OPINION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") for Baltimore County as a Petition for Variance filed by Baltimore County, legal owner of the subject property and TLR Land Ventures, LLC ("TLR"), lessee/contract purchaser ("Petitioners"). Petitioners are requesting variance relief from Section 238 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations ("BCZR") as follows: (1) to allow a 0 ft. side yard setback in lieu of the 30 ft. side yard setback; (2) to allow a floor area ratio of 2.4 in lieu of the maximum floor area ratio of 2.0; and (3) to allow buildings to be located as close as 30 ft. to each other in lieu of providing the required side yard setback of 60 ft. (*i.e.*, 30 ft. for each building). A two-sheet site plan was marked as Petitioners' Exhibit 1A & B.

Professional engineer Kristy Bischoff and Mitch Kellman appeared in support of the petition. Patricia A. Malone, Esq. and Chris Mudd, Esq. represented Petitioners. Eric Rockel, president of the Greater Timonium Community Council, Inc. (GTCC) attended the hearing to obtain additional information regarding the request. The Petition was advertised and posted as required by the BCZR. Substantive Zoning Advisory Committee ("ZAC") comments were received from the Department of Public Works ("DPW") and the Department of Planning ("DOP"). Neither agency opposed the requests. The site is approximately 5.079 acres in size and zoned ML-IM. The property is owned by Baltimore County and is currently used for parking at the Timonium Light Rail Station. The property will be leased to TLR (with an option to purchase) who will in turn sublease the property to Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of the Mid-Atlantic States, Inc. ("Kaiser"). Kaiser plans to construct a multi-story 227,000 sq. ft. health care facility at the site, including a garage with 1,036 parking spaces. While the garage will be used primarily for patients visiting the Kaiser facility, Petitioners indicated it will be made available for public parking on certain dates with special or large event (*E.g.*, a Ravens game).

A variance request involves a two-step process, summarized as follows:

- (1) It must be shown the property is unique in a manner which makes it unlike surrounding properties, and that uniqueness or peculiarity must necessitate variance relief; and
- (2) If variance relief is denied, Petitioner will experience a practical difficulty or hardship.

Cromwell v. Ward, 102 Md. App. 691 (1995).

Cromwell and similar cases emphasize that it is the physical attributes of the property itself which must be examined to determine if a variance is justified. The subject property contains environmental features (including a riverine floodplain) which constrain the building envelope. As such, the property is unique. If the Regulations were strictly interpreted Petitioners would experience a practical difficulty because they would be unable to construct the facility. Finally, I find that the variance can be granted in harmony with the spirit and intent of the BCZR, and in such manner as to grant relief without injury to the public health, safety and general welfare. This is demonstrated by the absence of County and/or community opposition.

In its initial ZAC comment the DPW indicated there is a riverine flood plain on the subject property, and it requested Petitioners to provide a flood plain study before obtaining zoning relief.

But in a revised comment dated October 2, 2018, the DPW noted a flood plain study is in the process of being prepared and Petitioners anticipated submitting it to the DPW by the end of the year. The DPW advised this was acceptable and recognized the zoning request was filed based on the "approximate floodplain."

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, this <u>10th</u> day of October, 2018, by the Administrative Law Judge for Baltimore County, that the Petition for Variance: (1) to allow a 0 ft. side yard setback in lieu of the 30 ft. side yard setback; (2) to allow a floor area ratio of 2.4 in lieu of the maximum floor area ratio of 2.0; and (3) to allow buildings to be located as close as 30 ft. to each other in lieu of providing the required side yard setback of 60 ft. (30 ft. for each building), be and is hereby GRANTED.

The relief granted herein shall be subject to the following:

- Petitioners may apply for necessary permits and/or licenses upon receipt of this Order. However, Petitioners are hereby made aware that proceeding at this time is at their own risk until 30 days from the date hereof, during which time an appeal can be filed by any party. If for whatever reason this Order is reversed, Petitioners would be required to return the subject property to its original condition.
- 2. Petitioners must comply with the ZAC comment submitted by the DOP, a copy of which is attached.
- 3. Prior to issuance of permits Petitioners must submit for approval by Baltimore County landscape and lighting plans for the site.

Any appeal of this decision must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

This is a Special Hearing to approve certain zoning issues.

The plan provided initially showed a 16'x16' Box Culvert that goes under Interstate 83. This culvert as labeled on the plan appears to discharge directly into the site. A culvert of this size typically conveys a large drainage area and an abundance of flow. Upon further review, we determined that this is not a culvert at all but may have been a tunnel for private vehicular traffic for an abandoned road labeled Zink Road. This theory is consistent with Baltimore County Drawings 1977-0127 and 1991-0581. With this information we can assume that the site may have a flood plain on it only at Goodwin Run as shown on the plan submitted.

After the Department of Public Works and the Bureau of Development Plan Review issued their Zoning Advisory Comments, Petitioner contacted the Department of Public Works to confirm that a floodplain study is in the process of being conducted. The study should be submitted by the end of the year. Petitioner has filed this zoning request based on an approximate floodplain.

The Department of Public Works and Petitioner have agreed that the floodplain study will be required before any building permits are issued for the proposed buildings. This study will determine the need, if any, for a FEMA map revision.

The Department of Public Works feels that the engineer has provided sufficient documentation to proceed with the Special Hearing without providing a flood study as previously requested in Interoffice Correspondence dated August 23, 2018.

The Administration is requesting approval of a ground lease with TLR Land Ventures, LLC (the tenant) for an approximate 5-acre parcel located on the east side of Greenspring Drive, between Timonium Road and Padonia Road, to support redevelopment of underutilized impervious area in an area with tremendous public infrastructure, to increase the County's tax base, and to create jobs. The lease is for 6 years with the option to renew for 13 additional 7-year terms plus one additional 2-year term. The lease also provides the tenant with the option to purchase the property. The County will charge a nominal rent of \$1 per year for the entire 99-year lease term. See Exhibit A.

Fiscal Summary

\$1 nominal rent per year for the entire 99-year lease term. The tenant will pay fair market value to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the State Highway Administration (SHA) (90% of the proceeds will go to the FHWA and 10% will go to SHA). The Administration anticipates significant economic benefits to the County.

Analysis

The County owns two parcels located on the east and west sides of Greenspring Drive, between Timonium Road and Padonia Road. The portion of the property east of Greenspring Drive is currently subject to a license agreement between the County and the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) for use as parking, including access to both MTA's bus transit and light rail station. The County desires to lease to the tenant a portion of the property currently used as parking to support the MTA station for purposes of redeveloping the leased area. The tenant

initially intends to construct a commercial development containing an office building of at least 100,000 sq. ft. of floor area plus dedicated structured parking for the building.

According to the lease, the property was acquired/improved using federal funding. In order to comply with the terms of the federal funding, the MTA, State Highway Administration (SHA), the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT), and the County have determined that the County should convey title of the majority of the property back to SHA. Meanwhile, MDOT, the MTA, and the SHA are evaluating, together with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the total number of parking spaces that must remain on the property in light of the anticipated displacement of existing parking to accommodate this lease. The precise portion of the property the County will lease to the tenant will be determined from the parking evaluation. The leased area will include the approximately 5-acre area shown and indicated as "Leased Property" on the Preliminary Subdivision Plan attached as Exhibit B. The Administration advised that it will determine the final description of the premises after completing a boundary survey, which is underway and will be complete prior to the effective date.

The lease indicates that the tenant, County, MDOT, MTA, SHA, and FHWA (the Parties) are negotiating a Consent Agreement that outlines the Parties' respective obligations regarding the disposition and improvement of the property. The Consent Agreement will replace the License Agreement once all parties approve it. Consent Agreement approval must occur within 45 days of the County Council's approval of the lease. Neither agreement is final until fully approved by the Maryland Board of Public Works (BPW).

The lease states that prior to its execution, the Parties consulted with MTA, and the County has received the required written limited consent from the MTA to enter into it.

Additionally, the lease indicates that the Parties understand and agree that due to the requirements of the federal funding, the County is not entitled to any value derived from the private (e.g., non-governmental) use of the property because the FHWA is entitled to 90% of such funds, and the SHA is entitled to the remaining 10%. The FHWA and SHA are obtaining appraisals to determine the fair market value of the premises, which the tenant anticipates paying within 60 days after the Consent Agreement becomes effective. The Administration advised that the tenant will be paying the fair market value for the land to the State during the initial 2 years of the lease in order to clear the property from the federal funding restrictions and enable the project to move forward.

April 16, 2018

The lease is for 6 years and will automatically renew for 13 additional 7-year terms and 1 additional 2-year term unless the tenant provides 60 days prior written notice. Base rent will be \$1 per year. The tenant shall pay all real property taxes, assessments, water and sewer charges, utilities, excises, levies, license and permit fees, and any other charges associated with the operation of the premises. The Administration advised that based upon a similar medical office building of the same square footage, estimated annual property taxes would total \$228,000. In addition, the tenant will be responsible for grounds maintenance, including sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, shrubbery, grass mowing, and upkeep of the general appearance of the premises. The lease requires the County's written consent for the tenant to assign the lease or to sublease the premises; however, assignment or sublease to an affiliate of the tenant will be effective upon written notice to the County. The tenant may terminate the lease by providing 180 days' notice from the lease date. Additionally, the lease shall automatically terminate unless all lease conditions are satisfied within 45 days of Council approval of the lease.

The lease provides the tenant with the option to purchase the property pursuant to Section 3-9-107(c) of the Baltimore County Code. This Code section states that leased property declared as surplus may be sold to a lessee who has leased the property continuously for a period of not less than 2 years before the property was declared surplus. Accordingly, the lease provides that within 60 days following the second anniversary of the effective date, the County will initiate the process of declaring the property surplus. Once this process is completed, the tenant will have the option to purchase the property. The purchase price will be determined based on two independent appraisals of the property, one selected by the County and one by the tenant. In the event the two appraisals are not within ten percent of each other, the Parties shall negotiate a fair purchase price; otherwise the Parties will obtain a third appraisal and the purchase price will be the average of the three appraisals. According to the Administration, the appraised fair market value at the time of the potential purchase from the County will be adjusted by the verified amount of payment made to the State/FHWA.

Section 3-9-110 of the Baltimore County Code states that "[i]n furtherance of public purposes, the county administration may lease property owned by the county." The Administration advised that the public purpose of the proposed lease is to support redevelopment of underutilized impervious area in an area with tremendous public infrastructure, to increase the tax base, and to create jobs.

The lease is subject to the advertising requirements of Section 3-9-110 of the Baltimore County Code.

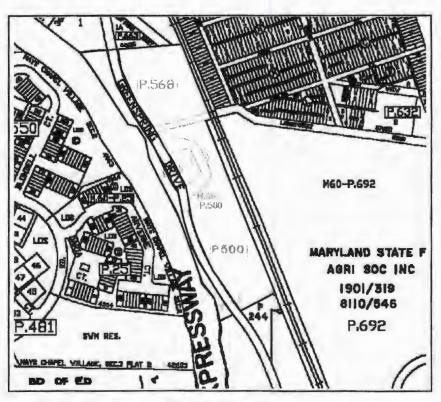

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for variance to allow proposed non-residential structures to have a 0' side yard setback, a floor area ratio of 2.4 and buildings to be located as close as 30 feet to each other in lieu of the required 30 foot side yard setback, 2.0 floor area ratio and 60' between buildings.

A site visit was conducted on August 22, 2018. The site is currently a parking facility serving bus, light rail and park and ride and falls within the Hunt Valley/Timonium Plan (HV/T Plan) area as adopted by County Council October 19, 1998.

The Hunt Valley/Timonium Plan predicted that "The next stage of land development within the employment area of the HV/T is likely to consist of redevelopment of existing lower value employment uses, modernization of now 'middle-aged' office and industrial buildings, and development of the area's remaining vacant parcels of land" (HV/T Plan Pg. 3). To this end the goals of the plan include: "Encourage development and redevelopment consistent with the goals and objectives; minimize the impact of redevelopment on existing manufacturing uses; encourage land uses that utilize light rail; establish design and amenity guidelines for development; strengthen access to the light rail from the surrounding employment, commercial and residential areas; and provide and improve opportunities for pedestrian and bicycle access throughout the HV/T area" (HV/T Plan Pgs. 3&4).

This plan establishes the importance of design quality in creating and maintaining a high quality visual and functional environment through the use of high quality architectural design and finish materials and extensive tree plantings. The significance of these design qualities to Baltimore County in assuring a high quality consistent design in the Hunt Valley/ Timonium area is re-enforced by their inclusion into the Comprehensive Manual for Development Policies (CMDP).

The Department has no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief conditioned upon the following:

- The architectural design and finish materials for all facades of all structures, to include the parking garage, shall respond positively to the Hunt Valley/ Timonium Design Guidelines established for buildings within the CMDP.
- Any landscape plan submitted to the Baltimore County Landscape Architect for approval shall
 reflect the screening and buffering guidelines in said CMDP. A successful plan will continue the
 landscape character of the projects directly to the north including 9475 Greenspring Drive and
 Deerco One and repeat the tree lined nature found on Greenspring Drive/Deerco Road to the
 south.
- The project will provide interior and exterior amenity areas for employees and visitors.
- The project will provide an attractive and functional access and wayfaring signage to light rail to encourage employees of this project and adjacent employment areas to utilize the light rail.

The Department of Planning has reviewed the petition for variance to allow proposed non-residential structures to have a 0' side yard setback, a floor area ratio of 2.4 and buildings to be located as close as 30 feet to each other in lieu of the required 30 foot side yard setback, 2.0 floor area ratio and 60' between buildings.

A site visit was conducted on August 22, 2018. The site is currently a parking facility serving bus, light rail and park and ride and falls within the Hunt Valley/Timonium Plan (HV/T Plan) area as adopted by County Council October 19, 1998.

The Hunt Valley/Timonium Plan predicted that "The next stage of land development within the employment area of the HV/T is likely to consist of redevelopment of existing lower value employment uses, modernization of now 'middle-aged' office and industrial buildings, and development of the area's remaining vacant parcels of land" (HV/T Plan Pg. 3). To this end the goals of the plan include: "Encourage development and redevelopment consistent with the g_{2a} is and objectives; minimize the impact of redevelopment on existing manufacturing uses; encourage land uses that utilize light rail; establish design and amenity guidelines for development; strengthen access to the light rail from the surrounding employment, commercial and residential areas; and provide and improve opportunities for pedestrian and bicycle access throughout the HV/T area" (HV/T Plan Pgs. 3&4).

This plan establishes the importance of design quality in creating and maintaining a high quality visual and functional environment through the use of high quality architectural design and finish materials and extensive tree plantings. The significance of these design qualities to Baltimore County in assuring a high quality consistent design in the Hunt Valley/ Timonium area is re-enforced by their inclusion into the Comprehensive Manual for Development Policies (CMDP).

The Department has no objection to granting the petitioned zoning relief conditioned upon the following:
