lane, Kimco was amenable to Planning's request to reduce the size of the rear facing signage on Building 3; however, because the south-facing signage on Building 4 (Sign YY) faces Wilkens Avenue, a large state highway, Kimco continues to seek approval of Sign YY at 50-SF as initially proposed.
- 2. Significantly, the residential community has supported the proposed \$4.5 million upgrades to the Center and the proposed signage. Moreover, during the 2016 CZMP, the Planning Staff, Planning Board, and County Council rezoned 3 acres on the southwest corner of Wilkens Avenue and Maiden Choice Lane from DR 5.5 to B.L., reflecting an acknowledgement of the commercialized nature of the intersection. The proposed signage will certainly have less impact on the nearby residential communities than the rezoning of 3 acres from residential to a commercial designation.

3. Sign YY will be similar in size to the existing "address sign" on the south-facing wall of Building 4. Kimco would further agree to a condition that it not be illuminated after business hours.

ii. The speed limit on Wilkens Avenue is 35-miles per hour and motorists would otherwise be unable to see the signage without it being a reasonable size. At 50-SF, Sign YY is the same size as the 50-SF "Giant Pharmacy"

sign and is far smaller than the 158-SF "Giant" logo signs that were all approved by the Deputy Zoning Commissioner in 2011.

4. As stated in §450.1.F of the Sign Regulations, Baltimore County has a substantial interest in promoting the public health, safety, and general welfare by reducing or eliminating excessive and incompatible signage. However, §450.1.B also notes that:

Businesses, small and large, established and new, contribute to Baltimore County's economic welfare by creating jobs and job opportunities, developing underutilized and revitalizing depressed areas, and providing an expanded tax base. Because signage is necessary for the success and growth of businesses in the county, the regulation of signage must reasonably accommodate the needs of the business community.

The office market is weak in this area of the County, and thus, it is necessary to offer office tenants the ability to alert current and potential customers to their presence. Because the space on the lone proposed freestanding joint-identification sign along Wilkens Avenue will be for retail tenants, the office tenants in Building 4 will have no other signage visible to the public.

- 5. A variance to permit Sign YY to have an area of 50 SF is a better alternative to permit a business tenant within Building 4 to advertise itself than other types of signage that would be permitted by right.
 - i. If the tenant for Sign YY had a separate exterior entrance, it would be permitted a sign up to 150 SF by right. Cf., the 77.5-SF MedStar Medical Group sign (Sign SS) on the east elevation of Building 4, which is permitted by right because of its separate ground-level entrance.
 - ii. Additionally, Building 4 is located on a separate parcel from the rest of the Center and would be permitted a large wall-mounted and/or freestanding joint-identification sign, which would be more visually impactful than Sign YY. For example:
 - 1. Building 4 is entitled to install a 25-foot tall, 150-SF freestanding joint-identification sign, and

2. Building 4 is entitled to install a wall-mounted joint identification sign with a maximum sign area of 12% of the wall upon which it is erected. The ±2800-SF wall (±80.1' x ±41.5') would, therefore, accommodate a wall-mounted sign of ±398.90 SF (2800 SF x 12% = 398.90 SF).

- 6. Building 2: The M&T Bank Signs (Signs W and V) are existing and the Petitioner would suffer a hardship if relief were denied, since they would need to dismantle and remove signs that have been present for many years without complaint. Because of the vegetation and grade change, homes in the nearby Broadfield community are not visually impacted by the signs that project a mere additional 2.8 feet from the mansard roof than is otherwise allowed, nor are they impacted by the mansard roof being just 15 degrees flatter than would otherwise be allowed. Each of the signs are 24-SF and are far smaller than the wall-mounted signage that would be permitted by right. For example, a wall-mounted sign on the west elevation could be as large as 78.20-SF by right.

Upon consideration of additional information presented to the Department of Planning by legal representatives for the petitioners, the Department offers these revised comments regarding the above referenced case.

The Department has no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief conditioned upon the following:

- The Department understands that the two existing freestanding signs on Wilkens Ave. are to be removed. The Department recommends removal occur prior to the issuance of any new sign permits.
- The Department understands that all signage attached to the southwestern façade of Building 3 (DD-II) will be of equal dimensions as shown on materials received by the Department on 9/21/2018. The Department recommends said signs be not more than 12 sq. ft. individually.
- The Department can support a sign YY on Building 4 having a maximum sq. footage of 12 feet only.
- The Department has no issue with the existing signage on Building 2 provided it is demonstrated that the structural type and location are consistent with BCZR § 450.5.B.7.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter comes before this Deputy Zoning Commissioner for consideration of a Petition for Variance filed by Mike Cardany, agent and authorized signatory on behalf of the legal owner of the subject property, Kensington Associates, LLC, and the proposed contract lessee, Giant of Maryland, LLC, through one of its Senior Managers of Construction, Juan Carlos Vivas, and its attorney, Charles B. Marek, III, Esquire of Gildea and Schmidt, LLC. Petitioner is requesting Variance relief from Section 450.4 Attachment 1.5.d of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit 12 total wall-mounted enterprise signs for the existing Giant supermarket, 11 to be located on the front building face and 1 located on the side building face in lieu of the 1 permitted, and for such other and further relief as may be required by the Zoning Commissioner. The subject property and requested relief are more fully described on the site plan and signage details that were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibits 1 and 2, respectively.

Appearing at the public hearing in support of the Petition were Ronald Brumbaugh, Senior Manager of Construction for Giant, Mark Johnston of Gutcheck, Little and Weber, the civil engineer for the project, and Alan Nethen of Gable Signs. Charles B. Marek, III, Esquire represented Petitioner at the hearing. There were no Protestants or other interested persons present

at the hearing. As a preliminary matter, Mr. Marek requested an amendment to the Petition for Variance to reduce the wall mounted signage by one (1) sign along the front building face. The new request was for ten (10) signs on the front building face and one (1) on the side building face.

This amendment, making the matter a lesser variance than requested and published, was granted.

Continuing with the Petition for Variance aspects of the relief requested, Mr. Marek proffered the evidence presented at the hearing, and the proffer and exhibits were accepted into the record of the case. The property in question is the "Wilkens Beltway Plaza" near the intersection of Wilkens Avenue and Maiden Choice Lane. To the north of the center is the Charlestown retirement community, to the west and south are office buildings and to the east is the Our Lady of Victory church and school. The property is accessed by three public streets that dead end into the center, Grouse Court, Pigeon Court and Elm Ridge Avenue. The site is approximately 8 acres and is zoned B.L. The site is improved with a multi-tenant retail building and two stand alone PAD sites. The Giant supermarket is the largest tenant in the site and considered the "anchor" store. In addition to being the anchor store, testimony revealed that Giant has a total of twelve (12) stores in Baltimore County and employs roughly 1200 people. The chain is an important economic driver of the County, as well as the State of Maryland, and works with local businesses and farms.

Giant is going through a global re-imaging of its stores, whereby the longstanding "big G" signage is being replaced with a "fruit-bowl" type logo and associated Giant lettering. As part of this change over from the old trademark to the new, Giant is upgrading not only the sign package, but also has allocated a significant sum to upgrade the interior of these stores. This re-imaging to the "fruit-bowl" logo and associated signage will take place not only in Baltimore County, but across Maryland, Virginia, Delaware any the other markets of Giant.

Testimony also focused on the aspects particular to the property that make it appropriate for variance relief. The property in question is well hidden and buffered by its surroundings and the significant impaired visibility is noted in the Zoning Advisory Comment from the Office of Planning. The access from three public roads that dead end into the center is unusual as there is no frontage on the collector roads. Additionally, there is a significant grade change moving eastward from Maiden Choice Lane into the site and, combined with the significant vegetation, makes the center barely visible from one of the two traffic bearing roads. Likewise, the sightlines into property are also significantly impaired along Wilkens Avenue by the vegetation and office buildings surrounding the Giant. Pictures taken along Wilkens Avenue and Maiden Choice Lane were marked and accepted into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibits 5 and 6 to demonstrate this limitation.

These peculiar aspects of the property work in concert to create a practical difficulty for the supermarket, which is the inability to adequately alert the customers to their presence in the center as well as their multitude of services. This leads to decreased economic vibrancy of the store and the center as a whole. In addition, due to the consolidation of uses under one roof, these stores with large building footprints (i.e. big box) are unable to adequately advertise their services. I believe that the granting of the variance is able to remedy this practical difficulty. Allowing multiple signs will give customers an opportunity to recognize the store from various points along their drive and not just one vantage point.

Moreover, the testimony and evidence also showed that the granting of the variance would be in the spirit and intent of the Zoning Regulations. The sign regulations do attempt to allow stores to adequately advertise their services, and I believe that this relief is in keeping with that and other goals of the signage regulations. Lastly customer recognition and identification of the stores is important as this re-imaging is occurring not just in Baltimore County, but throughout all of Giant's operation across counties and states, including Maryland, Virginia, Delaware and the District of Columbia.

The testimony also bears that the granting of the variance will be in the interest of the public. The new sign package will utilize light-emitting-diode (LED) technology for illumination, thereby reducing the energy consumption by roughly ninety percent (90%). The freestanding signage will also assist the flow of traffic as it will alert customers to the presence of the store and give them the time they need to properly and safely adjust their driving to accommodate their supermarket trip.

Finally, the Zoning Advisory Committee (ZAC) comments were received and are made part of the record of this case. Comments were received from the Office of Planning dated November 5, 2010 which indicates that they have no objection to the requested variance. The modified signage appears to be more attractive than the existing signage. The proposed wall mounted signs will not be highly visible from the public right-of-way.

Pursuant to the advertisement, posting of the property and public hearing on the Petitions held, and for the reasons set forth above, the Petition for Variance as amended should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this _____ day of December, 2010 by this Deputy Zoning Commissioner that Petitioner's Variance request from Section 450.4 Attachment 1.5.d of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("B.C.Z.R.") to permit 11 total wall mounted enterprise signs for the existing Giant supermarket, 10 to be located on the front building face and 1 located on the side building face in lieu of the 1 permitted be and is hereby **GRANTED**, subject to the following:

1. Petitioner may apply for permits and be granted same upon receipt of this Order; however, Petitioner is hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at its own risk until such time as the 30-day appellate process from this Order has expired. If, for whatever reason, this Order is reversed, Petitioner would be required to return, and be responsible for returning, said property to its original condition.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

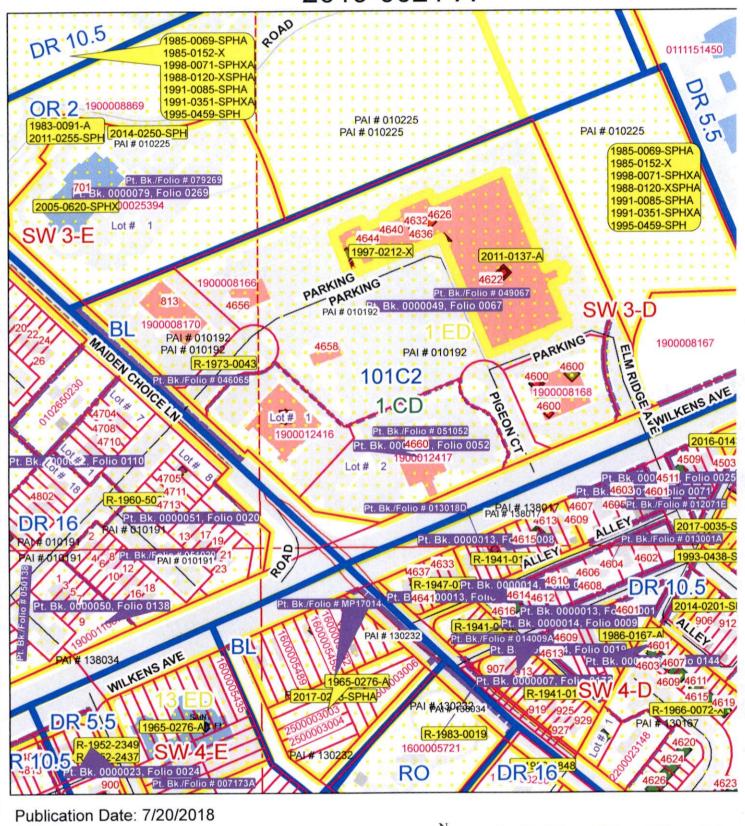

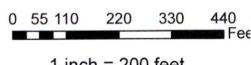

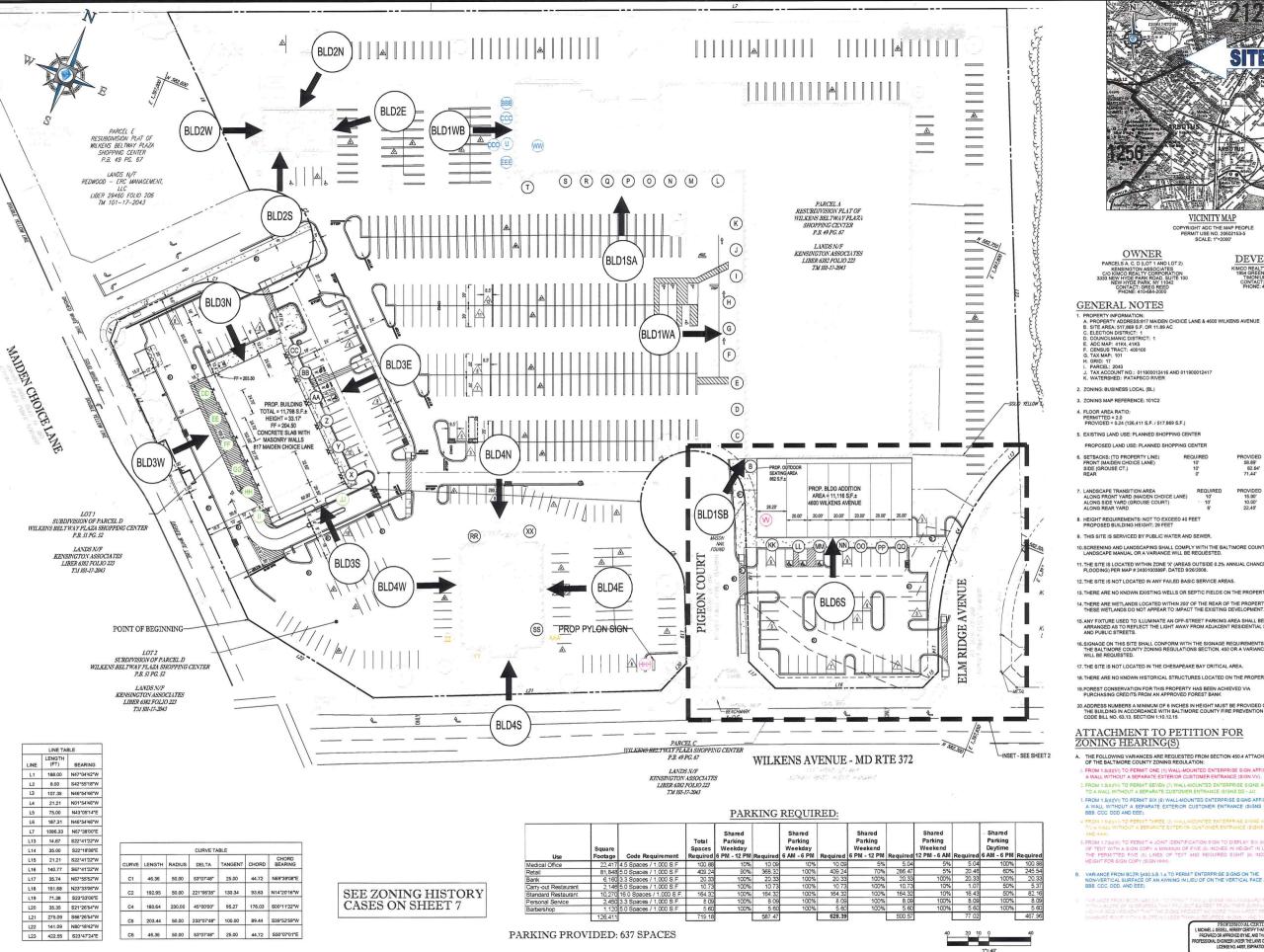

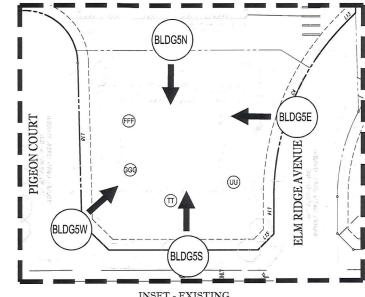

MAIDEN CHOICE ELEVATION

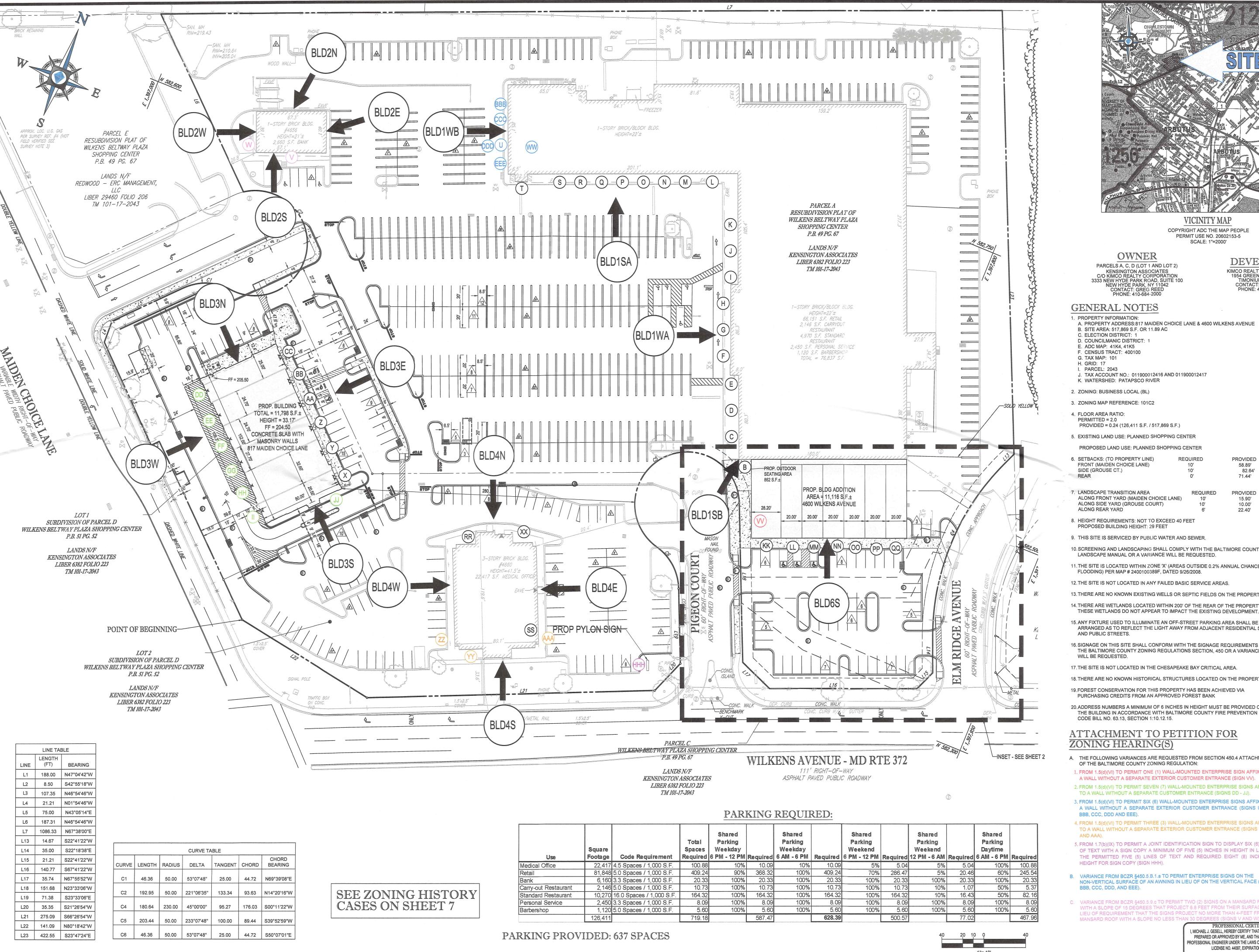




WILKENS BLVD ELEVATION

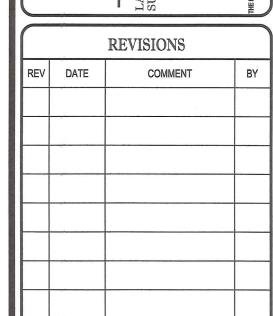

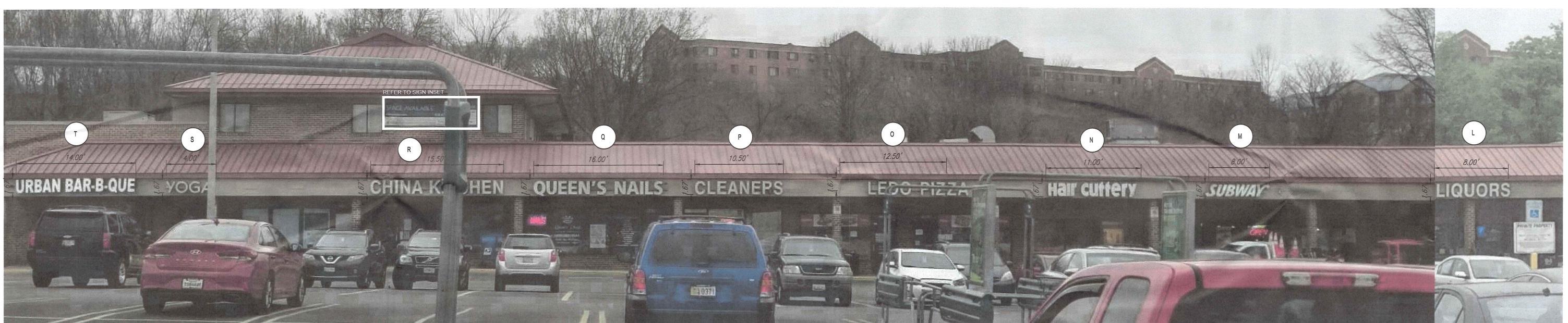

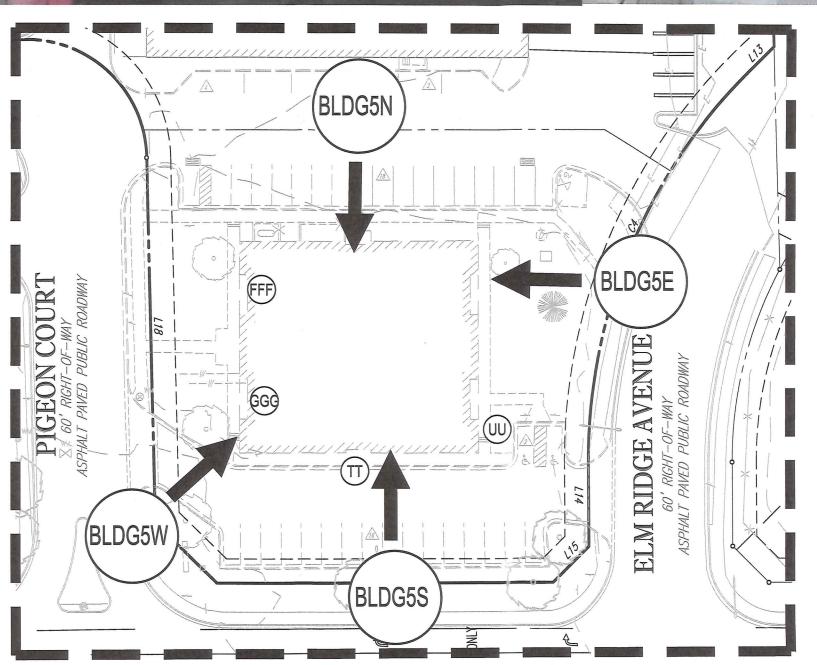


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BUILDING 1 WESTELEVATION (BLD1WB) NOT TO SCALE

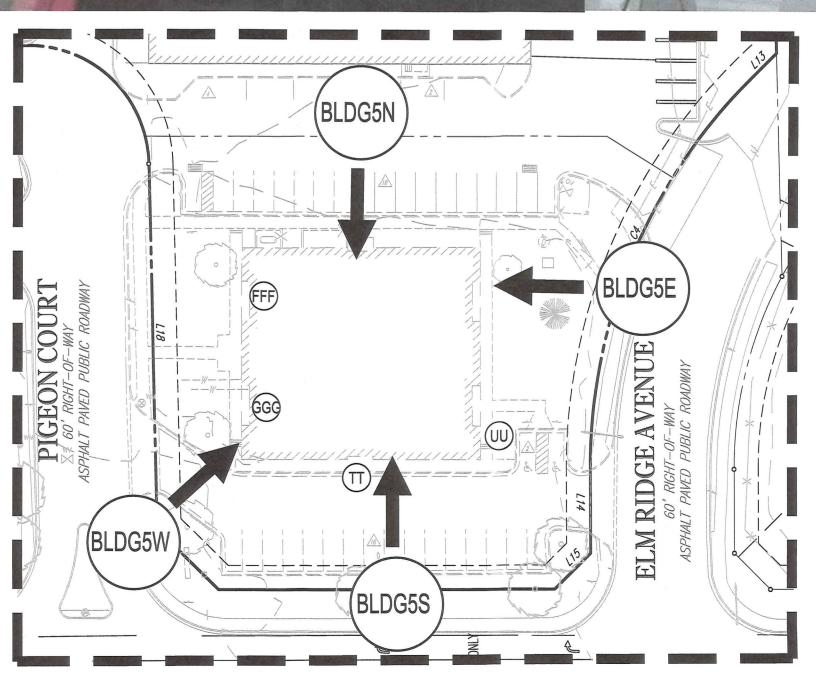

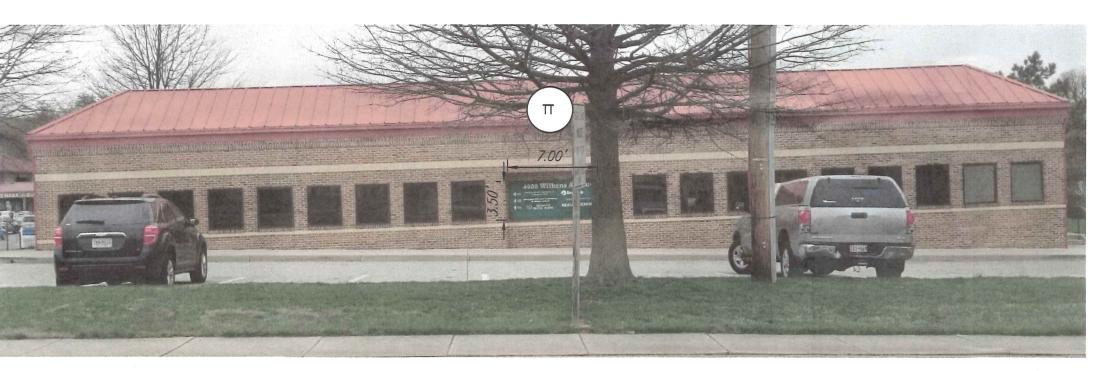
